Starting Five - Storylines for the UT Martin Game

1) The Missouri State Lady Bears continue to have success on the boards this season. MSU ranks 11th nationally and 1st in the Missouri Valley Conference with 17.1 offensive rebounds per game, while ranking 2nd in the conference and 45th in the country in total rebound average with 42.3 per game. Missouri State also owns a +8.7 rebound margin, which is third in the conference and top 40 nationally. Rebounding has been an advantage for the Lady Bears over the years, as they have won the rebounding battle 108 times in their last 131 contests.

2) Missouri State has faced a tough challenge in its non-conference slate. The combined record of the teams responsible for MSU's four losses this season own a combined record of 34-7, including two wins over Top 20 teams (Middle Tennessee defeated #18 Louisville, Toledo defeated #14 Michigan). The average NET ranking of those four teams is 43 with all ranking inside the top 65 in the NET.

3) With their win at TCU, Missouri State now has at least one victory over a Power Five school in 10 consecutive seasons, with 18 such wins over that span. The Lady Bears are 10-8 against such teams since the beginning of the 2019-20 season.

4) Fifth-year senior Sydney Wilson continues to move her way up the career victories list at MSU. With three wins so far this season, Wilson now has 102 for her Lady Bear career which is tied for third in program history alongside Tina Robbins (1991-94). Melody Howard (1991-94) is next on the list at No. 2 with 104 career victories.

5) Sophomore and JUCO transfer Indya Green was named the Missouri Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week on Dec. 12 for her 12-point, 14-rebound performance at TCU. The honor marked the first of her career. She leads the team with three double-doubles and 57 total rebounds on the season.

Series History

Missouri State and UT Martin have never met in the programs' histories.

The Opponent

UT Martin returns four starters from a year ago, while also welcoming nine newcomers to the mix for the 2022-23 season. The Skyhawks are 4-6 to begin the season and are coming off a 67-61 victory at South Dakota on Wednesday. Saturday's game in Springfield will be UTM's fourth-straight road contest, with the Skyhawks owning a 2-2 record on the road this season.

Of those who have played in at least half of UTM's games this season, Sharnecce Currie-Jelks leads the way with 13.8 points and 6.5 rebounds per game, while shooting 54% from the field. Paige Pipkin is also averaging in double figures with 11.1 ppg, while freshman Kenley McCarn is posting 19.8 ppg and 4.3 rpg in four games played this season. Seygan Robins leads UT Martin with 22 three-point baskets and is shooting 47% from behind the arc.

As a team, the Skyhawks are averaging 62.6 points and 29.0 rebounds per game, while owning a -7.8 rebounding margin. UTM is shooting .413 from the field, .344 from three-point range and .782 from the charity stripe.

Scouting the Lady Bears

Fifth-year senior Aniya Thomas leads the team with 11.7 points per game while leading the team with 32 assists on the season and shooting 78% from the free throw line. Sophomore Isabelle Delarue is second on the team with 10.0 points per game as she leads the team with 14 three-pointers on the season. Indya Green is averaging 9.4 points and 8.1 rebounds per game this season and is leading the team with three double-doubles. She was named MVC Newcomer of the Week on Dec. 12 for her 12-point, 14-rebound performance at TCU last week.

MSU's one returning starter from a year ago, Sydney Wilson, has found her rhythm after missing the first game of the season against Missouri and easing her way into more minutes. She is averaging 9.0 points and 5.2 rebounds on the year after recording her best performance of the season at TCU (13 points, 10 rebounds). Sophomore Kennedy Taylor recorded her first career double-double with a career-high 11 points while tying a career-best with 10 rebounds against UTSA. Paige Rocca has led the Lady Bears in scoring twice this season and has seven assists and five steals in five games played.

Freshmen Jade Masogayo and Jaiden Bryant are seeing the floor early this season. Masogayo made her first career start at TCU in her hometown of Fort Worth, Texas. She set a season and career high in points (9) at Toledo and rebounds (7) at TCU, while blocking five shots against Oklahoma State. Masogayo ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference and 34th nationally with 1.9 blocks per game. Meanwhile, Bryant is averaging 2.3 rebounds per game and has tallied six steals and six assists. Taylor Woodhouse, Ifunanya Nwachukwu and Khloe Moad are still looking for their first extended minutes of the season.

Quick Hits

• MSU has won the rebounding battle 108 times in the last 131 contests, going 92-16 when winning on the glass. The Lady Bears have out-rebounded 64 of their last 75 MVC opponents.

The Lady Bears set a school record for rebound margin in 2020-21 at plus-10.8 and ranked second nationally with a .794 defensive rebound margin after leading the country at .773 in 2019-20.

• Missouri State has at least one victory over a Power Five school in 10 consecutive seasons, with 18 such wins over that span, including a win on the road at TCU this season. The Lady Bears are 10-8 against such teams since the beginning of the 2019-20 season.

• Since the beginning of the 2017-18 season, MSU has compiled a 58-10 record inside Great Southern Bank Arena, while boasting a 37-4 record since the start of the 2019-20 season.

Since the start of the 2019-20 season, MSU's 37-4 home record has come by an average score of 72.4-54.9 with a plus-11.5 rebound margin.

The Lady Bears are 62-10 in their last 72 home games, beginning Feb. 10, 2017. Since then, MSU has averaged 72.8 points with a plus-15.8 scoring margin and plus-9.9 rebounding margin.

• MSU is 55-12 in its last 67 MVC road games, dating to Feb. 20, 2015, with win streaks of 13 (2018-20 - school record), 13 (2020-22 - tied school record) and 10 (2015-16 - 2nd at MSU) during that span. The Lady Bears have won at least six MVC road games for eight straight seasons.

• The Lady Bears are 42-9 in their last 51 true road games, 56-16 in the last 72 games away from home, and 31-5 in the last 36 MVC road contests. Missouri State posted an unbeaten road record for the first time in school history in 2020-21 with an 11-0 mark, one of two NCAA teams with at least 11 road wins and no losses.

Last season, Missouri State's streak of 13-straight road wins that tied a school record, which was set from Jan. 18-Nov. 14, 2019, was snapped at Oklahoma State.

• MSU has won 12 or more MVC games in seven consecutive years and has now posted 22 top-three finishes in 30 league seasons. MSU is 77-10 in its last 87 Valley games and 113-20 in the last 133.

Head Coach Beth Cunningham

Beth Cunningham was introduced as Missouri State's ninth women's basketball head coach on March 31, 2022.

Cunningham, who owns an impressive 20-year collegiate coaching resume, arrives in Springfield from Duke University, where she has spent the last two seasons as an assistant coach on coach Kara Lawson's staff. Prior to her stint at Duke, she spent eight seasons (2012-20) as an associate head coach at Notre Dame for Hall of Fame coach Muffet McGraw. She was part of one of the best stretches in NCAA women's history as Notre Dame compiled a 244-19 record in that span with seven straight 30-win seasons, six conference titles, five NCAA Final Four appearances and the 2018 National Championship. The Irish followed that up with a runner-up finish in the 2019 NCAA Championship, finishing the year with the No. 1 scoring offense in the country (88.6 points per game).

Before returning to her alma mater in the summer of 2012, Cunningham spent 11 years on the coaching staff at VCU, including one year as an assistant coach (2001-02), one as associate head coach (2002-03) and nine seasons as head coach starting in 2003-04. She is the Rams' all-time leader in women's basketball coaching wins with a 167-115 (.592) record and postseason appearances in each of her final five seasons. From 2008-12, VCU averaged better than 22 wins per season, including back-to-back 26-win seasons in 2008 and 2009, and the program's first NCAA Tournament berth in 2009.

At VCU, Cunningham coached three WNBA draft picks, two All-America selections, two Colonial Athletic Association Players of the Year and 18 all-conference selections.

During her playing days at Notre Dame (1993-97), Beth (Morgan) Cunningham was a trail-blazer, leading the program to its first NCAA Women's Final Four appearance and a 31-7 campaign her senior season. She was a two-time Associated Press and WBCA honorable mention All-America choice, four-time first-team all-conference selection and two-year team captain. The Irish were 97-32 in her four seasons, including a pair of conference titles and three NCAA appearances. She departed as the all-time leading scorer in Fighting Irish women's basketball history with 2,322 points (which now ranks third), having set or tied 28 school records during her career.

She was also a fixture in USA Basketball circles as both a player and coach, first suiting up for Team USA four times from 1996-99 (winning three medals including a gold at the 1997 USA World University Games) and later serving as the athlete representative on the USA Basketball Women's Junior National Team Committee and the USA Basketball Women's Collegiate Committee.

Following her amateur career, Cunningham spent three seasons playing professional basketball, including two years with the Richmond/Philadelphia Rage of the American Basketball League (ABL) and one year with the WNBA's Washington Mystics in 2000 before embarking on her coaching career.

Originally from Bloomington, Ind., Cunningham was a standout two-sport performer at Bloomington South High School, earning all-state honors in both basketball and tennis. She was inducted into the Monroe County Sports Hall of Fame in June 2011. She graduated from Notre Dame in 1997 with a bachelor's degree in Marketing from the top-ranked Mendoza Col-

lege of Business before going on to earn her Master's degree in Sports Leadership from VCU in 2003.

Cunningham and her husband, Dan, are the proud parents of three daughters (Margaret, Carly and Gretchen) and one son (Danny).

MSU Peaks in The Valley

The Lady Bears are 378-156 all-time in MVC play and have won at least a share of 14 regular-season and 11 conference tournament titles since the 1989-90 season. MSU has played in 14 of the 29 Valley tournament championship games and 16 of the 36 title games since the inception of the Gateway Conference Tournament in 1983.

Missouri State All-Time

Missouri State is in its 54th season of women's collegiate basketball and has an all-time record of 953-621 (.605) for the second-most wins of any MVC program, trailing new MVC member Belmont. MSU began formal competition in 1969 and has 37 winning seasons including the 2021-22 campaign. The Lady Bears have made 17 NCAA Tournament appearances, highlighted by Final Four trips in 1992 and 2001 to go along with Sweet 16 trips in 1993, 2019 and 2021.

Missouri State is one of eight programs to advance to a Sweet 16 in the 1990s, 2000s, 2010s and 2020s.

The Lady Bears are in their 41st NCAA Division I season and 31st MVC year. MSU was in AIAW competition on the state, regional and national levels through the 1981-82 season, moved to Division I and Gateway Collegiate Athletic Conference play in 1982-83 and started MVC competition in 1992-93 when the Gateway merged with The Valley.

MSU in the NCAA Tournament

The Lady Bears made their 17th NCAA Tournament appearance in 2021-22, defeating Florida State, 61-50, in the First Four Round before falling to sixth-seeded Ohio State, 63-56, in the First Round. MSU's NCAA Tournament history is highlighted by Final Four trips in 1992 and 2001 to go along with Sweet 16 trips in 1993, 2019 and 2021.

Missouri State is one of eight programs to advance to a Sweet 16 in the 1990s, 2000s, 2010s and 2020s. The other programs to accomplish the feat include: South Carolina, UConn, Stanford, Maryland, NC State, Texas A&M and Texas. The Lady Bears own a 19-17 record in the NCAA Tournament.

Fandemonium

With the conclusion of their 14th season in the newly-named Great Southern Bank Arena in 2021-22, the Lady Bears finished first in the MVC standings in terms of attendance, drawing 32,012 fans in 14 home dates in 2021-22 for a 2,287 average. MSU has led the MVC in attendance 26 times in the past 33 seasons, and ranked 44th nationally in 2021-22.

Since the 1990-91 season, Missouri State has ranked in the top 20 nationally in average attendance 19 times, including a string of 10 straight top-10 finishes from 1992 through the 2000-01 season. The Lady Bears led all of Division I women's basketball in attendance during the 1992-93 season by averaging 7,421 fans per contest.

MSU ranks in the top 10 among all Division I women's basketball programs in average home attendance over the last two-plus decades, and is joined on that list by the likes of Tennessee and Connecticut. Additionally, the Lady Bears have finished in the top 50 nationally in per game attendance for 32 of the last 35 years.

Home Court Advantage

After compiling a 325-108 record in Hammons Student Center over its 32-year stint as home of Missouri State basketball, the Lady Bears own a 149-53 record in their 15th season at the newly-named Great Southern Bank Arena.

Since the beginning of the 2017-18 season, MSU has compiled a 58-10 record in front of its home crowd, while boasting a 37-4 record since the beginning of the 2019-20 season.

Great Southern Bank Arena is the fourth regular home of Missouri State women's basketball in the five-plus-decade history of the program. The Lady Bears utilized both McDonald Arena and the Greenwood Laboratory School gym from 1969 until Hammons Student Center opened in 1976. MSU continued to play some of its home games at McDonald through the 1979-80 season.
