

## **FIRST AND TEN**

♦ After a convincing opening-week win, Missouri State returns to Robert W. Plaster Stadium on Thursday evening when the Bears host OVC preseason favorite UT Martin at 7 p.m. (ESPN+) in their home opener. The game is being billed as a "Maroon Out" with fans encouraged to wear maroon BearWear and arrive early.

- ♦ The Bears are **69-37-4** all-time in home openers, including a **28-10-2** mark in such games as a Division I program. During his career, coach **Bobby Petrino** is **13-3** in home openers as a head coach (1-1 at Missouri State).
- ♦ Montrae Braswell (CB, Avon Park, Fla.) notched a 98-yard kickoff return at UCA, which marks the seventh-longest in Bears history and the third KO return touchdown of Braswell's career (96-yard vs. UCA (9/11/21), 100-yards at South Dakota (3/13/21). He now leads the country in kickoff return average (65.0) and earned MVFC Special Teams Player of the Week honors and FedEx FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week.
- ♦ QB Jason Shelley (Sr., Frisco, Texas) racked up 317 of MSU's 356 yards of total offense in the week one victory at Central Arkansas, pushing him to 4,106 yards of total offense at MSU. He is just the ninth MSU player to account for 4,000 career yards, doing so in just 13 games. He is the first Bear since Cody Kirby (2010) to reach that milestone. The 2021 MVFC Offensive Player of the Year is one of 35 players on the 2022 Walter Payton Award Preseason Watch List, which recognizes the top offensive player in the FCS ranks.
- ♦ Shelley leads the MVFC in total offense (317.0) and is among the national leaders in four categories: 16th in total offense, 22nd in passing yards per game (266.0), 22nd in yards per completion (14.78), 24th in passing yards per attempt (8.87).
- ♦ All-American wide receiver **Ty Scott** (Estill, S.C.) began the 2022 season where he left off in 2021, hauling in **8** receptions for **160** yards in MSU's season opener at Central Arkansas. Scott's effort marked the second-best, single-game receiving yardage total of his career with 7 of his 8 catches going for 10 yards or more with 3 receptions of 25+ yards (41-27-36). His effort at UCA pushed him up to No. 17 on MSU's career rec. yds. list (1,270).
- ◆ Scott has risen to the top of the nation's wide receivers after just one week, ranking 4th nationally in receiving yards per game (160.0), 7th in receiving yards (160), 9th in receptions per game (8.0) and 22nd in all-purpose yardage (162.00). His 8.0 receptions per game also leads the Missouri Valley.
- ◆ MSU's defense held UCA scoreless for more than 47 minutes in the season opener in Conway and its efforts helped the Bears rank high nationally in several categories: **2nd** in sacks (7.0), **13th** in red zone defense (50.0), **14th** in team tackles for loss (9.0), **19th** in scoring defense (14.0) and **20th** in pass efficiency defense (102.68).
- ♦ With his 2 field goals (36, 37) at UCA last Thursday, **Jose Pizano** (K, Lehi, Utah) ranks **7th** nationally in field goals per game (2.00). His streak of **16** straight FG makes was snapped on his final attempt (43 yds.) in Conway.
- ◆ Coach Bobby Petrino finished 11th in voting for the 2021 Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award and is one of just 21 active FCS coaches with 100 or more career victories (133).
- ♦ Making his 14th career start, defensive lineman **Anthony Payne** (Sr., Kansas City, Mo.) made a pair of impactful sacks in MSU's road win at UCA. He finished with 3 total tackles on the night to go with his 2.0 sacks and 2.0 tackles for loss -- both career highs. His sack total ranks **4th** nationally.
- ♦ Missouri State's offense shares the national lead in red zone efficiency (100%), while ranking **28th** in passing offense (266.0) and **33rd** in passing efficiency (145.48).
- ◆ Since the start of the 2021 season, MSU opponents have punted or turned the ball over on their opening drive in 10 of the 13 games in that span. The Bears forced UCA to punt on its opening drive last week.
- ♦ Missouri Valley Football Conference teams were 4-7 on opening weekend with Missouri State securing the only road victory in the league with its 27-14 win at UCA. The Bears' point total was also the second-best in the MVFC.
- ◆ UT Martin ranks 6th nationally in total offense (577.0), 11th in rushing offense (260.), 12th in passing offense (317.0) and 18th in scoring offense (42.0).

#### **HEAD COACH BOBBY PETRINO**

**Bobby Petrino** is in his third season as Missouri State's head football coach after joining the Bears program on January 16, 2020. He is currently **133-65** (.672) in his 17th season as a head coach and is **14-9** (.609) at Missouri State, including a **7-3** ledger at Plaster Stadium and 7-6 road record. As Bears head coach, Petrino is **12-3** in MVFC games (6-1 at home). Petrino is also **0-1** all-time against UT Martin.

He picked up his **75th** career conference victory on Oct. 2, 2021 at Illinois State and his **130th** all-time win on Nov. 6, 2021 at Southern Illinois.

Petrino's second season in Springfield in the fall of 2021 was even more impressive than his debut campaign. The Bears finished 14th in both the AFCA and Stats Perform final polls, while rolling to a 6-2 league record and runner-up finish in the MVFC. In addition, the Bears made a second straight appearance in the NCAA FCS Playoffs, while

Petrino tied for 11th in the final voting for the Eddie Robinson Award for FCS National Coach of the Year.

The Bears boasted a dozen all-conference players in 2021 with QB Jason Shelley earning MVFC Offensive Player of the Year and MVFC Newcomer of the Year laurels. Five other MoState players earned All-America distinction in 2021.

During his debut in 2020-21, Petrino helped lead the Bears to a 5-1 mark in Valley play to earn a share of the MVFC regular-season title. His efforts not only landed him the prestigious Bruce Craddock MVFC Coach of the Year Award, but also led the Bears to their first NCAA FCS playoff appearance in 30 years.

In August 2021, ESPN ranked Petrino No. 77 on its Top 100 college football coaches of the last 50 years. Petrino previously served as head coach in two stints at Louisville as well as Arkansas and Western Kentucky. He spent 14 seasons at the FBS level and led his programs to 11 bowl appearances with seven teams ranked in the top 25 at season's end.

The Helena, Mont., native is in his 34th year of collegiate coaching overall, having guided his programs to AP top-six final rankings three times (2004, 2006, 2011) and directing some of the nation's top offensive programs along the way. His clubs have finished in the top five nationally in scoring offense three times, while his 2004 club at Louisville led the country in scoring (49.8 ppg). He has developed 34 NFL Draft selections during his illustrious career, including four in the first round, and Heisman Trophy winner Lamar Jackson.

Petrino and his wife Becky have four children: Kelsey, Nick, Bobby and Katie — and eight grandchildren. Nick Petrino is Missouri State's offensive coordinator, while sons-in-law Ryan Beard (defensive coordinator) and L.D. Scott (defensive line) are also on the MSU coaching staff this season.

### **THE SERIES**

Missouri State leads the all-time series against UT Martin, **6-1**, in a regional rivalry that dates back to 1996. The Bears are 4-1 all-time against the Skyhawks and 2-0 in Martin.

Two meetings ago at Plaster Stadium (9/12/09), Missouri State used a fast start to cruise to a 24-14 victory before 9,357 home fans. The Bears jumped out to a 10-0 cushion behind a 23-yard field goal by Matt Hottelman and a 2-yard TD run by Jonathan Davis in the opening quarter. Cody Kirby added a 13-yard touchdown run in the third quarter while he finished the day with 103 passing yards.

Last season, the teams squared off in the opening round of the NCAA FCS Playoffs at Plaster Stadium (11/27/21) with the Skyhawks prevailing, 32-31, in a thriller. With 1:03 to go, on the heels of 25- and 9-yard completions from MSU's **Jason Shelley** to Xavier Lane, a tipped pass was intercepted by UTM's D'Carrious Stephens at his own 46, killing MSU's drive and crushing its comeback hopes in crunch time. The Bears turned the ball over six times on three interceptions, a fumble and two special teams mishaps that led directly to 23 Skyhawks points and ultimately proved to be the difference. Shelley was 22-for-42 for 279 yards and 3 touchdowns with Lane snagging 7 receptions for 110 yards. Shelley also rushed for a game-high 93 yards. UTM was led by Dresser Winn who ompleted 22-of-43 attempts for 272 yards and a pair of TDs.

#### **BEARS ON THE AIR**

All Missouri State games will air live on the Missouri State Radio Network with Springfield flagship station KWTO (101.3 FM) providing the feed to the five-station network and at RadioSpringfield.com.

The voice of the Bears, **Art Hains**, first began calling MSU's action in 1977 and is in his second stint and 43rd season overall. He called MSU games from 1977-81 and returned to the mic in 1985. Hains celebrated his 2,500th MSU sports event on Nov. 9, 2019. Former MSU great **Dennis Heim** (1974-77), who was a two-time All-MIAA defensive tackle and later played in the NFL (Giants and Bucs) and CFL (Argonauts), provides color commentary.

## **BRASWELL EARNS SPECIAL TEAMS AWARDS AFTER OPENER**

Bears cornerback and return specialist **Montrae Braswell** (Avon Park, Fla.) has been named *Missouri Valley Football Conference Co-Special Teams Player of the Week* (announced Sept. 4), as well as *FedEx Ground FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week* (announced Sept. 5). Braswell broke loose for a 98-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter of MSU's road win at UCA on opening night. The return came on the heels of a UCA's first scoring drive of the game, and Braswell's big play made it 27-7 at the time and put the game out of reach. It was his third career kick return touchdown and the seventh-longest kickoff return in Missouri State history. For the game, he averaged 65.0 yards on two kickoff return attempts in the win (the other was 32 yards). The honor was Braswell's second career MVFC Special Teams Player of the Week (Sept. 11, 2021), while he was also named MVFC Defensive Player of the Week on March 13, 2021.

### THE WRIGHT STUFF

After three seasons at Kansas State, running back **Jacardia Wright** (Decatur, III.) has joined the Missouri State program this season and looks to make an immediate impact with the Bears. Prior to shouldering most of the preseason load in the Missouri State backfield, Wright posted 51 carries for 195 yards (3.8 ypc) with 1 touchdown and a long of 37 yards in three years in Manhattan.

In Week One at Central Arkansas, Wright carried 13 times for 38 yards and had 1 pass reception.

### SHELLEY NAMED TO WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

Quarterback **Jason Shelley** (Sr., Frisco, Texas) is one of a handful of elite FCS football players announced August 3 to the Walter Payton Award Preseason Watch List. The Walter Payton Award is presented in January to the national offensive player of the year in college football's NCAA Division I subdivision. Shelley is one of 35 players on this year's preseason watch list that includes ten other quarterbacks and eight total players from the MVFC.

A Preseason All-America and Preseason All-MVFC first-team pick, **Shelley** was named as the 2021 MVFC Offensive Player of the Year and MVFC Newcomer of the Year. He is coming off a 2021 campaign in which he threw for a school-record 3,347 yards and racked up another program record 3,789 yards of total offense, both of which led the conference. He was also a finalist for the 2021 Walter Payton Award (finishing 10th) and the CFPA Player of the Year in addition to earning All-MVFC first-team selection at QB.

**Shelley** completed his first season at MSU ranked 11th nationally in points responsible for (194), seventh in yards per completion (14.24), ninth in passing yards (3,347), 14th in passing yards per game (278.9), 18th in passing touchdowns (22), and 22nd in passing efficiency (142.69). The two-time MVFC Offensive Player of the Week became the first MSU quarterback to throw for 200 yards or more in every game (12) for the season, while snapping additional Bears records for plays (555), passing attempts (400) and completions (235). Shelley engineered four game-winning drives in the fourth quarter last season and was a three-time MVFC Newcomer of the Week.

#### **BURKETT LANDS ON FCS PUNTER OF YEAR WATCH LIST**

Bears punter **Grant Burkett** (So., Joplin, Mo.) has been named to the 2022 FCS Punter of the Year Award Preseason Watch List, as announced Aug. 1 by the Augusta Sports Council and Ray Guy Award Committee. The list of 22 candidates was compiled based on last season's watch list, all-conference squads and All-America teams, as well as the 2022 preseason all-conference teams.

**Burkett** ranked second in the nation with a school-record punting average of **46.2** per attempt last season, while helping the Bears rank second nationally as a team in net punting (42.81). He had 16 punts of 50 yards or better with 15 attempts downed inside the opponents' 20-yard line. In addition to being an All-Missouri Valley Football Conference first-team selection, Burkett made four FCS All-America teams in 2021, including second-team selections by the AFCA, STATS Perform and Hero Sports, and a third-team selection by the Associated Press.

#### BRASWELL AMONG ELITE DEFENSIVE PLAYERS ON BUCHANAN LIST

MSU cornerback **Montrae Braswell** (Jr., Avon Park, Fla.) is on the exclusive list of FCS football players announced August 4 to the Buck Buchanan Award Preseason Watch List. The Buck Buchanan Award is presented annually by Stats Perform to the national defensive player of the year in college football's NCAA Division I subdivision. Braswell is one of 35 players on this year's preseason watch list that includes six other defensive backs and six total players from the Missouri Valley Football Conference.

After earning All-MVFC first-team honors at two positions in 2021, Braswell was named as an All-America second-team selection by the AP and Stats. Hero Sports also named him to its Sophomore All-America Team at both DB and return specialist. Defensively, Braswell finished third in the Missouri Valley Defensive Player of the Year voting and ranked seventh nationally -- and tops in the MVFC -- in passes defended per game (1.4). He also snagged four interceptions and brought down 44 ball carriers with 33 solo stops. On special teams, his 29.4 kickoff return average ranked fifth nationally and tops in the MVFC. He was also a two-time MVFC Special Teams Player of the Week.

## TRANSFERS FILL THE GAP

Coming off their second straight NCAA FCS Playoff appearance, the Bears return **14** starters (7 offense, 7 defense) for coach **Bobby Petrino**'s third season at the helm.

Helping fill in the gap are a crop of 43 newcomers to the program, which includes 10 transfers from FBS programs, 5 transfers from FCS schools, 11 junior college transfers and 17 true freshmen.

All told, **26** Missouri State players have experience at FBS programs (see *sidebar*), which includes returning players, two-year transfers and four-year transfers.

Petrino returns 41 lettermen and 53 total players from last season, including all 8 All-MVFC selections.

## **GREAT SCOTT**

One of the most dynamic wide receivers in program history, **Ty Scott** (Jr., Estill, S.C.) is coming off a remarkable debut season in which he earned All-Missouri Valley Football Conference first-team honors and MVFC All-Newcomer Team distinction. He posted school-record totals for receptions (66), receiving yards (1,110) and receiving touchdowns (8) in 2021 and earned a spot on the Hero Sports Sophomore All-America Team. Scott led all Valley players in receiving yards per game (92.5) and finished third in the league in receptions per game (5.5). He also ranked eighth in the MVFC in all-purpose yards (92.9). Nationally, Scott ranked 11th in receiving yards, 12th in receiving yards per game, 34th in receptions per game, 41st in receiving touchdowns, 45th in yards per reception (16.8) and 77th in all-purpose yards (92.25). He notched six games in 2021 with 100 or more receiving yards, including four straight from 10/9/21 to 10/30/21, another club record.

This season, Scott has earned Preseason All-America honors from Bluebloods (1st Team), Hero Sports (2nd) and Phil Steele (2nd), while notching Preseason All-MVFC first-team laurels.

### **DEFENSIVE ATTACK BRINGS THE SACK**

Missouri State's 2021 season total of **30** sacks (for 166 yards) was a new program record, surpassing the team's total of 27 sacks in Coach Petrino's first season in Springfield (2020-21). A total of 15 Bears contributed to the record-breaking sack total last season, including a team-high 8.0 sacks from **Kevin Ellis** (DE, Forth Worth, Texas), which placed him **3rd** in the MVFC and **41st** nationally in sacks per game (0.67).

The Bears racked up 7 sacks in their season opener at Central Arkansas with **Anthony Payne** (DL, Kansas City, Mo.) accounting for 2.0 sacks to lead the way.

#### BEARS PICKED THIRD IN VALLEY PRESEASON POLL

Missouri State is picked third in the Missouri Valley Football Conference preseason poll with eight Bears landing on the Preseason All-MVFC Team. It marks the highest the Bears have been ranked in the preseason MVFC poll since 1996 (second).

Defending national champion North Dakota State captured 39 of 41 possible first-place votes and 446 total points to land as league preseason favorites, ahead of South Dakota State (407), Missouri State (355), Southern Illinois (306) and Northern Iowa (304) to round out the top five in the 11-team league.

Bears earning Preseason All-MVFC honors were: Jason Shelley (QB), Ty Scott (WR), Landon Bebee (OL), Kevin Ellis (DL), Kyrig McDonald (DB), Montrae Braswell (DB and RS), Grant Purkett (P) and Jose Pizano (PK). All are first-team selections, except Pizano who earned second-team honors.

Former Bears linebacker Dylan Cole (Rogersville, Mo.) originally signed with the Houston Texans as a free agent in September of 2017 and is now in his second season with the Tennessee Titans. Cole has appeared in 46 career NFL games with 83 career tackles.

A consensus first-team FCS All-America selection for the Bears, **DYLAN COLE CAREER NFL STATS** Cole averaged 12.9 tackles per game in 2016 to lead all NCAA Divi-G-GS Tot-S-A PΠ Year Team sion I FCS players. He recorded at least 13 tackles in nine different 2017 Houston 12-1 32-16-16 2018 Houston 8-0 13-13-0 games as a senior, including a season-high 19 vs. SIU. The All-2019 Houston 16-13-3 MVFC first-team selection finished third in the 2016 Buck Buchanan 2020 Houston 6-0 6-3-3 Award voting as the top defensive player in the FCS ranks. Cole also 2021 Tennessee 9-0 16-10-6 played in the NFLPA Collegiate Bowl and earned CoSIDA Academic 2022 Tennessee All-District honors as well as MVFC Scholar-Athlete Team first-team Totals 6 years 83-55-28

Likewise, defensive lineman Eric Johnson (Plainfield, III.) was selected by the Indianapolis Colts as the 159th overall pick of the National Football League Draft in 2022 as the sixth selection of the fifth round.

Johnson played in a school-record 55 consecutive games as a five-year starter for Missouri State. His draft stock skyrocketed in the offseason with his standout efforts in the NFLPA Bowl and Senior Bowl games after he earned All-Missouri Valley Football Conference second-team honors in his final season in Springfield. During the 2021 campaign, Johnson racked up 43 total stops with 6.5 tackles for loss and 3 blocked kicks. He seemed to save the best for last with a career-high 11 tackles against UT Martin (11/27/21) in the NCAA FCS Playoff game at Plaster Stadium in his final college game with a forced fumble and a blocked kick. Johnson finished his collegiate career with 131 total stops, including 19.5 tackles for loss and 6.5 sacks

Missouri State University officially introduced Bobby Petrino as its new head football coach in a news conference at JQH Arena on January 16, 2020.

During his first season as head coach of Missouri State in 2020-21, coach Petrino guided the Bears to a 5-1 ledger in the Missouri Valley Football Conference and a share of the MVFC title. It marked the program's first conference championship since 1990 and ultimately earned MSU an at-large bid into the NCAA FCS playoffs, also the team's first in 30 years. The Bears finished with a final national ranking of 13 in both the STATS and AFCA national polls and earned 10 All-MVFC selections, including first-teamer and FCS Sophomore All-American DB Montrae Braswell.

For transforming the MoState program overnight into league contenders, Petrino was named MVFC Coach of the Year and finished ninth in the FCS National Coach of the Year voting, garnering two first-place votes in a stacked field of national coaching leaders.

Petrino's second season in Springfield was even more impressive than his debut. The Bears finished 14th in both the AFCA and Stats Perform final polls, while rolling to a 6-2 league record and runner-up finish in the MVFC. In addition, the Bears made a second straight appearance in the NCAA FCS Playoffs, while Petrino tied for 11th in the final voting for the Eddie Robinson Award for FCS National Coach of the Year.

The Bears boasted a dozen all-conference players in 2021 with QB Jason Shelley earning MVFC Offensive Player of the Year and MVFC Newcomer of the Year

laurels. Five other MoState players earned All-America distinction in 2021.

In August of 2021, ESPN named Petrino as one of the top 100 college football coaches of the last 50 years (#77).

Prior to coming to Springfield, Petrino previously served as head coach in two stints at Louisville as well as Arkansas and Western Kentucky. He compiled a 119-56 record in 14 seasons at the NCAA Division I FBS level and led those programs to 11 bowl appearances with seven teams ranked in the top 25 at season's end.

The Helena, Mont., native will begin his 34th year of collegiate coaching in the fall of 2022. He has guided his programs to top-six final rankings in the Associated Press poll three times (2004, 2006, 2011), directing some of the nation's top offensive programs along the way.

His clubs have finished in the top five nationally in scoring offense three times, while his 2004 club at Louisville led the country in scoring at 49.8 points per game. He has developed 35 NFL Draft selections during his illustrious career, including four in the first round, and Heisman Trophy winner Lamar Jackson.

His first stint at Louisville (2003-06) boasted 41 wins over a four-year span in the first head coaching assignment of his career with four bowl appearances in four seasons. Petrino directed the Cardinals to their first BIG EAST title in 2006, Louisville's second year in the league.

Petrino's 2004 campaign was one of the best in

school history, leading the Cardinals to an 11-1 record that culminated in a Conference USA title and a 44-40 Liberty Bowl win over 10th-ranked Boise State. The Cardinals led the nation in total offense (539.0) and scoring offense (49.8), scored 50 or more points seven times and set an NCAA record by scoring 55 or more points in five straight games.

He stepped away from college football in 2007 to coach the NFL's Atlanta Falcons for a season, then returned to guide the Arkansas Razorbacks for four years, from 2008-11. In Fayetteville, Petrino's squads were 34-17 in his time there -- including a 29-10 ledger over his last three campaigns -- with three bowl appearances and an impressive 11-2 record and No. 5 final ranking in 2011.

Petrino spent the 2013 season as head coach at Western Kentucky, where he helped WKU finish 8-4 while closing the season with a fourgame winning streak. The Hilltoppers also set a new school record for total offense (5,502 yards) and passing first downs (141) in a season.

His return to Louisville in 2014 was immediately successful, guiding the Cardinals to a 9-4 year out of the gates before reeling off four consecutive bowl appearances and another 9-4 campaign in 2016. In his nine total seasons in Louisville, Petrino's Cardinals were 77-35 overall and 45-24 in conference games (CUSA, Big East and ACC).

Petrino literally grew up in the

coaching profession. His father, Bob Petrino, Sr., coached at Carroll College in Helena, Mont., for 26 seasons, earning 163 victories and 15 conference titles. Petrino officially started his coaching career as a graduate assistant for his father at Carroll College in 1983.

After a graduate assistant stint as quarterbacks coach at Weber State in 1984, Petrino returned to be the offensive coordinator for his father in 1985-86 at Carroll. They had the top-ranked offense in the NAIA ranks in both of his seasons, thanks in large part to the play of Bobby Petrino's younger brother, Paul, who was a four-year starter at quarterback.

He returned to Weber State as the wide receivers and tight ends coach (1987-88), then served three seasons at Idaho (1989-91), including two years at offensive coordinator. The 1990 Idaho squad defeated MSU, 41-35, in the first round of the NCAA FCS playoffs in Springfield.

From there, he took assignments at Arizona State (1992-93), Nevada (1994) and Utah State (1995-97), before drawing the offensive coordinator position at Louisville in 1998. He guided future NFL star Jake Plummer at Arizona State and engineered the nation's No. 2 passing offense (330) and total offense (500.1) at Nevada for a 9-2 squad that won a share of the Big West title. Petrino also helped Utah State set school records in total offense (468.5) and passing yards (317.5) during the 1996 season. Likewise, the 1998 Louisville team was the top-ranked NCAA FBS squad in scoring and total offense.

Petrino stepped away from the college game from 1999-2001 for three seasons with the Jacksonville Jaguars, including the offensive coordinator role in 2001.

He played college football for his father at Carroll College, twice earning NAIA All-America honors and leading the Fighting Saints to three straight Frontier Conference championships. He was named the league MVP in 1981 and 1982. He also played four years of basketball at Carroll while earning a bachelor's degree in physical education with a minor in mathematics in 1983.

Petrino and his wife Becky have four children: Kelsey, Nick, Bobby and Katie — and eight grandchildren.
