- Missouri State (19-15, 8-4 Missouri Valley Conference) will play four games in a five-day stretch, starting with a 6 p.m. Tuesday contest at Missouri and ending with a Thursday-Saturday home series with Belmont.
- MoState is 31-31 all-time against Missouri and 1-1 versus Belmont.
- The Bears have continued their slugging ways this year after ranking in the top 17 nationally in 2022 in home runs and slugging percentage with 4.03 extra base hits per game. This season, the Bears rank 37th in homers and 44th in doubles with 4.03 extra base hits per contest.
- Missouri State freshman outfielders Zack Stewart and Taeg Gollert have made an immediate impact this season and rank 1-4 in the MVC in doubles with 14 and 10, respectively. Stewart is hitting .329 with seven homers and 37 RBI, while Gollert hit two grand slams vs. Bradley on April 9 and has six homers and 26 RBI.
- Missouri State homered in the first 11 games this season to extend its streak to 29 consecutive games with a long ball. The Bears have now blasted a round-tripper in 26 of 34 games this year and 44 of the last 52, with 91 total in that span. MSU has also tallied three or more extra-base hits in 24 of 34 games, with eight or more on four different occasions. The Bears lead the MVC in doubles, homers and slugging.
- The Missouri State leads the MVC in total strikeouts (334) and strikeouts per nine innings (9.84), the best rate in school history (9.10 in 2016 is 2nd), ranking 48th nationally in the latter category. Brandt Thompson leads the league with 63 strikeouts and Hayden Minton ranks third with 57. Thompson (66th - 4.5) and Minton (74th - 4.38) both rank in the top 75 nationally in strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- Third-year sophomore outfielder Spencer Nivens earned preseason all-MVC honors this season after a Freshman All-America season in 2022, and has continued his high level of play to lead the MVC in hits, triples, slugging percentage and total bases this season while sitting second in average and fourth in runs and homers. Nivens hit for MSU's first cycle since 1998 on Feb. 24 against Central Arkansas.
- MSU is 450-318 in its 33rd MVC season with six regular season titles. Since 2015, the Bears have won more combined regular season titles (3-2) and tournament championships (3-1) than the rest of the league's current membership combined. The Bears' current six-game MVC winning streak is the team's longest in league play since 2018.
- Head coach Keith Guttin ranks second among active coaches and 13th overall with 1,359 career wins. Among active skippers, Guttin trails only Danny Hall of Georgia Tech (1,368). Minnesota's John Anderson is just behind at 1,357 wins.

Athletics Communications

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LEADING OFF

Missouri State (19-15, 8-4 MVC) will play four games in a five-day stretch, starting with a 6 p.m. Tuesday contest at Missouri (23-11).

The Bears then return home for a Thursday-Saturday series against MVC newcomer Belmont (19-18, 5-7), facing the Bruins at 11 a.m. each day at Hammons Field on days in which the Springfield Cardinals are also at home.

SERIES HISTORIES

MoState is 31-31 all-time against Mizzou with a 15-17 record in Columbia. MSU's most recent win at Taylor Stadium was a 7-5 victory on April 13, 2021, and represented head coach Keith Guttin's 1,300th career win. The Tigers won this year's first meeting, 10-1 on April 11 in Springfield.

The Bears are 1-1 against Belmont with both meetings taking place in Nashville. Missouri State won 7-5 on February 24, 2017, and lost 1-0 in 11 innings on Feb. 21, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT

Missouri State swept UIC to run its MVC winning streak to six games, the program's longest conference win streak since 2018. The Bears won the three games in Chicago by scores of 6-2, 19-3 and 12-6, hitting .382 as a team with 10 home runs and a .736 slugging percentage in the series. Ten different Bears recorded at least hits in the series, and six hit a home run.

PITCHERS TIE SCHOOL RECORD

Missouri State tied a school record by striking out 19 SIU Edwardsville hitters on March 10 at Hammons Field. Brandt Thompson fanned 12 without issuing a walk in 6.1 innings, and Trey Ziegenbein added the final seven in 2.2 frames of hitless relief. The previous 19 K performance by the Bears came at Oklahoma Christian on March 23, 1967.

MVC HISTORY

Missouri State is in its 33rd Missouri Valley Conference season and owns a 450-318 record in league games with six regular season titles. Since 2015, the Bears have won more combined regular season titles (3-2) and tournament championships (3-1) than the rest of the league's current membership combined.

ROAD TO SUCCESS

MSU has proven solid on the road over the past eight-plus seasons, logging a 111-94 (.541) record in such contests. Including their 27-17 record in neutral-field games over the same stretch, the Bears have gone 140-111 (.558) away from Hammons Field since the start of the 2015 season.

The Bears have several high road win totals in recent years, logging 19 road wins in 2017 and a program-record 21 wins in 27 road contests in 2015. Coupled with their 9-3 record in neutral field contests in 2015, the Bears' total of 30 wins away from home was second only to national champion Virginia in the Division I ranks. The Bears also posted the longest road win streak in Division I baseball in 2015, claiming 11-straight victories from March 15 to April 25.

IN RARE COMPANY

With Missouri State's 7-5 win at Missouri on April 13, 2021, Bears head coach Keith Guttin reached 1,300 career victories and now sits in 13th place on the NCAA's Division I career coaching wins list.

With a career record of 1,359-887 (.605), Guttin ranks second among active coaches (full list on page 4). Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history.

Of the top 20 in all-time victories, 10, including Guttin, have spent their entire coaching career at one institution.

NON-CON DOMINATION

MSU has been solid against non-conference competition over the last eight seasons, compiling a 142-102 (.582) record in regular-season games versus non-league foes since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears have won 66 of their last 98 regular-season non-conference home games.

CARDIAC CUBS

Missouri State has nine come-from-behind victories this season after notching 16 in 2022, including rallying 7-1 after seven innings to beat Grand Canyon in the NCAA Tournament, and from down 5-0 twice - Feb. 27 vs. Cal Poly and March 4 vs. Indiana. MSU has 117 comeback wins since the start of the 2015 season.

The Bears have rallied from at least a seven-run deficit twice in that span, erasing an 8-1 deficit to win 10-9 at Evansville on May 11, 2019, and wiping out an 8-0, seventh-inning deficit by scoring seven times in the seventh, three more in the eighth and one in the ninth to beat Oklahoma 11-8 on March 15, 2019.

BEARS IN THE PRO RANKS

Missouri State has had 18 players selected in the first 12 rounds of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft since 2010. In 2021, Jake Burger and Dylan Coleman became the 21st and 22nd Bears to play in the Major Leagues, and joined Ross Detwiler, Pierce Johnson and Luke Voit as MSU alums appearing in the big leagues in 2022.

In 2023, Burger (White Sox), Coleman (Royals), Johnson (Rockies) and Voit (Brewers) have appeared in an MLB game.

Overall, the Bears have produced 152 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts over their 59 years as a varsity program, including 134 during Keith Guttin's 40-year tenure as head coach.

HALL OF FAMERS

MSU head coach Keith Guttin was enshrined into the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame in 2015, while pitching coach and 2012 Louisville Slugger National Player of the Year Nick Petree joined the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in February 2022.

BEARS ON AIR

All Missouri State baseball games this season will be streamed on the Varsity Network App. Fans can download the app for iPhone or Android use for instant access to free game day audio streams and receive push notifications to remind them of games starting or upcoming audio broadcasts. Additionally, the Bears' April 25 home contest against Arkansas can be heard on the America's Pastime Radio Network on Sirius XM.

KEITH GUTTIN Head Coach

41st Season
Alma mater: UMSL (1978)

One of the most successful baseball coaches in Missouri Valley Conference history, **Keith Guttin** began his MSU head coaching career in 1983, and has spent the past 40 seasons building the Bears into one of the top programs in the country. Under Guttin, the Bears have won 61 percent of their games, averaging 34 victories a year and racking up 12 different 40-win seasons.

Guttin, who currently ranks second among active Division I head coaches and 13th overall in career victories (1,359) as of April 16, 2023, has been a part of the MSU baseball program as a player, assistant coach and head coach for 45 of the program's 59 years. He took the helm of Bears baseball at the start of the 1983 season, coinciding with the move of Missouri State athletics to Division I status. He inherited the reins of the program from its only previous head baseball coach, former Missouri State Director of Athletics Bill Rowe. Guttin ultimately helped stretch MSU's string of consecutive winning seasons to 32 in a row, easily the longest of any Missouri State athletics team. His 1,349 career wins are the most recorded by any head coach in the 113-year history of Missouri State athletics, and the Bears have finished in the top half of the conference race in all but seven of his 40 seasons.

During Guttin's tenure, 130 Bears have signed professional contracts, including six first-round draft picks and 20 players who have advanced to the Major Leagues. Additionally, MSU has won 20 combined conference regular-season and tournament championships and made 12 NCAA Division I Tournament appearances.

In 2003, Guttin led the Bears to the NCAA Division I College World Series for the first time in school history, marking the only trip to Omaha by a Division I team from the state of Missouri since 1965. He has been a conference coach of the year 11 times and was selected as the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in both 1997 and 2003.

Guttin's pupils have produced results off the diamond as well. Missouri State baseball players have been recognized on the Valley's all-academic team 66 times since the inception of the honor in 1992. Additionally, seven Bears have garnered academic All-America honors on 12 different occasions under Guttin, including three-time selection Brian Mahaffey.

Missouri State is coming off a successful stretch that has seen the Bears claim three MVC regular-season titles and play in four NCAA Tournaments in the last eight seasons. In 2018, Guttin picked up his second consecutive MVC Coach of the Year honor after leading the Bears to their 12th 40-win campaign, as MSU swept the MVC regular-season and postseason tournament crowns for just the second time in school history. The previous spring, the Bears won their first 18 Valley games en route to the title, then captured their third overall NCAA Regional crown by knocking off Arkansas in the deciding game of the Fayetteville Regional. MSU saw its storybook season come to an end at the Fort Worth Super Regional, as TCU secured a fourth straight trip to Omaha with a two-game sweep of Guttin's Bears. Consensus All-America picks Jake Burger and Jeremy Eierman led a potent Bears lineup

that paved the way to a 43-20 campaign, while Valley pitcher of the year Jake Fromson led a star-studded pitching staff and garnered All-America recognition of his own.

The 2015 season will go down as one of the more memorable campaigns for Guttin, who was inducted into both the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame and Springfield Area Sports Hall of Fame during the year. He also surpassed the 1,100 career victory mark early in MSU's record-setting season en route to earning his fifth MVC Coach of the Year nod. Under Guttin's guidance, the 2015 Bears set a program record with 49 victories and were ranked as high as No. 6 (*Baseball America*) in the nation while capturing the Valley's regular-season and postseason tournament titles. MSU went on to earn its ninth NCAA Division I postseason berth, sweeping the Springfield Regional at Hammons Field to advance to its second Super Regional appearance, where the Bears came up just one win shy of punching their ticket to the College World Series.

In 2001, Guttin led the Bears to their first-ever MVC regular-season championship and, in the process, dethroned perennial league powerhouse Wichita State. The Shockers had previously won outright or shared the Valley regular season crown in the previous 14 years, but the Bears posted a 22-10 record in 2001 and bested WSU by one game for the MVC crown.

While the accomplishments of Guttin's teams on the field speak volumes about the success of his program, another dream came true in April 2004 when the Bears opened a sparkling 8,000-seat stadium just four blocks north of the Missouri State campus. It was merely a coincidence that the crown jewel of the Missouri State baseball program came one year after the Bears exploded onto the national college baseball radar in the College World Series. But both events show the growth of college baseball in the Ozarks and the amount of community and administrative support the program had received in the last several years. With the continued support of the MSU community, Guttin has led the Bears' efforts in numerous charitable endeavors, including the program's annual Price Cutter Celebrity Golf Classic, proceeds from which have been committed to Champion Athletes of the Ozarks in each of the last 20 years. MSU's popular First Pitch and Reunion Night has also been a positive force for both the Bears and a variety of local charitable organizations. The preseason kickoff event has benefitted entities such as the Miracle League Ball Field, Care to Learn, Boys and Girls Clubs and the Wounded Warrior Project.

The Bears have finished lower than third in the league standings just 10 times since Guttin took over. Guttin directed Missouri State to six straight league titles in Mid-Continent play from 1984 through 1989. He has given MSU its first five Valley postseason tournament championships in 1996, 1997, 2015, 2018 and 2022. He was voted the MVC Coach of the Year in 1993, 2001, 2003, 2008, 2015, 2017 and 2018 and was selected the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 1997 and 2003.

Guttin had two notable seasons as the Missouri State second baseman, coming from Mineral Area College. He earned MIAA all-conference honorable mention in 1977 as the Bears made their first NCAA Division II tournament appearance in seven years.

A University City native, Guttin finished his undergraduate degree at the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1978, and earned his master's degree in 1984 at Truman State. He and his wife, Marianne, have three daughters, Lauren, Lindsey and Samantha; and two grandsons, Bradley and Brody.

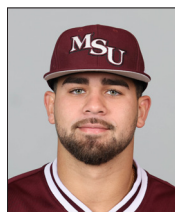

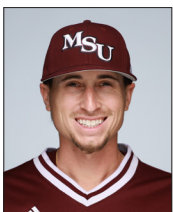
