KEY STORYLINES

► Missouri State wraps the non-conference portion of its schedule this Saturday when the Bears host regional rival UT Martin (6 p.m., ESPN+) on Family Weekend. Including last week's game vs. SMU, the Bears are now **2-1** under coach Ryan Beard in non-conference home games.

► The Bears have scored first and taken the early lead in all three games this season. The Bears have scored on their opening drive twice in three tries.

► Under coach Ryan Beard, the Bears are **11-2** when they rack up 400 or more yards in total offense.

► Massey Ratings lists Missouri State's strength of schedule as **No. 8** among 136 FBS programs and tops in Conference USA. The Bears are ranked **No. 108** overall in this week's Massey FBS power ratings (4th in CUSA). Likewise, NatStat ranks MoState **No. 96** on its Team Context Ratings (out of 225 FBS & FCS clubs).

► The UT Martin game is the 3rd of **6** night games on the 2025 slate for the Bears, the team's most since 2003 (7).

► In the last meeting between the Bears and Skyhawks at Plaster Stadium (9/8/22), QB Jason Shelley and WR Ty Scott connected on fourth-quarter TD passes of 7 and 22 yards to erase a 24-21 UT Martin lead. The Bears pushed ahead 35-24 with 4:37 left in the game and held on to win 35-30, racking up 437 yards with Shelley passing for 297 yards (19/24) and Jacardia Wright rushing for 120 yards.

► LB Jared "Bird" Lloyd is closing in on 100 career tackles. The fourth-year squadman needs **11** total tackles to reach the century mark (21 career games).

► WR **Jmariyae Robinson** needs 7 pass receptions to become the 17th Bear to eclipse 100 career catches. His **1,256** career receiving yards currently ranks 19th on MSU's career list. He also has at least one pass reception in **26** consecutive games, dating back to 9/1/23.

► The home attendance total of **15,037** for last Saturday's home opener against SMU was the 13th-largest home crowd in Bears football history and the club's 7th-best drawing ever for a home opener. It was also the largest home attendance total for any game during the Ryan Beard era.

► According to CFBstats, Missouri State ranks **29th** among all FBS programs in average time of possession per game (**32:51**), which also ranks 2nd in CUSA.

► In two previous starts against UT Martin, **Jacob Clark** is 49-of-75 (.653) for **720** yards, 6 TDs and 0 interceptions with 747 yards of total offense.

► Missouri State's current three-game home stand is its longest since **2018**.

► MoState is **17-7** in its last **24** home games, dating back to March 13, 2021. In that span, the Bears have scored two or more touchdowns **21** times and scored 30 or more points **17** times. MSU has reeled off 4 straight winning home seasons.

► Former Bears LB Eunique Valentine now plays for UT Martin. The Knoxville, Tenn. native was with MoState in 2024 (0g) after previous stops at Tennessee (2020-21) and Butler Community College (2021-23). The Skyhawks have two players originally from the state of Missouri in OL Mitchell Appleton (DeSoto) and CB Chris Rhodes (Kansas City).

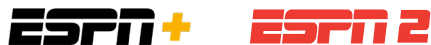

MEDIA SCHEDULE

Coach Ryan Beard and select players will appear at a press conference for credentialed media representatives on **Mondays** of game weeks in the Plaster Stadium west lobby, starting at **1:30 p.m.** In October, the pressers will move to Fridays at 1:30 p.m.

Videos of each interview session will be posted on the MSU Bears YouTube channel.

Postgame press conferences will be held in Pummill Hall, just east of the Missouri State game-day locker room.

COLLAB. REPLAY

Conference USA utilizes a collaborative replay system, where Coordinator of Officials Mike Defee and his staff will oversee all replay reviews. Each CUSA stadium is equipped with DVSport replay technology that connects directly to the central hub. When a play is challenged or requires review, video angles are transmitted in real time, providing the replay team access to every available camera feed as they work in coordination with the on-site replay official to make the ruling.

This structure ensures that every critical decision benefits from the combined expertise of both the local crew and the central command center and creates a consistent standard across games, accelerates review times and improves accuracy with simultaneous access to every angle.

AVAILABILITY REPORT

CUSA has implemented a standardized player availability reporting process that requires institutions to designate student-athletes as "Out" (0% likelihood of participation) or "Questionable" (~50% likelihood). Any player not listed will be presumed available.

Each member institution will submit a report for all contests no later than three hours prior to kickoff for football. Reports will be made public by the conference office prior to gametime. For non-conference and postseason contests, availability reports will not be made available if the opposing institution does not submit a corresponding report. The process is designed to balance transparency with student-athlete privacy and institutional needs, while aligning with national standards for competitive integrity.

BEARS ON THE AIR

MISSOURI STATE RADIO NETWORK

All Missouri State games will air live on the Missouri State Radio Network with Springfield flagship station KWTO (101.3 FM) providing the feed to the five-station network and online with the **Varsity Network App**.

Missouri State alum **Corey Riggs** begins his fourth season on the Bears radio team and will serve as the play-by-play announcer for the radio network all season. Before taking over as Missouri State's Director of Broadcasting in 2024, Riggs worked on MSU home football, basketball and baseball



TV broadcasts for more than two decades with both on-air and production duties. He also serves as the

production anchor for the Missouri State Radio Network and host of the "MoState Update" podcast and "Inside the Den" weekly coaches shows for football and men's basketball.

Former Bears football standout **Sam Block** (2007-10) will share color analyst duties with local sports personality **Tom Mast** and others throughout the season, while long-time Missouri State radio personality **Tom Ladd** will serve as the sideline reporter for all football games this season.

A FAREWELL TO ART

Longtime radio voice of the Bears, **Art Hains**, announced his retirement on August 8, 2024 and called his final Missouri State game on Sept. 13 vs. SMU (his alma mater).

Hains first began calling Missouri State action in 1977 and had two stints and **46** seasons behind the microphone. He first called MSU games from 1977-81 and returned for an encore run from 1985 to 2025. A member of the Missouri State Athletics Hall of Fame and Missouri Sports Hall of Fame, Hains has battled through a life-threatening illness that began in September of 2022 (after game three) before he returned to the booth for home games in 2023 and 2024. A documentary on Art's dramatic story will debut at Alamo Drafthouse on Oct. 30.

A native of Marshall, Missouri, Hains called just under **3,000** MSU sports events during his career, including **463** Bears football games.

The home radio facility at Plaster Stadium was dedicated as the Art Hains Broadcast Booth on Sept. 13, 2025 with his wife Lisa, children Chris and Kathleen and other family in attendance.

FIRST FBS SEASON YIELDS FIVE NATIONAL TV GAMES

Missouri State's inaugural season in the FBS ranks will bring five nationally-televised broadcasts to Bear Nation, including non-conference games at USC (Aug. 30, B1G Network) and at home vs. SMU (Sept. 13, CBS Sports Network). The Bears will also play on ESPN2 at Middle Tennessee (Oct. 8) and on CBS Sports Network at New Mexico State (Oct. 22) in addition to the homecoming game against FIU (Oct. 29) on CBS Sports Network.

All remaining games will appear on ESPN Platforms, including ESPN+, with home games anchored by play-by-play announcer **Don West**, color analyst **Tom Mast** and sideline report **Cierra Clark**.

BEARS MOVE UP TO FBS & CONFERENCE USA

On May 10, 2024 - Missouri State announced it had accepted an invitation to join Conference USA as a full-league member, effective July 1, 2025. The move places Missouri State in the DI Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) for the first time this season. As part of their two-year reclassification cycle, the Bears are eligible for a CUSA regular-season title, but are not eligible to participate in the CUSA Championship game or any Bowl games in 2025. Next season (2026), the Bears will be fully eligible to compete in both the Conference USA Championship Game and bowl games.

The "Group of Five" football status of CUSA gives its league members an elevated presence in the NCAA's governance structure and joins its cohort leagues with representation in the expanded CFP playoff system.

Founded in 1995 and based in Dallas, CUSA's membership is 12 schools in 2025-26.

WEEKDAY CUSA

The 2025 season marks the return of Weekday CUSA after two successful seasons of the mid-week scheduling model as part of Conference USA's new television deal with partners CBS Sports Network and ESPN. Eight of last season's weekday games were decided by single digits and seven games saw more than 60 total points scored, setting the stage for plenty of excitement in this year's 18-game schedule.

CLARK ON CAMPBELL AWARD LIST

The 13th annual Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award Watch List was announced Aug. 20 with Missouri State quarterback **Jacob Clark** included among the list's 102 players from nine different conferences.

The Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award recognizes the top offensive player in Division I football who also exhibits the enduring characteristics that define Earl Campbell: integrity, performance, teamwork, sportsmanship, drive, community and tenacity; specifically, tenacity to persist and determination to overcome adversity and injury in pursuit of reaching goals. In addition, the nominee must meet one or more of the following criteria: Played football at and graduated from a Texas high school and/or currently playing at Texas DI four-year college.

The winner will be announced in December and celebrated at a banquet on Jan. 21.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

Current Missouri State head coach **Ryan Beard** replaced legendary coach **Bobby Petrino** as Missouri State's sideline boss on Dec. 19, 2022. Petrino served as head coach of the Bears the previous three seasons (2020-22).

Upon his promotion from defensive coordinator to head coach in 2023, Beard was able to retain 8 of the 10 assistant coaches from the previous staff, including Offensive Coordinator **Nick Petrino** and Defensive Line Coach **LD Scott** (now the team's Defensive Coordinator) -- both brothers-in-law to Beard.

Ryan is married to the former Katie Petrino (Bobby's daughter), and L.D. Scott is married to the former Kelsey Petrino (also Bobby's daughter). Nick Petrino is (obviously) Bobby's son and Katie and Kelsey's brother.

Bobby Petrino is currently the offensive coordinator at Arkansas (just 150 miles from Springfield).

NATIONAL QB OF WEEK FOR CLARK

QB **Jacob Clark** (Rockwall, Texas) earned the *Manning Award National QB of the Week* on Sept. 10 after helping the Bears overcome a 13-point second-half Marshall to secure their first FBS win. Clark completed 21-of-31 passes for **359** yards and 3 touchdowns, eclipsed 5,000 career passing yards and reached 40 career TD passes in the game. He also passed for 300 yards for the 9th time in 18 career starts.



TURNING IT ON

Missouri State's home opener against SMU on Sept. 13 (CBS Sports Network) was the Bears first national broadcast from Plaster Stadium since an ABC Regional telecast on Oct. 3, 1981 vs. SEMO as the Division II game of the week.

CENTER OF ATTENTION

Bears' starting center **Cash Hudson** booked 17 starts over the previous two seasons and anchors a veteran-led offensive line this season. Hudson was named to several preseason All-CUSA teams, including the official CUSA Preseason Watch List. A year ago, he finished with a 96-percent assignment grade, 92 percent effort grade and 88 percent technique grade to earn All-MVFC honors. He was also a Phil Steele Freshman All-American in 2023.

Hudson is one of four returning starters on MSU's O-Line along with **Erick Cade**, **Mark Hutchinson** and (injured) **Hutson Lillibridge**.

DEEP DIVE INTO CLARK'S IMPACT

In 2024, MoState QB **Jacob Clark** averaged 7.9 yards per play in total offense, the most by any Bear in nearly 40 years. QB Tom Leeker averaged 8.3 yards per play in 1985 for an MSU club that went 6-4-1.

YOUNG EARNS CUSA POW HONOR

LB **Kanye Young** (Menifee, Calif.) was named *CUSA Defensive Player of the Week* on Sept. 8 after pacing a feisty Missouri State defense in the club's win at Marshall. He posted a team-high 7 total tackles, including 3 solos, 2 QB hurries, a tackle for loss, and a game-clinching interception on Marshall's final drive of the game. Missouri State held Marshall to just **274** yards of total offense and **12** first downs on the night.

ASKREN IS CUSA'S TOP FROSH

TE **Jeron Askren** (Wichita, Kan.) scored the game-winning touchdown to complete MSU's 4th-quarter comeback at Marshall. His 8-yard TD grab from Jacob Clark with 2:12 to play sealed MSU's first victory as an FBS program and earned him *CUSA Freshman of the Week* honors.

BEARD HONORED BY CBS SPORTS

Head coach **Ryan Beard** was named the CUSA Coach of the Week by @CBSSports pundit Matt Zenitz on Sept. 8 after Missouri State earned the program's first-ever win as an FBS program with a come-from-behind win at Marshall on Sept. 6.

WR Jmariyae Robinson needs 7 pass receptions to become the 17th Bear to eclipse 100 career catches. His 1,256 career receiving yards currently ranks 19th on MSU's career list. He also has at least one pass reception in 26 consecutive games, dating back to 9/1/23.

BEAR-NATION MOVEMENT

Missouri State's 2025 roster includes players from 26 states, including 25 from the Show-Me State (Missouri), 18 from Texas, 13 from Florida and five apiece from California, Illinois and Kansas.

BEARD NO. 29 ON ESPN LIST

ESPN ranks head coach Ryan Beard 29th on its list of all college football head coaches as players. Beard was a star defensive back at Bowling Green (Ky.) High School before going to Western Kentucky. He twice earned All-Sun Belt honors with the Hilltoppers, and made the Sun Belt's All-Freshman Team (2008), when he started 10 games and led the team with 3 interceptions. Beard had a career-high 71 tackles as a junior and logged 51 total stops during his senior season.

GARDNER SHINES IN DEBUT

Tristian Gardner's 33-yard touchdown reception from Jacob Clark in the second quarter of the season opener at USC on Aug. 30 made him the first Missouri State freshman to snag a TD pass in his collegiate debut since DJ Frost did so at Northern Arizona (8/29/19).

HUTCH IN THE CLUTCH

Starting guard Mark Hutchinson (Hayward, Calif.) played a huge role in Missouri State's Sept. 6 win at Marshall, playing all 70 plays and getting stellar coaching staff grades: 94% assignment, 90% effort, 86% technique. His hustle to block the safety downfield on Ramone Green's late-game 55-yard pass reception sprung him free and ultimately set up the winning TD.

SPECIAL TEAMS ARE SPECIALTY

In 2024, the Bears ranked in the FCS top 20 in four special teams categories: 9th in kickoff return defense (9.1), 18th in kickoff return average (23.63), 19th in net punting (43.83), and 19th in punt return defense (5.08).

HEAD COACH RYAN BEARD

3rd Season



Missouri State University officially presented Ryan Beard as its new head football coach on Dec. 19, 2022. At the time of his hire, Beard (34) was the program's youngest coach on record and was the 22nd person to hold the football

Bears' top coaching position.

His elevation to head coach came on the heels of three seasons as Missouri State's defensive coordinator (2020-22) under former head coach Bobby Petrino.

Last season (2024), the Bears' final campaign at the FCS level, Beard guided MoState to an 8-4 overall record and No. 23 national ranking with 12 all-conference standouts and three All-Americans in his camp. Quarterback Jacob Clark finished 14th in the Walter Payton FCS Player of the Year voting, while running back Jacardia Wright signed an undrafted free agent contract with the Seahawks after the season. The Bears reeled off eight straight wins from Sept. 14 to Nov. 9, the squad's longest since a stretch from 1988-89.

The Bears finished 6-2 in Valley play to tie for fourth place and match the team record for conference victories (1978, 2021), including MSU's first 6-0 start in conference play since 1978. Likewise, the Bears started 8-2 overall for the first time since 1990 and reached eight overall wins for the ninth time in program history -- first since the 2021 NCAA playoff team. Likewise, MSU's four-game road win streak was its first since a split-season stretch from 1996-97.

Beard's 2024 squad boasted one of the nation's most efficient offensive attacks, racking up 306.2 yards per game through the air (5th), 424.8 total yards per game (17th) and 34.8 points per outing (13th), all of which ranked in the top 20 nationally.

In his inaugural coaching season (2023), Beard guided the Bears to a 4-7 overall record and a 3-5 ledger in the Missouri Valley Football Conference. The team's strong November surge included a 35-16 home win over No. 18-ranked Northern Iowa. The Bears finished No. 5 in the nation in passing offense (300.3), No. 7 in pass efficiency (158.77), 26th in total offense (400.8) and 31st in scoring (29.8).

Missouri State was rewarded with seven All-MVFC selections in Beard's first campaign, including first-teamers Grant Burkett (P) and Raylen Sharpe (WR). Sharpe finished fourth in the MVFC Offen-



sive Player of the Year voting. Likewise, Burkett (second team) and Sharpe (third team) were named to the Associated Press FCS All-America Team, while the Bears also boasted three Phil Steele Freshman All-America honorees, including first-teamers Cash Hudson (OL) and Avery Powell (CB).

At the end of the 2023 season, Beard was named to the American Football Coaches Association's exclusive 35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute.

During his three seasons as MSU's defensive coordinator, Beard played a significant role in the team's resurgence, managing a defensive unit that boasted 18 all-conference selections, four All-Americans and three professional players in his tenure at MoState.

In his first campaign in Springfield in 2020-21, Beard and his defensive unit broke the program record for sacks with 27, created 15 turnovers, and held every Missouri Valley Football Conference foe under 30 points for the first time since 1989. His inaugural season on the MSU staff culminated in five all-conference selections, while the Bears captured a share of the Valley championship and earned an NCAA FCS playoff berth for the first time in 30 years.

As an encore effort in 2021, Beard's second year with the program saw the Bears top the club sack record again (30) while racking up 25 takeaways and securing 15 interceptions. In addition to making a second straight NCAA playoff appearance

in 2021, MSU finished in sole possession of second place in the rugged Missouri Valley Football Conference, ranked ninth nationally in turnovers gained and finished 14th in interceptions per game. The 2021 Bears also boasted five all-conference players on the defensive side of the ball, including safeties Kyriq McDonald and Titus Wall. Wall had immediate success with the Calgary Stampeders of the Canadian Football League, while Bears' defensive lineman Eric Johnson was drafted by the Indianapolis Colts in the fifth round of the 2022 NFL Draft.

The 2022 Bears defense gave up just 15.8 points per game over their last four games with defensive end Kevin Ellis leading the nation in fumble recoveries. Four MSU defenders earned all-conference laurels, including McDonald, three-time captain Kevin Ellis and five-time All-MVFC pick Montrae Braswell who signed a free agent deal with the Kansas City Chiefs.

Before coming to Missouri State, Beard spent the 2019 season at Central Michigan University as the special teams and safeties coach for head coach Jim McElwain. He joined the Central Michigan staff in February of 2019 and helped lead the Chippewas to an 8-6 campaign on a defensive secondary that created 13 interceptions.

Beard served as an assistant at Louisville during the 2017 and 2018 seasons, starting as the defensive backs coach and in quality control before moving on to become the Cardinals' linebackers coach and their co-special teams coordinator. Among those who Beard coached at Louisville are Jaire Alexander, who was selected by the Green Bay Packers in the first round of the NFL draft; 2014 Jim Thorpe Award winner



Gerod Holliman; and James Sample, a former member of the Jacksonville Jaguars.

As the defensive backs coach at Western Kentucky in 2016, Beard helped lead the Hilltoppers to the Conference USA championship and a win in the Boca Raton Bowl.

Beard was a standout defensive back at Western Kentucky himself from 2007-11. He was a two-time All-Sun Belt Conference selection and was named to the league's All-Freshman squad and its All-Academic team. In 2011, he earned the Western Kentucky Iron Man Award.

A native of Bowling Green, Ky., Beard was a four-year letterman at Bowling

Green High for coach Kevin Wallace, where his efforts helped the Purples advance to the 3A state championship contest in each of his last two years.

Beard holds two degrees from Western Kentucky: a bachelor of science in Business Management (2012), and a master of science in Recreation and Sport Administration (2014).

He is married to the former Katie Petriño. The couple have four children with son Beau and daughter Lainey, in addition to twins Jacob and Kailey born in the spring of 2022.

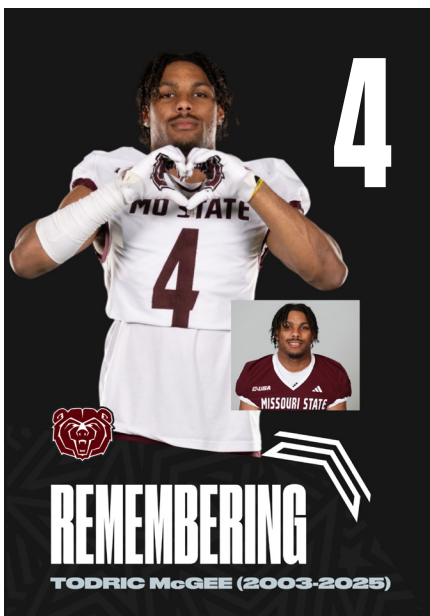
