Missouri Western State University in St. Joseph is a learning community focused on students as individuals and as members of society. The institution offers students at all stages of life the opportunity to achieve excellence in the classroom and beyond, as they prepare to be leaders in their work and in their communities.

Western demonstrates a strong commitment to the educational, economic, cultural and social development of the people it serves. The university sets the standard for excellence in student development and community leadership.

Founded as St. Joseph Junior College in 1915, Western was transformed into a four-year institution in 1969 and became a full member of the State of Missouri system in 1977. It was designated a university in 2005. Enrollment is approximately 5,500 with over 180 faculty members.

The student-centered, high-quality instruction focuses on experience-based learning and community service. Every classroom and public meeting room on campus is equipped with presentation technology.

The university provides a blend of traditional liberal arts and career-oriented degree programs, offering one-year certificates, two-year associate degrees, preprofessional transfer programs, four-year baccalaureate degrees and professional master's degrees.

Western's College of Professional Studies and College of Liberal Arts and Sciences offer baccalaureate degrees in the fields of art, biology, business, chemistry, communication, computer science, criminal justice, economics, education, engineering technology, English, French, government, history, interdisciplinary studies, mathematics, music, nursing, physical education, psychology, recreation, social work and Spanish as well as master of applied science and master of applied arts degree's.

The Western Institute offers applied learning, business training, applied research support and lifelong learning opportunities for the region. In addition, groups throughout the nation utilize Western's facilities for conferences and seminars.

The institution is accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Institutions of Higher Education. Program accreditations include the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology, American Bar Association, American Chemical Society, American Health Information Management Association, Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education, Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education, Council on Social Work Education, National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Science, National Association of Schools of Music and National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education.

The campus, comprising more than 700 acres, contains six residence halls, a residential commons building and 12 major campus buildings including eight academic buildings, a student union, a fitness center, a conference center and a learning resource center. The campus has a large nature study area, a nature trail and nine ponds.





Western Facts and Figures

* According to a recent economic impact report conducted by Western, the university had a financial impact of \$160.9 million on the region last year. Western's economic impact increased \$21 million since the last study in 2003.

* Missouri residents comprise 92% of the university's students, and about 3,900 of the total enrollment are from the 10-county region.

* With 550 employees, Western is St. Joseph's 10th largest employer.

* Western offers opportunities for applied learning not always found in other colleges and universities. Last year, 89% of Western graduates had participated in applied learning opportunities through internships, practicums, research projects, or study abroad.

* Western's expenditures in the community result in an additional 1,036 jobs in the area.

* Last year, 860 area high school students enrolled in dual credit courses.

* Western is engaged in several community partnerships, including the Institute for Industrial Applied Life Sciences, Another Smart Move initiative, St. Joseph's Community Plan, Northwest Missouri Regional Healthcare Workforce Development Group, and many with the St. Joseph School District.

* The Western Institute was established in 2004 and serves as an invaluable resource for the community. Along with coordinating the continuing education programs and conference and meeting facilities, the Institute provides research and education to the community and arts classes for all ages.

* Last year, over 5,200 elementary and secondary students participated in camps, workshops and competitions on campus.

* The Western Institute works with the Missouri Career Center to train displaced workers and offers courses focusing on professional develop-

ment to more than 1,000 people annually, including Spanish, Excel and Leadership Skills.

* Students have high-speed internet ports in every residence hall room and access to computer labs 24 hours a day.

* Because of a partnership with Heartland Health, Western has increased the number of students allowed in the nursing program from 40 to 50.

* The Western Institute assisted area companies in receiving \$115,000 in customized training grants.

* The Christopher S. "Kit" Bond Science and Technology Incubator opened on Western's campus in May 2008. The 25,000 sq. ft. incubator provides custom-outfitted space and support for entrepreneurs in the early stages of commercial development.

* In the last year, Western departments received 13 grants totaling almost \$1.4 million. The grants fund projects such as public safety workshops, tutoring, a video project, synthetic biology research, and training for writing teachers.

* A groundbreaking ceremony was held in April 2008 for the construction of Remington Hall, an approximately 60,000 sq. ft. addition to Agenstein Hall. Agenstein Hall, which houses the science and mathematics departments, will be renovated.

* More than 900 new students participated in a day of service in St. Joseph, Mo., during their orientation to Western.

* For the second year in a row, Western was named to the President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll. This distinction from the highest levels of government recognizes Western's leadership in helping to build a culture of service and civic engagement.

* In the past year, Western students provided more than 100,000 hours of service to schools, organizations and businesses through unpaid practica and internships. They also logged more than 6,000 hours of community service as part of their courses.





Academic Advisement

Each Western student has their own academic advisor within their department of study. Your advisor will put you in the best position to graduate as well as line up valuable applied learning and research opportunities. In addition, the Western Athletics Department has its own compliance and academic coordinator who serves as a direct liaison between the student-athlete and academic faculty to ensure each athlete has the resources they need to succeed.

Center for Academic Support

The Center for Academic Support provides one-on-one and small group tutoring for most courses on campus. Located on the northeast corner of the library building, the center consists of group study spaces and a large open area for students to receive tutoring or work independently. The center also offers free tutoring in math, writing, specific courses, reading and study skills. In addition to these services, students have access to online assistance, Supplemental Instruction (SI), and workshops sponsored by the center.

Athletics Mentor Program

Student-athletes that need additional academic support participate in the athletics mentoring program. The program, which is facilitated through the Center for Academic Support, provides each athlete with a mentor who provides one-on-one attention on all facets of college life.

Class Size

Students will enjoy an excellent learning environment with comfortable class sizes. At Missouri Western, you're more than just a number. With the average class around 30 students, instructors will know your name and know what you need to succeed.

Focus on Applied Learning

Western has been labeled the "New American Regional University" with a focus on applied learning and applied research. The emphasis on applied learning allows students real world internship experience. Whether you want to intern at the state capital, run your own fitness center or have a career in collegiate coaching, you will get those opportunities at Western.

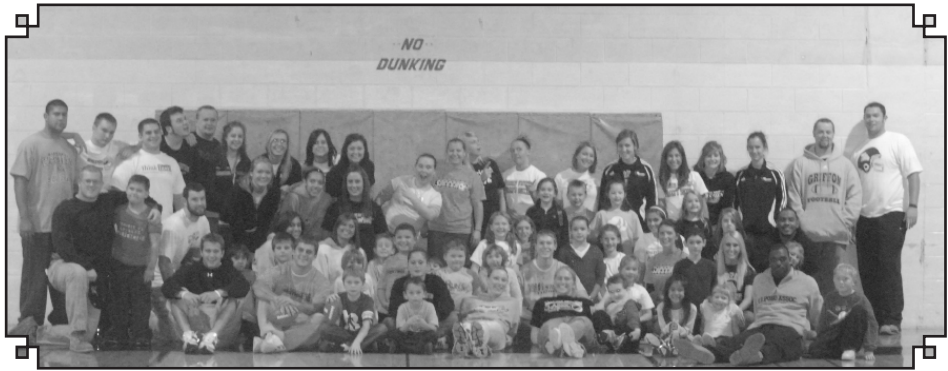

Missouri Western student-athletes get involved with the community in many way. 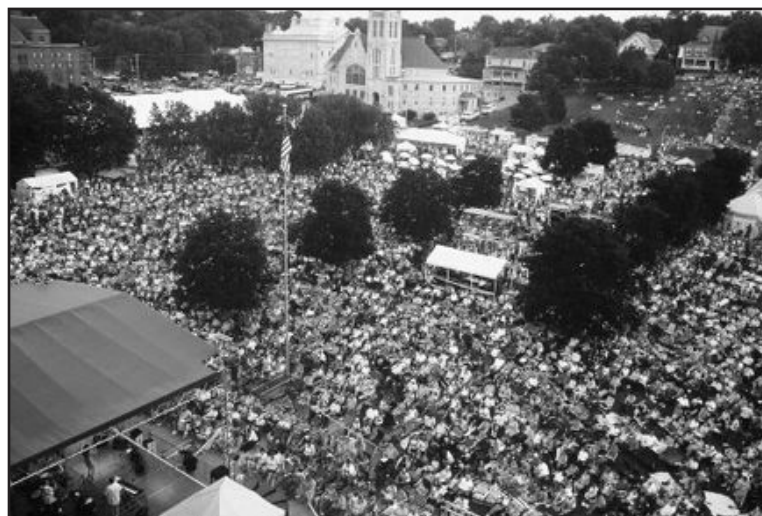

Radio

680 KFEQ is the exclusive radio home to Griffon softball. Coach Bagley will be on the air occasionally on Friday mornings at 9:30 am to talk Griffon baseball with Bob Orf. With a 50,000 watt signal, KFEQ can be heard in over 30 states throughout the country.

Internet

Television

ABC affiliate KQTV is the official television home of the Griffons. During the softball season, the Griffons always receive priority attention, whether it be live feeds from games, post-game shows or interviews after practice. Great games and performances never go unnoticed.

Weekly Specials

During the season, the coverage does not stop when the game ends. Every Friday morning, 680 KFEQ hosts the Griffon coaches show where each of the week's games are analyzed with Head Coach Jen Bagley. Griffon coaches and players also take part in a weekly Griffon Luncheon held for the media every Monday at La Dolce Vita at 36th Street Restaurant.

Newspapers

The St. Joseph News-Press, with a circulation to over 75,000 homes throughout northwest Missouri, is the official news source of the Griffons. Complete with a beat writer, feature stories and full game reports, Griffon coverage is second to none during the season. To offer more regional coverage, the Kansas City Star covers the MIAA throughout the year while the Griffon News covers the campus beat.



Meet the Coaches





Jen Bagley
Head Coach

Missouri Western head coach Jen Bagley starts her 8th season in St. Joseph. Bagley holds a 220-173 overall record in seven seasons and has coached 20 All-MIAA selections over the past four seasons, including the programs first NFCA All-America selection.

This past season she coached the MIAA Freshman of the Year (Alison Jones). Jen's team has averaged 31 wins a season since she took over as head coach for the Griffons.

Bagley has led the Griffons to back-to-back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Division II national tournament. The Griffons qualified for the NCAA Central Regional Tournament in 2005, 2006 and 2007 under Bagley, appearing for the first time in school history in 2005. The Griffons posted a 1-2 record in the national tournament during all 3 seasons, getting the programs' third national tournament win over Winona State 7-0.

In 2008, the Griffons finished the season with a 27-28 overall record and 8-10 in the MIAA. Bagley, coached four All-MIAA selections including Freshman of the Year Alison Jones. The Griffons upset the No. 2 seed Central Missouri Jennies in the first round of the MIAA tournament.

In 2007, the Griffons finished the season 34-26 and 10-8 in the MIAA. Coach Bagley coached four All-MIAA selection including one first team selection in pitcher Lindsey Predovich.

In 2006, the Griffons went 40-20 overall, finishing 2nd in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association regular season standings. The second place league finish was its highest ever since joining the MIAA and the NCAA ranks in 1989. Last season, Bagley coached five All-MIAA selections including two first team selections in pitcher Lindsey Predovich and utility player Kara Unger.

During the 2005 season, Bagley led the Griffs to its first ever appearance in the NCAA Division II national tournament, breaking numerous school and MIAA records along the way. Western finished the season at 48-20, setting team records for wins, home runs and runs batted in. Western went from 31 wins in 2004 to 48 wins in 2005. Bagley was named the 2004 Wilson/MIAA Softball Coach-of-the-Year.

Bagley came to Western from Humboldt State University where she helped coach a Lumberjack team to a 54-14-1 overall record in 2001 and a 3rd place finish in the NCAA Division II championship tournament. Bagley was at Humboldt State for one season as the pitching coach. Previously, Bagley was the pitching coach and 1st base coach at Minnesota State - Moorhead (formerly Moorhead State University) from 1996-2000.

The Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota native earned a bachelor's degree in legal studies from Minnesota-Moorhead in 1996 and was a 3-time all-conference pitcher for the Dragons from 1993-96. Bagley is still the career strikeout leader at MSM, totaling 590 for her career.

Assistant Coach

Beverly begins her 3rd season as an assistant coach for the Griffon softball team in 2009. Beverly was a 4-year letterwinner and All-America selection for Western during her playing career. Beverly holds MWSU career records for: games

played (222), at bats (697), hits (263), runs batted in (160), doubles (58) and home runs (37). Her season records are in games played (68), games started (68), hits (93), runs batted in (67) and doubles (24). Beverly was also named to the NCAA Division II All-Region team two times.



Lou Rizzuti
Assistant Coach

Lou Rizzuti was an assistant Varsity coach at Dowling Catholic High School in West Des Moines, IA for 6 seasons, compiling a record of 270-42. This equates to a winning percentage of over 86%. Lou coached the infield at Dowling High and had

an infield efficiency rating of 93%. Lou's other accomplishments include: 6 CIML Conference Championships, 4 District and Regional Championships, 4 state tournament appearances with 1 state title and 2 runner-ups. In six seasons, Lou assisted in the recruiting of 12 senior players at acquiring scholarships to Division 1 and Division 2 schools. Lou also assisted the Griffons softball team in 2005. Lou is the father of a four year softball starter and a graduate of Missouri Western with a Nursing degree.

The Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, an 11-member conference of NCAA Division II institutions in Missouri, Kansas and Nebraska, was first organized in 1912 as the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association.

Over the past 95 years, the MIAA has gained the reputation of being one of the top NCAA Division II conferences in the nation. MIAA student-athletes have won 12 NCAA team championships and, since 1964, 153 individual national titles. The MIAA currently conducts championships in eight sports for men and eight for women.

For the men, champions are crowned in football, cross country, basketball, indoor and outdoor track & field, baseball, tennis and golf. The women compete for titles in volleyball, cross country, soccer, basketball, indoor and outdoor track & field, softball, golf and tennis.

The MIAA turned a new page on July 1, 1992, when the NCAA Division II conference changed its name from the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletic Association to the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association.

The decision to make the change originated in 1989, when Pittsburg State University and Washburn University became the first schools outside the state of Missouri to gain membership in the MIAA.

The conference was first organized in 1912 with 14 member institutions. Of those original members, the University of Central Missouri, Truman State University, and Northwest Missouri State University still remain a part of the MIAA.

The first change in membership came in 1924, when the MIAA reorganized to include only the five regional Missouri state colleges: Central, Truman (at the time known as Northeast Missouri State), Northwest, Southeast Missouri State University and Southwest Missouri State University (now Missouri State).

Over the next 56 years, three schools joined the membership: the Missouri School of Mines (later the University of Missouri-Rolla) in 1935, Lincoln University in 1970, and the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1980.

The 1980s brought the biggest changes in the conference. In 1981, Southwest Missouri State University opted to move to NCAA Division I and the MIAA appointed its first full-time commissioner, Ken Jones, in July.

He would be in the position for 16 years, retiring in 1997. Former Gulf South and Metro commissioner Ralph McFillen succeeded Jones, serving 10 years before his retirement in 2007. Jim Johnson succeeded McFillen in July of that year.

Southwest Baptist University brought membership back to eight schools in 1986, before the major expansion of the conference in 1989. Pittsburg State, Washburn, Missouri Southern State College (now University) and Missouri Western State College (now University) ° formerly members of the Central States Intercollegiate Conference ° began competition in the 1989-90 season.

Southeast Missouri State left the MIAA following the 1990-91 season to move on to NCAA Division I, and was replaced by Emporia State University in the 1991-92 season.

In August 1991, Judy Willson was hired as the MIAA's first full-time sports information director. She left in 1994, and was succeeded by Matt Newbery, formerly the assistant sports information director at Pittsburg State. He became the assistant to the commissioner for media relations in 2005. A third full-time staff member was added in 2005, as former Emporia State track and field athlete Natasha Oakes was hired as the assistant to the commissioner for compliance. Larry House joined the staff in August 2007 as coordinator of external affairs.

The current membership of the MIAA is at 11 schools, with the departure of Missouri-St. Louis in 1996 and Missouri-Rolla in 2005, the forfeiture of membership by Lincoln in 1999 and the addition of Fort Hays State University in 2006 and the University of Nebraska-Omaha in 2008.

President Dr. Robert A. Vartabedian

Dr. Robert Vartabedian was named the fourth president since 1969 Dec. 17, 2007 and officially began his duties July 1, 2008. Dr. Vartabedian succeeds Dr. James Scanlon, who officially retired June 30, 2008 after serving as president for seven years.

Dr. Vartabedian most recently served as vice president for academic affairs at Eastern New Mexico University (ENMU) in Portales, N.M. since 2005. In that role, he was chief academic officer for a university with a total enrollment of about 9,500. He recently oversaw re-accreditation efforts in six departments. The university's 2007 evaluation by the Higher Learning Commission/North Central Association was accepted without any deficiencies and is being showcased as a model application.

Previously, Dr. Vartabedian was dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at Western Carolina University in Cullowhee, N.C. from 1999 to 2005, serving eight months as interim vice chancellor for academic affairs in 2004. As dean, he oversaw 14 academic departments and four centers. As interim vice chancellor, he was the chief administrator for all academic programs for the 8,400 students enrolled.

Both ENMU and Western Carolina created several new academic programs under Dr. Vartabedian's leadership. He has overseen building renovation projects at ENMU for science, technology and music and five major building projects at Western Carolina totaling \$60 million, including a \$30 million Fine and Performing Arts Center.

Community involvement has been a hallmark of Dr. Vartabedian's career. He created the ENMU "Peanut Project" as a way to forge a partnership with the local peanut industry while providing students with hands-on experience in a marketing campaign. He also recently directed a faculty showcase theatre production of Mitch Albom's "And the Winner Is," with proceeds benefiting ENMU scholarships and the Portales Main Street Project.

Previous administrative experience for Dr. Vartabedian includes time as a department head and director of graduate studies in communication at West Texas A&M University in Canyon, Texas and as a division head, coordinator of graduate studies in communication and assistant dean of graduate studies at Wichita State University in Wichita, Kan. He has received numerous teaching awards throughout his career.

Dr. Vartabedian graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor of arts in speech communication from California State University, Fresno, Calif. in 1974. He received a master of arts in speech communication from Wichita State University, and a doctorate in communication from the University of Oklahoma. He and his wife, Dr. Laurel Vartabedian, have two children: Rob, and daughter-in-law, Audrey, of Amarillo, Texas and Sarah, of Austin, Texas. Dr. Vartabedian and his wife reside in St. Joseph.



Athletics Director David Williams

David Williams is in his first year at Missouri Western after accepting the job in March 2008. Williams is a graduate of Augustana College in Rock Island, Ill., with a degree in education. He earned a master's degree in educational administration from North Dakota State University, Fargo. Williams was an assistant basketball coach at North Dakota State and later served as the top assistant basketball coach at University of Wisconsin-Parkside. In addition, Williams was the head men's golf coach at Parkside, prior to accept-

ing the Athletic Director position at Parkside in January of 2001.

In August of 2006, Williams was elected as president of the Division II Athletics Directors Association (DII ADA) for 2006-07.

Williams has hit the ground running at Missouri Western, as there are already plans for facility improvements such as SGA Stadium (the new on-campus home of Griffon baseball), improvements to the visitor sideline at Spratt Memorial Stadium and the Griff Zone (interactive student lounge in the Looney Complex).

During his tenure at Parkside, Ranger athletics enjoyed a plethora of successes. Under Williams' administration, 12 of 15 Ranger sports qualified for NCAA post-season appearances. Parkside teams won 10 Great Lakes Valley Conference (14 institutions) championships in six different sports. Numerous All-Americans and Academic All-Americans emerged.

In fact, the grade point average of the Parkside student-athletes has been consistently higher than the student body at

large. Parkside student-athletes routinely exceed the 3.0 GPA mark each semester.

Facility improvements during Williams' reign were prominent. The Sports and Activities Center saw a facelift in the form of new state-of-the-art scoreboards and the first videoboard in the region. The baseball and softball fields received new scoreboards in the spring of 2007, and in 2006, the baseball field saw new dugouts sprout. Oberbruner Field, home of Ranger baseball, has seats from the former Milwaukee County Stadium, which housed the Green Bay Packers and Milwaukee Brewers for decades. A new outfield fence was also erected under Williams' administration.

Williams lured a number of high-profile events to the Parkside campus including the NCAA Division I fencing national championship and the NCAA Division II national wrestling championship. The NAIA national cross country championship is a staple on Parkside's cross country course as is the Footlocker Regional Championships. In addition, Parkside has hosted a multitude of conference and regional championships in several sports.

Williams and his wife, Suzanne, live in St. Joseph with their children Cooper 10, Carter 7 and Caden 2.



Trevor Berneking **Sports Information Director**

Trevor Berneking enters his second year as Western's Sports Information Director after serving as a graduate assistant at Northern State University in Aberdeen, SD. Trevor is originally from Grand Marais, Minn. where he graduated from Cook County High School in 2000.

Berneking played football at Univeristy of Minnesota, Crookston for four years where he was a two-year captain and an NSIC All-Conference selection as a defensive lineman. Following his playing career, he served as a student assistant for one year.

Berneking graduated in December of 2004 with a bachelor's degree in sport and recreation management and business management with an emphasis in marketing. Berneking also received a minor in coaching. He received his master's in the spring of 2007 in physical education, health and coaching.



Brett Esely **Assistant AD/External Relations**

Brett Esely was promoted to Assistant Athletics Director – External Relations on July 1, 2007. Esely's responsibilities include overseeing the Sports Information Office and media relations, marketing, advertising, public relations, event management, ticketing and being the liaison to the Gold Coat Club for current and prospective members.

Esely will also serve as the color analyst with Bob Orf on 680 KFEQ for away men's and women's basketball broadcasts. In addition to his duties within the department, Esely begins the second year of a four-year term as the Central Region Chairman for the NCAA Division II Men's Golf Committee.

Prior to entering his current role, Esely spent four years as the NCAA Compliance & Ticketing Coordinator for the department and served three years as graduate assistant coach for the MWSU men's basketball program under Tom Smith.

Esely holds a bachelor's degree from Missouri Western in sports marketing/management and recently received his master's degree in sports marketing/management from the United States Sports Academy. In his spare time, Esely enjoys watching all sports, playing golf and going to Chiefs games. Esely and his wife, Kate, reside in St. Joseph.

David Lau came to Missouri Western in 1999 as an assistant baseball coach and administrator. development officers in the MIAA and NCAA Division II, raising over \$300,000 annually.

In 1994, Smith became the Head Women's Tennis Coach and coached the first ever tennis team to the NCAA Tournament in 1998.
