Where Were We?

Missouri Western enters the third year of the Tyler Fenwick era in 2025, as the Griffons look to bounce back from a 4-7 mark in 2024, including a 2-7 mark in MIAA play.

While it was the fewest number of wins since 2017, the Griffons competed hard with all seven of their losses coming by an average margin of 7.1 points. Four of the losses were to nationally ranked opponents, and two of those were in overtime.

Personnel Pieces

Missouri Western welcomes back a plethora of talent in 2025 with 21 total starters back, including 11 players on the offensive side who started four games or more in 2024.

The Griffons also made some key additions in the offseason, signing 30 freshmen and 10 transfers. The position of choice in this class was defensive backs with 14 DBs joining the team. Missouri Western also signed seven new receivers, as each of the top four pass catchers from 2024 graduated.

Three QBs please

Missouri Western returns each of their top three quarterbacks from the 2024 season. Junior **Kane Donovan** started the first four games of 2024 for Missouri Western, but went down with a season-ending leg injury at Emporia State in week four, opening the door for both senior **Brendan Berwald** and junior **Kody Kirk** to also get a heavy dose of snaps.

Statistically, Berwald was the leader in the clubhouse in 2024, starting each of the last six games and finishing with 1501 passing yards and 11 touchdowns to go with 439 rushing yards and a running TD. Together, all three QBs combined for 2547 passing yards, 19 touchdowns and 16 interceptions. In fact, the Griffons set a school record in 2024 with 402 total pass attempts.

Halling the Load

Two-time all-MIAA running back **Brandon Hall** is back for a fifth and final season after a promising 2024 was cut short with an ankle injury in week four. Even though he missed seven games last year, Hall is the lead returning rusher with 557 yards and five touchdowns. He averaged 139.25 rush yards per game and 8.3 yards per carry. He also hauled in 11 passes for 66 yards and an additional score.

Hall currently ranks No. 8 in program history with 2240 career rushing yards. His career average of 6.14 yards per carry is currently No. 5 in the program record books.

Holding the Line

Missouri Western's offensive line had four new starters in 2024, but that position group held its own, giving up an MIAA-low 16 sacks last season. **Quentin Garrett**, **Joe Turner**, **Connor Holt** and **Brayden Wickliffe** (honorable mention all-MIAA) are all back for 2025 after starting every game the previous season.

Defensive Diamonds

Defensively, the Griffons bring back eight starters, including three all-MIAA performers. Among them is last year's tackle leader and linebacker **Kiemen Gaskin** (third team all-MIAA), who finished with 84 total tackles - fifth most in a single season in program history.

Also back on defense is corner **Desmond Green** (second team all-MIAA), who shined with a team-high four interceptions in 2024. He now has six INTs in his career, including a pick-six against Northwest Missouri State in 2023.

Another senior, defensive tackle **Grant Finley** (third team all-MIAA), looks to make an even bigger impact up front after leading Missouri Western in 2024 with five sacks, including three solo sacks against Nebraska-Kearney. He finished 2024 with 9.5 tackles for loss, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

Non-Conference Flavor

Missouri Western, for the first time since 2009, opens the season with back-to-back non-conference games. The Griffons open the season with a big test in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, taking on Augustana on Saturday, August 30 at 1 p.m. The Vikings made the playoffs in 2024, and haven't played Missouri Western since the 2009 Mineral Water Bowl, which was a 34-21 Griffon victory.

The other non-conference game will be a home contest against in-state rival Missouri S&T on Sept. 13 at Spratt Stadium at 6 p.m. This will mark the first meeting with the Miners since 2013, when then No. 6 Missouri Western dominated S&T 63-3 in Week 2 of that season in St. Joseph.

That game will also be a reunion of sorts for Missouri Western head coach Tyler Fenwick. After a highly successful run as Missouri Western's offensive coordinator from 2007-2012, Fenwick took his first head coaching job with S&T in 2013 and was there through the end of the 2018 season.

Fenwick piled up 37 wins during his time in Rolla, including a Mineral Water Bowl victory and 2018 GLVC Coach of the Year honors. He led S&T to just their third 10-win season in history and their first postseason win since 1950.

Augustana Analysis

Augustana heads into 2025 with expectations of getting back to the postseason. Preseason ranked at No. 23, the Vikings were picked to finish second in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) preseason coaches' poll.

The Vikings have been in the playoffs in four of the last five years, and have won back-to-back regular season NSIC Conference titles. Augie is coming off of an 8-4 mark in 2024, falling narrowly to Minnesota State, 20-19, in the first round of the playoffs.

Augie returns 13 total starters this season, including junior and second team all-NSIC performer Gunnar Hensley. Named as the NSIC South Division Preseason Offensive Player of the Year in 2025, Hensley threw for 2,515 yards and 18 touchdowns in 2024, completing 66.8 percent of his passes. He also rushed for 179 yards and two scores.

Hensley's top target from last season, senior Isaiah Huber, returns after grabbing 51 passes for 607 yards and six touchdowns in 2024.

Defensively, senior defensive back Logan Leonard is back after a second team all-NSIC nod in 2024. He had 48 tackles, five pass breakups and a team-leading four interceptions last season.

Augustana is led by head coach Jerry Olszewski (Ole-chef-ski), who goes into his 13th year with the Vikings. He's compiled an 82-45 record in Sioux Falls, including nine winning seasons, five playoff berths and two conference championships.

Saturday marks just the fourth ever meeting with Augustana and just the second ever in the regular season. The first meeting between the two schools, and the only previous meeting in the regular season, was in Sioux Falls on September 6, 1980, and the game ended in a 22-22 tie.

Since then, Augie and MoWest met twice in the Mineral Water Bowl - once in 2008 (37-16 Augie) and again in 2009 (34-21 MWSU).

It's been awhile since Augustana has played any MIAA school in the regular season. A 2009 season opener vs. Emporia State was the most recent. Augie won 32-21.

MISSOURI WESTERN

Fenwick's 2024 squad ranked No. 1 in the MIAA and No. 13 in the nation in kickoff return yards (842) and No. 2 in the conference in tackles for loss (75). The Griffons also ranked No. 1 in the MIAA and No. 3 in the country in fewest number of opponent sacks allowed (16). Twelve players from the 2024 team earned all-MIAA recognition.

In his first season back in St. Joseph in 2023, the Griffons made significant progress with a record of 8-4 (7-3 in MIAA), tying for third in the MIAA and earning a Farmer's Bank and Trust Live United Bowl appearance.

The 2023 team ranked third in the MIAA in scoring, averaging 37.4 points per game. They led the MIAA in rushing with an average of 200.2 yards per game, while also adding 218.2 passing yards per game.

During Fenwick's previous stint at Missouri Western as offensive coordinator from 2007-2012, he helped lead the Griffons to the postseason in each

of the six seasons he was on staff, including an appearance in the NCAA Division II quarterfinals in 2012. The Griffons were outright MIAA champions that same year.

In summary, when Fenwick was the OC at MWSU, the Griffons averaged 35.1 points per game and went a combined 53-18 over those six seasons.

Before returning to MWSU, Fenwick spent the previous three seasons as head coach at Southeastern Oklahoma State University, taking a team that posted a 1-10 record in his first season (2019) to a 9-3 mark in his second season (2021) – the biggest turnaround in NCAA Division II. Southeastern had a pair of postseason appearances in Fenwick's tenure, appearing both times in the Live United Bowl against Emporia State.

The 2021 Great American Conference Coach of the Year, Fenwick mentored 28 all-GAC selections, including GAC Defensive Player of the Year and all-America selection Maalik Hall. Prior to Southeastern, Fenwick took his first head coaching job at Missouri S&T where he posted a 37-29 record overall from 2013-2018, including a 10-2 mark in 2018 which included winning Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) Coach of the Year honors as well as being named the Don Hansen Super Region 3 Coach of the Year.

That 2018 season ended on a six-game winning streak and a 10-2 record, including a 51-16 victory over Minnesota State-Moorhead in the Mineral Water Bowl. That win was the first postseason victory for Missouri S&T since 1950 and is still just the second postseason win in their history.

What's more, S&T's 10-2 record in 2018 was the best among all 21 college football teams in the state of Missouri that year.

Fenwick left S&T ranking third in career victories after seeing his program tie or break 26 individual or team records over six seasons. A total of 79 Miners earned All-GLVC recognition during Fenwick's tenure, including 31 first team selections. Six of them would go on to earn All-American honors across various organizations, while in the classroom his student-athletes have added six College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-America awards over the same span.

Before joining Jerry Partridge at Missouri Western in 2007, Fenwick spent the 2006 season as the offensive coordinator at Minnesota State-Moorhead, where he guided an offensive unit that improved its yardage totals by 65 percent from the previous year, as the Dragons won four of their last five games to finish with a 6-5 record.

Prior to that, he spent five years on the staff at Occidental College in California – the last four as offensive coordinator.

At Occidental, he was the wide receivers coach during the 2001 season as the Tigers went 8-1 and won the Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC) championship, then moved into the offensive coordinator role the following season. Over the four years guiding the offense, Occidental had a 33-9 record, won two SCIAC titles and made two appearances in the NCAA Division III playoffs, winning twice in the 2004 tournament. During those five years, Fenwick coached four all-conference quarterbacks and twice had the conference's Offensive Player of the Year.

Fenwick began his coaching career at the high school level at Birmingham High School in Lake Balboa, California as the program's offensive coordinator, helping guide the team to a conference championship and playoff appearance with a 10-2 record.

Originally from Los Angeles, CA, Fenwick graduated from Chaminade College Preparatory High School. He attended Los Angeles Valley College and the University of New Mexico, where he earned his bachelor's degree in university studies in 1999. A two-year letterman for the Lobos as a wide receiver, he caught 14 passes during the two years he played at UNM.

Fenwick and his wife, Angela, have three children - daughter Kyleigha and sons Kayden and Kiptyn. His father, Jim, was a highly successful coach at the junior college and four-year levels in California and has been inducted into three different Hall of Fames.
