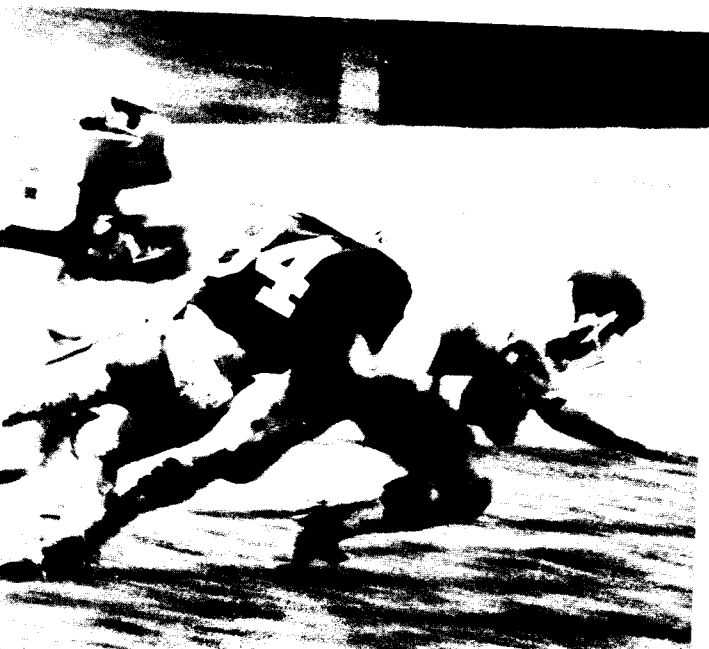
Commends Millsaps

al) — The Mississippi Senate has passed a resolution commending the Millsaps College football team and its victory in the 1980 football season.

The resolution No. 516 congratulated the Majors for their performance "which can only be attained by long hours of practice and to the game and skillful, knowledgeable play."

During the 1980 schedule last season, the team held its opponents to 11 points while the team itself amassed 350 points.

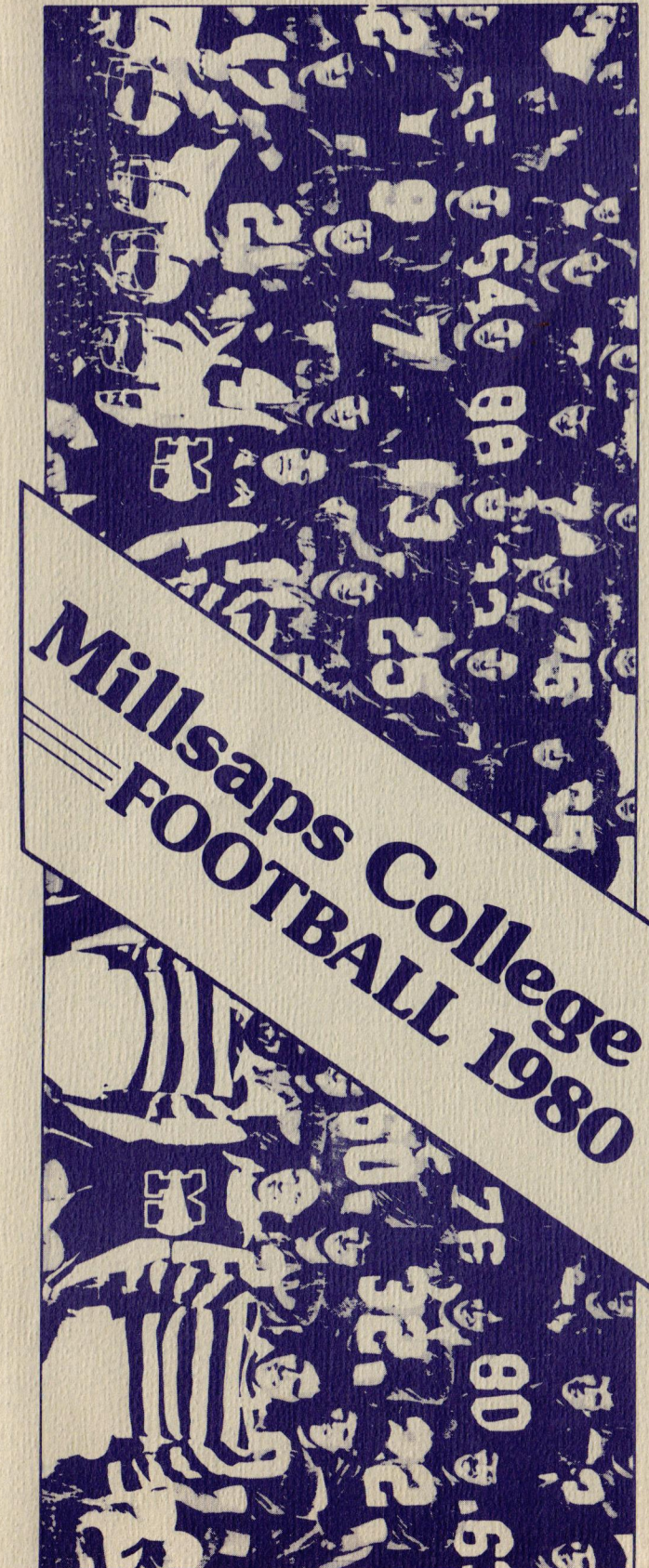

Head Coach

Beginning his 17th season as the Majors' head football coach, Davis has led his teams to winning seasons 11 out of the last 12 campaigns. The 1975 team went to the NCAA Division III national playoffs where it beat Colorado College in Colorado Springs, CO and was defeated by national champion Whittenberg University. Davis graduated from Mississippi State University with a B.S. degree in education administration. His playing career included St. Mary's, CA; Pre Flight, Corpus Christi Naval Air Station; Mississippi State University, where he made the ALL-SEC team four years; the Los Angeles Dons, Chicago Bears, and Green Bay Packers. He has coached the backfield at Mississippi State and was head football coach at West Point High School and Columbus Lee High School. The past 12 seasons show a combined record of 68 wins, 39 losses and one tie.

TOMMY RANAGER

Assistant Coach

Guiding the Majors offensive and defensive lines, Ranager enters the 17th year as the Majors' line coach. A graduate of Meridian High School, Ranager earned a B.S. in physical education at Mississippi State University in 1963 and a master's degree in education at Mississippi College. He was a three-letter winner in football at Mississippi State and was named to the SEC squad in his senior year. Ranager served one year as line coach and track coach at Hazlehurst High School before assuming his duties at Millsaps. Ranager also coaches the Millsaps baseball team.
