THE TEN COUNT

- ◆ Missouri State kicks off its **111th** basketball season and **41st** season in Division I on Wednesday (7 p.m.) when the Bears entertain long-time, in-state rival Missouri S&T at Great Southern Bank Arena. MSU is **37-3** in home openers during its Division I era, including a **12-2** ledger in home openers at Great Southern Bank Arena.
- ◆ Coach **Dana Ford**, who finished fourth in the MVC Coach of the Year voting in 2021-22, was also named as a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award for the third time in his career.
- ◆ Missouri State is **62-11** under coach Dana Ford when the Bears shoot a higher field goal percentage than their opponent. Likewise, MoState is **37-4** under Ford when they shoot 50 percent or better from the field with 15 fifty-percent games last season.
- ◆ This is the **141st** meeting between the Bears and Miners in a series that dates back to 1910. The Bears lead the series, **116-24** overall, including a **65-8** ledger in Springfield (**1-0** at Great Southern Bank Arena). Missouri S&T is MSU's second-longest standing rivalry, just between SMO (148) and Northwest Missouri (137) in total games played.
- ◆ The Bears were picked **4th** in the new-look, 12-team Missouri Valley Conference this season, the league announced Oct. 19 with its preseason poll of coaches, media and communications staffs. Coach **Dana Ford's** squad returns one starter (**Donovan Clay**) from a 23-11 squad that finished as MVC runners-up and advanced to the NIT. Meanwhile, Missouri S&T was tabbed 10th in the 13-team GLVC preseason poll.
- ◆ **Kendle Moore** (Sr., Danville, Ill.) accumulated **1,036** career points in 120 games at Colorado State, including **172** career 3-pointers for the Rams. He is one of 14 new players on the 2022-23 Bears roster, including 7 Division I transfers.
- ◆ The Bears' only returning starter, **Donovan Clay** (Sr., Alton, Ill.) was named to the Preseason All-MVC second team, the league announced on Oct. 19. It marks the second time in Clay's career that he has earned Valley preseason laurels (also in 2020-21). Last season, Clay earned **MVC All-Defensive Team** honors after earning a reputation as one of the league's top lock-down defenders. Clay had **36** blocks, **21** steals and **165** defensive rebounds on the season, while averaging **8.4** points and shooting at a **53.7**-percent clip from the field. He is **4** points away from 900 in his career (97g).
- ◆ **Bryan Trimble, Jr.** (Sr., Kansas City, Mo.) paced Missouri State's efforts in last Saturday's 78-58 exhibition win over visiting Newman. Trimble had a game-high 20 points on 7-of-13 field goals to go with 6 three-pointers and 3 rebounds. Returnee **Donovan Clay** also posted a double-double against Newman, boasting 15 points and 10 rebounds, while going 11-for-11 at the free throw line.
- ◆ Bears point guard **Matthew Lee** (Sr., San Juan, Puerto Rico) made national headlines last season as he helped lead the Saint Peter's Peacocks to the NCAA Elite Eight. After guiding his club to NCAA wins over Kentucky, Murray State and Purdue, Lee landed on the cover of *Sports Illustrated*, some 45 years after his father (Butch Lee) was on the cover. Matthew's father is the only Puerto Rican to win both NCAA (Marquette) and NBA (Lakers) basketball titles.
- ◆ **Jonathan Mogbo** (Jr., West Palm Beach, Fla.) racked up 5 blocked shots in 24 minutes during the Bears' exhibition win over Newman last Saturday. Mogbo, a transfer from Northeastern Oklahoma A&M (NEO), ranked 17th nationally last season among all NJCAA players with 10.5 rebounds per game.

HEAD COACH DANA FORD

Dana Ford (Illinois State, 2006) is **72-51** (.585) in his fifth season as Missouri State head coach, including a **43-16** ledger at Great Southern Bank Arena, 23-26 record in away games, and 6-9 mark at neutral sites. He is now **129-116** (.527) in his ninth season as a head coach, including four seasons at Tennessee State. Ford is also **44-28** in Valley games (23-13 at home, 21-15 away).

He is **1-0** all-time against Missouri S&T (1-0 at home).

CollegiateInsider.com recently named Ford one of the dozen "Coaching Names to Remember" for the 2021-22 season.

He picked up his **100th** career victory on Feb. 7, 2021 at Illinois State (72-62) and coached his 100th game at Missouri State on Dec. 15, 2021 vs. South Dakota State.

In a breakout 2021-22 campaign, Missouri State finished the season as one of the nation's most-efficient offensive teams, ranking 2nd nationally in free throw percentage (.797), 14th in field goal percentage (.482) and 23rd in 3-point FG percentage (.374) -- the only DI team to rank in the top 25 in all three. KenPom also rated the Bears 21st in effective FG percentage (54.6) and 23rd in adjusted offensive efficiency (113.2). MSU led the MVC in all of those metrics, except 3-point percentage, while also leading The Valley in scoring (77.3) and turnovers per game (10.6), which ranked 38th and 34th in the country, respectively.

Likewise, the 2021-22 Bears finished as runners-up in the Missouri Valley Conference, racking up a 23-11 overall record and 13-5 record in the league. The Bears' season win total was the program's most since 2011 and the 10th-best in team history. The squad advanced to the MVC Tournament semifinals for the third straight year and also represented The Valley in the NIT in Ford's first postseason tournament showing at MoState. The Bears also set team records for 3-point field goals (283) while boasting two first-team all-conference players in the school's all-time best scoring tandem -- Gaige Prim and Isiah Mosley -- while Donovan Clay earned MVC All-Defensive Team honors, and Isaac Haney landed on the MVC All-Freshman Team. Jaylen Minnett was also named to the MVC All-Bench squad.

For the third time in his head coaching career, Ford was a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award at the conclusion of the 2021-22 season.

He was introduced as Missouri State's 18th men's basketball coach on March 22, 2018 after coaching the previous four seasons at Tennessee State. The native of Tamm, Illinois was 57-65 (.467) at Tennessee State, including a 52-39 ledger in his last three seasons in Nashville. He coached five All-OVC players and two OVC All-Newcomer Team selections during his tenure at TSU. Under his leadership, TSU doubled its home attendance average and twice earned votes in the AP Top 25 poll in 2016-17.

Ford, 38, earned the Ben Jobe Award in 2016 as the nation's top Division I minority coach. That same year, he was named Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year and NABC District 19 Coach of the Year after engineering one of the biggest turnarounds in NCAA history, from a 5-26 record in his first season to a 20-11 mark in 2015-16.

He has served as an assistant at Tennessee State, Wichita State and Illinois State and was responsible for recruiting future NBA talents such as Robert Covington (Trail Blazers) and Fred Van Vleet (Raptors).

BEARS ON THE AIR

All games air live on the Bears Radio Network with Springfield flagship station KWTO (93.3 FM) providing the feed to the five-station network and online at RadioSpringfield.com.

Play-by-play duties this season will be split between **Don West** and **Corey Riggs** with former MSU great **Mike Keltner** (1970-74) providing color commentary.

Missouri State hall of fame broadcaster **Art Hains** continues to recover from a serious health threat. Hains has spent 41 seasons as the Voice of the Bears and celebrated his 1,000th MSU basketball broadcast on Jan. 2, 2013 and his 2,500th MSU event on Nov. 9, 2019.

CLAY EARNS VALLEY PRESEASON HONORS

One of the league's top lock-down defenders, **Donovan Clay** (Sr., Alton, Ill.) was named to the *Preseason All-MVC* second team, the league announced Oct. 19. It marks Clay's second Preseason All-MVC honor of his career, also garnering preseason laurels in 2020-21.

Last season, Clay earned *MVC All-Defensive Team* honors after compiled 36 blocks and 21 steals, ranking 4th in the MVC in blocks and tied for 5th in rebounding average (6.2). He also started all 34 games, averaging 8.4 points with a 53.7 FG pct.

BEARS PICKED FOURTH IN VALLEY POLL

The Missouri Valley Conference released its preseason poll and all-conference team on Oct. 19, and Missouri State was predicted to finish fourth in the 12-team league.

Drake received 52 of the 54 possible first-place votes and 646 total points to earn the coveted position as MVC preseason favorite with Bradley (542) and Southern Illinois (537) each picking up one first-place vote in the second and third positions, respectively.

Missouri State (418) edged out defending champion Northern Iowa (416) for the No. 4 position with Valley newcomer Belmont (388) tabbed sixth. The remainder of the poll includes Indiana State (344), Murray State (324), Valparaiso (234), Illinois State (186), UIC (109) and Evansville (68) in positions 7-12.

EXHIBITION RECAP

Behind a 20-point performance from **Bryan Trimble Jr.**, Missouri State coasted to a 78-58 victory over Newman in exhibition play on Nov. 5. Trimble finished 7-of-13 from the field and 6-of-12 from 3-point range to pace the Bears who led by as many as 24 in the second half. **Donovan Clay**, the club's only returning starter, posted a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds.

Matthew Lee and **Chance Moore** also scored in double figures for Dana Ford's squad with 12 and 10 points, respectively. MSU had 30 points in the paint and shot 48.3 percent from the field with 10 3-pointers.

REDSHIRTS ANNOUNCED

Bears head coach Dana Ford announced that freshmen **Jonathan Dunn** (F, Rogersville, Mo.), **Kanon Gipson** (G, Rogersville, Mo.), **David Hill** (G, Williamsport, Pa.) and **Tommy Pinegar** (G, Springfield, Mo.) will redshirt during the 2022-23 season. All four players will have four seasons of eligibility remaining.

FIFTY-ONE STRAIGHT WINNING SEASONS AT HOME

With its win over Evansville on Jan. 29, 2022, the Bears secured their **51st** straight winning season at home. Missouri State has been over .500 in home every season since 1971-72, encompassing three different home venues. Now in its 15th season at Great Southern Bank Arena, MSU is **154-68** (.694) all-time at "The Vault."

KEEPING TALLY IN THE VALLEY

Since **Dana Ford** took the helm in 2018, the Bears have reeled off four straight Valley seasons with a .500 record or better, including 10 or more wins three times. MSU last reached four straight .500 league seasons in a six-year stretch from 2001-02 to 2006-07, some 15 years ago. The Bears have also finished second or third in the MVC standings in three of four seasons under coach Ford.

BEARS BASKETBALL HISTORY

The Bears have an all-time record of **1728-1028** (.627), now in their 111th season; a **744-511** (.593) ledger in their 41st Division I season; and a **313-261** (.545) mark in their 33rd season in the Missouri Valley Conference. MSU is also **154-68** (.694) in its 15th season at JQH Arena.

During the Division I era, MSU has made NCAA Tournament appearances in 1987, 1988, 1989, 1990, 1992, and 1999. With NCAA Tournament wins over Wisconsin and Tennessee, the 1999 Bears advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 for the first time in program history. The Bears have appeared in the National Invitation Tournament 10 times -- 1986, 1991, 1993, 1997, 2000, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2011 and 2022. The 1986, 1993 and 2006 squads all reached the NIT quarterfinals. MSU has also appeared in the CIT twice -- 2010 and 2014.

MSU won NAIA national championship titles in 1952 and 1953 under the late coach Bob Vanatta, while making six NAIA national tournament trips from 1939-1954. MSU also appeared in the NCAA Division II Tournament 10 times, finishing as national runners-up four times -- 1959, 1967, 1969 and 1974.

MSU has won 24 regular-season conference titles, including the 2010-11 MVC championship. The Bears have also recorded 28 seasons of 20 or more victories, including 15 in the Division I era.

REBOUND FOUNDATION

Bears head coach Dana Ford and his wife Christina are the founders of the Rebound Foundation which raises funds and awareness to help renew and restore women who have experienced a life of domestic abuse. The foundation provides a stable home and fresh start to abuse victims and their children. The Rebound Foundation currently provides homes in Springfield, Mo., and Chicago, Ill.

MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY

Missouri State University is a public, comprehensive university system with a mission in public affairs, whose purpose is to develop educated persons while achieving five goals: democratizing society, incubating new ideas, imagining Missouri's future, making Missouri's future, and modeling ethical and effective behavior.

With an enrollment of **23,307** (fall 2022), MSU is the second-largest institution for higher learning in Missouri, and its identity is distinguished by its statewide mission in public affairs. This mission requires a campus-wide commitment to foster competence and responsibility in the common vocation of citizenship. MSU is a selective admissions, graduate-level, teaching and research institution.

MSU is a member of the MVC in 14 sports with affiliate membership in the Missouri Valley Football Conference (MVFC), Mid-American Conference (men's swimming) and Coastal Collegiate Sports Association (beach volleyball). American League batting champ), and Jackie Stiles (WBB Hall of Fame).

MSU is a member of the Missouri Valley in 14 sports with membership in the Missouri Valley Football Conference, Mid-American Conference (men's swimming) and Coastal Collegiate Sports Association (beach volleyball).

#BEARS UNITE

Missouri State's student-athletes across all 17 intercollegiate sports are wearing a #BearsUnite patch on their uniforms or team gear this season as a symbol of unity in the fight against injustice and discrimination. Missouri State Director of Athletics Kyle Moats, who is in his 13th year as AD, announced June 4, 2020 the implementation of a department-wide educational initiative that values inclusion of diversity, tolerance and social responsibility. Year one initiatives include: departmental training; community engagement programs; and a formal reporting procedure for discriminatory behavior of any kind.

MISSOURI VALLEY CONFERENCE

The nation's second-oldest NCAA Division I conference continues to be a leader in college athletics and is one of the nation's most progressive conferences. League members have worked together to put a high value on league harmony and invest in athletic programs to compete at the highest level.

In 2018, Loyola University of Chicago advanced to the Final Four, giving the MVC a representative on the biggest stage in college basketball for the second time in six seasons (Wichita State, 2013). MVC participation in ESPN's multi-team events and elite tournaments, have added strong opponents and more national television exposure to non-conference scheduling. The MVC also boasts tradition from the likes of Hall of Famers Larry Bird and Oscar Robertson among a list of more than 260 players drafted to the NBA.

UIC, Belmont and Murray State join the MVC this season.

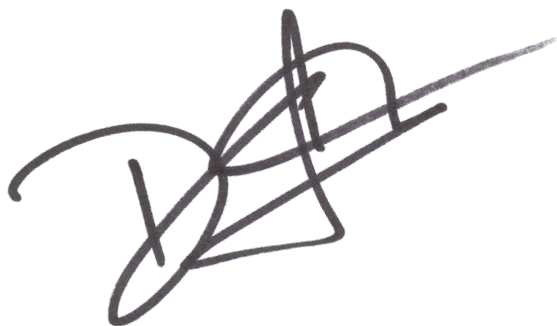

A new era for Missouri State men's basketball officially began on March 22, 2018 with the introduction of Dana Ford as the program's 18th head coach.

In a breakout 2021-22 campaign, Missouri State finished the season as one of the nation's most-efficient offensive teams, ranking 2nd nationally in free throw percentage (.797), 14th in field goal percentage (.482) and 23rd in 3-point FG percentage (.374) -- the only DI team to rank in the top 25 in all three. KenPom also rated the Bears 21st in effective FG percentage (54.6) and 23rd in adjusted offensive efficiency (113.2). MSU led the MVC in all of those metrics, except 3-point percentage, while also leading The Valley in scoring (77.3) and turnovers per game (10.6), which ranked 38th and 34th in the country, respectively.

Likewise, the 2021-22 Bears finished as runners-up in the Missouri Valley Conference, racking up a 23-11 overall record and 13-5 record in the league. The Bears' season win total was the program's most since 2011 and the 10th-best in team history. The squad advanced to the MVC Tournament semifinals for the third straight year and also represented The Valley in the NIT in Ford's first postseason tournament showing at MoState. The Bears also set team records for 3-point field goals (283) while boasting two first-team all-conference players in the school's all-time best scoring tandem -- Gaige Prim and Isiah Mosley -- while Donovan Clay earned MVC All-Defensive Team honors, and Isaac Haney landed on the MVC All-Freshman Team. Jaylen Minnett was also named to the MVC All-Bench squad.

For the third time in his head coaching career, Ford was a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award at the conclusion of the 2021-22 season.

During his third season in Springfield in 2020-21, the Bears matched a school record with seven conference road wins and finished third in the MVC standings, going 17-7 overall and 12-6 in the league. The Bears advanced to the MVC Tournament semifinals for the second straight season and became the first Valley team since 2015 to post two players on the All-MVC first team without being a league champion or runner-up. Isiah Mosley was the Bears first-ever MVC scoring leader and was also the top vote-getter on the Valley's Most-Improved Team, while Gaige Prim also earned All-MVC first-team laurels after finishing 10th nationally in field goal percentage (.599) and earning a spot on the MVC All-Defensive Team. MSU also boasted a player on the MVC All-Newcomer Team in point guard Demarcus Sharp.

Ford was also a national finalist for the Ben Jobe Award and Skip Prosser Award at the conclusion of the 2020-21 campaign.

In 2019-20, Ford engineered a solid season finish that saw the Bears go 9-9 in the Missouri Valley Conference and upset third-seeded Indiana State in the MVC Tournament quarterfinals. The Bears matched or out-rebounded

24-of-33 opponents, including nine of their last 10, to finish 25th nationally in rebound margin (6.2). The Bears also posted their second-best free throw percentage (.749) of the program's Division I era and had their highest scoring average in league games (71.6) in 10 years. Despite eight losses by four points or less, MSU boasted two All-MVC performers for the second year in a row with second team selection Keandre Cook and third-teamer Gaige Prim, who also was recognized on the MVC All-Newcomer Team.

In his first season at Missouri State in 2018-19, Ford began the year as the fifth-youngest Division I coach in the nation (33) and helped guide the Bears to a third-place finish in The Valley. In addition to pushing the Bears to their first winning conference record (10-8) since the 2010-11 campaign, two MSU players earned All-MVC honors, including the 2019 MVC Newcomer of the Year, and three players who landed spots on the Valley's All-Newcomer team.

Ford orchestrated one of the best turnarounds in NCAA history when he accepted the Tennessee State job in 2014-15 as the nation's youngest Division I head coach at the time. The Tigers went from a 5-26 record his first season to a 20-11 ledger in 2015-16. He earned Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year, NABC District 19 Coach of the Year and the Ben Jobe Award for his outstanding efforts that season.

Over his last three years in Nashville, Ford led the Tigers to a combined 52-39 record and coached five All-OVC players in addition to two players recognized on the OVC All-Newcomer Team. Under his leadership, Tennessee State also doubled its home attendance average and twice earned votes in the Associated Press Top 25 poll during the 2016-17 season.

A native of Tamms, Ill., Ford is a 2006 graduate of Illinois State University where he was a four-year letterman for the Redbirds under coaches Tom Rich-

ardson and Porter Moser from 2002-06. He was a regular starter and led ISU in steals as a senior.

He went on to successful assistant coaching stints at Winthrop and Wichita State under coach Gregg Marshall and later as associate head coach at Illinois State under coach Dan Muller. His coaching resume also includes assistant coaching stops at Chipola (Fla.) College and Tennessee State. He was an assistant for two NCAA Tournament teams at Winthrop (2006-07) and Wichita State (2011-12) as well as a NJCAA national final four run at Chipola College (2008-09) and was responsible for recruiting future NBA talents such as Robert Covington (LA Clippers) and Fred Van Vleet (Raptors).

Dana and his wife Christina have two daughters, Charlie Rose and latest addition Cline (born in July 2020), and three sons, Carson, Cameron and Crain. They are also the parents of another daughter, Promise, who passed in infancy in 2017.

The Fords are also the founders of the Rebound Foundation which raises funds and awareness to help renew and restore women

who have experienced a life of domestic abuse. The foundation provides a stable home and fresh start to abuse victims and their children. The Rebound Foundation currently provides homes in Springfield, Mo., and Chicago, Ill.

Ford has also received recognition from numerous civic organizations, including a Citizen Service Commendation by the Springfield Police Department in June of 2021 for his help in creating the Bears, Badges and Kids program. Bears, Badges and Kids provides community-wide, basketball-centric events for youth that center on community unity and education.

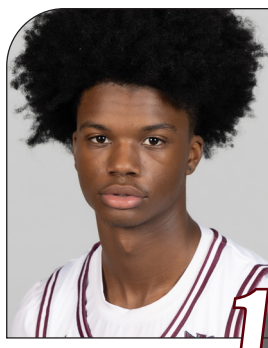
