- The **Missouri State Bears** will open the home portion of their 2020 schedule, as well as a five-game home-stand, with a three-game non-conference set against the **Maine Black Bears** at Hammons Field
- Keith Guttin** ranks fourth on the NCAA's Division I wins list for active coaches and 19th all-time with 1,285 victories for his 38-year career; he needs 15 wins to catch Fresno State's Bob Bennett in the 18th spot on the chart
- MSU is 10-6 in home openers since moving into Hammons Field in 2004, including wins in seven of its last nine home debuts since 2011; The Bears, who will play their 400th game at Hammons on Sunday, are 260-137 overall in their 16 seasons at the facility
- Since snapping a lengthy scoring drought Feb. 25 at ORU, the Bears have plated 30 runs in their last 41 turns at bat; MSU has produced 10 different multi-run scoring rallies over the same span after logging just two such rallies in their first 67 innings of the 2020 season
- Ben Whetstone** ranks among the Bears' career defensive leaders in several categories, including second in career fielding (.992) and 10th in both double plays (97) and putouts (970)
- MSU ranks third in the Valley in both ERA (4.05) and double plays turned (8), as well as fourth in team fielding (.975)
- The Bears have won 42 of their last 64 regular-season non-conference home games, outscoring their non-league opponents by a 856-575 margin at Hammons Field over the same stretch
- The duo of **Hayden Juenger** and **Forrest Barnes** have formed a dominant one-two punch out of the Bears' bullpen, combining to go 3-0 with three saves and a 2.84 ERA in 11 total appearances
- Drake Baldwin** brings a six-game hit streak into Friday's game; the freshman leads the Bears in hitting (.333), hits (15), on-base percentage (.388), total bases (22) and slugging percentage (.489)

LEADING OFF

After wrapping up their season-opening 12-game road swing with at Oklahoma State on Tuesday, the **Missouri State Bears** return to the friendly confines of Hammons Field Friday (March 6) to open the home portion of their 2020 schedule with a three-game set against the **Maine Black Bears**. Friday's series opener is slated for a 3 p.m. first pitch, while game two on Saturday (March 7) will get underway at 2 p.m. and Sunday's (March 8) finale will begin at Noon (CST).

Missouri State (6-6) turned in its best offensive effort of the season Tuesday in Stillwater, posting four different rallies of at least two runs to post an 11-10 win over the Cowboys. The Bears received balanced contributions from up and down its lineup, led by big games from **Jack Duffy** and **Dakota Kotowski**, who combined to record six hits and seven RBIs.

Maine (0-10) enters the series in search of its first victory of the season following a four-game sweep at Louisiana Tech last weekend.

SERIES HISTORY

Friday's contest will mark the first meeting of the two former NCAA Division I College World Series qualifiers. The Bears have played just two teams from the America East Conference in their 57-year history, amassing a 2-1 mark against UMBC (1-0) and Stony Brook (1-1).

WELCOME HOME

Missouri State will open its 2020 home slate Friday looking to extend a recent home-field advantage of unprecedented proportions in the history of the MSU program. The Bears have logged four of their top single-season home win totals since the 2015 season, going 17-6 at home last spring after a 21-7 home mark in 2017, a Hammons Field-record 22 victories in 2016 and the Bears' best-ever home win percentage at Hammons with a 19-3 (.864) mark in 2015.

Those four seasons give the Bears a combined 79-24 (.767) home record over the four-year stretch. The Bears have won 38 of their last 53 regular-season non-conference home games, outscoring their non-league opponents by a 786-494 margin at Hammons Field since the start of the 2015 season.

ELITE COMPANY

The Bears' Feb. 25 game at ORU marked the beginning of a notable string of elite opponents for Missouri State, which will play nine-straight games against NCAA Division I College World Series qualifying teams and 16 of 17 contests overall against CWS-qualifying clubs.

MSU will play two games against ORU (who appeared in Omaha in 1978), three against Rice (seven appearances), one game with Oklahoma State (20 appearances) and three contests against Maine (seven appearances) over the period Feb. 25-March 8. Following a midweek game against SIU Edwardsville (March 11), the Bears will then play seven more games against three additional CWS qualifiers (UC Irvine, Alabama and San Jose State) before opening Valley play with a three-game set at Bradley, which has made two of its own CWS trips.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK HANGIN' TOUGH

The Bears offense has been bolstered by the addition of several talented newcomers over the season's first three weeks. MSU's top three hitters are all new to the program this year, with freshman **Drake Baldwin** leading the club with a .333 average and nine RBIs through the first 12 games. Junior transfer **Grant Wood** has gotten off to a hot start as well, batting .304 with hits in each of his first nine games as a Bear, and freshman outfielder **Greg Ziegler** has turned in a .296 batting mark with three multi-hit performances to date.

CARDIAC CUBS

The Bears posted their third come-from-behind victory of the season Tuesday at OSU, following comeback wins at Austin Peay (Feb. 20) and ORU (Feb. 25) in the first two weeks of the season. MSU made the comeback rally an art form in accumulating the most overall victories over a four-year period (170) in program history from 2015-18. Since the start of the 2015 season, the Bears have rallied for a victory on 93 separate occasions, including 21 times in 2018, which represented 52.5 percent of their overall season win total (40). Last spring, the Bears completed their second comeback victory from at least a seven-run deficit last season when they erased an 8-1 deficit en route to a 10-9 win over Evansville on May 11. That effort followed an 11-8 comeback win over Oklahoma (March 15), in what is believed to be the largest come-from-behind victory program history. MSU wiped out an 8-0, seventh-inning deficit by scoring seven times in the seventh, three more in the eighth and one in the ninth.

GETTING OFFENSIVE

Since enduring a 34-inning scoreless drought over parts of five games from Feb. 20-25, the Bears' offense has heated up to score 30 runs in their last 41 innings, averaging 6.2 runs per contest in their last five games. **Drake Baldwin** has paced the Bears at the plate, hitting .381 with eight RBIs, while **Jack Duffy** has batted .350. Furthermore, MSU has posted 10 different multi-run rallies over the same stretch after logging only two such rallies over its first 67 turns at bat of the season.

BEARS DUO TABBED PRESEASON ALL-MVC

Returning all-conference outfielders **Jack Duffy** and **Dakota Kotowski** led the Bears' contingent on the Missouri Valley Conference's preseason team.

A three-year starter in the Bears' outfield, Duffy batted .341 in MVC play and a team-leading .305 overall to garner a second-team All-MVC selection in 2019. The Kansas City, Mo., product recorded 17 multi-hit performances, including a career-best four-hit effort vs. New Orleans on April 20, and reached base safely in all 21 Valley contests. An MVC Scholar-Athlete Team selection for the second year in a row last spring, Duffy brought a 12-game hit streak into the 2020 season after logging a blistering stretch drive at the plate, hitting .409 over the Bears' final 10 games last year.

Kotowski, a *Collegiate Baseball* Freshman All-America choice last spring, became the ninth MSU player to be honored as the Valley's Freshman of the Year. He finished his rookie campaign with 12 home runs and a .576 slugging percentage to lead the Bears en route to earning first-team All MVC recognition. The Channahon, Ill., native ranked second overall in the MVC in home runs and third in slugging percentage and rated among the top 15 MVC hitters in batting, slugging,

on-base percentage, home runs, RBI, total bases and walks during league play. Kotowski's home run total ranks third on MSU's freshman chart, trailing only former big leaguers Ryan Howard (19 in 1999) and Jason Hart (15 in 1996). Additionally, he became the 42nd Missouri State baseball player to garner All-America status.

BEARS IN THE PRO RANKS

Two Missouri State baseball standouts reached contractual agreements with professional organizations following the conclusion of the season. With seventh-round pick **Drew Millas** going to the Oakland Athletics as the 224th overall selection, the Bears closed the decade with their 16th player selection in the first 11 rounds of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft since 2010. MSU senior left-hander **Davis Schwab** was also picked in the draft, going in the 37th round (the 1,117th overall selection) to the Atlanta Braves.

Additionally, former Missouri State baseball standout **Matt Hall** became the 20th Bear to receive a call up to the big leagues in 2018. Hall became the fourth former Bear to earn a Major League roster spot in the last four years, following **Luke Voit** and **Pierce Johnson** in 2017 and **Buddy Baumann** in 2016. Overall, the Bears have produced 146 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts over their 56 years as a varsity program, including 127 during **Keith Guttin's** 37-year tenure as head coach.

VALLEY FORECAST

Highlighted by a pair of selections to the 2020 Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference Baseball Team, Missouri State was tabbed second in the Valley's annual preseason poll in a vote of the conference's head coaches.

MSU will welcome back eight position starters and 10 total pitchers from last year's squad, including six veterans who have earned all-conference honors during their respective careers. The Bears will be looking to bounce back from a 20-36 campaign in 2019 and a sixth-place MVC finish – just their seventh second-division finish in 28 Valley seasons.

Defending Valley co-champion DBU garnered five of the eight first-place votes and finished with 61 points overall to claim the top spot in the poll. The Patriots edged the Bears (51 points), who received one first-place vote, while Illinois State (49) and Indiana State (40) rounded out the top half of the preseason poll. Bradley (38) and Evansville (21) finished fifth and sixth, respectively, while Southern Illinois (18) and Valparaiso (10) were slotted into the final two positions in the poll.

IN RARE COMPANY

With Missouri State's 6-1 win over New Orleans on April 19, 2019, Bears head coach **Keith Guttin** moved past legendary Miami coach Ron Fraser (1,271) to climb to the 19th position on the NCAA's Division I career coaching wins list.

With a career record of 1,285-818 (.611), Guttin now needs 15 more victories to match the career total of Fresno State's Bob Bennett (1,300) in the No. 18 spot on the chart. Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history, while his win total ranks fourth among all active Division I head coaches entering the 2020 season, his 38th at the Bears' helm.

LIFTING THE LID

Thanks to 7.0 shutout innings from **Logan Wiley**, the Bears notched their first opening day shutout in 50 years with their 1-0 win over Central Arkansas on Feb. 14. The Bears are now 25-13 in season openers under head coach **Keith Guttin** and 37-20 overall as a program in such contests. MSU has also gone a combined 18-7 on opening weekend since 2013. MSU has started seven of the last eight campaigns with at least six wins in its first 10 games (failing to do so only in 2019), including their best-ever start (10-1) to a season in 2017.

NON-CON DOMINATION

MSU has been nearly unstoppable against non-conference competition over the last five seasons, compiling an 99-66 (.600) record in regular-season games versus non-league foes since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears have won 42 of their last 64 regular-season non-conference home games, outscoring their non-league opponents by a 856-575 margin at Hammons Field over the same stretch.

ROAD TO SUCCESS

MSU has proven to be hard to stop on the road over the past five seasons, logging an 80-61 (.567) record in such contests. Including their 26-14 record in neutral-field games over the same stretch, the Bears have gone 106-75 (.586) away from Hammons Field since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears went 14-8 in true road games in 2018, after logging 19 road wins in 2017 and a program-record 21 wins in 27 road contests in 2015. MSU's 0.857 win percentage on the road that year represented its best since 1978, when it posted an identical percentage with a 12-2 road mark. Coupled with their 9-3 record in neutral field contests in 2015, the Bears' total of 30 wins away from home was second only to national champion Virginia in the Division I ranks. The Bears also posted the longest road win streak in Division I baseball in 2015, claiming 11-straight victories from March 15 to April 25.

BEARS ON RADIO

Once again in 2020, Meyer Communications is slated to provide live radio coverage of all 56 Missouri State regular-season games, plus all Bears' games in the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and any 2020 postseason play. The broadcasts can be heard primarily on **KBFL 1060 AM** and **96.9 FM** in Springfield with Art Hains, Ben Goss and Corey Riggs describing the action. An online audio stream is available through KBFL's website via RadioSpringfield.com.

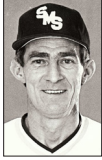

RETIRED NUMBERS



Bill Rowe

On Saturday, May 8, 2004, former head baseball coach and director of athletics **Bill Rowe** became the first person in the 48-year history of the MSU baseball program to have his number retired.

Rowe guided the baseball Bears as head coach for 19 years from the start of the program in 1964 through its final season in NCAA Division II in 1982. He led the Bears to a 394-230-1 record and four Division II College World Series appearances. Under Rowe, the Bears finished as national runners-up in 1969 and finished third nationally in 1970 (just the sixth and seventh years of the program). As athletic director, Rowe guided the Bears from

Division II to Division I and saw the Bears change leagues from the MIAA and Mid-Continent Conferences to a current membership in the Missouri Valley Conference.

The retirement ceremony for Rowe's jersey was held prior to the Bears' doubleheader against Illinois State.

The indoor practice facility at Hammons Field also bears Rowe's name as of January 30, 2010.



Ryan Howard

On Dec. 18, 2010, Missouri State retired the No. 6 jersey of former Bear and 2006 National League Most Valuable Player **Ryan Howard** at JQH Arena.

A St. Louis native who played at Missouri State from 1999-2001, Howard finished his collegiate career with 50 home runs, 183 RBIs and a .335 career average in 172 games. He was the 1999 Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Year and MSU's A.E. "Ted" Willis Most Valuable Player in 2000.

Since being drafted by Philadelphia in the fifth round of the 2001 draft, Howard has enjoyed a standout professional career. His long list of accomplishments as a member of

the Phillies includes 2005 National League Rookie of the Year, 2006 NL MVP, 2006 Home Run Derby champion, 2008 World Series champion, 2009 NLCS MVP and three All-Star selections.

Howard debuted with the Phillies in 2004, accumulating a career batting average of .258 with 382 homers and 1,194 RBIs in 1,572 MLB games over 13 seasons.

KEITH GUTTIN Head Coach

38th Season
Alma mater: UMSL (1978)

One of the most successful baseball coaches in Missouri Valley Conference history, **Keith Guttin** began his MSU head coaching career in 1983, and has spent the past 37 seasons building the Bears into one of the top programs in the country. Under Guttin, the Bears have won 61 percent of their games, averaging 35 victories a year and racking up 12 different 40-win seasons.

Guttin, who entered the 2020 season fourth among active Division I head coaches in career victories, has been a part of the MSU baseball program as a player, assistant coach and head coach for 43 of the program's 57 years. He took the helm of Bears baseball at the start of the 1983 season, coinciding with the move of Missouri State athletics to Division I status. He inherited the reins of the program from its only previous head baseball coach, former Missouri State Director of Athletics Bill Rowe. Guttin ultimately helped stretch MSU's string of consecutive winning seasons to 32 in a row, easily the longest of any Missouri State athletics team. His 1,285 career wins are the most recorded by any head coach in the 112-year history of Missouri State athletics, and the Bears have finished in the top half of the conference race in all but five of his 37 seasons.

During Guttin's tenure, 127 Bears have signed professional contracts, including six first-round draft picks and 18 players who have advanced to the Major Leagues. Additionally, MSU has won 20 combined conference regular-season and tournament championships and made 11 NCAA Division I Tournament appearances, including 10 in the last two decades.

In 2003, Guttin led the Bears to the NCAA Division I College World Series for the first time in school history, marking the only trip to Omaha by a Division I team from the state of Missouri since 1965. He has been a conference coach of the year 11 times and was selected as the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in both 1997 and 2003.

Guttin's pupils have produced results off the diamond as well. Missouri State baseball players have been recognized on the Valley's all-academic team 66 times since the inception of the honor in 1992. Additionally, seven Bears have garnered academic All-America honors on 12 different occasions under Guttin, including three-time selection Brian Mahaffey.

Missouri State is coming off a successful stretch that has seen the Bears claim three MVC regular-season titles in the last five seasons. In 2018, Guttin picked up his second consecutive MVC Coach of the Year honor after leading the Bears to their 12th 40-win campaign, as MSU swept the MVC regular-season and post-season tournament crowns for just the second time in school history. The previous spring, the Bears won their first 18 Valley games en route to the title, then captured their third overall NCAA Regional crown by knocking off Arkansas in the deciding game of the Fayetteville Regional. MSU saw its storybook season come to an end at the Fort Worth Super Regional, as TCU secured a fourth straight trip to Omaha with a two-game sweep of Guttin's Bears. Consensus All-America picks Jake Burger and Jeremy Eierman led

a potent Bears lineup that paved the way to a 43-20 campaign, while Valley pitcher of the year Jake Fromson led a star-studded pitching staff and garnered All-America recognition of his own.

The 2015 season will go down as one of the more memorable campaigns for Guttin, who was inducted into both the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame and Springfield Area Sports Hall of Fame during the year. He also surpassed the 1,100 career victory mark early in MSU's record-setting season en route to earning his fifth MVC Coach of the Year nod. Under Guttin's guidance, the 2015 Bears set a program record with 49 victories and were ranked as high as No. 6 (*Baseball America*) in the nation while capturing the Valley's regular-season and postseason tournament titles. MSU went on to earn its ninth NCAA Division I postseason berth, sweeping the Springfield Regional at Hammons Field to advance to its second Super Regional appearance, where the Bears came up just one win shy of punching their ticket to the College World Series.

In 2001, Guttin led the Bears to their first-ever MVC regular-season championship and, in the process, dethroned perennial league powerhouse Wichita State. The Shockers had previously won outright or shared the Valley regular season crown in the previous 14 years, but the Bears posted a 22-10 record in 2001 and bested WSU by one game for the MVC crown.

While the accomplishments of Guttin's teams on the field speak volumes about the success of his program, another dream came true in April 2004 when the Bears opened a sparkling 8,000-seat stadium just four blocks north of the Missouri State campus. It was merely a coincidence that the crown jewel of the Missouri State baseball program came one year after the Bears exploded onto the national college baseball radar in the College World Series. But both events show the growth of college baseball in the Ozarks and the amount of community and administrative support the program had received in the last several years. With the continued support of the MSU community, Guttin has led the Bears' efforts in numerous charitable endeavors, including the program's annual Price Cutter Celebrity Golf Classic, proceeds from which have been committed to Champion Athletes of the Ozarks in each of the last 20 years. MSU's popular First Pitch and Reunion Night has also been a positive force for both the Bears and a variety of local charitable organizations. The preseason kickoff event has benefitted entities such as the Miracle League Ball Field, Care to Learn, Boys and Girls Clubs and the Wounded Warrior Project.

The Bears have finished lower than third in the league standings just 10 times since Guttin took over. Guttin directed Missouri State to six straight league titles in Mid-Continent play from 1984 through 1989. He has given MSU its first four Valley postseason tournament championships in 1996, 1997, 2015 and 2018. He was voted the MVC Coach of the Year in 1993, 2001, 2003, 2008, 2015, 2017 and 2018 and was selected the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 1997 and 2003.

Guttin had two notable seasons as the Missouri State second baseman, coming from Mineral Area College. He earned MIAA all-conference honorable mention in 1977 as the Bears made their first NCAA Division II tournament appearance in seven years.

A University City native, Guttin finished his undergraduate degree at the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1978, and earned his master's degree in 1984 at Truman State. He and his wife, Marianne, have three daughters, Lauren, Lindsey and Samantha, and one grandson, Bradley.

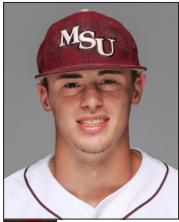
