

2021 Missouri State Soccer Fan Guide

Due to the health and safety protocols implemented relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, Missouri State University has made several changes to the soccer game-day experience at Betty & Bobby Allison South Stadium. This includes adjustments to and/or elimination of some popular game-day traditions. The following guidelines include:

- Admission to Betty & Bobby Allison South Stadium is free this year with the northwest gate serving as the only entry point. The gate will open 60 minutes prior to game time.
- Attendance is limited to 30% capacity and all fans will be asked to follow social distancing guidelines.
- Face coverings, over the nose and mouth, are required for all fans at all times. Children 2 and younger are not required to wear a mask.
- To eliminate touch points, game flip cards will be available on a digital basis through the MSU Bears mobile app and at MissouriStateBears.com.
- Access to the field is restricted to Tier 1 personnel only and fans are prohibited from entering the track and pitch area.
- Concessions and public restrooms will be available during the games.
- The stadium will be cleared at the conclusion of the match with any parent/player meetings taking place outside the stadium only.
- Access to the press box and camera deck is restricted to game-day personnel and authorized media only.
