FIVE THINGS TO KNOW

- » Utah begins the season in San Marcos, Texas playing in a tournament beginning with the home team Texas State followed by Missouri State on Saturday and Nevada on Sunday.
- » The Utes will begin the season with 11 straight road games against 11 different teams playing in three different tournaments. In all, Utah will play its first 18 of 21 games on the road to start the season. The first home series for Utah is against Niagara on March 8-10.
- » There are seven starters from a season ago, but one big loss was junior DaShawn Keirse, who was drafted in the fourth round by the Minnesota Twins. He set a program record hitting .386 a season ago.
- » Oliver Dunn was the other Ute to hit over .300 a season ago hitting .319 and finishing with 31 RBI. The rising junior second baseman also led the team with nine stolen bases while slugging .459.
- » Utah has 12 freshmen on the roster with three junior college transfers. Overall, this team is much more experienced than a season ago returning seven starters in Brett Brocoff and Joshua Tedeschi.

FIRST PITCH

Utah begins its 2019 season at Texas State in their tournament playing three different teams in three days.

They begin with Texas State on Friday, February 15 at 5 p.m. MT followed by Missouri State on Saturday at 11 a.m. and then finishes the weekend out with Nevada at 10 a.m. on Sunday.

SERIES HISTORY

The Utes will face Texas State for the first time, but have played Missouri State and Nevada three times each.

Utah is a perfect 3-0 against Missouri State, but is 1-2 against Nevada.

COVERING THE UTES

Fans can follow the action this weekend with a live stream from Texas State or live stats on Statbroadcast. There will also be updates on social media throughout the weekend.

SCHEDULE

The Utes non-conference schedule is very unique this season. The team will play 11 different opponents in its first 11 games three different tournaments on the road.

After starting the season at Texas State, they will travel to San Diego and then East Carolina on the third weekend.

After traveling for three straight weekends, they will then host Niagara at home in the final weekend of non-conference play before hitting the road again for Pac-12 Conference action.

In all, Utah will play 18 of its first 21 games on the road this season.

After traveling a lot early in the season, the Utes will finish the season in the friendly confines of Smith's Ballpark playing 10 of its final 13 games at home.

EXPERIENCE RETURNING

There were times in the 2018 season when six freshmen were on the field at once because of injuries

allowing them to earn good experience. This season, Utah is returning seven starters with more experience coming off the bench.

The team has 13 upper classmen led by outfielder Chandler Anderson and infielder Oliver Dunn.

Overall, Utah has 188 games started returning on the infield and even with the loss of DaShawn Keirse Jr., the outfield returns 125 starts from a season ago.

The projected starting pitchers for the season started in 20 games during the 2018 season.

MOELLER RETURNS TO LINEUP

After sitting out the 2018 season with Tommy John surgery, Zack Moeller will return to the lineup as a catcher or designated hitter and is expected to be a boost not only for the offense, but also behind the plate.

In 2017, he started 47 games and played in 49. He hit .265 and had 30 RBI. He was second on the team with five home runs.

DUNN LOOKING FOR A BIG SEASON

Second Baseman Oliver Dunn heads into 2019 with high hopes after having a great sophomore season. He was second on the team hitting .319 and in RBI with 31. Dunn also led the team stealing nine bases in 11 attempts.

Through his first two seasons, he has started in 104 of the 106 games he's seen action in and has a career batting average of .285.

After hitting over .300 in 2018, he was named honorable mention All-Pac 12.

ANDERSON ENTERS SENIOR SEASON

Chandler Anderson comes into his senior season with the most experience on the team playing in 120 games starting in 85 of those during his first three seasons.

The senior outfielder has a career batting average of .274.

He hit .243 his junior season and went eight-for-eight on stolen bases.

SUMMER BALL

Four Utes had success in summer leagues across the country.

Dunn helped lead Wareham Gatemen win the 2018 Cape Cod Baseball League Championship. He hit .230 in the league in 34 games with 10 RBI and scored 19 runs.

Anderson had a huge summer for the Corvallis Knights. He was named Second Team All-WCL after hitting .337 and batting in 34 RBI. Anderson led the team with 22 stolen bases and was second on the team scoring 40 runs. He stepped up in the playoffs batting .474 as the Knights won their third WCL title in a row. The outfielder hit .318 through 54 games in the regular season.

Outfielder Dominic Foscalina played in the Alaska Baseball League for the Anchorage Glacier Pilots. He hit .267 and had 20 RBI on 20 hits. He played in 24 games.

Shea Kramer also had some success playing for the Willmar Stingers in the Northwoods League and had 15 RBI on 20 hits in 35 games.

MLB DRAFT

DaShawn Keirse, Jr. left after his junior season when he was drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the fourth round.

The junior outfielder set a program record hitting .386 and having a 1.049 OPS. He had 78 hits on the season and scored 47 runs while also having 22 RBI.

In just three seasons, Keirsej had a decorated career in a Utah uniform. He was a three-time All-Pac-12 member as well as a three-time Pac-12 All-Defensive Team member. After his record-setting season in 2018, he was named ABCA/Rawlings West All-Region second team. In 2016, he was a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American and became the first Ute named to the Pac-12 Defensive Team.

Keirsej became the 11th Utah player drafted in the first 10 rounds of the MLB Draft since 2008.

PRESEASON PAC-12 COACHES POLL

The Pac-12 Coaches Poll was released and Utah was voted to finish 11th in the league.

UCLA was picked to win the league just edging out Stanford with 97 points to the Cardinal 90. Defending National Champion Oregon State was picked to finish in third.

Last season, the Pac-12 had two teams in the College World Series as Washington joined Oregon State in Omaha.

2016 PAC-12 CHAMPS

Utah baseball became the first men’s program at Utah to claim a Pac-12 Championship.

In 2016, the Utes went 19-11 in conference play to claim the championship. Heading into the final series of the regular season, Utah won two out of three against the Washington Huskies to clinch the title.

600 CAREER VICTORIES

Head Coach Bill Kinneberg sits just 12 wins away from 600 career victories.

He has been the head coach at UTEP for a season as well as Wyoming for seven seasons. He enters his 16th season at Utah.

Utah baseball plays in perhaps one of the most beautiful settings in the nation. Smith's Ballpark, nestled in downtown Salt Lake City, offers sprawling views of the 11,000-foot peaks of the Wasatch Mountain Range.

Smith's Ballpark features seating that curves towards the playing field to enhance sight lines for every seat. The suite level is one of the closest upper decks in the nation, offering fans the amenities of comfort without sacrificing proximity to the field of play. The outfield is asymmetrical (345 feet down the left-field foul line, 386 to the left-center alley, 420 feet to center field, 373 feet to the right-center alley and 315 feet down the right field line). Right field has a short home run porch, and the bullpens are on the field, directly in front of the fans.

Smith's Ballpark also serves as the home of the Salt Lake Bees, the Triple-A farm club of the Los Angeles Angels.


