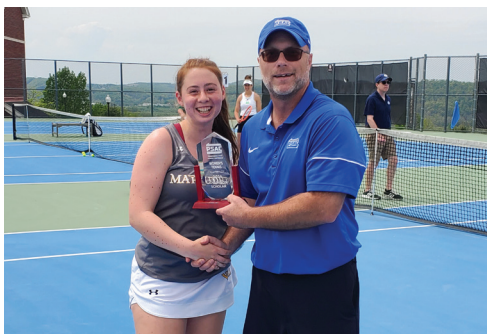

NEW DIRECTOR OF ATHLETICS



After a nationwide search, Millersville University announced on Feb. 29 that **Kate Corcoran** will be the next director of athletics. Corcoran comes to the 'Ville from Cabrini University, where she served as vice president

of athletics and student engagement.

"Kate's leadership experience in the areas of athletics and student engagement will benefit our student-athletes," says Dr. Gail Gasparich, Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs at Millersville. "Having an equal commitment to our students' athletic endeavors and academic experiences will ensure our students benefit from all aspects of their college experience at Millersville University."

At Cabrini, Corcoran provided leadership in the areas of the student-athlete experience, including residence life, student engagement and leadership, counseling and psychological services, and health services. She also designed,

implemented, managed and evaluated Cabrini's 18 intercollegiate athletics programs and oversaw the budget.

"I am excited and grateful to be joining Millersville University and leading Millersville Athletics," says Corcoran. "My sincere thanks to President Wubah, Dr. Gasparich, Dr. Lynn Marquez and the entire search committee for trusting me with this role. Throughout the entire process, I was very impressed by the student-athletes, staff, coaches and individuals I met at Millersville. Their commitment to each other, the student-athletes, and the passion they have for Millersville Athletics were palpable. I am excited to join the Marauder community and look forward to the journey, working with the coaches and staff to provide a quality and successful student-athlete experience."

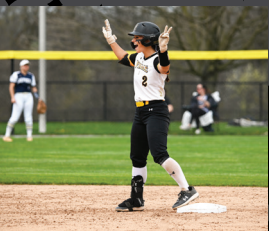
Corcoran had been with Cabrini since 2016, when she started as senior associate director of athletics and senior women's administrator. In 2021, she was named director of athletics and recreation and became vice president of athletics and student engagement in 2022. During her time at Cabrini, the men's lacrosse program won the 2019 NCAA Division III Championship, and the department totaled 41 CSAC and Atlantic East Conference championships in six years. Eleven programs reached NCAA Tournament play. She successfully

raised funds for several facility enhancement projects, and she launched the department's first week of giving that has since topped its goal in each of the last three years. She has also served on numerous NCAA committees.

"We will look to provide a quality student-athlete experience that includes striving for competitive and academic excellence," says Corcoran. "Millersville Athletics is positioned to be successful not only in the PSAC but regionally and nationally, and my focus will be to further build on the success the Marauder community has achieved. The experience we provide will prepare our student-athletes for life after Millersville and set them up to be successful in their chosen career path.

"As the director of athletics, I plan to be very visible and collaborative not only with our coaches, staff and student-athletes but across the entire campus as well." "I believe it is important to listen and interact with the community so we can better serve our student-athletes as we strive to push our department forward."

Corcoran earned a bachelor's degree in sport management/business administration from DeSales University and a master's degree in business administration from Rosemont College.

TEAM HIGHLIGHTS

CROSS COUNTRY

Behind All-PSAC runs from Morgan Janiuk and Hannah Sweda, the cross country team placed sixth at the PSAC Championships for its best finish since 2010. Janiuk was the first Marauder to finish in the top 10 since 2010. It was a dramatic turnaround for the team, which placed 13th the year prior. Millersville also jumped eight spots at the NCAA Atlantic Regional, placing sixth out of 25 teams for the best finish in 13 years. "Our team was on a mission in 2023 to get better," says coach Andy Young. "These women were hungry to improve our results after a bit of a disappointment in 2022, so our team culture and work ethic were very on point. With 10 of our top 12 athletes returning and some new additions to the team, this group is excited to make some noise in 2024."

FIELD HOCKEY

The Marauders started the season strong, winning four of their first five games and owning a goal differential of +14. In one stretch, Millersville earned three straight wins, including head coach Shelly Behrens' 200th win as the Marauders head coach, and capping off the winning streak was a road win against West Chester, Millersville's first in 10 years. However, the Marauders' luck took a turn for the worse late in the season, as they dropped three of their last four games by one goal, including an overtime nonconference loss and a shootout loss that knocked them out of postseason contention. "The 2023 season is how we learned what not to do, and how good we can be with sharper execution overall," says coach Shelly Behrens. "It was a season of close calls and near misses, and it is up to us to learn and get better in 2024."

FOOTBALL

A season with high hopes and a fast start was ultimately derailed

by injuries and near misses. The Marauders won the first two games of the season and started 3-1, with its only loss coming on the road against nationally ranked Slippery Rock. In week four, the Marauders beat West Chester for the first time in 21 years, giving them their best start in 20 years. But a one-score, late-game loss to Lock Haven the following week started a slide that the Marauders could not stop. Starting quarterback Rob Footman Jr. missed several games, as did All-PSAC East running back Jaheim Morris. Millersville lost four games by seven points or fewer, and dropped close games late to nationally ranked Shepherd and eventual PSAC champion Kutztown.

MEN'S SOCCER

Millersville returned to the PSAC's pinnacle with a dominating season that included a PSAC East title, the program's fourth PSAC Championship in five seasons, and a home match in the NCAA Tournament. Bob Hennessey, the PSAC Tournament MVP and PSAC

East Athlete of the Year, set a PSAC postseason record with four goals in the semifinal win over West Chester. Aaron Maynard, the PSAC East Defensive Athlete of the Year, led the defense, which allowed just four goals in the final 10 matches. Both Maynard and Hennessey were named All-America First Team. Maynard was named CSC Academic All-America, and senior Mike Kreider was selected as the PSAC Champion Scholar. Coach Steve Widdowson won his fifth Coach of the Year award from the PSAC. "The 2023 season was a memorable one for our program not just because we were able to win another PSAC Championship but because it was done with a great group of people and players that truly enjoyed working together and for each other. The enjoyment we had and the experiences we shared allowed us to prove wrong a lot of people who doubted us, and this made the championship that much sweeter when it was won. The 2023 team was a tribute to the University, our program and our alumni."

WOMEN'S SOCCER

Goalkeeper Bella Fiorenza was twice recognized as the PSAC East Defensive Athlete of the Week and helped the Marauders to impressive wins over West Chester and East Stroudsburg. Graduate student Kylie Sullivan was also a key member of the defensive back line and earned All-PSAC East Second Team honors for the second time. Isabel Coy, also an Athlete of the Week honoree, was an All-PSAC East Second Team pick. Aalivia Wainwright led the team in goals and points. "Our seniors have had a massive impact on our program, especially those returning for fifth years," says coach Matt Procopio. "We will miss them and wish them all the best in future successes. Now, the younger players must use the knowledge learned from the seniors to develop the program, take the lead and provide the same opportunity for those joining us next fall."

WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL

2023 was a year of growth for the Marauders, who entered the season

with 13 newcomers and finished just short of the playoffs in head coach Brian Smith's 14th season at the helm. Smith tallied his 200th career victory during the campaign, while junior Emma Ludwig and sophomore Taylor Welter each earned All-PSAC East Second Team nods. "The 2023 season was year one of a team rebuild," said Coach Smith. "We lost seven seniors from 2022, started five freshmen in three of our six rotations and never had less than three on the court at once. The future looks promising, as our young team got plenty of playing time and learned lots of lessons. We've seen steady improvement in our weak areas across the board and look forward to getting back at it this fall."

MEN'S BASKETBALL

Millersville shared the PSAC East title, winning it for the second time in three seasons, and reached the NCAA Atlantic Regional once again, finishing the season 24-7 with three wins over nationally ranked teams. The Marauders achieved their first

national ranking since the 2006-07 season. Senior Matt Dade became the first Marauder since 2008 to earn All-Atlantic Region honors. Jaden Faulkner and Drew Stover joined Dade on the All-PSAC East team. Faulkner finished his stellar career ranked 15th in career scoring, third in assists and ninth in steals. Dade also surpassed 1,000 career points during the season. "We had a great season and couldn't be more proud of our accomplishments," says coach Casey Stitzel. "Now that we have established ourselves as one of the best programs in the region, next year we hope to go even further."

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

First-year head coach Kira Mowen took over a program with only a handful of returning players but brought the team together down the stretch for a PSAC Tournament appearance. The Marauders won six of their final 10 regular season games and defeated East Stroudsburg in the opening round before falling in the second. Guard

Jabria Ingram and forward Makiah Shaw were key to the team's success, and each earned All-PSAC East Second Team honors for their efforts. "As I look ahead to next season, the excitement for this roster is there," says coach Mowen. "We've put in a lot of great work this offseason and I'm looking forward to seeing what our first signee class brings to the table. I cannot wait for the fall to get the players back on campus and work out as a family again."

WOMEN'S SWIMMING

In his first season as the head coach, Evan Anthony continued to take the swimming program on an upward trajectory. The team captured seventh place at the PSAC Championships, matching the program's best-ever finish. It also set a program record for swimmers qualified. Five school records fell after the calendar turned to 2024, three by relay teams. Jordan Plempel, the team's top scorer at the PSAC Championships, broke the 200-yard individual medley record,

and Jewels Hepner set a new mark for the 50-yard freestyle. "The team had a fantastic season, with many personal best swims and team records," says coach Anthony. "We have also established a culture of success in the classroom and pool, which we will continue to build upon."

TRACK & FIELD

The Marauders wrapped up the indoor season by finishing sixth at the PSAC Indoor Championships, led by Darian Hauf and Chanel Hercules. Hauf finished as the conference runner-up in the pole vault for the second straight year, securing a top-two finish in all three years she has competed. Hercules broke a 13-year-old program record in the long jump, clearing it by two inches to finish second with a jump of 18-3. Hauf's outstanding pole vault season included a meet record at the Millersville Metrics, while teammates Hercules (long jump), Morgan Janiuk (1,500-meter run) and Maddy Downs (discus) also won events. At the PSAC Outdoor

Championships, the Marauders had six athletes earn All-PSAC, headlined by Hauf, who became the first athlete in program history to win a PSAC Championship in each of her first three seasons. Joining her was fellow pole vaulter Megan Malecki, Aubrey Sydnor in the 400-meter dash, Janiuk in the 1,500-meter run, and Downs and Seya Trujillo in the discus. Hauf wrapped up the Marauders outdoor season by competing at the NCAA Outdoor Championships, finishing 15th in Division II with a vault of 12-7½. "We were happy to keep our team in the top three at outdoor PSACs but not satisfied with how the top two pulled away this year. We had our largest women's roster in team history, and I think we struggled to find the mojo that allowed us to win PSACs in 2022. Our team is already making plans for next year, and with over 20 recruits joining us, we think we have the quality and depth to give the rest of the PSAC a run for their money in the 2025 season."

WRESTLING

Under second-year head coach Jerry Boland, Millersville wrestling set a program record with five NCAA Division II Championship qualifiers, and 133-pound Devin Flannery became one of three three-time All-Americans with a third-place finish at nationals. He was joined at nationals by three-time qualifier Brandon Connor, four-time qualifier Craig Cook, two-time qualifier Anthony Giampietro and Jonathan Parrilla. Flannery was also one of six Marauders named All-PSAC, a total that also set a program record. The 12 dual victories were the program's most since 1992. The team also excelled in the classroom, with a program record nine wrestlers earning NWCA Scholar All-America status. "We had a great mix of upperclassmen and underclassmen experience this year that set a high standard for our future," said coach Jerry Boland. "With another talented recruiting class coming in, it should be exciting to see how we continue to raise the bar."

BASEBALL

Millersville climbed as high as No. 2 in the national rankings, but a rash of injuries ultimately cut short the team's postseason run. The Marauders made their 12th consecutive postseason appearance under coach Jon Shehan and extended the region's longest active streak of NCAA Regional appearances to 11. They led the region with five CCA All-Atlantic Region selections. Starting pitcher Alex Mykut was named ABCA and CCA All-America First Team. Center fielder Jeff Sabater led all college baseball players in stolen bases and set a PSAC record with 57.

"The 2024 season was another successful season, taking part in an 11th consecutive Atlantic Regional while winning 38 games," said Coach Shehan. "With the addition of lights at the Coop, consistent support from our alumni and friends of the program, and an excellent incoming class, we couldn't be more excited about the future!"

MEN'S GOLF

Playing in challenging weather conditions, Millersville blew away the field for coach Scott Vandegrift's fifth PSAC Championship. Timothy Peters, who would go on to be named the PSAC Athlete and PSAC Freshman of the Year, became the first Marauder to be a PSAC medalist since Conor Gilbert in 2014, and he did so by edging his senior teammate, Bobby Lugiano, who placed runner-up. With balance and depth, the Marauders set a program record with six tournament wins. The team qualified for the NCAA Super Regional, and Peters missed qualifying for nationals by just one shot over 54 holes. Lugiano, an All-PSAC Second Team selection for the second time, set a new career scoring record.

WOMEN'S GOLF

A third-place finish at the PSAC Championship highlighted a season that included five tournament wins—a total that tied a school record. Amanda Wolf, who placed fourth at the PSAC Championship,

was named All-PSAC Second Team, becoming just the seventh Marauder to earn that distinction. Her 83.0 scoring average ranked 10th all-time. Wolf, Charley Kirby and Emma Schotsch all won a tournament in 2023-24.

WOMEN'S LACROSSE

Coach Kaitlyn Hafdell's young team was led by three All-PSAC East Second Team selections in Liv Genovese, Rachel Keeney and Ella Linthicum. Keeney led the team in points and goals, and Linthicum led the team in assists. KC O'Neill, a true freshman, stepped into the starting role at goalkeeper midway through the season and made 15 saves against eventual national runner-up East Stroudsburg, providing a bright outlook for the program's future. "Although the season did not conclude the way we had hoped, this was a great learning opportunity to grow off," says Coach Hafdell. "We had three amazing seniors graduate, but with the depth of returners, I am more than confident we will pick back

up next season better than before and excel. These players have a lot of heart and never stop battling. They will be hungry for more and will expect more out of themselves next season. I think this drive that they possess is something that puts them above other programs, and it will show come next season what 'Ville lacrosse is truly made of."

SOFTBALL

It was a historically significant season for the softball team, as the team combined to break or tie 13 individual program records. Aleese Angelo was named the PSAC East Athlete of the Year and surpassed six career marks while tallying the most hits in a single season in team history. Pitcher Alex Schaefer finished her career with the most strikeouts in Marauder history and the most in a single game. Angelo, Gabi Turner and Gabby D'Ottavio all earned All-PSAC honors as well. "Our seniors led the way this season with their leadership and on-field contributions," says coach Jen Probst. "We reached multiple team

and individual milestones while having one of our best semesters as a team in the classroom. I'm very proud of the way we competed, ending regionally ranked and with 15 players earning scholar-athlete status."

MEN'S TENNIS

The Millersville men's tennis team surprised many in the PSAC by getting hot at the right time to finish as the PSAC Tournament runner-up. The Marauders started 2-6 and dropped their first two conference duals to Edinboro and Mercyhurst. But after the loss to Mercyhurst on March 24, the Marauders went on a roll, led by All-PSAC singles and doubles players Dylan Tull and Zach Pernia. Millersville won its next four matches and finished the regular season on an eight-match win streak, including three shutout wins. The Marauders headed into the PSAC Tournament on fire and beat Mercyhurst in a rematch, winning 4-2 to advance to the PSAC Championship for the first time since 2007. The team also qualified

for its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2011. "Our men's team had a fantastic finish to the season," says coach Matt Helsel. "It was a great blend of experience and youth that continued improving as the season progressed, ultimately landing us back in the NCAA Regional bracket for the first time in a long time."

WOMEN'S TENNIS

After capturing its second PSAC Eastern Division championship in three years, the Millersville women's tennis team made its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2007. The Marauders won nine of 10 matches after returning from spring break, with Sophie Lanius and Noelle Htwar picking up weekly conference awards while doing so. Millersville clinched the division title with a win over Bloomsburg in the penultimate match of the regular season and saw their season end in the NCAA Tournament in a loss to Slippery Rock. It was a season to remember for Millersville, as Htwar and head coach Matt Helsel were

recipients of PSAC East Athlete and Coach of the Year, and Chloe Abramowitz, Sido Rault and Hui Jen Soo all earned All-PSAC East honors. "Our women's team surged at the perfect time, winning 12 of 14 matches in one stretch to capture the PSAC East Division title," says Coach Helsel. "Several standout players led us to a great finish, where we ended up playing in the NCAA Regional for the first time in 17 years."



CAMBRUZZI AND MARCH INVEST IN 'VILLE WRESTLING FUTURE

graduated from Millersville nearly two decades apart, but their experiences wrestling for the Black & Gold set them up for success in their

careers, and now they are among the dedicated Marauder alums who are giving back to the wrestling program.

Cambruzzi has stayed connected to Millersville for much of the last 20 years. He followed a four-year wrestling career with two years as a graduate assistant coach and a master's degree, helping the Marauders to four consecutive East Region titles at the Division I level. After quickly finding success in commercial real estate, Cambruzzi was offered a role as an adjunct professor teaching business—a role that he has held for 12 years.

"I loved the school," says Cambruzzi. "I was part of a program that was about all the things that

are important to character development." Cambruzzi's affinity for Millersville has nothing to do with any individual success found on the mat. Millersville wrestling gave him an opportunity to compete in the sport he loves and taught him invaluable lessons about work ethic and character. His education prepared him for his career as a managing partner with TRUE Commercial Real Estate. He has established two scholarships for wrestlers, investing in and anchoring a program that was critical to his life.

"If I can give to something that was beneficial to me so it can be beneficial to someone else, I take some satisfaction in knowing I can create that opportunity for someone else," says Cambruzzi. "There are athletes who aren't even born yet that will someday look back and say that Millersville wrestling was such a big part of their life."

While Cambruzzi was afforded the opportunity to give back at a young age, Randy March spent 32 years as a high school wood and metal shop teacher and put his children through college before establishing a scholarship. March is a mat legend at Millersville. He was a three-time NCAA

Championships qualifier, the career wins record holder and a 2019 inductee into the Millersville Athletics Hall of Fame.

March has a great deal of pride in his four years at Millersville, and like Cambruzzi, March holds on to the intangibles that came through the sweat and blood of training with teammates and competing at the highest levels of collegiate wrestling, and the opportunities that come in life after those experiences.

"I had 110 wins that came under the Millersville banner, and I'm proud of that," says March. "I was a guy who didn't win districts (in high school), but I had a strong work ethic and didn't want anyone to outwork me in the room. I had teammates who made me better. Once you get to Millersville, you can make something of yourself."

The gifts from Cambruzzi, March and other wrestling alums have helped the Marauders surge back into national relevance in recent years. In 2024, coach Jerry Boland's team set a program record with five national qualifiers, six All-PSAC honorees and seven NWCA Scholar All-Americans.
