Missouri Western plays its home opener Thursday, September 9 inside Spratt Stadium as the Griffons entertain the Fort Hays State Tigers at 7:00 p.m. MWSU will try and bounce back from a loss in its season opener last week as they fell on the road at Central Oklahoma, 24-20.

The Griffons rallied from a 24-7 halftime deficit last week in Edmond, but they were unable to complete the comeback as they dropped their fourth straight season opener. Missouri Western had the ball three times in the fourth quarter to take the lead, but they failed to score on all three drives. The MWSU defense blanked the Broncos in the second half to keep them in the game.

Fort Hays State comes to Spratt Stadium after a 15-7 loss at home in its season opener against Northwest Missouri State. The Tigers struggled offensively as they ran for only 48 yards, completed only 38.1 percent of their passes and had two interceptions. The FHSU defense kept the Tigers in the game as they limited the Bearcats to just 96 yards passing. Chris Brown enters his 10th season as the head coach at Fort Hays State as he is 66-38 overall, including a 61-34 mark in the MIAA.

SERIES HISTORY

MWSU is 16-12-1 all-time against Fort Hays State and they are 9-5-1 in games played at Spratt Stadium. The Griffons have won the last two meetings. Since Fort Hays State came into the MIAA in 2006, the Griffons are 12-2 against FHSU. MWSU is 7-1 in their last eight home games against Fort Hays State. This will be the third straight season in which Missouri Western faces the Tigers in the second game of the season after losing its opening game of the season. In the previous two meetings, MWSU has beaten a ranked Fort Hays State team. The Tigers have been ranked in the previous three meetings.

SEASON OPENERS

The Griffons are now 29-20-2 all-time in season openers after losing last week at Central Oklahoma. MWSU has struggled to get off to a good start in during Coach Williamson tenure as he is 0-4 and the Griffons have dropped the season opener in five of the last six seasons.

HOME OPENERS

MWSU is 37-12-1 all-time in their home openers. The Griffons fell in 2019 to Northwest Missouri State, which stopped a streak of seven consecutive wins in their first game of the season at home. Five of the 12 losses came in the first seven years of the program. Since 1977, Missouri Western is 35-7-1 in their home openers, and they'll try to avoid back-to-back losses in home openers since the 1986 and 1987 seasons. The Griffons have played Fort Hays State just two times in a home opener and they're 2-0, winning 37-14 in 2001 and 23-13 in 2018.

FIRST CAREER SCORES

Missouri Western is a very young team offensively with only one senior on the two-deep roster, and because of that there will be a lot of firsts in 2021. Three Griffons scored their first career touchdowns last Thursday against Central Oklahoma, and all were running backs. Freshman Brandon Hall found the end zone in the second quarter on a 41-yard TD run, freshman Shen Butler-Lawson, Jr. had a one-yard touchdown run in the third quarter and freshman Brison Cobbins scored on a three-yard run in the fourth quarter against UCO on his first career carry.

OTHER FIRSTS

Along with those three running backs that scored last week, freshman RB Jonas Bennett had his first career rushing attempt and freshman QB Reagan Jones played three series under center. He finished 3-for-5 for 28 yards and he finished with 12 yards rushing. Wide Receivers Hezekiah Trotter, Traveon James and C.J. Parks also played a lot for Missouri Western last week and they had their first career receptions.

CAREER NIGHT FOR COOP

Griffon sophomore wide receiver Cooper Burton

had his best day in black and gold. The sophomore from Benton High School in St. Joseph had career highs in receptions (7), receiving yards (90), rushing attempts (3) and rushing yards (23). Burton finished fourth on the team in 2019 as a freshman with 17 catches and he was third with 277 receiving yards.

DOMINATE SECOND HALF

MWSU is loaded with veterans on the defensive side of the ball, but they struggle in the first half against UCO last week. They allowed 24 points and 271 yards of the offensive as the Griffons dug themselves a 24-7 hole in the break. The vets adjust at halftime and shutout UCO in the second half and limited the Bronchos to just 112 yards. Of the six possession Central Oklahoma had, MWSU forced them to punt on five of those drives and had three three-and-outs to keep their team in the game. Seniors Devan Burrell and Evan Chohan each had eight tackles to lead that side of the football, while seniors Terrance March and Chris Blakeney led the team with 1.5 tackles for loss.

NEED TO PROTECT THE SPRATT

Last Thursday's loss at Central Oklahoma stopped a streak of 11 consecutive wins away from Spratt Stadium that dated back to week two of the 2018 season. Missouri Western has not had the same success at Spratt Stadium. The Griffons are 8-9 overall at home under Coach Williamson and they're 2-6 at Spratt Stadium in their last eight home games. Coach Williamson's tenure got off to a great start at home at he went 6-1 his first seven games inside Spratt Stadium.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

The COVID-19 pandemic has drastically altered the Missouri Western roster over the last year. Like all other teams, no Griffon lost a season of eligibility last fall and it has made their roster very young and inexperienced. MWSU has 117 players on their current roster and 73 of those players are freshman. 15 are in their third season at MWSU as they redshirted in 2019, while 31 of those freshmen are in their second season and 27 are true freshman. The Griffons have 22 sophomores, 16 of which are in their fourth season and six more in their third year. Missouri Western has only 22 upperclassmen on its roster this season. They have 14 juniors and eight seniors.

PRESEASON MIAA RANKINGS

Missouri Western is picked to finish fourth in the preseason MIAA media poll and they're selected to finished fifth by the league's coaches. Those preseason rankings are the highest for MWSU during Coach Williamson's tenure. The Griffon have finished higher than they were picked in the preseason poll each of the last two year, including in 2019 when they were selected seventh in both preseason polls and they finished tied for third.

Williamson enters his fifth season as the head coach of the Griffons after being named the sixth head coach in program history in December of 2016. This is his third stint at his alma matter as he was a GA after graduating from MWSU and was also a coordinator from 2000-06. Williamson is 20-15 overall and 18-15 in the MIAA, all coming in his first three seasons as year four was canceled in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Williamson has improved his record every year at Missouri Western and made the postseason in each of the last two seasons. The Griffons went 4-7 during his first season in 2017 and tied for eighth in the MIAA. In 2018, MWSU snapped a streak of back-to-back losing season by going 7-5 overall and 6-5 in league play as they finished sixth. The Griffons were invited to the Live United Bowl in Texarkana, Arkansas as they make their first postseason appearance since 2012 and made the programs first bowl game since 2009. Missouri Western defeated Southern Arkansas 30-25 to cap off Williamson's second season.

Williamson guided the Griffons in 2019 to their first nine-win season in seven years as MWSU finished 9-3 overall and tied for third in the MIAA with an 8-3 record. After just missing out on the NCAA Division II playoffs, Missouri Western was invited back to the Live United Bowl and defeated Henderson State, 35-14. It was the first time the program won back-to-back bowl games in consecutive years.

Williamson then had to navigate the Griffons through a challenging period during his fourth year as the 2020 season was canceled by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Missouri Western was one of only 10 NCAA Division II programs to play at least one football game in the fall of 2020, even though they didn't count toward any historical or statistical purposes. MWSU lost both games played as they traveled to NCAA Division I FCS member Central Arkansas and they hosted Pittsburg State at Spratt Stadium.

PREVIOUS COACHING HISTORY
 Williamson came to his alma mater after serving as the defensive coordinator at NCAA Division I FCS Stephen F. Austin. He was in charge of the Lumberjacks defense for three seasons.

Prior to his stint at SFA, Williamson spent seven seasons at NCAA Division I FCS Central Arkansas. He was the defensive coordinator of the Bears from 2010-2013 after serving as the defensive line coach and special teams coordinator the three previous years.

Williamson coached at Missouri Western for seven seasons before leaving for UCA. He was the defensive line coach and special teams coordinator from 2000-2004 and was the defensive coordinator in 2005 and 2006.

Williamson was at NCAA Division II Arkansas-Monticello for one season in 1999 before returning to MWSU. He was the defensive line coach and recruiting coordinator for the Boll Weevils. His first stint at Missouri Western happened after graduation as he was a graduate assistant for the Griffons in 1997 and 1998.

PERSONAL

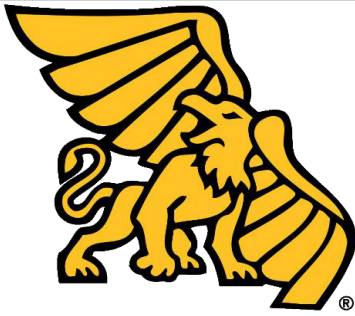
