### QUICK KICKS

- No. 8 Missouri State (9-0-0, 7-0-0 MVC) scored a pair of second-half goals to come out ahead on a 2-1 result at Central Arkansas in its non-conference finale on Saturday (April 3). Facing their first halftime deficit of the season, the Bears responded quickly in the second half against UCA with **Aadne Bruseth** knotting things up in the 54th minute while **Jack Denton** fired in the game-winning goal to secure MSU's ninth straight victory.
- The Bears are one of just four teams in all of Division I men's soccer to hold a perfect record on the season and boast the most wins (9) among the remaining clubs. It marks the second straight year Missouri State has rattled off nine consecutive wins to begin the season after the 2019 squad became the first DI program to post a perfect regular season (16-0-0) since Akron in 2009.
- As the 2020-21 champions, MSU secured the program's ninth overall Missouri Valley Conference regular-season crown and its sixth championship in the past 10 years. With the top seed locked up for the 2020-21 MVC Tournament, Missouri State will host the semifinal round match at Betty and Bobby Allison South Stadium on April 13 at 6 p.m. This season's conference tournament is being played at the site of the higher seeds.
- The MSU attack features a relentless charge in their offensive half, leading the nation in corner kicks per game (9.44) with 85 corner set-pieces in nine matches. Additionally, the Bears have sent a total of 32 shots towards goal in 2021 which ranks 12th nationally on a per-game basis (6.89). Missouri State leads the league in most statistical categories, sitting atop the conference in goals (20), assists (19), shots per game (14.44) and goals against average (.550).
- **Nicolo Mulatero** (Jr., F, Givoletto, Italy) paces the Bears offense with his six goals and five assists in his junior campaign. He has recorded two multi-goal outings this season with a pair of goals against both Drake (March 22) and Evansville (March 30). The Italian forward leads the MVC in goals (6) and points (17) while his two game-winners and five assists is tied for best in the conference.
- **Michael Creek** (Sr., GK, St. Louis, Mo.) has started all nine matches in goal, logging 807:59 goalie minutes and allowing just four goals while posting five shutouts this season. His five clean sheets in 2021 - which ranks ninth-best among Division I keepers - gives him 18 for his career to rank fourth on the program's career shutout list. Creek earned MVC Goalkeeper of the Year in 2019 after finishing the season with seven shutouts and a 0.645 goals against average that ranked ninth in the nation.
- **Aadne Bruseth** (Jr., F, Batnfjordsøra, Norway) scored a goal for the third straight game with his second-half equalizer against UCA on Saturday. The Norwegian forward has put together an incredible four-game stretch that began with a three-assist performance against Drake (March 22) before going on to record a goal in each of the next three games. He added his fifth assist of the year in the win against the Purple Aces on March 30.
- **Josh Dolling** (Sr., F, Liverpool, England) recorded his first goal of 2021 by capping MSU's four-goal outing at Evansville (March 30) with a header in the 86th minute. As a reigning United Soccer Coaches All-American, Dolling has 19 shots on the year with 11 of them coming on target. His 22 career goals is tied for seventh with Heath Melugin (2008-11) on Missouri State's all-time scoring list.
- Missouri State has collected eight of the MVC's weekly awards this year with Mulatero (March 23, March 2), Bruseth (March 30) and **Dawson Lee** (March 9) earning offensive honors and **Connor Langan** (March 2), **Kyle Hiebert** (March 16), **Greg Stratton** (March 23) and **Adrian Barosen** (March 30) picking up defensive accolades.

## Head Coach Jon Leamy

Bears head coach **Jon Leamy** is in his 29th season leading the Bears' program as the winningest coach in school history with a **289-185-66** (.596) overall record. He began the 2020-21 season ranked 24th among all active NCAA Division I coaches in career victories.

Coach Leamy is **7-4-3** all-time against Loyola.

During his tenure, the Bears have been nationally-ranked on seven different occasions and have made the NCAA Tournament four times (1997, 1999, 2009, 2019). His resume also includes 10 MVC Tournament finals appearances and one Valley championship title.

The six-time MVC Coach of the Year and three-time Midwest Region Coach of the Year has produced 153 all-conference selections and 79 MVC Scholar-Athlete picks. He is also the winningest MVC coach with 111 career victories in league play.

With Leamy at the helm, Missouri State men's soccer has nine MVC regular season titles, including winning back-to-back crowns on two separate occasions (2013-2014, 2019-2020/21).



## Know the Foe

- Loyola (5-3-2, 4-2-1 MVC) has won two straight games after suffering a 2-0 defeat to Missouri State on March 26. The Ramblers enter the final regular-season match tied with Drake (4-2-1, 4-2-1 MVC) in the league standings with both teams eyeing an opportunity to host an MVC Tournament semifinal game. The Bulldogs will face Evansville later in the evening on Thursday (April 8) at 6 p.m.

- The Ramblers are led by junior midfielder Billy Hency who is tied for second in the MVC in points (11) with MSU's Aadne Bruseth. Hency was named MVC Offensive Player of the Week on Tuesday (April 6), joining teammate Michael Hong who earned Valley Defensive Player of the Week honors. Goalkeeper Simon Jillson has posted two shutouts this season while logging 524:49 minutes in goal.

- Head coach Neil Jones is 71-48-24 in his eighth season at the helm for the Ramblers. He has a 4-6-3 record against Missouri State which includes losses in three of the past four meetings with the Bears.

## Series History

- Missouri State leads the all-time series 8-4-3 against Loyola, including a 3-1-1 record when playing in Springfield.

- Earlier this year, the Bears won a 2-0 result at Loyola (March 26) to clinch the MVC regular-season championship. Aadne Bruseth and Greg Stratton scored back-to-back goals in the second half and the MSU defense pitched its fifth shutout of 2021 to secure a second straight Valley title for the Bears.

- Head coach, Jon Leamy is 7-4-3 against LUC, going unbeaten in his first five matches against the Ramblers.

## Bears in the Polls

- Missouri State remains at No. 8 in the latest United Soccer Coaches poll that was announced on Tuesday (April 6). It becomes the second straight year MSU has boasted a top-10 team after the 2019 squad reached as high as No. 9 in the rankings.

- The Bears also hold rankings in a pair of media polls, No. 8 in the College Soccer News Top 30 poll (April 5) and No. 9 in Top Drawer Soccer's Top 25 rankings (April 5).

- Missouri State cracked the top-25 rankings for the third consecutive year after a nine-week stretch in 2019 that saw the Bears peak at No. 9 preceded by earning a spot at No. 25 during the 2018 season (Oct. 9, 2018).

- The Bears are ranked No. 2 in the latest RPI rankings that were released on April 5.

## Going Streaking

- With Saturday's result, MSU increased its regular-season winning streak to 25 games, dating back to the start of 2019. The Bears posted a flawless 16-0 record during the 2019 regular season, becoming the first NCAA Division-I team to register a perfect regular season since Akron in 2009.

- The Bears have also won 17 straight regular-season conference games, following a perfect 10-0 MVC record in 2019. MSU was the first league team to go 10-0 in a season and helped secure an MVC regular-season championship.

- Missouri State opened its 2021 spring season with three straight shutouts for the second straight year after holding opponents scoreless through the first three games in 2019 as well. The Bears would go on to add another consecutive shutout streak in 2019 with a four-game stretch spanning from Sept. 6 to Oct. 9, 2019.

- The Bears have scored at least one goal in 31 straight matches, going over two years without being shut out in a match. Their last scoreless outing occurred back on Nov. 3, 2018 with a 1-0 setback against Central Arkansas in the regular-season finale.

### A Season to Remember

- The 2019 Missouri State men's soccer team had one of its best seasons in the program's 38-year history. The Bears recorded their first perfect regular season, rolling through the competition on their way to a 16-0 record. They became the first Missouri Valley Conference team to go 10-0 in league play while claiming the club's eighth MVC regular-season championship.
- After reaching as high as No. 9 in the top-25 rankings, Missouri State was selected to host its first-ever NCAA Tournament match with an at-large bid for their fourth trip to the postseason tournament. On Nov. 21, a stadium-record crowd watched the Bears win the program's first NCAA Tournament match with a 1-0 victory against Denver to advance to the second round where they fell in overtime to UCF to close out a remarkable 18-1-1 season.
- The Bears set a team record for most wins in a season (18) and held the nation's longest winning streak since 2009 with a 17-game winning stretch.
- The 2019 squad featured 9 All-Conference honorees (Creek, Denton, Dolling, Hiebert, Stratton, Matthew Bentley, Ian Jones, Ben Stroud, Stuart Wilkin), five All-Region selections (Bentley, Creek, Dolling, Hiebert, Wilkin), three All-Americans (Bentley, Dolling, Hiebert), two CoSIDA Academic All-Americans (Creek, Hiebert), and a MAC Hermann Trophy semifinalist (Bentley). The Bears swept a handful of conference postseason awards by winning Offensive (Bentley) and Defensive (Hiebert) Player of the Year honors as well as Goalkeeper (Creek) and Coaching Staff of the Year (Leamy, Seabolt, Lukowski, Woods).
