FIRST AND TEN

◆ Coming off a near-upset at No. 10-ranked Arkansas last week, Missouri State returns to Robert W. Plaster Stadium on Saturday when the Bears begin MVFC play against No. 2-ranked South Dakota State (2 p.m., ESPN3). It is **Family Weekend** on campus with BearFest village festivities commencing at 11 a.m. on game day.

◆ For the second straight week -- and fourth time in his career -- QB **Jason Shelley** (Sr., Frisco, Texas) is the *Missouri Valley Football Conference Offensive Player of the Week* after he threw for 357 yards last week at Arkansas. He was 24-for-43 through the air with no interceptions and a touchdown. He also added a 24-yard rushing touchdown that put the Bears up 17-0 at the time. The 2021 *MVFC Offensive Player of the Year* is also on the 2022 *Walter Payton Award Preseason Watch List*, which recognizes the top offensive player in the FCS ranks.

◆ Bears head coach **Bobby Petrino** will be facing South Dakota State for the first time in his career. Now in his third season at Missouri State, Petrino is **12-3** in MVFC games (6-1 at home).

◆ This week's game marks the first meeting between the Bears and Jackrabbits since 11/2/19. Only 5 current MSU players played in that game -- **Landon Bebee** (OL, Webb City, Mo.), **Kevin Ellis** (DL, Fort Worth, Texas), **Anthony Payne** (DL, Kansas City, Mo.), **Jalen Williams** (DL, Overland Park, Kan.) and **Von Young** (LB, Buckner, Mo.).

◆ MoState has not turned the ball over in either of its last two ball games (UT Martin and Arkansas). The last time the Bears went turnover-free in back-to-back games was **Oct. 18-25, 2014** (vs. South Dakota and Illinois State).

◆ Missouri State engineered four of its six longest scoring drives of the season in last week's upset bid at No. 10-ranked Arkansas. Behind QB **Jason Shelley**, the Bears had scoring drives of 75, 71, 69 and 64 yards in Fayetteville, with a 45-yard drive added for good measure.

◆ **Milestone Updates:** **Jason Shelley** is **108** passing yards away from 6,000 for his career ... Shelley is also **8** rushing yards away from 500 for his Missouri State tenure ... **Ty Scott** is **69** receiving yards away from 1,500 at Missouri State (15g) ... **Kevin Ellis** is **18** tackles away from 200 for his career (45g) and **1.5** sacks away from 20.

◆ **Jason Shelley** has thrown a touchdown pass in **8** straight games, just **2** shy of matching the program record (10), set by Jay Rodgers in 1999. Shelley has also thrown for 200 yards or more in all **15** career games at MSU.

◆ **Ty Scott** (WR, Estill, S.C.) ranks **4th** nationally in receiving TDs (4), **7th** in receiving yards per game (107.0), **8th** in receiving yards (321), **14th** in total touchdowns (4) and **18th** in receptions per game (6.3). He leads the Missouri Valley in receiving touchdowns and receptions per game.

◆ **Grant Burkett** (P, Joplin, Mo.) leads the MVFC and ranks **14th** nationally in punting average (44.1). His 64-yard punt at Arkansas last week was his longest since Sept. 11, 2021 vs. UCA.

◆ The Bears defense ranks **13th** nationally in 3rd down efficiency (.257) and **18th** in turnover margin (+1.0).

◆ Missouri State kicker **Jose Pizano** (Lehi, Utah) has made **18** of his last **19** FG attempts and converted **45** straight extra points. He ranks **22nd** nationally in FG per game (1.33) and **24th** in FG percentage (.800), which leads all MVFC kickers. A year ago, the All-American scored **109** points, the third-best single-season scoring total in program history and most points ever by a Bears kicker.

◆ Missouri State's offense ranks **1st** nationally in fewest interceptions (0); **10th** in passing efficiency (166.37); **11th** in passing offense (306.7); **11th** in turnovers lost (2); **15th** in yards per completion (15.08) and **18th** in red zone efficiency (.909). The team's **306.7** yards per game through air leads the MVFC.

◆ **Ferrin Manuleleua** (LB, Manteca, Calif.) is coming off a team-high **8** tackles at Arkansas last week, including 4 solo stops and a forced fumble. He and **Montrae Braswell** (CB, Avon Park, Fla.) lead the team with 20 total tackles apiece this season.

◆ With rankings of **No. 2 & 3** in this week's FCS polls, South Dakota State is the highest-ranked foe to visit Plaster Stadium since **No. 1** NDSU appeared here on Nov. 10, 2018. The last time MSU was involved in a game between two Top 5 teams was Oct. 19, 1996 when No. 3 UNI defeated the No. 5 Bears, 38-31, in Cedar Falls.

HEAD COACH BOBBY PETRINO

Bobby Petrino is in his third season as Missouri State's head football coach after joining the Bears program on January 16, 2020. He is currently **134-66** (.670) in his 17th season as a head coach and is **15-10** (.600) at Missouri State, including an **8-3** ledger at Plaster Stadium and 7-7 road record. As Bears head coach, Petrino is **12-3** in MVFC games (6-1 at home). Petrino has never coached against South Dakota State.

He picked up his **75th** career conference victory on Oct. 2, 2021 at Illinois State and his **130th** all-time win on Nov. 6, 2021 at Southern Illinois.

Petrino's second season in Springfield in the fall of 2021 was even more impressive than his debut campaign. The Bears finished 14th in both the AFCA and Stats Perform final polls, while rolling to a 6-2 league record and runner-up finish in the MVFC. In addition, the Bears made a second straight appearance in the NCAA FCS Playoffs, while Petrino tied for 11th in the final voting for the Eddie Robinson Award for FCS National Coach of the Year.

The Bears boasted a dozen all-conference players in 2021 with QB Jason Shelley earning MVFC Offensive Player of the Year and MVFC Newcomer of the Year laurels. Five other MoState players earned All-America distinction in 2021.

During his debut in 2020-21, Petrino helped lead the Bears to a 5-1 mark in Valley play to earn a share of the MVFC regular-season title. His efforts not only landed him the prestigious Bruce Craddock MVFC Coach of the Year Award, but also led the Bears to their first NCAA FCS playoff appearance in 30 years.

In August 2021, ESPN ranked Petrino No. 77 on its Top 100 college football coaches of the last 50 years.

Petrino previously served as head coach in two stints at Louisville as well as Arkansas and Western Kentucky. He spent 14 seasons at the FBS level and led his programs to 11 bowl appearances with seven teams ranked in the top 25 at season's end.

The Helena, Mont., native is in his 34th year of collegiate coaching overall, having guided his programs to AP top-six final rankings three times (2004, 2006, 2011) and directing some of the nation's top offensive programs along the way. His clubs have finished in the top five nationally in scoring offense three times, while his 2004 club at Louisville led the country in scoring (49.8 ppg). He has developed 34 NFL Draft selections during his illustrious career, including four in the first round, and Heisman Trophy winner Lamar Jackson.

Petrino and his wife Becky have four children: Kelsey, Nick, Bobby and Katie — and eight grandchildren. Nick Petrino is Missouri State's offensive coordinator, while sons-in-law Ryan Beard (defensive coordinator) and L.D. Scott (defensive line) are also on the MSU coaching staff this season.

THE SERIES

South Dakota State leads the all-time series between the teams, **11-1**, with the Jackrabbits reeling off 6 straight wins in the rivalry. The teams first played in 2008 when SDSU joined the MVFC.

MSU's only win in the series came on Oct. 19, 2013, with a 35-21 win at Plaster Stadium.

In the last meeting between the teams (Nov. 2, 2019), South Dakota State used a balanced offensive attack and a shutdown effort by its defense to make a 14-point first-half lead stand in an eventual 35-14 victory over the Bears in Springfield. The No. 4-ranked Jackrabbits scored the first 21 points of the afternoon and racked up 526 yards of total offense, while the SDSU defense forced three turnovers, held the Bears scoreless for three quarters and permitted just 249 yards in all. Jeremiah Wilson provided an offensive spark for the Bears, rushing for 87 yards on 12 carries, including a 57-yard scoring run early in the fourth period. Cade Johnson hauled in five catches for 164 yards, including a back-breaking 89-yard scoring catch to help seal the outcome, while Pierre Strong and C.J. Wilson combined for 196 yards on the ground to lead SDSU.

BEARS ON THE AIR

All Missouri State games will air live on the Missouri State Radio Network with Springfield flagship station KWTO (101.3 FM) providing the feed to the five-station network and at RadioSpringfield.com.

The voice of the Bears, **Art Hains**, first began calling MSU's action in 1977 and is in his second stint and 43rd season overall. He called MSU games from 1977-81 and returned to the mic in 1985. Hains celebrated his 2,500th MSU sports event on Nov. 9, 2019. Former MSU great **Dennis Heim** (1974-77), who was a two-time All-MIAA defensive tackle and later played in the NFL (Giants and Bucs) and CFL (Argonauts), provides color commentary.

NEAR-UPSET AT ARKANSAS GIVES BEARS NATIONAL ATTENTION

The No. 5-ranked team in the FCS ranks led 17-0 out of the gates in their attempt to take down No. 10 (FBS) ranked Arkansas on Sept. 17 in Fayetteville. The Razorbacks would tie the game, 17-17, late in the third quarter, but the Bears stood tall, reeling off 10 straight points from there and led 27-17 after a 31-yard field goal by **Jose Pizano** with 12:04 remaining in the game.

Pizano's field goal set off a string of "upset alerts" from national media dialed into the MVFC vs. SEC matchup. However, the home squad scored 21 unanswered points in the final 11 minutes, 38 seconds to overcome a double-figure lead by the Bears and escaped with a 38-27 win.

MSU would punt on its final three possessions of the night, while Arkansas dug in and scored three touchdowns in short order. Raheim Sanders scored on a 73-yard pass from K.J. Jefferson with 11:38 to go, then less than three minutes later, the Razorbacks struck again with an 82-yard punt return touchdown -- the first allowed by the Bears since 2019. On the ensuing drive, MSU QB **Jason Shelley** hit **Kevon Latulas** for a 38-yard strike into Arkansas territory at the 37. But the drive would stall there after a timely Arkansas sack of Shelley on third-and-11 forced the Bears to punt. UofA tacked on another TD with 64 seconds remaining to put things out of reach and squash the hopes of the upset-minded visitors from Springfield.

CREW CAPTAINS

Bobby Petrino's captains for the 2022 season are **Kevin Ellis** (DE, Fort Worth, Texas), **Landon Bebee** (OL, Webb City, Mo.), **Jason Shelley** (QB, Frisco, Texas) and **Kyriq McDonald** (S, Madison, Ala.). It marks Ellis' third season and Bebee's second season as team co-captains.

TRANSFERS FILL THE GAP

Coming off their second straight NCAA FCS Playoff appearance, the Bears return **14** starters (7 offense, 7 defense) for coach **Bobby Petrino's** third season at the helm.

Helping fill in the gap are a crop of **43** newcomers to the program, which includes **10** transfers from FBS programs, **5** transfers from FCS schools, **11** junior college transfers and **17** true freshmen.

All told, **26** Missouri State players have experience at FBS programs (see sidebar), which includes returning players, two-year transfers and four-year transfers.

Petrino returns **41** lettermen and **53** total players from last season, including all **8** All-MVFC selections.

FOR ARKANSAS EFFORT, SHELLEY EARNS VALLEY POW HONOR

For his efforts against No. 10-ranked Arkansas on Sept. 17, **Jason Shelley** (QB, Frisco, Texas) earned Co-Offensive Player of the Week. He was in top form on the national stage in Fayetteville, firing for **357** passing yards for the second-highest passing total of his career. He also added a 24-yard rushing touchdown in the second quarter that put the Bears ahead 17-0 at the time. For the night, Shelley was **24-for-43** with no interceptions and a touchdown. It also marked the second-most passing yards ever by any Missouri State quarterback against an FBS foe and the Bears' third-highest scoring total ever against an FBS team.

The award marks Shelley's seventh MVFC weekly award during his career with the Bears. He earned MVFC Offensive Player of the Week laurels twice last season and MVFC Newcomer of the Week honors three times in 2021.

SHELLEY LANDS VALLEY, NATIONAL AWARDS AFTER UTM VICTORY

QB **Jason Shelley** (Sr., Frisco, Texas) threw for **297** yards and 5 touchdowns in Missouri State's week two win over UT Martin on Sept. 8 to earn *MVFC Offensive Player of the Week* and *CFPA National FCS Performer of the Week* honors. He was **19-for-24** overall, while his 5 TD passes tied a Bears single-game record. Shelley's 14th straight 200-yard passing game included two clutch fourth-quarter TD passes to **Ty Scott**, the first of which put the Bears up for good and capped a 63-yard scoring drive.

JACARDIA SHOWS THE WRIGHT STUFF IN HOME DEBUT

Running back **Jacardia Wright** (So., Decatur, Ill.), a transfer from Kansas State, logged his first career 100-yard rushing game in MSU's win over UT Martin on Sept. 8, carrying **23** times for **120** yards (5.2 yards per carry) in a breakout effort that earned him *MVFC Newcomer of the Week* honors. He also scored on a 19-yard pass from Shelley with 35 seconds left in the first half to contribute to his **162** all-purpose yards for the game.

During his tenure at Kansas State, Wright logged 51 carries for 195 yards (3.8 ypc) with 1 touchdown.

BRASWELL EARNS SPECIAL TEAMS AWARDS AFTER OPENER

Bears cornerback and return specialist **Montrae Braswell** (Avon Park, Fla.) was named *Missouri Valley Football Conference Co-Special Teams Player of the Week* (announced Sept. 4), as well as *FedEx Ground FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week*. Braswell broke loose for a **98-yard** kickoff return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter of MSU's road win at UCA on Sept. 1. The return came on the heels of a UCA's first scoring drive of the game, and Braswell's big play made it 27-7 at the time and put the game out of reach. It was his third career kick return touchdown and the seventh-longest kickoff return in Missouri State history. The honor was Braswell's second career MVFC Special Teams Player of the Week (Sept. 11, 2021).

SHELLEY NAMED TO WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

Quarterback **Jason Shelley** (Sr., Frisco, Texas) is one of a handful of elite FCS football players announced August 3 to the *Walter Payton Award Preseason Watch List*. The Walter Payton Award is presented in January to the national offensive player of the year in college football's NCAA Division I subdivision. Shelley is one of 35 players on this year's preseason watch list that includes ten other quarterbacks and eight total players from the MVFC.

A Preseason All-America and Preseason All-MVFC first-team pick, **Shelley** was named as the 2021 MVFC Offensive Player of the Year and MVFC Newcomer of the Year. He is coming off a 2021 campaign in which he threw for a school-record 3,347 yards and racked up another program record 3,789 yards of total offense, both of which led the conference. He was also a finalist for the 2021 Walter Payton Award (finishing 10th) and the CFPA Player of the Year in addition to earning All-MVFC first-team selection at QB.

Shelley completed his first season at MSU ranked 11th nationally in points responsible for (194), seventh in yards per completion (14.24), ninth in passing yards (3,347), 14th in passing yards per game (278.9), 18th in passing touchdowns (22), and 22nd in passing efficiency (142.69). The two-time MVFC Offensive Player of the Week became the first MSU quarterback to throw for 200 yards or more in every game (12) for the season, while snapping additional Bears records for plays (555), passing attempts (400) and completions (235). Shelley engineered four game-winning drives in the fourth quarter last season and was a three-time MVFC Newcomer of the Week.

BURKETT ON FCS PUNTER OF YEAR WATCH LIST

Bears punter **Grant Burkett** (So., Joplin, Mo.) has been named to the 2022 *FCS Punter of the Year Award Preseason Watch List*, as announced Aug. 1 by the Augusta Sports Council and Ray Guy Award Committee. The list of 22 candidates was compiled based on last season's watch list, all-conference squads and All-America teams, as well as the 2022 preseason all-conference teams.

Burkett ranked second in the nation with a school-record punting average of **46.2** per attempt last season, while helping the Bears rank second nationally in team net punting (42.81). He had **16** punts of 50 yards or better with **15** attempts downed inside the opponents' 20-yard line. In addition to being an All-MVFC first-team selection, Burkett made four FCS All-America teams in 2021, including second-team selections by the AFCA, Stats Perform and Hero Sports, and a third-team selection by the Associated Press.

BRASWELL AMONG ELITE DEFENSIVE PLAYERS ON BUCHANAN LIST

MSU cornerback **Montrae Braswell** (Jr., Avon Park, Fla.) is on the exclusive list of FCS football players announced August 4 to the Buck Buchanan Award Preseason Watch List. The Buck Buchanan Award is presented annually by Stats Perform to the national defensive player of the year in college football's NCAA Division I subdivision. Braswell is one of 35 players on this year's preseason watch list that includes six other defensive backs and six total players from the Missouri Valley Football Conference.

After earning All-MVFC first-team honors at two positions in 2021, Braswell was named as an All-America second-team selection by the AP and Stats. Hero Sports also named him to its Sophomore All-America Team at both DB and return specialist. Defensively, Braswell finished third in the Missouri Valley Defensive Player of the Year voting and ranked seventh nationally -- and tops in the MVFC -- in passes defended per game (1.4). He also snagged four interceptions and brought down 44 ball carriers with 33 solo stops. On special teams, his 29.4 kickoff return average ranked fifth nationally and tops in the MVFC. He was also a two-time MVFC Special Teams Player of the Week.



GREAT SCOTT

One of the most dynamic wide receivers in program history, **Ty Scott** (Jr., Estill, S.C.) is coming off a remarkable debut season in which he earned All-Missouri Valley Football Conference first-team honors and MVFC All-Newcomer Team distinction. He posted school-record totals for receptions (66), receiving yards (1,110) and receiving touchdowns (8) in 2021 and earned a spot on the Hero Sports Sophomore All-America Team. Scott led all Valley players in receiving yards per game (92.5) and finished third in the league in receptions per game (5.5). He also ranked eighth in the MVFC in all-purpose yards (92.9). Nationally, Scott ranked 11th in receiving yards, 12th in receiving yards per game, 34th in receptions per game, 41st in receiving touchdowns, 45th in yards per reception (16.8) and 77th in all-purpose yards (92.25). He notched six games in 2021 with 100 or more receiving yards, including four straight from 10/9/21 to 10/30/21, another club record.

This season, Scott has earned Preseason All-America honors from Bluebloods (1st Team), Hero Sports (2nd) and Phil Steele (2nd), while notching Preseason All-MVFC first-team laurels.

THREE MO STATE STANDOUTS MAKE SHRINE LIST

Three Missouri State football standouts were announced on July 12 to the list of "Shrine Bowl 1000" prospects. The list was compiled by Optimum Scouting and includes all-star game-eligible players at all levels of college football (FBS, FCS, Division II, Division III and NAIA) under consideration for the East-West Shrine Game.

Bears on that list include **Ty Scott** (WR, Estill, S.C.), **Kyriq McDonald** (S, Madison, Ala.) and **Montrae Braswell** (CB, Avon Park, Fla.).

DEFENSIVE ATTACK BRINGS THE SACK

Missouri State's 2021 season total of 30 sacks (for 166 yards) was a new program record, surpassing the team's total of 27 sacks in Coach Petrino's first season in Springfield (2020-21). A total of 15 Bears contributed to the record-breaking sack total last season, including a team-high 8.0 sacks from **Kevin Ellis** (DE, Fort Worth, Texas), which placed him 3rd in the MVFC and 41st nationally in sacks per game (0.67).

The Bears racked up 7 sacks in their season opener at Central Arkansas with **Anthony Payne** (DL, Kansas City, Mo.) accounting for 2.0 sacks to lead the way.

CARDIAC BEARS CREATE FOURTH-QUARTER DRAMA

Jason Shelley's two fourth-quarter touchdown passes to fellow All-American Ty Scott lifted the Bears to a 35-30 come-from-behind win over UT Martin on Sept. 8. The late-game heroics swung MSU from a 24-21 deficit to a 35-24 lead in the span of just over 11 minutes. It marked the eighth fourth-quarter comeback by the Bears in just three seasons under coach **Bobby Petrino**. Missouri State's fourth-quarter victories under Petrino are as follows:

CFPA ANNOUNCES NATIONAL PERFORMER OF THE YEAR LIST

MSU's Jason Shelley (QB, Frisco, Texas) is among 38 FCS players announced on Sept. 8 to the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) FCS National Performer of the Year Watch List. The list includes 25 other quarterbacks and three other MVFC standouts.

The CFPA National Performer of the Year will be announced on Jan. 13.

BEARS PICKED THIRD IN VALLEY PRESEASON POLL

Missouri State is picked third in the Missouri Valley Football Conference preseason poll with eight Bears landing on the Preseason All-MVFC Team. It marks the highest the Bears have been ranked in the preseason MVFC poll since 1996 (second).

Defending national champion North Dakota State captured 39 of 41 possible first-place votes and 446 total points to land as league preseason favorites, ahead of South Dakota State (407), Missouri State (355), Southern Illinois (306) and Northern Iowa (304) to round out the top five in the 11-team league.

Bears earning Preseason All-MVFC honors were: **Jason Shelley** (QB), **Ty Scott** (WR), **Landon Bebee** (OL), **Kevin Ellis** (DL), **Kyriq McDonald** (DB), **Montrae Braswell** (DB and RS), **Grant Purkett** (P) and **Jose Pizano** (PK). All are first-team selections, except Pizano who earned second-team honors.

BEARS IN THE NFL

Former Bears linebacker **Dylan Cole** (Rogersville, Mo.) originally signed with the Houston Texans as a free agent in September of 2017 and is now in his second season with the Tennessee Titans. Cole has appeared in 46 career NFL games with 83 career tackles.

A consensus first-team FCS All-America selection for the Bears, Cole averaged 12.9 tackles per game in 2016 to lead all NCAA Division I FCS players. He recorded at least 13 tackles in nine different games as a senior, including a season-high 19 vs. SIU. The All-MVFC first-team selection finished third in the 2016 Buck Buchanan Award voting as the top defensive player in the FCS ranks. Cole also played in the NFLPA Collegiate Bowl and earned CoSIDA Academic All-District honors as well as MVFC Scholar-Athlete Team first-team laurels.

Likewise, defensive lineman **Eric Johnson** (Plainfield, Ill.) was selected by the Indianapolis Colts as the 159th overall pick of the National Football League Draft in 2022 as the sixth selection of the fifth round.

Johnson played in a school-record 55 consecutive games as a five-year starter for Missouri State. His draft stock skyrocketed in the offseason with his standout efforts in the NFLPA Bowl and Senior Bowl games after he earned All-Missouri Valley Football Conference second-team honors in his final season in Springfield. During the 2021 campaign, Johnson racked up 43 total stops with 6.5 tackles for loss and 3 blocked kicks. He seemed to save the best for last with a career-high 11 tackles against UT Martin (11/27/21) in the NCAA FCS Playoff game at Plaster Stadium in his final college game with a forced fumble and a blocked kick. Johnson finished his collegiate career with 131 total stops, including 19.5 tackles for loss and 6.5 sacks.

In the first two weeks of the 2022 season, Johnson has played but has not record any tackles.

MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY

Missouri State University is a public, comprehensive university system with a mission in public affairs, whose purpose is to develop educated persons while achieving five goals: democratizing society, incubating new ideas, imagining Missouri's future, making Missouri's future, and modeling ethical and effective behavior.

MSU is a member of the Missouri Valley in 14 sports with affiliate membership in the Missouri Valley Football Conference (MVFC) (football), Mid-American Conference (men's swimming) and Coastal Collegiate Sports Association (beach volleyball).

MISSOURI VALLEY FOOTBALL CONFERENCE

Founded in 1985, the Missouri Valley Football Conference (formerly the Gateway Conference) has shaped itself into the nation's premier NCAA FCS conference. Missouri State is a charter member of the MVFC, along with current members Northern Iowa, Illinois State, Southern Illinois and Western Illinois.

The 11-team league now includes expansion members: Indiana State (1986), Youngstown State (1997), North Dakota State (2008), South Dakota State (2008), South Dakota (2013) and North Dakota (2020). Murray State will join the league in 2023.

The Valley has produced nine of the last 11 national champions at the NCAA Division I FCS level with three national runners-up in that same span.

The Bears have earned MVFC conference titles in 1989, 1990 and 2020-21 with NCAA FCS playoff berths in all three of those championship seasons in addition to a 2021 playoff berth.

Head Coach Bobby Petrino



Missouri State University officially introduced Bobby Petrino as its new head football coach in a news conference at JQH Arena on January 16, 2020.

During his first season as head coach of Missouri State in 2020-21, coach Petrino guided the Bears to a 5-1 ledger in the Missouri Valley Football Conference and a share of the MVFC title. It marked the program's first conference championship since 1990 and ultimately earned MSU an at-large bid into the NCAA FCS playoffs, also the team's first in 30 years. The Bears finished with a final national ranking of 13 in both the STATS and AFCA national polls and earned 10 All-MVFC selections, including first-teamer and FCS Sophomore All-American DB Montrae Braswell.

For transforming the MoState program overnight into league contenders, Petrino was named MVFC Coach of the Year and finished ninth in the FCS National Coach of the Year voting, garnering two first-place votes in a stacked field of national coaching leaders.

Petrino's second season in Springfield was even more impressive than his debut. The Bears finished 14th in both the AFCA and Stats Perform final polls, while rolling to a 6-2 league record and runner-up finish in the MVFC. In addition, the Bears made a second straight appearance in the NCAA FCS Playoffs, while Petrino tied for 11th in the final voting for the Eddie Robinson Award for FCS National Coach of the Year.

The Bears boasted a dozen all-conference players in 2021 with QB Jason Shelley earning MVFC Offensive Player of the Year and MVFC Newcomer of the Year

laurels. Five other MoState players earned All-America distinction in 2021.

In August of 2021, ESPN named Petrino as one of the top 100 college football coaches of the last 50 years (#77).

Prior to coming to Springfield, Petrino previously served as head coach in two stints at Louisville as well as Arkansas and Western Kentucky. He compiled a 119-56 record in 14 seasons at the NCAA Division I FBS level and led those programs to 11 bowl appearances with seven teams ranked in the top 25 at season's end.

The Helena, Mont., native will begin his 34th year of collegiate coaching in the fall of 2022. He has guided his programs to top-six final rankings in the Associated Press poll three times (2004, 2006, 2011), directing some of the nation's top offensive programs along the way.

His clubs have finished in the top five nationally in scoring offense three times, while his 2004 club at Louisville led the country in scoring at 49.8 points per game. He has developed 35 NFL Draft selections during his illustrious career, including four in the first round, and Heisman Trophy winner Lamar Jackson.

His first stint at Louisville (2003-06) boasted 41 wins over a four-year span in the first head coaching assignment of his career with four bowl appearances in four seasons. Petrino directed the Cardinals to their first BIG EAST title in 2006, Louisville's second year in the league.

Petrino's 2004 campaign was one of the best in

school history, leading the Cardinals to an 11-1 record that culminated in a Conference USA title and a 44-40 Liberty Bowl win over 10th-ranked Boise State. The Cardinals led the nation in total offense (539.0) and scoring offense (49.8), scored 50 or more points seven times and set an NCAA record by scoring 55 or more points in five straight games.

He stepped away from college football in 2007 to coach the NFL's Atlanta Falcons for a season, then returned to guide the Arkansas Razorbacks for four years, from 2008-11. In Fayetteville, Petrino's squads were 34-17 in his time there -- including a 29-10 ledger over his last three campaigns -- with three bowl appearances and an impressive 11-2 record and No. 5 final ranking in 2011.

Petrino spent the 2013 season as head coach at Western Kentucky, where he helped WKU finish 8-4 while closing the season with a four-game winning streak. The Hilltoppers also set a new school record for total offense (5,502 yards) and passing first downs (141) in a season.

His return to Louisville in 2014 was immediately successful, guiding the Cardinals to a 9-4 year out of the gates before reeling off four consecutive bowl appearances and another 9-4 campaign in 2016. In his nine total seasons in Louisville, Petrino's Cardinals were 77-35 overall and 45-24 in conference games (CUSA, Big East and ACC).

Petrino literally grew up in the

coaching profession. His father, Bob Petrino, Sr., coached at Carroll College in Helena, Mont., for 26 seasons, earning 163 victories and 15 conference titles. Petrino officially started his coaching career as a graduate assistant for his father at Carroll College in 1983.

After a graduate assistant stint as quarterbacks coach at Weber State in 1984, Petrino returned to be the offensive coordinator for his father in 1985-86 at Carroll. They had the top-ranked offense in the NAIA ranks in both of his seasons, thanks in large part to the play of Bobby Petrino's younger brother, Paul, who was a four-year starter at quarterback.

He returned to Weber State as the wide receivers and tight ends coach (1987-88), then served three seasons at Idaho (1989-91), including two years at offensive coordinator. The 1990 Idaho squad defeated MSU, 41-35, in the first round of the NCAA FCS playoffs in Springfield.

From there, he took assignments at Arizona State (1992-93), Nevada (1994) and Utah State (1995-97), before drawing the offensive coordinator position at Louisville in 1998. He guided future NFL star Jake Plummer at Arizona State and engineered the nation's No. 2 passing offense (330) and total offense (500.1) at Nevada for a 9-2 squad that won a share of the Big West title. Petrino also helped Utah State set school records in total offense (468.5) and passing yards (317.5) during the 1996 season. Likewise, the 1998 Louisville team was the top-ranked NCAA FBS squad in scoring and total offense.

Petrino stepped away from the college game from 1999-2001 for three seasons with the Jacksonville Jaguars, including the offensive coordinator role in 2001.

He played college football for his father at Carroll College, twice earning NAIA All-America honors and leading the Fighting Saints to three straight Frontier Conference championships. He was named the league MVP in 1981 and 1982. He also played four years of basketball at Carroll while earning a bachelor's degree in physical education with a minor in mathematics in 1983.

Petrino and his wife Becky have four children: Kelsey, Nick, Bobby and Katie — and eight grandchildren.
