- Missouri State enters the weekend riding a seven-game win streak and their first 9-0 MVC start in 27 seasons as a Valley member; the Bears 9-0 start is the first for a Valley club since Wichita State started the 2004 MVC season with 15 straight wins, while their 13-game MVC win streak is the fifth-longest in conference history
- The Bears bring the No. 13 RPI rating in all of Division I baseball into the weekend; MSU also rejoined *Collegiate Baseball's* Division I poll with a No. 28 ranking on Monday
- MSU holds a 51-40 edge over Evansville in a series that dates back to 1986; the Bears have won four in a row vs. the Purple Aces in Evansville, including a three-game sweep at Braun Stadium two years ago
- The Bears have recorded at least one home run in 13 straight games and hit 27 long balls as a team over the same stretch; Led by **Jake Burger's** six round-trippers, nine different Bears have gone deep during the streak, including five that have recorded at least four homers since April 7
- Burger and **Jeremy Eierman** have combined to post the top home run total for Division I teammates this spring with 32 round-trippers in just 41 games to date; the duo ranks No. 1 and No. 2 in the Valley in home runs, RBIs, total bases and slugging percentage
- Tied for third nationally with 17 home runs, Burger is the NCAA Division I active leader for career homers; the junior also leads the nation in runs scored (53) and ranks fourth in total bases (121) and sixth in slugging (.747)
- The MSU pitching staff can boast three MVC statistical leaders as well, with **Doug Still** (2.18) and **Jake Fromson** (2.54) ranking first and second in ERA, respectively; **Jordan Knutson** leads the league in strikeouts (64) while Still shares the MVC lead with six victories and Fromson has posted league-best figures for opponent batting (.177), fewest hits allowed (29) and fewest earned runs allowed (13)
- The Bears' bullpen has allowed just one run over its last 13.2 combined innings spanning five games
- Blake Graham** has hit .453 in the month of April, belting four homers and driving in 17 runs in 16 games

LEADING OFF

Off to their best Missouri Valley Conference start in 27 seasons as a member of the league, the **Missouri State Bears** will look to keep their April hot streak burning when they travel to Indiana for a three-game MVC set with the **Evansville Purple Aces** this weekend. The Bears and Aces will open the series with a 6 p.m. game Friday (April 28), before playing squaring off in a 1 p.m. doubleheader Saturday.

MSU (28-13) brings a seven-game win streak into the series after completing a season sweep of Mizzou with a 5-1 decision Tuesday at Hammons Field. The Bears swept Wichita State last weekend to run their Valley win streak to 13 straight victories. MSU has hit a blazing-hot .325 in MVC play to date, while the Bears pitching staff has logged a 3.00 ERA.

Evansville (13-27, 4-5 MVC) has dropped five straight games since sweeping Illinois State two weeks ago in Normal. The Aces lost both ends of a two-game midweek series with Murray State earlier this week, as well as both games of its non-conference series with Northern Illinois last weekend.

SERIES HISTORY

Missouri State brings a 51-40 advantage over Evansville into the weekend, as well as a 21-17 edge against the Aces on their home field. Last year, UE took two of three meetings from the Bears in Springfield, claiming a 14-5 victory in the opening game of the series, as well as a 7-1 decision in the rubber match. MSU swept the Aces in its most-recent trip to Braun Stadium in 2015, however.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Several MSU veterans continue to make their moves up the Bears' career leaderboard in a number of statistical categories. Most notably, **Jake Burger** belted his 17th home run of the season and his 42nd as a Bear last Sunday to

move into a tie with Brian Mahaffey for the No. 6 spot of MSU's career homer list. Burger also climbed past a pair of former teammates on the Bears' all-time hits list over the weekend when he gashed Wichita State for seven hits in a three-game sweep. He passed up Tate Matheny (214) and Spencer Johnson (216) to take over the No. 18 spot and needs just six hits to match the career total of Aaron Conway in the 17th position on the chart.

Additionally, **Bryan Young** added to his MSU record with his 31st save as a Bear April 18 at Mizzou, and **Jordan Knutson** made his 41st mound start as a Bear last Saturday to move into a tie with Aaron Meade and Nick Petree for the third-most career starts in program history.

STREAKING IN THE VALLEY

Missouri State is off to a 9-0 start in MVC play for the first time in 27 seasons as a member of the conference. The Bears also ran their regular-season Valley win streak to a program-record 13-straight games with their sweep of Wichita State over the weekend.

The Bears' unbeaten start in conference play is their longest such start since 1990, when they went 11-0 overall in their final league season in the Mid-Continent Conference. MSU surpassed its previous Valley-best streak of 12-straight wins (May 9, 1993 through April 17, 1994) with last Sunday's doubleheader sweep of WSU.

IN RARE COMPANY

Bears head coach **Keith Guttin** picked up his 1,200th career victory April 18 with MSU's 5-3 win at Missouri. The Bears' 35th-year bench boss ranks 25th all-time in NCAA Division I history for coaching victories.

Guttin cracked the NCAA's top 25 coaching wins list on opening weekend, moving past Andy Lopez with MSU's victories over Stony Brook and Rhode Island. With a career record of 1,204-752 (.616), Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history.

BURGER ADDS ANOTHER HONOR

For the seventh time in 10 weeks, a Missouri State standout was named Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week, as **Jake Burger** picked up his third MVC honor of the season Monday.

Burger played a starring role in MSU's best offensive week of the season, hitting .455 (10-for-22) with 13 runs scored and 11 RBIs while clubbing key home runs in three different wins. The Chesterfield, Mo., product belted the Bears' first grand slam of the season while going 2-for-4 with four runs scored and four RBIs in a 15-9 win at Saint Louis last Monday, then blasted a pivotal two-run homer the following night at Mizzou to power a 5-3 Bears win.

The junior third baseman was nearly unstoppable in a three-game sweep of Wichita State over the weekend, scoring three times in Saturday's 12-5 win, before going 6-for-11 with four more runs scored, his 17th home run of the season and five RBIs in a doubleheader sweep of the Shockers on Sunday to help extend MSU's program-record Valley win streak to 13-straight games.

Burger joins last week's MVC honoree, **Jack Duffy**, three-time Valley Player of the Week selection **Jeremy Eierman**, and MVC Pitcher of the Week honorees **Austin Knight** and **Jordan Knutson**, on the Bears' list of Valley award winners this spring.

BEARS IN THE NATIONAL SPOTLIGHT

Several Bears are turning heads on the national level, led by **Jake Burger**, who leads all Division I players in runs scored (53) entering play this weekend. Burger also ranks fourth in total bases (121) and sixth in slugging (.747), while **Jeremy Eierman** is right on his heels in homers and total bases, ranking sixth in both categories. The duo also rates among the top 30 D-I players in RBIs.

On the mound, **Jake Fromson** also rates among the top hurlers in the country with the 12th-best WHIP (0.85) in the Division I ranks. The junior also ranks 26th in hits allowed per nine innings (5.87), while **Doug Still's** total of six victories is tied for 34th nationally.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

After the MSU duo of Spencer Johnson and **Jake Burger** teamed up to post the top combined home run total in the country last spring, the Bears can boast the top 1-2 power punch in Division I baseball again this season. Burger is once again a key component in the middle of the MSU order with a Valley-best 17 long balls to date, while sophomore shortstop **Jeremy Eierman** is right on his heels with 15 after clubbing a key two-run shot in the Bears' 12-5 win over WSU last Saturday. The duo leads Mercer's Charlie Madden (16) and Hunter Bening/J.T. Thomas (12) by four home runs for the national lead in combined homers by teammates.

Individually, Burger ranks third nationally behind only Morehead State's Niko Hulsizer (19) and Eastern Kentucky's Ben Fisher (18) in the Division I home run race. Eierman, meanwhile is sixth in the country with Wake Forest's Gavin Sheets, just one long ball behind Madden in fifth. As a team, the Bears rank 12th in the nation with their 55 home runs this season. MSU has recorded at least one home run in 13 straight games and hit a total of 27 long balls as a team over the same stretch. Led by Burger's six round-trippers, nine different Bears have gone deep during the streak, including five players that have recorded at least four homers since April 7.

THRICE AS NICE

Not only have **Jake Burger** and **Jeremy Eierman** inflicted a healthy portion of damage on opposing pitching staffs this spring, but senior first baseman **Justin Paulsen** has made things triple tough on MSU foes. Together, the trio has combined to hit .355 (167-for-470) with 126 runs scored and 125 more driven in this season.

Individually, each ranks among the top five Valley players in batting and on-base percentage, while two of the three combine to rank first and second in five different offensive categories (slugging percentage, on-base percentage, home runs, RBIs and total bases).

INSTA-GRAHAM

Since his return to the Missouri State lineup on March 31 following a five-week layoff due to injury, **Blake Graham** has provided instant offense for an already-potent Bears' batting order. The senior has batted a team-high .421 (24-for-57) with four home runs and 17 RBIs to help MSU go 13-4 overall and post its best-ever MVC start. Last week, the Edwardsville, Ill., product hit .526 overall, including an unconscious stretch versus Wichita State over which he went 8-for-11 (.727) with 10 RBIs in a three-game MSU sweep.

Graham has been the Bears' hottest hitter in the month of April, hitting .453 in 16 games. He has also enjoyed the friendly confines of Hammons Field in 2017, batting a team-high .462 (18-for-39) in his 12 home appearances this spring.

YOUNG TOPS MSU SAVES LIST

Missouri State closer **Bryan Young** was one of 60 players named to the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association's initial watch list for its 2017 Stopper of the Year Award, given annually to the top relief pitchers in NCAA Division I baseball.

A 2017 preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference selection, Young is coming off one of the more dominant two-year stretches ever produced by a Bears reliever. He became Missouri State's 10th first-team All-American after setting a school record with 16 saves in 2015. The right-hander led the MVC and ranked third nationally in saves, while logging a perfect 7-0 record and a 1.30 earned run average. The MSU closer earned first-team All-America recognition from the NCBWA, as well as third-team honors from both *Perfect Game* and *Collegiate Baseball* at the conclusion of the season.

Young, who was one of five finalists for the 2015 NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award, picked up right where he left off as a sophomore, logging a 1.31 earned run average, while saving 11 games in his 24 mound appearances last season. The Kansas City, Mo., native owns the MSU career saves record with 31, ranks second among all active Division I pitchers for ERA (1.59) and fourth in saves.

CARDIAC CUBS

The Bears rallied for its ninth and 10th come-from-behind victories of the season last week, overcoming an early 1-0 disadvantage for a 5-3 win at Mizzou, before erasing two different deficits vs. Wichita State on Saturday in a 12-5 win. Missouri State's win in Columbia marked its 50th comeback victory since the start of the 2015 season. Last year, the Bears posted 17 comeback wins, on the heels of a 2015 season that saw them claim victory in 24 such contests.

MSU rallied from its biggest deficit in nearly six years last March vs. Arkansas State, coming all the way back from a 5-0 hole to defeat the Red Wolves by a 15-11 final tally. The Bears' last come-from-behind win after trailing by five runs occurred on May 26, 2010, when MSU overcame a 7-2 deficit against Southern Illinois at the MVC Championship in Wichita. MSU was particularly resilient in MVC play in 2015, capturing eight of their 18 conference victories in comeback fashion.

LIFTING THE LID

With its 12-1 win over Rhode Island, Missouri State is now 23-12 in season openers under head coach **Keith Guttin** and 35-19 overall in such affairs. The Bears' big win over the preseason Atlantic 10 Conference favorite marked their fifth-consecutive opening day victory. Additionally, MSU's 12 runs matched their 2016 opening day offensive output as its best since the 2004 season opener (13 runs vs. Little Rock). The Bears have employed a potent offensive attack in recent years, totaling 41 runs in their last four season debuts.

ALL ABOUT THE ACADEMICS

Senior outfielder **Alex Jefferson** was named to the 2016 CoSIDA Academic All-District VI Baseball Team in recognition of his combined performances athletically and in the classroom. Jefferson hit a career-best .286 with three homers, 24 RBIs and 31 runs scored for the season, including a torrid run through the MVC Championship that saw the outfielder hit .455 en route to earning the MVC Elite 18 Award as the tournament's top academic performer.

A Normal, Ill., product, Jefferson has excelled in the classroom, maintaining a 3.97 grade-point average as an accounting major. Additionally, he has earned the MVC Commissioner's Academic Excellence Award in each of the last three years.

WELCOME WAGON

Despite returning 15 letterwinners and six regular position starters from last year's 38-21 club, MSU has had several newcomers log substantial playing time over the first 10 weeks of the season. The Bears' opening day lineup featured three newcomers, including catcher **Logan Geha**, designated hitter **Matt Brown** and starting pitcher **Doug Still**, while freshmen **Drew Millas** and **Jack Duffy** drew starting assignments in game two vs. Stony Brook, and rookie left-hander **Nate Witherspoon** got the mound start in game three against McNeese.

A total of 12 different Bears made their MSU debuts in the Lake Area Classic, led by the performance of Still, who earned the win over Rhode Island after allowing just one run in 6.0 innings. Millas came through with a key two-out, two-run double to help ice the 7-0 win over Stony Brook, plated another with a two-out hit in MSU's win at Oral Roberts (Feb. 21), then provided the go-ahead tally in the 11th at Lipscomb (Feb. 25) with his first home run as a Bear.

Perhaps the biggest blow from a newcomer came at ORU, as **Ryan Skalnik** put the Bears on top for good with a bases-loaded double, before **Trey Turner** helped shut down the Golden Eagle attack with 2.1 innings of no-hit relief to earn the victory in his first mound outing as a Bear.

BEARS IN THE PRO RANKS

Former Missouri State baseball standout **Buddy Baumann** became the 17th Bear to receive a call up to big leagues last July, when the San Diego Padres made the move official by promoting the Rogersville, Mo., product to their 25-man Major League roster.

Prior to being selected by Kansas City in the seventh round of the 2009 MLB Draft, Baumann went 18-8 with a 4.09 ERA over his three-year Missouri State career, striking out 215 batters innings to rank among the school's all-time leaders. He earned second-team All-America honors from the ABCA and *Collegiate Baseball* after going 11-1 with a 3.23 ERA as a junior in 2009. Baumann is one of four former Bears currently in big league spring training camps, joining **Ross Detwiler** (A's), **Pierce Johnson** (Cubs) and **Brad Ziegler** (Marlins), while eight additional former MSU standouts remain active in the minor league ranks.

Last summer, two MSU seniors — **Spencer Johnson** and **Sam Perez** — were among those taken in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Perez was the first Missouri Valley Conference player to be chosen in the draft, as the Miami Marlins selected the right-hander in the fifth round with the 143rd overall pick on the second day of the 40-round amateur draft. The following day, Johnson heard his name called by the Houston Astros in the 16th round with the 487th overall pick.

With the selections of Johnson and Perez, Missouri State extended an impressive string of talent production that has resulted in at least one Bear being picked in 30 of the last 31 MLB Drafts dating back to 1986. Overall, the Bears have produced 136 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts over their 53 years as a varsity program, including 116 during **Keith Guttin's** 34-year tenure as head coach.

HOME SWEET HAMMONS

After spending the bulk of the first six weeks of the season away from Hammons Field, the Bears returned to Springfield March 28 to open a season-long nine-game home stand. MSU has been successful, both at home and on the road so far in 2017, claiming wins in 15 of its first 20 home dates to go along with 13 road/neutral-field victories. Since the start of the 2015 season, the Bears have posted a 56-16 (.778) record at Hammons Field, including 30 wins in their last 39 home games versus non-conference foes.

WHAT'S ON TAP

The Bears' 2017 schedule will feature a total of 54 games, including 23 home dates and match-ups against six different 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. In all, the Bears are slated to play 29 games against 13 different opponents that rated among the top 125 RPI-finishers a year ago, including 13 contests against NCAA Regional qualifiers.

Highlighting the home portion of the schedule will be three-game non-conference series against Central Arkansas (March 3-5) and Memphis (March 17-19), as well as midweek games regional rivals Oral Roberts (March 28), Kansas (April 4), Arkansas (April 11) and Missouri (April 25). The Bears will host four Missouri Valley Conference weekend series, beginning with a three-game league-opening set against Bradley (March 31-April 2) and continuing with match-ups against Dallas Baptist (April 7-9), Wichita State (April 21-23) and Indiana State (May 12-14). The 2017 MVC Baseball Championship returns to Hammons Field for the first time in five years and the fourth time overall, May 24-27, with the champion earning the league's automatic NCAA Tournament bid.

BEARS ON THE AIR

Once again in 2017, Meyer Communications is slated to provide live radio coverage of all 54 Missouri State regular-season games, plus all Bears' games in the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and any 2017 postseason play. The broadcasts can be heard primarily on **KBFL 1060 AM** and **96.9 FM** in Springfield with Art Hains, Rob Evans and Corey Riggs describing the action. An online audio stream is available through KBFL's website via RadioSpringfield.com.

Additionally, fans can keep tabs on the Bears through **The Valley on ESPN3**, under the MVC's media rights agreement that will provide increased coverage of conference events across ESPN platforms through the 2023-24 academic year. This spring, nine different MSU home baseball games will be broadcast on ESPN3.

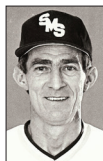

Bill Rowe

On Saturday, May 8, 2004, former head baseball coach and director of athletics **Bill Rowe** became the first person in the 48-year history of the MSU baseball program to have his number retired.

Rowe guided the baseball Bears as head coach for 19 years from the start of the program in 1964 through its final season in NCAA Division II in 1982. He led the Bears to a 394-230-1 record and four Division II College World Series appearances. Under Rowe, the Bears finished as national runners-up in 1969 and finished third nationally in 1970 (just the sixth and seventh years of the program). As athletic director, Rowe guided the Bears from

Division II to Division I and saw the Bears change leagues from the MIAA and Mid-Continent Conferences to a current membership in the Missouri Valley Conference.

The retirement ceremony for Rowe's jersey was held prior to the Bears' doubleheader against Illinois State.

The indoor practice facility at Hammons Field also bears Rowe's name as of January 30, 2010.



Ryan Howard

On Dec. 18, 2010, Missouri State retired the No. 6 jersey of former Bear and 2006 National League Most Valuable Player **Ryan Howard** at JQH Arena.

A St. Louis native who played at Missouri State from 1999-2001, Howard finished his collegiate career with 50 home runs, 183 RBIs and a .335 career average in 172 games. He was the 1999 Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year and MSU's A.E. "Ted" Willis Most Valuable Player in 2000.

Since being drafted by Philadelphia in the fifth round of the 2001 draft, Howard has enjoyed a standout professional career. His long list of accomplishments as a member of

the Phillies includes 2005 National League Rookie of the Year, 2006 NL MVP, 2006 Home Run Derby champion, 2008 World Series champion, 2009 NLCS MVP and three All-Star selections.

Howard debuted with the Phillies in 2004, accumulating a career batting average of .258 with 382 homers and 1,194 RBIs in 1,572 MLB games over 13 seasons.

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KEITH GUTTIN

Head Coach

35th Season
Alma mater: UMSL (1978)

One of the most successful baseball coaches in Missouri Valley Conference history, Keith Guttin began his MSU head coaching career in 1983, and has spent the past 34 seasons building the Bears into one of the top programs in the country. Under Guttin, the Bears have won 61 percent of their games, averaging 35 victories a year and racking up nine 40-win seasons.

Guttin, who entered the 2017 season seventh among active Division I head coaches in career victories, has been a part of the MSU baseball program as a player, assistant coach and head coach for 40 of the program's 54 years. He took the helm of Bears baseball at the start of the 1983 season, coinciding with the move of Missouri State athletics to Division I status. He inherited the reins of the program from its only previous head baseball coach, former Missouri State Director of Athletics Bill Rowe. Guttin ultimately helped stretch MSU's string of consecutive winning seasons to 32 in a row, easily the longest of any Missouri State athletics team. His 1,204 career wins are the most recorded by any head coach in the 110-year history of Missouri State athletics, and the Bears have finished in the top half of the conference race in all but four of his 34 seasons.

During Guttin's tenure, 116 Bears have signed professional contracts, including five first-round draft picks and 15 players who have advanced to the Major Leagues. Additionally, MSU has won 13 regular-season or conference tournament championships and made nine Division I NCAA Tournament appearances, including eight in the last two decades.

In 2003, Guttin led the Bears to the NCAA Division I College World Series for the first time in school history, marking the only trip to Omaha by a Division I team from the state of Missouri since 1965. He has been a conference coach of the year 10 times and was selected the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 1997 and again in 2003.

Guttin's pupils have produced results off the diamond as well. Missouri State baseball players have been recognized on the Valley's all-academic team 60 times since the inception of the honor in 1992. Additionally, seven Bears have garnered academic All-America honors on 12 different occasions under Guttin, including three-time selection Brian Mahaffey.

The 2015 season will go down as one of the more memorable campaigns for Guttin, who was inducted into both the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame and Springfield Area Sports Hall of Fame this past year. He also surpassed the 1,100 career victory mark early in MSU's record-setting season en route to earning his fifth MVC Coach of the Year nod. Under Guttin's guidance, the 2015 Bears set a program record with 49 victories and were ranked as high as No. 6

(Baseball America) in the nation while sweeping the Valley's regular-season and postseason tournament titles. MSU went on to earn its ninth NCAA Division I postseason berth, sweeping the Springfield Regional at Hammons Field to advance to its second Super Regional appearance, where the Bears came up just one win shy of punching their ticket to the College World Series.

While the accomplishments of Guttin's teams on the field speak volumes about the success of his program, another dream came true in April 2004 when the Bears opened a sparkling 8,000-seat stadium just four blocks north of the Missouri State campus. The Bears finished the year ninth among NCAA Division I teams in attendance, playing only a portion of their home schedule at Hammons Field.

It was merely a coincidence that the crown jewel of the Missouri State baseball program came one year after the Bears exploded onto the national college baseball radar in the College World Series. But both events show the growth of college baseball in the Ozarks and the amount of community and administrative support the program had received in the last several years.

With the continued support of the MSU community, Guttin has led the Bears' efforts in numerous charitable endeavors, including the program's annual Price Cutter Celebrity Golf Classic, proceeds from which have been committed to Champion Athletes of the Ozarks in each of the last 20 years. MSU's popular First Pitch and Reunion Night has also been a positive force for both the Bears and a variety of local charitable organizations. The annual preseason kickoff event has benefitted entities such as the Miracle League Ball Field, Care to Learn, Boys and Girls Clubs and the Wounded Warrior Project.

The Bears have finished lower than third in the league standings just nine times since Guttin took over. Guttin directed Missouri State to six straight league titles in Mid-Continent play from 1984 through 1989. He gave MSU its first two Valley postseason tournament championships in 1996 and 1997. He was voted the MVC Coach of the Year in 1993, 2001, 2003 and 2008 and was selected the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 1997 and again in 2003.

Guttin had two notable seasons as the Missouri State second baseman, coming from Mineral Area College. He earned MIAA all-conference honorable mention in 1977 as the Bears made their first NCAA Division II tournament appearance in seven years.

A University City native, Guttin finished his undergraduate degree at the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1978, and earned his master's degree in 1984 from Truman State.

Guttin was a Missouri State assistant under Rowe from 1979 to 1981, as Missouri State won its last MIAA title and made two NCAA appearances. Guttin returned to Missouri State in 1982 after a year at Rend Lake College where he served as assistant coach to former Bear Kirk Champion as RLC claimed an Illinois JUCO sectional crown.

Guttin and his wife, Marianne, have three daughters; Lauren, Lindsey and Samantha.
