- Missouri State enters the week with the No. 28 RPI in all of Division I baseball; the Bears also rejoined both *Collegiate Baseball's* Division I poll (No. 24) and *D1Baseball's* Top 25 (No. 23) on Monday
- The Bears lead the series with Evansville by a 53-40 margin, including a 25-18 edge at home vs. UE
- Entering its longest home stand of the season, MSU has won seven straight home games and is 8-2 at Hammons Field this season; the Bears are 70-20 (.778) at home since the start of the 2015 season
- MSU leads the Valley in team earned run average (3.16), opponent batting (.222), fewest earned runs allowed (82) and double plays turned (22); Individually, **Dylan Coleman** paces the circuit in strikeouts (57), while **Drew Millas** ranks fourth in RBIs (29) and **Jeremy Eierman** rates fourth in home runs (5) and fifth in runs scored (25)
- Ben Whetstone** has reached base safely via a hit, walk or hit by pitch in each of the Bears' 26 contests this season; the sophomore first baseman has also been solid in games following a Missouri State defeat, hitting .409 with all four of his home runs and seven RBIs in such outings to help the Bears go 6-0 after a loss
- Eierman homered twice and drove in a career-best seven runs in the Bears' 8-2 win over CSUN on March 25, climbing to ninth on the Bears' all-time home runs list with the 36th and 37th round-trippers of his career; he trails Ben Carlson in the No. 8 spot by one home run
- MSU has won 12 of its last 14 games since March 11, thanks in large part to a bullpen that has posted a 1.10 ERA and allowed an opponent batting average of just .176; additionally, **John Privitera** and **Matt Brown** have drawn a combined 25 walks over the same stretch, while posting on-base percentages of .466 and .448, respectively
- Head coach **Keith Guttin** (1,238) needs four more victories to match the career total of former Southern Illinois coach Itchy Jones for the No. 21 position on the NCAA's Division I coaching wins list
- Missouri State has 69 combined come-from-behind victories over the last four seasons, including 10 through its first 26 contests of the 2018 campaign

LEADING OFF

Winners of 12 of their last 14 games, the **Missouri State Bears** will look to continue their hot streak this weekend at Hammons Field against the **Evansville Purple Aces**. The Bears will open their longest home stand of the season Friday (April 6) with a 1 p.m. contest, before facing the Aces in single games Saturday (2 p.m.) and Sunday (1 p.m.).

The Bears (19-7) jumped 47 spots to No. 28 in the Division I RPI ratings last week, after recording a road win at Kansas and sweeping a Friday doubleheader from Indiana State to run its win streak to a season-best eight games. The Sycamores stopped MSU's streak Saturday with a 6-4 decision, but the Bears will enter Friday's game 6-0 following a loss this season.

Evansville (6-16) will be opening Valley play this weekend looking to right the ship, after losing 11 of its last 12 games. The Aces were swept in a three-game non-conference road series with Creighton last weekend, before dropping a mid-week contest with Murray State Wednesday.

SERIES HISTORY

Missouri State brings a 53-40 advantage over Evansville into the weekend, as well as a 25-18 edge over the Aces in Springfield. Last year, MSU took both meetings with UE in Evansville, overcoming early Aces leads in both contests to extend their road win streak in the series to six straight games. **Jeremy Eierman** homered twice and drove in four runs in the 13-8 opening-game win, before Justin Paulsen tied a Missouri State single-game record with three doubles in the second tilt.

Evansville has enjoyed its fair share of success against the Bears at Hammons Field in recent years, claiming two of the clubs' last three regular-season series in Springfield dating back to 2010. Overall, the Bears are 14-10 against UE at home since moving into Hammons in 2004.

STARTING STRONG

With their MVC series win at Indiana State over the weekend, the Bears have now won 12 of their last 13 MVC-opening series. Additionally, MSU is a combined 26-10 in its opening conference series since 2006.

Missouri State posted its best-ever-start to a Valley season in 2017 as part of its 22-game MVC win streak. The Bears won their first 18 conference games before falling to Illinois State (May 19) in their regular-season finale. With their 8-5 win over the Redbirds on May 18, the Bears ran their regular-season Valley win streak to a league-record 22-straight games, dating back to their May 15, 2016 win at DBU. They surpassed the previous all-time win streak by an MVC club with their title-clinching win vs. Indiana State on May 13, topping Wichita State's 19-game league win streak (1981-82).

POLL POSITION

With three wins in four games last week, the Bears solidified their position in two major college baseball polls, moving into the *Collegiate Baseball* Top 30 (24th) and *D1Baseball.com* (23rd) polls, while Missouri State saw its RPI climb 48 spots to a peak of No. 27 over the weekend. Each position represents a regular-season best for the Bears, who have now garnered a regular-season top 25 ranking in each of the last four seasons. MSU, which is 3-1 versus ranked foes this season, was tabbed for No. 22 in *Collegiate Baseball's* preseason poll and No. 30 in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association preseason poll.

SHUTDOWN STAFF

MSU pitching has locked into high gear over the last 16 games, posting a 2.92 team ERA and winning 13 of those outings. In all, nine different Bears hurlers have logged sub-3.00 ERA's over the same span, while the staff as a whole has limited the opposition to a .199 batting mark.

A pair of freshmen have led the charge with **Ty Buckner** going 2-1 with a 1.99 ERA and **Connor Sechler** has allowed just one run in 12.2 combined innings, over which he has fanned 18 batters and walked just two to go 3-0 with two saves. The Bears have given up an average of 3.4 runs per outing and have yielded 10 or more hits just twice during the same stretch.

STREAKING AT HAMMONS

With five home victories on their last home stand, the Bears ran their 2018 home mark to 8-2 and extended their current Hammons Field win streak to seven straight games. That streak represents the sixth different home win streak of at least six games since the start of the 2015 season.

The Bears have logged their top two single-season home win totals over the last two years, going 21-7 at home last spring, following a Hammons Field record 22 victories in 2016. In 2015, MSU posted its best-ever showing at Hammons with a 19-3 (.864) mark, giving the Bears a combined 70-20 (.778) home record, including a 23-7 mark in MVC play, since the start of the 2015 season.

CARDIAC CUBS

Missouri State has made a habit of eliminating leads over the last three seasons, and their recent home stand highlighted this trend. The Bears rallied for a come-from-behind win in game two of last Friday's doubleheader at Indiana State and have now totaled 69 come-from-behind victories since the start of the 2015 season. This year alone, the Bears have rallied for 10 wins after trailing the opposition. MSU has been good in close encounters as well, recording a 6-1 mark in one-run contests, including three walkoff wins at home.

With its 10-5 comeback victory over SEMO (March 20), MSU also improved to 6-0 following a loss. The Bears have hit .291 with seven of home runs in those six victories. **Ben Whetstone** has been particularly lethal in games following losses, batting .409 and slugging 1.000 with all four of his homers and seven RBIs. On the mound, **Dylan Coleman** has posted a pair of wins and a 2.57 ERA in such outings.

IN RARE COMPANY

With Missouri State's 10-5 win over SEMO on March 20, Bears head coach **Keith Guttin** moved past former San Diego State coach Jim Dietz into sole possession of the No. 22 spot on the NCAA's Division I career coaching wins list. With a career record of 1,238-766 (.618), Guttin needs four more wins to catch former Southern Illinois coach Itchy Jones in the No. 21 position on the list. Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history, while his win total ranks sixth among all active Division I head coaches.

STREAKING STEINMETZ

After starting the season with only five hits in his first 30 at-bats, junior outfielder **Hunter Steinmetz** has keyed a recent surge that has seen the Bears go 15-4 since March 3. Over the same span, Steinmetz has hit .342 (25-for-73) with 19 RBIs and 17 runs scored. The Springfield native has recorded a hit in nine straight games, hitting .389 over the streak after going 7-for-17 (.417) in the Bears' four outings last week.

COLEMAN CLIMBING

Junior right-hander **Dylan Coleman** picked up his fifth mound victory of the season last Friday with a 4-3 decision over Indiana State, striking out seven Sycamores over 6.2 innings to move up to the seventh position on MSU's career strikeout list (245), passing a pair of former first-round MLB Draft picks in Jon Harris and Ross Detwiler. Coleman, who fanned an MVC-high 106 batters in 2016, needs two more K's to match the career totals of Jordan Knutson (2014-17) and Jarrod Mays (1994-96), currently tied for fifth on the list with 247 career strikeouts.

Coleman also needs one more win to crack the Bears' all-time top 10 list for that category. With 19 wins, he trails five different Bears — most recently Sam Perez (2013-16) — in the 10th spot with 20 victories.

EIERMAN ON FIRE

After a slow start to the 2018 season, preseason All-American **Jeremy Eierman** caught fire to record a career-best 11-game hitting streak, March 3-20, batting .455 (20-for-44) with three home runs and 16 total runs scored to help the Bears go 8-3 over the same stretch. In addition to his career-best hit streak, Eierman handled 41 of 42 defensive chances and swiped six bases in six tries during the hot streak.

Eierman, who was named MVC Player of the Week for the fifth time in his MSU career on March 19, has been at the forefront of the conversation throughout the fall and leading into the preseason about the Bear with the most promising potential to follow in the footsteps of several recent Major League Baseball Draft picks from Missouri State. The Bears have seen six players selected in the top 10 rounds of the MLB Draft over the last three seasons, including two first-rounders.

The Warsaw, Mo., product shared the No. 5 spot nationally with 23 home runs after turning in an NCAA postseason to remember, helping the Bears to their third Division I Regional crown. Eierman was a unanimous preseason All-America pick and was tabbed for USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award watch list.

MARCH MADNESS

As part of their 19-7 start to the season, the Bears locked up their eighth-consecutive .500 or better month of February. Missouri State has been even better in the month of March, which has traditionally been the Bears' most successful month. MSU went 15-5 in March this season, has gone 50-21 in March over the last four seasons and logged 16 winning months of March since 2001. Overall, MSU has posted a .633 March winning percentage and finished .500 or better in the month 46 times in 55 years as a varsity program.

SECHLER TABBED FOR VALLEY HONOR

After picking up a win and a save in the Bears' Missouri Valley Conference opening series at Indiana State, **Connor Sechler** became the second MSU hurler in as many weeks to be named MVC Pitcher of the Week on Monday.

Sechler played an instrumental role in the Bears' doubleheader sweep of Indiana State on Friday, earning a save MSU's 4-3 win in game one—its 12th victory in a Valley opener in the last 13 years—before picking up the win in the Bears' 5-4 decision in the nightcap. A freshman from Bolivar, Mo., Sechler struck out two Sycamores in a scoreless inning and two-thirds to log his second collegiate save, then allowed just one hit over 3.1 innings in game two to give his offense the opportunity to mount the decisive two-run rally in the 11th inning. In all, the right-hander allowed one run on two hits while striking out five in 5.0 innings to help the Bears lock down the series win.

Sechler became the fourth Bear to earn a Valley honor this spring, joining junior **Dylan Coleman**, who earned the same award a week ago, sophomore **Drew Millas** and **Jeremy Eierman**, who picked up MVC Player of the Week recognition on March 5 and March 19, respectively.

ROAD TO SUCCESS

MSU has proven to be hard to stop on the road over the past three seasons, logging a 59-33 (.641) record in such contests. Including their 20-6 record in neutral-field games over the same stretch, the Bears have gone 79-39 (.669) away from Hammons Field since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears went 19-13 in true road games a year ago, after finishing with a program-record 21 wins in 27 road contests in 2015. MSU's 0.857 win percentage on the road represented their best since 1978, when they posted an identical percentage with a 12-2 road mark.

VALLEY FORECAST

With 18 letterwinners returning from last year's 43-20 squad, the Bears were tabbed second in the Missouri Valley Conference's 2018 preseason poll of the league's head coaches. DBU Defending Valley Tournament champion DBU garnered seven of the eight first-place votes and finished with 63 points overall to claim the top spot in the poll.

The Patriots edged the Bears (57 points), who received the remaining first-place vote, while Indiana State (42) and Southern Illinois (35) rounded out the top half of the preseason poll. Illinois State (31) and Bradley finished fifth and sixth, respectively, while Evansville (18) and Valparaiso were slotted into the final two positions in the poll. The league's eight clubs will convene in Dallas at the conclusion of the conference season for the right to represent the Valley in the 2018 NCAA Tournament.

WHAT'S ON TAP

The 2018 Missouri State baseball schedule will feature a total of 53 games, including 24 home dates and match-ups against seven different 2017 NCAA Tournament teams. In all, the Bears are slated to play 23 games against 12 different opponents that rated among the top 125 RPI-finishers a year ago, including 13 contests against NCAA Regional qualifiers.

Highlighting the home portion of the schedule will be a three-game non-conference series (April 13-14) against an Oregon State squad that returns the bulk of its roster from last year's club that earned the top overall national seed in the 2017 NCAA Baseball Championship and advanced to the College World Series with a 56-6 overall record.

MSU's home slate will also feature midweek return visits from Missouri (April 10) and Kansas (May 2) as part of home-and-home series with the Tigers and Jayhawks. The Bears will host three Missouri Valley Conference weekend series, beginning with a three-game set against Evansville (April 6-8), followed by series with Illinois State (April 20-22) and Southern Illinois (May 11-13).

FEELING SUPER

Coming off the winningest three-year period in program history with 130 victories since the start of the 2015 season, the Bears turned in a stretch like no other in school history. Over the last three seasons, nine different players have been selected as All-Americans, six different players have been taken in the top 10 rounds of the MLB Draft, including two first-rounders.

Last year's 43-20 team captured the program's fifth MVC regular-season crown, as well as the NCAA Fayetteville Regional title to advance to Super Regional play for the third time. With their run to the Regional title, the Bears advanced to NCAA Super Regional play for the second time in three seasons and the third time as a Division I program in 2017.

BEARS IN THE PRO RANKS

Four Missouri State baseball standouts reached contractual agreements with professional organizations after being selected in the 2017 Major League Baseball Draft.

First-round pick **Jake Burger** agreed to terms with the Chicago White Sox after the club selected the three-time All-American third baseman 11th overall in the June 12 draft, while fellow MSU juniors **Trey Turner** and **Doug Still** followed suit by reaching deals with Washington and San Francisco, respectively. Senior first baseman **Justin Paulsen** inked a contract with San Diego after being picked in the 39th round by the Padres.

Former Missouri State baseball standouts **Pierce Johnson** and **Luke Voit** became the 18th and 19th Bears to receive call-ups to the big leagues last year. Johnson was selected by the Cubs in the Comp Round of the 2012 MLB Draft with the 43rd overall pick, while Voit was taken by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 2013 draft. The duo became the second and third Bears to receive big-league call-ups in the last two seasons after **Buddy Baumann** made his Major League debut with San Diego in July 2016. Voit is one of three former Bears currently on MLB 40-man rosters, joining Baumann and **Brad Ziegler** (Marlins), while 11 additional former MSU standouts remain active in the minor league ranks.

In 2016, two MSU seniors — **Spencer Johnson** and **Sam Perez** — were among those taken in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Perez was the first Missouri Valley Conference player to be chosen in the draft, as the Miami Marlins selected the right-hander in the fifth round with the 143rd overall pick on the second day of the 40-round amateur draft. The following day, Johnson heard his name called by the Houston Astros in the 16th round with the 487th overall pick. With the selections of Johnson and Perez, Missouri State extended an impressive string of talent production that has resulted in at least one Bear being picked in 30 of the last 31 MLB Drafts dating back to 1986.

BEARS ON RADIO

Once again in 2018, Meyer Communications is slated to provide live radio coverage of all 53 Missouri State regular-season games, plus all Bears' games in the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and any 2018 postseason play.

The broadcasts can be heard primarily on **KBFL 1060 AM** and **96.9 FM** in Springfield with Art Hains, Ben Goss and Corey Riggs describing the action. An online audio stream is available through KBFL's website via RadioSpringfield.com.

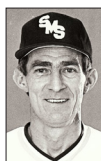

Bill Rowe

On Saturday, May 8, 2004, former head baseball coach and director of athletics **Bill Rowe** became the first person in the 48-year history of the MSU baseball program to have his number retired.

Rowe guided the baseball Bears as head coach for 19 years from the start of the program in 1964 through its final season in NCAA Division II in 1982. He led the Bears to a 394-230-1 record and four Division II College World Series appearances. Under Rowe, the Bears finished as national runners-up in 1969 and finished third nationally in 1970 (just the sixth and seventh years of the program). As athletic director, Rowe guided the Bears from

Division II to Division I and saw the Bears change leagues from the MIAA and Mid-Continent Conferences to a current membership in the Missouri Valley Conference.

The retirement ceremony for Rowe's jersey was held prior to the Bears' doubleheader against Illinois State.

The indoor practice facility at Hammons Field also bears Rowe's name as of January 30, 2010.



Ryan Howard

On Dec. 18, 2010, Missouri State retired the No. 6 jersey of former Bear and 2006 National League Most Valuable Player **Ryan Howard** at JQH Arena.

A St. Louis native who played at Missouri State from 1999-2001, Howard finished his collegiate career with 50 home runs, 183 RBIs and a .335 career average in 172 games. He was the 1999 Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year and MSU's A.E. "Ted" Willis Most Valuable Player in 2000.

Since being drafted by Philadelphia in the fifth round of the 2001 draft, Howard has enjoyed a standout professional career. His long list of accomplishments as a member of

the Phillies includes 2005 National League Rookie of the Year, 2006 NL MVP, 2006 Home Run Derby champion, 2008 World Series champion, 2009 NLCS MVP and three All-Star selections.

Howard debuted with the Phillies in 2004, accumulating a career batting average of .258 with 382 homers and 1,194 RBIs in 1,572 MLB games over 13 seasons.

MISSOURI STATE BASEBALL

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KEITH GUTTIN

Head Coach

36th Season
Alma mater: UMSL (1978)

One of the most successful baseball coaches in Missouri Valley Conference history, **Keith Guttin** began his MSU head coaching career in 1983, and has spent the past 35 seasons building the Bears into one of the top programs in the country. Under Guttin, the Bears have won 61 percent of their games, averaging 35 victories a year and racking up 11 different 40-win seasons.

Guttin, who will enter the 2018 season sixth among active Division I head coaches in career victories, has been a part of the MSU baseball program as a player, assistant coach and head coach for 40 of the program's 54 years. He took the helm of Bears baseball at the start of the 1983 season, coinciding with the move of Missouri State athletics to Division I status. He inherited the reins of the program from its only previous head baseball coach, former Missouri State Director of Athletics Bill Rowe. Guttin ultimately helped stretch MSU's string of consecutive winning seasons to 32 in a row, easily the longest of any Missouri State athletics team. His 1,238 career wins are the most recorded by any head coach in the 110-year history of Missouri State athletics, and the Bears have finished in the top half of the conference race in all but four of his 35 seasons.

During Guttin's tenure, 121 Bears have signed professional contracts, including six first-round draft picks and 17 players who have advanced to the Major Leagues. Additionally, MSU has won 17 regular-season or conference tournament championships and made 10 NCAA Division I Tournament appearances, including nine in the last two decades.

In 2003, Guttin led the Bears to the NCAA Division I College World Series for the first time in school history, marking the only trip to Omaha by a Division I team from the state of Missouri since 1965. He has been a conference coach of the year 11 times and was selected as the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in both 1997 and 2003.

Guttin's pupils have produced results off the diamond as well. Missouri State baseball players have been recognized on the Valley's all-academic team 62 times since the inception of the honor in 1992. Additionally, seven Bears have garnered academic All-America honors on 12 different occasions under Guttin, including three-time selection Brian Mahaffey.

Missouri State is coming off its second NCAA Super Regional appearance and MVC regular-season title in three seasons. The Bears won their first 18 Valley games en route to the title, then captured their third overall NCAA Regional crown by knocking off Arkansas in the deciding game of the Fayetteville Regional. MSU saw its storybook season come to an end at the Fort Worth Super Regional, as TCU secured a fourth straight trip to Omaha with a two-game sweep of Guttin's Bears. Consensus All-America picks Jake Burger and Jeremy Eierman led a potent Bears lineup that paved the way to a 43-20 campaign, while Valley pitcher of the year Jake Fromson led a star-studded pitching staff and garnered All-America recognition of his own.

The 2015 season will go down as one of the more memorable campaigns for Guttin, who was inducted into both the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame and Springfield Area Sports Hall of Fame during the year. He also surpassed the 1,100 career victory mark early in MSU's record-setting season en route to earning his fifth MVC Coach of the Year nod. Under Guttin's guidance, the 2015 Bears set a program record with 49 victories and were ranked as high as No. 6 (*Baseball America*) in the nation while capturing the Valley's regular-season and postseason tournament titles. MSU went on to earn its ninth NCAA Division I postseason berth, sweeping the Springfield Regional at Hammons Field to advance to its second Super Regional appearance, where the Bears came up just one win shy of punching their ticket to the College World Series.

In 2001, Guttin led the Bears to their first-ever MVC regular-season championship and, in the process, dethroned perennial league powerhouse Wichita State. The Shockers had previously won outright or shared the Valley regular season crown in the previous 14 years, but the Bears posted a 22-10 record in 2001 and beat WSU by one game in the final league standings.

While the accomplishments of Guttin's teams on the field speak volumes about the success of his program, another dream came true in April 2004 when the Bears opened a sparkling 8,000-seat stadium just four blocks north of the Missouri State campus. The Bears finished the year ninth among NCAA Division I teams in attendance, playing only a portion of their home schedule at Hammons Field.

It was merely a coincidence that the crown jewel of the Missouri State baseball program came one year after the Bears exploded onto the national college baseball radar in the College World Series. But both events show the growth of college baseball in the Ozarks and the amount of community and administrative support the program had received in the last several years. With the continued support of the MSU community, Guttin has led the Bears' efforts in numerous charitable endeavors, including the program's annual Price Cutter Celebrity Golf Classic, proceeds from which have been committed to Champion Athletes of the Ozarks in each of the last 20 years. MSU's popular First Pitch and Reunion Night has also been a positive force for both the Bears and a variety of local charitable organizations. The preseason kickoff event has benefitted entities such as the Miracle League Ball Field, Care to Learn, Boys and Girls Clubs and the Wounded Warrior Project.

The Bears have finished lower than third in the league standings just nine times since Guttin took over. Guttin directed Missouri State to six straight league titles in Mid-Continent play from 1984 through 1989. He has given MSU its first three Valley postseason tournament championships in 1996, 1997 and 2015. He was voted the MVC Coach of the Year in 1993, 2001, 2003, 2008, 2015 and 2017 and was selected the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 1997 and 2003.

Guttin had two notable seasons as the Missouri State second baseman, coming from Mineral Area College. He earned MIAA all-conference honorable mention in 1977 as the Bears made their first NCAA Division II tournament appearance in seven years.

A University City native, Guttin finished his undergraduate degree at the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1978, and earned his master's degree in 1984 at Truman State. He and his wife, Marianne, have three daughters; Lauren, Lindsey and Samantha.
