### **FIRST AND TEN STORYLINES**

- ◆ Fresh off a convincing victory over Lindenwood in their home opener, the Missouri State Bears return to the road this week for a Saturday showdown at UT Martin in MSU's non-conference finale. The fourth meeting between the clubs in four seasons will kick at 6 p.m. with coverage on ESPN+.
- ◆ QB Jacob Clark (Sr., Rockwall, Texas) is this week's MVFC Co-Offensive Player of the Week after he broke the club single-game record for pass completion percentage (.848) against Lindenwood. Clark was 28-for-33 for 302 yards and 2 touchdowns and engineered scoring drives on MSU's first three possessions in its home opener. It marks the second straight year Clark has earned MVFC honors after the home opener.
- ◆ Clark leads all MVFC signal callers in passing yards (817), passing yards per game (272.3) and completions per game (23.33), which all rank in the top 10 nationally (4th-6th-9th). He is also 2nd in The Valley in pass efficiency (142.1) and yards per attempt (7.86). Clark passed for 332 yards and 3 TDs last year at UT Martin.
- ◆ Jacardia Wright (Sr., Decatur, Ill.) needs 133 rushing yards to reach 2,000 for his career to go with his 399 carries and 19 rushing TDs. He is part of Missouri State's "Thunder and Lightning" backfield along with Jayden Becks (So., Waxahachie, Texas). The tandem has combined for 315 ground yards and 5 rushing scores through Missouri State's first three ball games.
- ◆ Safety P.J. Hall (Little Rock, Ark.) has an interception in each of the last two games (5 for his career) and ranks 2nd nationally (1st in the MVFC) in interceptions per game (0.67). The fifth-year standout has started the last 14 games in the MSU secondary.
- ♦ Hunter Wood (Sr., Springdale, Ark.) became the 18th MSU receiver to record 10 pass receptions in a game when he snagged a career-high 10 catches for 90 yards vs. Lindenwood in week three. He now ranks 22nd nationally in receptions per game (5.7), 27th in punt return average (7.3), 49th in receiving yards (187) and 53rd in receiving yards per game (62.3). He ranks 3rd in the MVFC in receptions per game. He had 7 receptions for 74 yards against the Skyhawks last season in Martin.
- ♦ MoState's offense ranks among the national leaders in completion percentage (11th), passing offense (12th), first downs (14th), passing efficiency (24th), red zone offense (28th), total offense (28th) and 3rd-down efficiency (31st). The Bears lead the MVFC in passing offense (272.3) and 2nd in efficiency (142.14).
- ◆ Defensively, Missouri State is emerging as a force to reckon with, ranking 8th nationally in interceptions (4), 17th in tackles for loss (7.0), 25th in takeaways (5); and 27th in turnover margin (+0.67). MSU's 5 takeaways leads the Missouri Valley Football Conference.
- ◆ Jacardia Wright (Sr, Decatur, III.) logged his third career 100-yard rushing game (143) and racked up a career-high 208 all-purpose yards and a pair of touchdowns in MSU's win over Lindenwood. The standout running back averaged 6.8 yards per carry and 13.5 yards (on five receptions for 65 yards). He ranks 7th nationally and 1st in the MVFC in total offense (136.0) and 29th nationally in rushing yards per game (88.3).
- ♦ WR **Jmariyae Robinson** (So., Cocoa, Fla.) has scored in all three games and ranks **12th** nationally in touchdowns (4) and **18th** nationally in points per game (8.0), both ranking **2nd** in The Valley.
- ♦ MSU linebacker **Tahj Chambers** (Sr., Arlington, Texas) is coming off a team-high and career-high **13** tackles against Lindenwood, catapulting him to **16th** nationally and **3rd** in the MVFC in tackles per game (**10.0**), just behind teammate **Todric McGee** (Jr., Wichita, Kan.) who is **14th** nationally and **2nd** in the MVFC (**10.3**).
- ♦ The Bears have scored in 20 of their last 24 quarters (dating back to last season) and have notched double-figure scoring totals in 42 consecutive ball games, including 20 or more points 34 times in that span.

### HEAD COACH RYAN BEARD

Missouri State University officially presented Ryan Beard as its new head football coach on Dec. 19, 2022. At the time of his hire, Beard was the program's youngest coach on record and was the 22nd person to hold the football Bears' top coaching position. Beard is 5-9 overall in his second season as MSU head coach (0-1 vs. UTM).

His elevation to head coach came on the heels of three seasons as defensive coordinator (2020-22) at Missouri State under former head coach Bobby Petrino.

In his inaugural head coaching season, Beard guided the Bears to a 4-7 overall record and a 3-5 ledger in the MVFC. The team's strong November surge included and a 35-16 home win over No. 18-ranked Northern Iowa.

The 2023 Bears finished No. 5 in the nation in passing offense (300.3), No. 7 in pass efficiency (158.77), 26th in total offense (400.8) and 31st in scoring (29.8).

Missouri State was rewarded with seven All-MVFC selections in Beard's first campaign as head coach, including first-teamers Grant Burkett (P) and Raylen Sharpe (WR). Sharpe finished fourth in the MVFC Offensive Player of the Year voting. Likewise, Burkett (second team) and Sharpe (third team) were named to the Associated Press FCS All-America Team, while the Bears also boasted three Phil Steele Freshman All-America honorees, including first-teamers Cash Hudson (OL) and Avery Powell (CB).

At season's end, Beard was named to the American Football Coaches Association's exclusive 35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute.

During his three seasons as MSU's defensive coordinator, Beard played a significant role in the team's resurgence, managing a defensive unit that boasted 18 all-conference selections, four All-Americans and three professional players in his tenure at MoState.

Before coming to Missouri State. Beard spent the 2019 season at Central Michigan as the special teams and safeties coach for head coach Jim McElwain. He joined the Central Michigan staff in February of 2019 and helped lead the Chippewas to an 8-6 campaign on a defensive secondary that created 13 interceptions.

Beard served as an assistant at Louisville during the 2017 and 2018 seasons, starting as the defensive backs coach and in quality control before moving on to become the Cardinals' linebackers coach and their co-special teams coordinator. As the DB coach at WKU (2016), Beard was part of a CUSA championship Boca Raton Bowl win.

He was a standout defensive back at Western Kentucky himself from 2007-11. He was a two-time All-Sun Belt Conference selection and was named to the league's All-Freshman squad and its All-Academic team. A native of Bowling Green, Ky., Beard was a four-year letterman at Bowling Green High for coach Kevin Wallace, where his efforts helped the Purples advance to the state 3A championship contest each of his last two years.

Beard, 35, holds two degrees from Western Kentucky: a bachelor of science in Business Management (2012), and a master of science in Recreation and Sport Administration (2014).

He is married to the former Katie Petrino. The couple have four children with son Beau and daughter Lainey, in addition to twins Jacob and Kailey born in the spring of 2022.

Missouri State leads the all-time series vs. UT Martin, 7-2, including a 2-1 record in Martin.

The teams have played three times in recent years, including a narrow 32-31 Skyhawks win in Springfield during the 2021 NCAA FCS playoffs. The Bears avenged that loss at Plaster in 2022 (35-30) before UTM struck back last season with a 38-31 victory in Martin. MSU is averaging 39.1 points per game in the nine previous meetings.

### BEARS ON THE AIR

All Missouri State games will air live on the Missouri State Radio Network with Springfield flagship station KWTO (101.3 FM) providing the feed to the four-station network and online with the Varsity Network App.

The voice of the Bears, Art Hains, first began calling Missouri State action in 1977 and is in his second stint and 45th season overall behind the microphone. He called MSU games from 1977-81 and returned for his second stint in 1985. A member of the Missouri State Athletics Hall of Fame and Missouri Sports Hall of Fame, Hains celebrated his 2,500th MSU sports event on Nov. 9, 2019. After battling through a life-threatening illness that began in September of 2022 (after game three). Hains returned to the booth for home games last fall and will continue to serve in that capacity during the 2024 season.

Missouri State alum Corey Riggs begins his third season on the Bears radio team and will serve as the playby-play announcer for all road games in addition to providing color commentary on all home broadcasts. Riggs has worked on MSU home football TV broadcasts for more than two decades with both on-air and production duties from Plaster Stadium. He also serves as the production anchor for the Missouri State Radio Network and was recently announced as the Director of Broadcasting Services for Missouri State Sports Properties.

Former Bears football standouts Sam Block (2007-10) and Clay Harbor (2006-09) will share color analyst duties for away games this season.

### **MO STATE BEGINS TRANSITION TO CUSA**

On May 10, Missouri State University announced it had accepted an invitation to join Conference USA as a full-league member, effective July 1, 2025. The announcement places MSU in the NCAA's exclusive Division I Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) for the first time.



MoState football will continue competing in the Missouri Valley Football Conference for the 2024 season with eligibility for a conference title but not the NCAA FCS playoffs. In 2025, football will compete in Conference USA with eligibility for a conference regular-season championship but not the CUSA Championship Game or a bowl game. In 2026, the Bears will be eligible to compete in both the Conference USA Championship Game and a bowl game.

The "Group of Five" football status of CUSA gives its league members an elevated presence in the NCAA's governance structure and joins its cohort leagues with representation in the expanded CFP playoff system. Founded in 1995 and based in Dallas, CUSA's membership in 2024-25 will include 10 schools with Missouri State and Delaware expanding the league's membership to 12 schools in 2025-26.

### CLARK LIGHTS UP LINDENWOOD TO EARN MVC OFFENSIVE AWARD

MSU QB **Jacob Clark** (Sr., Rockwall, Texas) earned MVFC Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 16 after he broke a club single-game record for pass completion percentage (.848) and going 28-for-33 vs. Lindenwood in MSU's home opener. He accounted for 302 passing yards, 309 yards of total offense, and passed for two scores. Clark engineered scoring drives on Missouri State's first three possessions to mount his third career 300-yard passing effort. He had streaks of 14- and 11-straight completed passes in the game, the former of which matches the second-most in MSU history.

It is Clark's second career MVFC honor after earning the same award on Sept. 23, 2023.

### MCGEE EARNS MVFC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF WEEK AFTER OPENER

Safety **Todric McGee** (Jr., Wichita, Kan.) was named Missouri Valley Football Conference Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 2 for his efforts in the Bears' near-upset of No. 3-ranked Montana in the season opener.

McGee shined brightest on a night when Missouri State's defense held the defending national runners-up under 30 points for just the second time in its past nine games. He logged a game-high 11 total tackles, including three solo stops. He also assisted on a tackle for loss in the contest.

The award marks McGee's first Valley weekly honor who earned All-MVFC second-team laurels last season.

### BEARS GIVE NO. 3 MONTANA SCARE IN SEASON OPENER

Visiting Missouri State racked up **356** total yards and outgained No. 3-ranked Montana in the season opener at Washington-Grizzly Stadium on Aug. 31, but the Grizzlies held on late to secure a 29-24 win over the Bears.

MSU QB **Jacob Clark** was 23-of-39 for 257 yards through the air, while **Jacardia Wright** added 76 ground yards and 69 receiving yards for Missouri State to keep pace with the defending FCS national runners-up.

The Bears were whistled for 13 penalties for 113 yards, directly leading to four Montana first downs. The Grizzlies drew just four flags on the night and accounted for 347 total yards, including 167 on the ground.

After trailing by two at the half, Missouri State recaptured the lead less than three minutes into the third quarter. A 27-yard pass from Clark to Wright set up a 32-yard touchdown run by Jayden Becks on the next play. The quick, six-play scoring strike gave MSU a 17-12 lead, which held up until the final minute of the third period.

### ELEVEN BEARS ON PRESEASON ALL-VALLEY TEAM

Eleven Missouri State football standouts were honored on July 22 on the Preseason All-Missouri Valley Football Conference Team, the league announced as part of its annual Media Days.

Leading the way for the Bears were first-team honoree **Grant Burkett** (P, Joplin, Mo.) and second-teamers **Darion Smith** (DL, St. Louis, Mo.), **P.J. Hall** (S, Little Rock, Ark.) and **Todric McGee** (S, Wichita, Kan.). MoState also landed seven honorable mention (third team) picks, including **Caden Bolz** (LS, Overland Park, Kan.), **Jacardia Wright** (RB, Decatur, III.), **Jmariyae Robinson** (WR, Cocoa, Fla.), **Cash Hudson** (OL, Tulsa, Okla.), **Hutson Lillibridge** (OL, St. Louis, Mo.), **Tahj Chambers** (LB, Arlington, Texas) and **Avery Powell** (CB, East Orange, N.J.).

The MVFC also released its preseason poll at its Media Days. The Bears were picked **9th** in the 12-team league's prognostications with 164 total points and a first-place vote.

### MISSOURI STATE ANNOUNCES FIRST SERIES FOR FBS ERA

On June 27, Missouri State announced a pair of non-conference football series for its inaugural season as a Division I FBS program in 2025. The Bears inked home-and-home series against Southern Methodist University (SMU) and Marshall University. Both series will begin in 2025 with reciprocal games in 2026.

The program's first-ever home game against an FBS opponent will take place on Saturday, Sept. 13, 2025 when the Bears host SMU at Robert W. Plaster Stadium. The game is expected to be a night contest and will kick off the university's official home debut at its reclassified level. MoState will return the game in Dallas on Sept. 26, 2026.

Likewise, the Bears have signed a home-and-home set with Marshall, starting with a Sept. 6, 2025 game in Huntington, W.Va. against the Thundering Herd. The teams will also play in Springfield in a rematch on Sept. 19, 2026.

#### ALL IN THE FAMILY

Coach **Ryan Beard** replaced legendary coach Bobby Petrino as Missouri State's sideline boss on Dec. 19, 2022. Petrino served as head coach of the Bears the previous three seasons (2020-22).

Upon his promotion from defensive coordinator to head coach last season, Beard was able to retain 8 of the 10 assistant coaches from the previous staff, including Offensive Coordinator **Nick Petrino** and Defensive Line Coach **LD Scott** (named the team's new Defensive Coordinator) -- both brothers-in-law to Beard.

Ryan is married to the former Katie Petrino (Bobby's daughter), and L.D. Scott is married to the former Kelsey Petrino (also Bobby's daughter). Nick Petrino is (obviously) Bobby's son and Katie and Kelsey's brother.

### LEADING THE SLEUTH

MoState's co-captains for the 2024 season are **Grant Burkett** (P, Joplin, Mo.), **Darion Smith** (DL, St. Louis, Mo.), **Jacardia Wright** (RB, Decatur, III.), **Jacob Clark** (QB, Rockwall, Texas) and **Tahj Chambers** (LB, Arlington, Texas). Burkett, Smith and Wright were also co-captains for the Bears last season.

The Bears are **3-0** on coin tosses this season.

### **BURKETT ON FCS PUNTER OF YEAR WATCH LIST**

MSU punter **Grant Burkett** (Sr., Joplin, Mo.) is one of 13 players selected to the 2024 FCS Punter of the Year Watch List, as announced August 2 by the Augusta Sports Council. Burkett was also a finalist for 2023 National Punter of the Year last season after earning All-America honors for the third straight season. He is a Stats Perform Preseason All-America third-team selection this year, after earning Preseason All-MVFC laurels as well.

Burkett is also a four-time All-MVFC selection who averaged 44.0 yards per punt last season with 11 kicks of 50 yards or more. His punting average led the MVFC and was good enough to finish seventh nationally. The FCS Punter of the Year Award winner will be announced Dec. 16.



### WRIGHT NAMED TO SENIOR BOWL WATCH LIST

Running back **Jacardia Wright** (Sr., Decatur, III.) has been named to the Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List, the organization announced Aug. 21. Wright was a second-team All-MVFC selection in 2023 and an MVFC All-Newcomer Team honoree in 2022. A year ago, he ranked fifth in the

Wright is one of 16 Missouri Valley Football Conference players on this year's Senior Bowl Watch List with eight different Valley schools represented in that number. All told, 81 FCS players are also included in this year's list, along with 859 prospects in all.

### BOLZ. BURKETT EARN STATS PERFORM PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA

Missouri State football standouts **Caden Bolz** (Sr., Overland Park, Kan.) and **Grant Burkett** (Sr., Joplin, Mo.) were among 24 players from the Missouri Valley Football Conference selected to the Stats Perform FCS Preseason All-America Team.

Bolz, a senior long snapper, was honored as a second-team selection. He was named the Preseason All-MVFC Team and was an honorable mention All-MVFC selection last season. He was perfect on 93 long-snap opportunities in 2023, including 43 extra point tries, 37 punts and 13 field goal attempts.

Burkett, a senior punter, is a third-team selection on the preseason All-America Team. He is a four-time All-MVFC selection and a three-time All-American who averaged 44.0 yards per punt last season with 11 kicks of 50 yards or more. His punting average led the MVFC and was good enough to finish seventh nationally while he was a finalist for FCS Punter of the Year in 2023. He is also a 2024 Preseason All-MVFC first-teamer.

### **BOLZ HEADLINES 10 BEARS ON PHIL STEELE TEAMS**

Missouri State long snapper **Caden Bolz** was named on August 2 to the Phil Steele FCS Preseason All-America Team. The senior from Overland Park, Kan., was honored as a second-team All-America selection selection by Phil Steele, after also receiving 2024 Preseason All-MVFC Team honors.


A year ago, Bolz was perfect on 93 long-snap opportunities in 2023, including 43 extra point tries, 37 punts and 13 field goal attempts. In 2023, he was a Phil Stele Preseason All-America fourth-team honoree as well as a Preseason All-MVFC first-team selection before garnering honorable mention All-MVFC honors to end the campaign.

Likewise, Bolz is also among 10 Bears named to the Phil Steele Preseason All-MVFC team, joining first-teamer Grant Burkett (P), second-teamers Jacardia Wright (RB), Darion Smith (DL) and Todric McGee (DB); and third-team selections Jmariyae Robinson (WR), Cash Hudson (OL), Hutson Lillibridge (OL), PJ Hall (DB) and Avery Powell (DB).

### **BEARS IN THE NFL**

DL **Eric Johnson II** (Plainfield, III.) was selected by the Indianapolis Colts as the 159th overall pick of the 2022 NFL Draft (6th pick of Round 5). After two seasons and 28 games in Indianapolis, he was recently picked up by the New England Patriots. He begins 2024 with 18 career tackles.

Johnson played in a school-record 55 consecutive games as a five-year starter for Missouri State (2017-2021). His draft stock skyrocketed in the offseason with his standout efforts in the NFLPA

Eight grid Bears were also announced as part of the league's Commissioner's Academic Excellence Award, which requires a minimum grade-point average of 3.2 for the previous two semesters. Freshmen are not eligible for this award. ### MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY

Missouri State University is a public, comprehensive university system with a mission in public affairs, whose purpose is to develop educated persons while achieving five goals: democratizing society, incubating new ideas, imagining Missouri's future, making Missouri's future, and modeling ethical and effective behavior.

With a current enrollment of 24,224 (Fall of 2023), MSU is the second-largest institution for higher learning in Missouri, and its identity is distinguished by its statewide mission in public affairs. This mission requires a campus-wide commitment to foster competence and responsibility in the common vocation of citizenship. MSU is a selective admissions, graduate-level, teaching and research institution.

Notable Missouri State alums include: John Goodman (actor), Kathleen Turner (actress), Jake Burger (Miami Marlins), Ryan Howard (2009 NLCS MVP, Philadelphia Phillies), Deidre Goodwin (actress), David Glass (late owner, Kansas City Royals), John Q. Hammons (businessman, hotel developer), Bob Holden (43rd governor of Missouri), Bill Mueller (2003 American League batting champ), and Jackie Stiles (WBB Hall of Famer).

MSU is a member of the Missouri Valley Conference in 15 sports with affiliate membership in the Missouri Valley Football Conference (MVFC) and CUSA (beach volleyball). The university has announced plans to join Conference USA as a full-time member on July 1, 2025.

### MISSOURI VALLEY FOOTBALL CONFERENCE

Founded in 1985, the Missouri Valley Football Conference has shaped itself into the nation's premier NCAA FCS conference. Last season, the MVFC extended its FCS-record to 13-straight title game appearances as South Dakota State defeated Montana in Frisco, Texas for the crown. Notably, the 2023 season marked the 19th title appearance for a league team (13-6), all since 1997.

Since 2010, the MVFC is 98-45 (.685) in the playoffs -- which includes 17 intra-conference games



(meaning the league is 81-28 (.743) against teams from other leagues). Last season, MVFC teams combined to go 27-10 against non-conference FCS teams. Five of the 10 losses were against ranked FCS teams.

An MVFC member has reached the FCS semifinals 20 times in the past 13 seasons (and 34 times overall) with multiple semifinalists seven times in the past 10 years.

Missouri State is a charter member of the MVFC, along with current members UNI, Illinois State and Southern Illinois. The 11-team league now includes expansion members: Indiana State (1986), Youngstown State (1997), North Dakota State (2008), South Dakota State (2008), South Dakota (2013), North Dakota (2020) and Murray State (2023). Western Illinois left the MVFC at the conclusion of the 2023 season to join the Ohio Valley.

### BEARD JOINS EXCLUSIVE AFCA 35 UNDER 35 INSTITUTE

In December, the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) announced its selections for its 2024 "35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute" with Missouri State head coach Ryan Beard among its honorees.

The most-recent class was chosen from a field of over 175 highly qualified applicants.

The AFCA 35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute is a prestigious program aimed at identifying and developing premier, future leaders in the football coaching profession. Selected participants are invited to attend the one-day institute that features a curriculum of interactive lectures focused on topics specifically tailored to emphasize leadership in the coaching profession, ethics, influential responsibilities, career progression, and family balance.

Missouri State University officially presented Ryan Beard as its new head football coach on Dec. 19, 2022. At the time of his hire, Beard (34) was the program's youngest coach on record and was the 22nd person to hold the football Bears' top coaching position.

His elevation to head coach came on the heels of three seasons as defensive coordinator (2020-22) at Missouri State under former head coach Bobby Petrino.

In his inaugural coaching season, Beard guided the Bears to a 4-7 overall record and a 3-5 ledger in the MVFC. The team's strong November surge included and a 35-16 home win over No. 18-ranked Northern Iowa.

The 2023 Bears finished No. 5 in the nation in passing offense (300.3), No. 7 in pass efficiency (158.77), 26th in total offense (400.8) and 31st in scoring (29.8).

Missouri State was rewarded with seven All-MVFC selections in Beard's first campaign, including first-teamers Grant Burkett (P) and Raylen Sharpe (WR). Sharpe finished fourth in the MVFC Offensive Player of the Year voting. Likewise, Burkett (second team) and Sharpe (third team) were named to the Associated Press FCS All-America Team, while the Bears also boasted three Phil Steele Freshman All-America honorees, including first-teamers Cash Hudson (OL) and Avery Powell (CB).

At season's end, Beard was named to the American Football Coaches Association's exclusive 35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute.

During his three seasons as MSU's defensive coordinator, Beard played a significant role in the team's resurgence, managing a defensive unit that boasted 18 all-conference selections, four All-Americans and three professional players in his tenure at MoState.

In his first campaign in Springfield in 2020-21, Beard and his defensive unit broke the program record for sacks with 27, created 15 turnovers, and held every Missouri Valley Football Conference foe under 30 points for the first time since 1989. His inaugural season on the MSU staff culminated in five all-conference selections, while the Bears captured a share of the Valley championship and earned an NCAA FCS playoff berth for the first time in 30 years.

As an encore effort in 2021, Beard's second year with the program saw the Bears top the club sack record again (30) while racking up 25 takeaways and securing 15 interceptions. In addition to making a second straight NCAA playoff appearance in 2021, MSU finished in sole possession of second place in the rugged Missouri Valley Football Conference, ranked ninth nationally in turnovers gained and finished 14th in interceptions per game. The 2021 Bears also boasted five all-conference players on the defensive side of the ball, including safeties Kyriq McDonald and Titus Wall. Wall went on to immediate success with the Calgary Stampeders of the Canadian Football League, while Bears' defensive lineman Eric Johnson was drafted by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round of the 2022 NFL Draft.

The 2022 Bears defense gave up just 15.8 points per game over their last four games with defensive end Kevin Ellis leading the nation in fumble recoveries. Four MSU defenders earned all-conference laurels, including McDonald, three-time captain Kevin Ellis and five-time All-MVFC pick Montrae Braswell who signed a free agent deal with the Kansas City Chiefs.

Before coming to Missouri State, Beard spent the 2019 season at Central Michigan University as the special teams and safeties coach for head coach Jim McElwain. He joined the Central Michigan staff in February of 2019 and helped lead

the Chippewas to an 8-6 campaign on a defensive secondary that created 13 interceptions.

Beard served as an assistant at Louis-ville during the 2017 and 2018 seasons, starting as the defensive backs coach and in quality control before moving on to become the Cardinals' linebackers coach and their co-special teams coordinator. Among those who Beard coached at Louisville are Jaire Alexander, who was selected by the Green Bay Packers in the first round of the NFL draft; 2014 Jim Thorpe Award winner Gerod Holliman; and James Sample, a former member of the Jacksonville Jaguars.

As the defensive backs coach at Western Kentucky in 2016, Beard helped lead the Hilltoppers to the Conference USA championship and a win in the Boca Raton Bowl.

Beard was a standout defensive

back at Western Kentucky himself from 2007-11. He was a two-time All-Sun Belt Conference selection and was named to the league's All-Freshman squad and its All-Academic team. In 2011, he earned the Western Kentucky Iron Man Award.

A native of Bowling Green, Ky., Beard was a four-year letterwinner at Bowling Green High for coach Kevin Wallace, where his efforts helped the Purples advance to the 3A state championship contest in each of his last two years.

Beard holds two degrees from Western Kentucky: a bachelor of science in Business Management (2012), and a master of science in Recreation and Sport Administration (2014).

He is married to the former Katie Petrino. The couple have four children with son Beau and daughter Lainey, in addition to twins Jacob and Kailey born in the spring of 2022.
