QUICK KICKS

- No. 13 Missouri State (4-0-0, 3-0-0 MVC) kept its undefeated season alive by converting a penalty kick in the late stages of a 2-1 win over Evansville on Sunday, March 14. Following a one-hour lightning delay, **Nicolo Mulatero** connected on his second PK goal of the year in the 85th minute to seal the Bears' fourth straight victory.
- The Bears attack has earned 43 corner kicks on the season, including double-digit efforts against Bradley (11) and Creighton (16). MSU ranks third in the nation in corner set-pieces per game with an average of 10.75. **Kyle Hiebert's** game-winning goal against Creighton (March 10) came courtesy of a corner kick sent in by **Kian Yari**.
- The Missouri State defense has allowed just one goal in 2021 after opening up the year with three straight shutouts recorded, a feat they accomplished last season on two separate occasions (Sept. 2-10, 2019; Sept. 26-Oct. 9, 2019). The Bears rank second in the conference with a .250 goals against average and are tied for 12th in the nation. With the three clean sheets, MSU's shutout percentage (.750) is tied for 10th-best among Division I teams.
- MSU captain **Kyle Hiebert (Sr., D, La Salle, Canada)** was selected as Missouri Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Week this past week (March 16) for his efforts in the Bears' wins against Creighton (March 10) and Evansville (March 14). After guiding MSU to its third straight shutout against the Bluejays where he chipped in the game-winning goal on the offensive side, Hiebert added another key defensive effort against UE where he helped to limit the Purple Aces to merely two shots in the match. The reigning MVC Defensive Player of the Year became the fourth MSU player to garner one of the conference's weekly awards after **Dawson Lee** (March 9), **Nicolo Mulatero** (March 2) and **Connor Langan** (March 2) each picked up an honor in the previous two weeks.
- **Nicolo Mulatero** (Jr., F, Givoletto, Italy) converted his second penalty kick of 2021 in Sunday's win against the Purple Aces. He is 2-2 on PK chances this year after firing one in against Bradley in the season opener (Feb. 27). Mulatero has also contributed a league-best three assists in four matches, setting up MSU goals in three straight games to begin his junior campaign. The three assists along with his two goals puts him as the Valley leader in points (7).
- **Michael Creek** (Sr., GK, St. Louis, Mo.) has held opponents scoreless in three of his four matches while logging all 360 goalie minutes. The three clean sheets in 2021 gives him 16 for his career to rank fourth on the program's career shutout list. He has saved nine of the 10 shots sent his way for a .900 save percentage that is third among MVC keepers. Creek earned MVC Goalkeeper of the Year in 2019 after finishing the season with seven shutouts and a 0.645 goals against average that ranked ninth in the nation.

Head Coach Jon Leamy

Bears head coach **Jon Leamy** is in his 29th season leading the Bears' program as the winningest coach in school history with a **284-185-66** (.592) overall record. He began the 2020-21 season ranked 24th among all active NCAA Division I coaches in career victories.

Coach Leamy is **22-9-4** all-time against Bradley.

During his tenure, the Bears have been nationally-ranked on seven different occasions and have made the NCAA Tournament four times (1997, 1999, 2009, 2019). His resume also includes 10 MVC Tournament finals appearances and one Valley championship title.

The six-time MVC Coach of the Year and three-time Midwest Region Coach of the Year has produced 153 all-conference selections and 79 MVC Scholar-Athlete picks. He is also the winningest MVC coach with 107 career victories in league play.

With Leamy at the helm, Missouri State men's soccer has eight MVC regular season titles, including winning back-to-back crowns (2013, 2014) for the first time in program history.



Know the Foe

- Bradley (2-3-0, 1-3-0 MVC) has dropped three of its last four matches, dating back to a 3-0 loss to the Bears in the conference season opener on Feb. 27. The Braves picked up their first league win against Evansville with a 1-0 result on March 4.
- The Braves have recorded a league-best six assists to set up their four goals of 2021. Keeper Bryce Logan has played all 450 minutes in goal for Bradley and leads the MVC in saves per game with 14 through five matches.
- Jim DeRose is in his 25th season as the head coach for the Braves and owns a 252-194-54 overall record. His 80 league wins ranks second all-time in the Valley behind Leamy's 107. He has led the Braves to the NCAA tournament on seven occasions with the most recent appearance coming in the 2013 season.

Series History

- Missouri State leads the all-time series 26-9-4 against Bradley with the Bears winning six straight matches, including a 3-0 victory in the 2021 season opener on Feb. 27. MSU's rivalry with Bradley (39) is second only to the 41 matches played against Tulsa.
- MSU is 11-5-1 in road matches against the Braves. The last meeting in Peoria featured a game-winner from Greg Stratton to seal a 2-1 win for the Bears on Oct. 19, 2019.
- Head coach Jon Leamy has been at the helm for 35 of the 39 matches in the series, boasting a 22-9-4 record against the Braves.

Bears in the Polls

- MSU jumped to No. 13 in the latest United Soccer Coaches poll that was announced Tuesday, March 16 after debuting at No. 19 in the weekly rankings on March 9.
- The Bears also hold rankings in a pair of media polls, No. 8 in the College Soccer News Top 30 poll (March 15) and No. 23 in Top Drawer Soccer's Top 25 rankings (March 15).
- Missouri State cracked the top-25 rankings for the third straight year after a nine-week stretch in 2019 that saw the Bears peak at No. 9 preceded by earning a spot at No. 25 during the 2018 season (Oct. 9, 2018).
- The Bears were unanimously selected to repeat as conference champions in the Valley preseason poll that was released on Feb. 2 after receiving all five first-place votes. **Michael Creek, Jack Denton, Josh Dolling** and **Kyle Hiebert** were also named to the 11-man preseason All-MVC team that was revealed alongside the poll.

Going Streaking

- With Sunday's result, MSU increased its regular-season winning streak to 20 games, dating back to the start of 2019. The Bears posted a flawless 16-0 record during the 2019 regular season, becoming the first NCAA Division-I team to register a perfect regular season since Akron in 2009.
- The Bears have won 13 straight regular-season conference games, following a perfect 10-0 MVC record in 2019. MSU was the first league team to go 10-0 in a season and helped secure the program's eighth MVC regular-season championship.
- Missouri State opened its 2021 spring season with three straight shutouts for the second straight year after holding opponents scoreless through the first three games in 2019 as well. MSU owned a The Bears would go on to add another consecutive shutout streak in 2019 with a four-game stretch spanning from Sept. 6 to Oct. 9, 2019.
- The Bears have scored at least one goal in 26 straight matches, going over two years without being shut out in a match. Their last scoreless outing occurred back on Nov. 3, 2018 with a 1-0 result against Central Arkansas.

A Season to Remember

- The 2019 Missouri State men's soccer team had one of its best seasons in the program's 38-year history. The Bears recorded their first perfect regular season, rolling through the competition on their way to a 16-0 record. They became the first Missouri Valley Conference team to go 10-0 in league play while claiming the club's eighth MVC regular-season championship.
- After reaching as high as No. 9 in the top-25 rankings, Missouri State was selected to host its first-ever NCAA Tournament match with an at-large bid for their fourth trip to the postseason tournament. On Nov. 21, a stadium-record crowd watched the Bears win the program's first NCAA Tournament match with a 1-0 victory against Denver to advance to the second round where they fell in overtime to UCF to close out a remarkable 18-1-1 season.
- The Bears set a team record for most wins in a season (18) and held the nation's longest winning streak since 2009 with a 17-game winning stretch.
- The 2019 squad featured 9 All-Conference honorees (Creek, Denton, Dolling, Hiebert, Stratton, Matthew Bentley, Ian Jones, Ben Stroud, Stuart Wilkin), five All-Region selections (Bentley, Creek, Dolling, Hiebert, Wilkin), three All-Americans (Bentley, Dolling, Hiebert), two CoSIDA Academic All-Americans (Creek, Hiebert), and a MAC Hermann Trophy semifinalist (Bentley). The Bears swept a handful of conference postseason awards by winning Offensive (Bentley) and Defensive (Hiebert) Player of the Year honors as well as Goalkeeper (Creek) and Coaching Staff of the Year (Leamy, Seabolt, Lukowski, Woods).
