- The **Missouri State Bears** will kick off a nine-game road swing Tuesday (April 2) with a 6 p.m. game against the **Southeast Missouri State Redhawks** at Capaha Field in Cape Girardeau, Mo.
- The Bears and Redhawks have met 105 times in a series that dates back to 1964, with MSU holding a 65-40 edge
- MSU is a combined 10-4 against the Ohio Valley Conference since 2015, with two of those losses coming at SEMO
- Bears closer **Connor Sechler** was named MVC Pitcher of the Week Monday for the second time in his MSU career after tossing 6.1 scoreless innings in two MSU victories over Indiana State over the weekend
- Sechler ranks among the Valley's top 10 hurlers in ERA (2.43), strikeouts (33), opponent average (.198), games finished (8) and total appearances (11)
- Dakota Kotowski** has hit .343 (12-for-35) over the Bears' last 10 games, with hits in eight of those contests
- Missouri State head coach **Keith Guttin** ranks fifth among all active NCAA Division I coaches in total wins (1,266) and needs five more victories to into the No. 19 position on the NCAA's Division I all-time coaching wins list
- The Bears have posted victories in 157 consecutive contests in which they have taken a lead into the ninth inning
- MSU has 82 combined come-from-behind wins over the last four-plus seasons, including rallying from an eight-run deficit to knock off Oklahoma by an 11-8 score on March 15

LEADING OFF

The **Missouri State Bears** kick off a nine-game road swing Tuesday (April 2) evening with a 6 p.m. (CDT) non-conference game against the **Southeast Missouri State Redhawks** at Capaha Field in Cape Girardeau, Mo. The Bears will then travel to Murray, Ky., Wednesday to square off against another Ohio Valley Conference foe, the **Murray State Racers**. First pitch from Reagan Field is scheduled for 4 p.m. (CDT).

The Bears (7-19) will attempt to build on a successful opening weekend of Missouri Valley Conference play that saw them take two of three games from Indiana State at Hammons Field. Southeast Missouri (14-14) dropped two of three OVC games with Eastern Illinois over the weekend and enters the week having lost four of its last five contests overall.

After concluding its midweek action Wednesday, Missouri State will meet Southern Illinois for a three-game MVC set in Carbondale, Ill., beginning with a 6:30 p.m. tilt on Friday (April 5).

SERIES HISTORIES

Missouri State holds a commanding 65-40 edge over SMO in a series that dates all the way back to the Bears' inaugural season of 1964. The Redhawks have been one of MSU's most-frequent opponents, with the 105 total games ranking behind only Indiana State (121 games), Wichita State (112) and Southern Illinois (111) in terms of series length for Bears' opponents. The Bears hold a 27-24 advantage against SMO in Cape Girardeau, but have lost two in a row at Capaha Field and three of their last four meetings on the road in the series.

Wednesday's game with Murray State will mark the Bears' first trip to play the Racers on their home turf since 1991. The Bears won last year's meeting by a 5-4 score in Springfield and have claimed two in a row from Murray. Overall, MSU is 3-1 against the Racers in Murray and 134-82 overall against the current membership of the Ohio Valley Conference.

FOR OPENERS

On the heels of another successful Missouri Valley Conference opening series this past weekend, MSU has now won 42-5 overall record in Valley play in its last 47 conference games. The Bears logged an 18-1 Valley season to capture the 2017 conference crown, then followed that effort with an 18-3 MVC slate last spring to become just the second club (joining Wichita State) to win back-to-back regular-season titles.

After taking two of three games from Indiana State to begin the 2019 MVC slate, the Bears have also won 13 of their last 14 Valley openers and have won or split 12 of their last 14 MVC-opening series. Additionally, MSU is a combined 28-11 in its opening conference series since 2006.

DAK DOING WORK

Bears freshman outfielder **Dakota Kotowski** has emerged as a force in the middle of the MSU lineup, hitting .343 (12-for-35) with hits in eight of the Bears' last 10 contests since March 16. The Channahon, Ill., product recorded three multi-hit games on the Bears' most-recent five-game home stand. Kotowski logged a pair of two-hit games in MSU's MVC series win over Indiana State after registering a career-best three hits against No. 8 Arkansas last Tuesday.

RIGHTING THE SHIP

While the Bears' 5-18 start represented their worst-ever start through 23 games, they do own a lengthy track record of flipping early results under head coach **Keith Guttin**. On four separate occasions, MSU has overcome sluggish starts to post winning overall records. The Bears have registered two seasons (1996 and 1997) in which they ultimately earned postseason bids after getting off to rocky starts, and another (2009) that culminated in a Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title.

In 1996 and 1997, the Bears captured their first two MVC Tournament titles, but not before getting off to a 9-13 start in 1996 and a 1-8 start the following year. MSU's previous all-time worst start in 1993 saw the Bears open with just six wins in their first 21 contests, only to end up with a 32-23 season mark after winning 25 of their final 29 regular-season games. Finally, the 2009 Bears got off to a 4-10 start, only to rebound to finish 34-20, including a 17-5 mark during their Valley title run.

POWER BOOST

After hitting just three home runs as a team through their first 10 games of the season, the Bears have experienced a power surge of sorts over their last 16 contests. MSU doubled its season total with three long balls in its series at Arkansas State (March 8-10), getting solo shots from **Logan Geha** and **Collin Clayton** and a two-run bomb from **Dakota Kotowski**. The home runs by Clayton and Kotowski marked their first as Bears. Of MSU's 15 homers so far, five of them (including **Anthony Herron, Jr.** and **Javier Ramos**) have come from newcomers hitting their first round-trippers in Maroon and White.

Geha, in particular, has enjoyed a recent power binge, clubbing three long balls in MSU's five games in Oklahoma the week of March 12-17. The junior catcher/outfielder hit all four of his home runs in a six-game span (March 10-17), including his first grand slam as a Bear that helped key MSU's comeback victory at Oklahoma on March 15.

SECHLER NAMED MVC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

After logging a total of 6.1 shutout innings in a pair of dominant relief outings this past weekend, Missouri State sophomore **Connor Sechler** was named Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week on Monday.

Sechler played pivotal roles in each of the Bears' back-to-back wins over Indiana State that locked up a season-opening Valley series win for MSU. The Bolivar, Mo., native worked the final 3 2/3 innings of Friday's 6-5, 11-inning decision, fanning five Sycamores and stranding the potential go-ahead baserunners in scoring position in three different innings. In Sunday's series-clinching 1-0 victory, he piggy-backed a strong start from Logan Wiley with 2 2/3 hitless frames of relief, striking out five more ISU hitters to help pave the way to the Bears' 26th consecutive home MVC regular-season win. The sophomore All-American would work out of a jams in the eighth and ninth innings, striking out the side in the latter after a two-base throwing error opened the inning.

For the season, Sechler is 2-2 with a 2.42 ERA and one save to go along with 33 strikeouts in 26.0 innings. He ranks among the Valley's top 10 pitchers in ERA, strikeouts, opponent average (.198), games finished (8) and total appearances (11). The weekly MVC honor is the first this season for a Bear and the second such award for Sechler, who earned the same honor April 2, 2018.

HOME SWEET HAMMONS

Missouri State opened its 2019 home slate with a pair of convincing victories over Central Arkansas (Feb. 26-27), extending a recent home-field advantage of unprecedented proportions. The Bears have logged four of their top single-season home win totals since the 2015 season, going 17-6 at home last spring after a 21-7 home mark in 2017, a Hammons Field-record 22 victories in 2016 and the Bears' best-ever home win percentage at Hammons with a 19-3 (.864) mark in 2015.

With their two wins over Indiana State last weekend, the Bears may now boast of a combined 83-29 (.741) home record since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears have won 40 of their last 59 regular-season non-conference home games, outscoring their opponents by a 820-527 margin at Hammons over that stretch.

MILLAS, SECHLER EARN NATIONAL SPOTLIGHT

After earning All-America honors to spearhead the Bears' 2018 MVC title run, both **Drew Millas** and **Connor Sechler** were tabbed for 2019 preseason All-America honors by *Collegiate Baseball*. Millas posted a career year in helping the Bears to their second consecutive Valley regular-season championship last spring, posting team-best figures for batting (.321), hits (68) and RBIs (61) en route to earning first-team All-MVC and second-team All-America honors from the NCBWA. The catcher/DH recorded 18 multi-hit games and 18 multi-RBI efforts, as well as three separate four-hit games as a sophomore.

Sechler was a freshman All-America choice of both *Collegiate Baseball* and the NCBWA after anchoring the Bears' bullpen with eight saves and a 2.98 earned run average in 2018. The right-hander limited the opposition to a combined .208 batting average, while striking out 59 hitters in 54.1 innings over an MSU freshman-record 32 appearances.

ROAD TO SUCCESS

MSU has proven to be hard to stop on the road over the past four seasons, logging a 69-47 (.595) record in such contests. Including their 25-12 record in neutral-field games over the same stretch, the Bears have gone 94-59 (.614) away from Hammons Field since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears went 14-8 in true road games a year ago, after logging 19 road wins in 2017 and a program-record 21 wins in 27 road contests in 2015. MSU's 0.857 win percentage on the road that year represented its best since 1978, when it posted an identical percentage with a 12-2 road mark.

Coupled with their 9-3 record in neutral field contests in 2015, the Bears' total of 30 wins away from home was second only to national champion Virginia in the Division I ranks and qualified as the best in school history. The Bears also posted the longest road win streak in Division I baseball in 2015, claiming 11-straight victories from March 15 to April 25.

WHAT A RELIEF

While the Bears have held a lead in just 10 of their 26 contests this season to date, the Missouri State bullpen can boast of a recent track record of locking down victories. Dating back to May 2014, the Bears have claimed victories in 157 consecutive games in which MSU has taken a lead into the ninth inning, including a perfect 5-0 mark in such contests this season. The Bears bullpen has posted an uncharacteristic 6.71 staff ERA through the first 26 games, but two mainstays from last year — sophomore closer **Connor Sechler** and senior lefty **Jake Lochner** — have combined to post a 3.29 ERA in 38.1 innings of relief with 43 total strikeouts.

VALLEY FORECAST

Highlighted by three selections to the 2019 Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Baseball Team, Missouri State was the choice of the league's head coaches to claim its third-consecutive conference crown. Leading the Bears' contingent of three preseason All-MVC choices were returning first-team all-conference picks catcher/DH **Drew Millas** and reliever **Connor Sechler**, while reigning MVC Championship Most Outstanding Player **Ben Whetstone** also picked up a nod at first base.

The Bears, ranked as high as No. 24 in *Collegiate Baseball's* Preseason Poll, captured their third NCAA Regional berth in four seasons last spring after becoming just the second Valley school to win back-to-back regular-season titles (joining Wichita State). MSU (59 points) garnered five of the eight first-place votes to edge DBU for the top spot by just one point.

IN RARE COMPANY

With Missouri State's 4-2 win over Indiana State at the 2018 MVC Championship, Bears head coach **Keith Guttin** moved past Jack Stallings for sole possession of the No. 20 spot on the NCAA's Division I career coaching wins list. With a career record of 1,266-795 (.615), Guttin needs five more wins to catch legendary Miami coach Ron Fraser (1,271) in the 19th position on the chart. Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history, while his win total ranked fifth among all active Division I head coaches entering the 2019 season, his 37th at the Bears' helm.

WATCH THE LEATHER, MAN

In addition to serving as a key cog in the Bears' lineup over the past two years, junior first baseman **Ben Whetstone** has proven to be one of the top defensive performers in The Valley as well. The Overland Park, Kan., native moved into the top spot on the Bears' career fielding percentage chart once again over the weekend. Whetstone's 0.993 fielding mark as a Bear narrowly leads Steve Seal's career percentage as the program's all-time best among all MSU defenders with at least 150 career fielding chances.

BEARS IN THE PRO RANKS

Three Missouri State baseball standouts reached contractual agreements with professional organizations after being selected in the 2018 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Second-round pick **Jeremy Eierman** agreed to terms with the Oakland Athletics after the club selected the two-time All-American shortstop 70th overall in the June draft, while fellow MSU juniors **Dylan Coleman** (fourth round) and **Hunter Steinmetz** (11th round) followed suit by reaching deals with San Diego and Toronto, respectively. Additionally, former Missouri State baseball standout **Matt Hall** became the 20th Bear to receive a call up to the big leagues last year. Hall became the fourth former Bear to earn a Major League roster spot, following **Luke Voit** and **Pierce Johnson** in 2017, and **Buddy Baumann** in 2016.

BEARS ON RADIO

Once again in 2019, Meyer Communications is slated to provide live radio coverage of all 54 Missouri State regular-season games, plus all Bears' games in the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and any 2019 postseason play. The broadcasts can be heard primarily on **KBFL 1060 AM** and **96.9 FM** in Springfield with Art Hains, Ben Goss and Corey Riggs describing the action. An online audio stream is available through KBFL's website via RadioSpringfield.com.

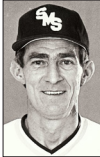

RETIRED NUMBERS



Bill Rowe

On Saturday, May 8, 2004, former head baseball coach and director of athletics **Bill Rowe** became the first person in the 48-year history of the MSU baseball program to have his number retired.

Rowe guided the baseball Bears as head coach for 19 years from the start of the program in 1964 through its final season in NCAA Division II in 1982. He led the Bears to a 394-230-1 record and four Division II College World Series appearances. Under Rowe, the Bears finished as national runners-up in 1969 and finished third nationally in 1970 (just the sixth and seventh years of the program). As athletic director, Rowe guided the Bears from

Division II to Division I and saw the Bears change leagues from the MIAA and Mid-Continent Conferences to a current membership in the Missouri Valley Conference.

The retirement ceremony for Rowe's jersey was held prior to the Bears' doubleheader against Illinois State.

The indoor practice facility at Hammons Field also bears Rowe's name as of January 30, 2010.



Ryan Howard

On Dec. 18, 2010, Missouri State retired the No. 6 jersey of former Bear and 2006 National League Most Valuable Player **Ryan Howard** at JQH Arena.

A St. Louis native who played at Missouri State from 1999-2001, Howard finished his collegiate career with 50 home runs, 183 RBIs and a .335 career average in 172 games. He was the 1999 Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year and MSU's A.E. "Ted" Willis Most Valuable Player in 2000.

Since being drafted by Philadelphia in the fifth round of the 2001 draft, Howard has enjoyed a standout professional career. His long list of accomplishments as a member of

the Phillies includes 2005 National League Rookie of the Year, 2006 NL MVP, 2006 Home Run Derby champion, 2008 World Series champion, 2009 NLCS MVP and three All-Star selections.

Howard debuted with the Phillies in 2004, accumulating a career batting average of .258 with 382 homers and 1,194 RBIs in 1,572 MLB games over 13 seasons.

KEITH GUTTIN

Head Coach

37th Season
Alma mater: UMSL (1978)

One of the most successful baseball coaches in Missouri Valley Conference history, **Keith Guttin** began his MSU head coaching career in 1983, and has spent the past 36 seasons building the Bears into one of the top programs in the country. Under Guttin, the Bears have won 61 percent of their games, averaging 35 victories a year and racking up 12 different 40-win seasons.

Guttin, who entered the 2019 season fifth among active Division I head coaches in career victories, has been a part of the MSU baseball program as a player, assistant coach and head coach for 41 of the program's 55 years. He took the helm of Bears baseball at the start of the 1983 season, coinciding with the move of Missouri State athletics to Division I status. He inherited the reins of the program from its only previous head baseball coach, former Missouri State Director of Athletics Bill Rowe. Guttin ultimately helped stretch MSU's string of consecutive winning seasons to 32 in a row, easily the longest of any Missouri State athletics team. His 1,266 career wins are the most recorded by any head coach in the 111-year history of Missouri State athletics, and the Bears have finished in the top half of the conference race in all but four of his 36 seasons.

During Guttin's tenure, 125 Bears have signed professional contracts, including six first-round draft picks and 18 players who have advanced to the Major Leagues. Additionally, MSU has won 20 combined conference regular-season and tournament championships and made 11 NCAA Division I Tournament appearances, including 10 in the last 23 years.

In 2003, Guttin led the Bears to the NCAA Division I College World Series for the first time in school history, marking the only trip to Omaha by a Division I team from the state of Missouri since 1965. He has been a conference coach of the year 11 times and was selected as the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in both 1997 and 2003.

Guttin's pupils have produced results off the diamond as well. Missouri State baseball players have been recognized on the Valley's all-academic team 65 times since the inception of the honor in 1992. Additionally, seven Bears have garnered academic All-America honors on 12 different occasions under Guttin, including three-time selection Brian Mahaffey.

Missouri State is coming off both its third NCAA Regional appearance and MVC regular-season title in the last four seasons. In 2017, the Bears won their first 18 Valley games en route to the title, then captured their third overall NCAA Regional crown by knocking off Arkansas in the deciding game of the Fayetteville Regional. MSU saw its storybook season come to an end at the Fort Worth Super Regional, as TCU secured a fourth straight trip to Omaha with a two-game sweep of Guttin's Bears. Consensus All-America picks Jake Burger and Jeremy Eierman led a potent Bears lineup that paved the way to a 43-20 campaign, while Valley pitcher of the year Jake Fromson led a star-studded pitching staff and garnered All-America recognition of his own.

The 2015 season will go down as one of the more memorable campaigns for Guttin, who was inducted into both the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame and Springfield Area Sports Hall of Fame during the year. He also surpassed the 1,100 career victory mark early in MSU's record-setting season en route to earning his fifth MVC Coach of the Year nod. Under Guttin's guidance, the 2015 Bears set a program record with 49 victories and were ranked as high as No. 6 (*Baseball America*) in the nation while capturing the Valley's regular-season and postseason tournament titles. MSU went on to earn its ninth NCAA Division I postseason berth, sweeping the Springfield Regional at Hammons Field to advance to its second Super Regional appearance, where the Bears came up just one win shy of punching their ticket to the College World Series.

In 2001, Guttin led the Bears to their first-ever MVC regular-season championship and, in the process, dethroned perennial league powerhouse Wichita State. The Shockers had previously won outright or shared the Valley regular season crown in the previous 14 years, but the Bears posted a 22-10 record in 2001 and beat WSU by one game in the final league standings.

While the accomplishments of Guttin's teams on the field speak volumes about the success of his program, another dream came true in April 2004 when the Bears opened a sparkling 8,000-seat stadium just four blocks north of the Missouri State campus. The Bears finished the year ninth among NCAA Division I teams in attendance, playing only a portion of their home schedule at Hammons Field.

It was merely a coincidence that the crown jewel of the Missouri State baseball program came one year after the Bears exploded onto the national college baseball radar in the College World Series. But both events show the growth of college baseball in the Ozarks and the amount of community and administrative support the program had received in the last several years. With the continued support of the MSU community, Guttin has led the Bears' efforts in numerous charitable endeavors, including the program's annual Price Cutter Celebrity Golf Classic, proceeds from which have been committed to Champion Athletes of the Ozarks in each of the last 20 years. MSU's popular First Pitch and Reunion Night has also been a positive force for both the Bears and a variety of local charitable organizations. The preseason kickoff event has benefitted entities such as the Miracle League Ball Field, Care to Learn, Boys and Girls Clubs and the Wounded Warrior Project.

The Bears have finished lower than third in the league standings just nine times since Guttin took over. Guttin directed Missouri State to six straight league titles in Mid-Continent play from 1984 through 1989. He has given MSU its first four Valley postseason tournament championships in 1996, 1997, 2015 and 2018. He was voted the MVC Coach of the Year in 1993, 2001, 2003, 2008, 2015, 2017 and 2018 and was selected the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 1997 and 2003.

Guttin had two notable seasons as the Missouri State second baseman, coming from Mineral Area College. He earned MIAA all-conference honorable mention in 1977 as the Bears made their first NCAA Division II tournament appearance in seven years.

A University City native, Guttin finished his undergraduate degree at the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1978, and earned his master's degree in 1984 at Truman State. He and his wife, Marianne, have three daughters; Lauren, Lindsey and Samantha.
