ENTRY INFORMATION

All entries must be completed via Direct Athletics.

Entries open: Tuesday, May 5, 2026, 9am.

Entries close: Monday, May 11, 2026, 11:59pm.

Entry fees are \$40 per person per event, no team cap. Entry fees will be collected via Direct Athletics. Please note, this is an entry fee, not an acceptance fee.

TIMING

FACILITY

1. 400-meter Beynon rubber track, 8 lanes.
2. 8 dash and 8 hurdle lanes, both directions, either side.
3. Beynon 2000 Hobart approaches for PV, HJ, LJ, TJ.
4. TJ boards: Women: 28' & 32'6", Men: 36' & 40'.
5. 1/4" pyramid spikes maximum for all events except high jump and javelin.
6. Concrete circles for shot put (2), discus (2), and hammer (1).

FIELD EVENTS

- *Projected starting heights & progressions:* the goal for HJ and PV height progressions is to hit the height most likely to qualify to the DIII NCAA, based on TFRRS to date.
- Throwing implements to be weighed prior to the competition for all events, 3pm-4pm.
- 9 college athletes to the finals in the throws and horizontal jumps. *All unattached athletes in all events are exhibition and not eligible for advancement to finals.
- For inclement weather, our facility has the ability to run PV and HJ indoor in a full setup, the same as our indoor home meets.

UNATTACHED ATHLETES

The only unattached athletes who will be accepted to the meet are pacers, or college-age and older unattached athletes already at or better than the marks required to qualify to the NCAA Final (DIII) or First Round (DI). High school runners may not compete. Unattached athletes must request entry, receive an invitation, and pay via Direct Athletics. Name and projected events/performances with verification or qualifying information must be included in email. Coaches may enter unattached pacers directly to Julie. *Unattached athletes are exhibition only and not eligible for finals in any event.

WARM UP AREAS

The infield must remain clear of all student-athletes, coaches and spectators at all times, except those actively warming up in designated area, or competing in or coaching a field event at those event times only. Team gathering areas and cheering may not be set up on the infield. The Morrison indoor track at Johnson Athletic Center will be open before and during the competition for team areas and warmups. The stands and perimeter grass are all available team areas.

APPROVED SHOES

The 2026 MIT Final Qualifier is an approved World Rankings Competition on the calendar. If an athlete wishes to have his/her performance count toward the World Rankings, a completed shoe declaration form must be submitted to the clerking team along with visual verification of the shoes listed on the form. We will also spot/random check shoes after races, as required by this stipulation.

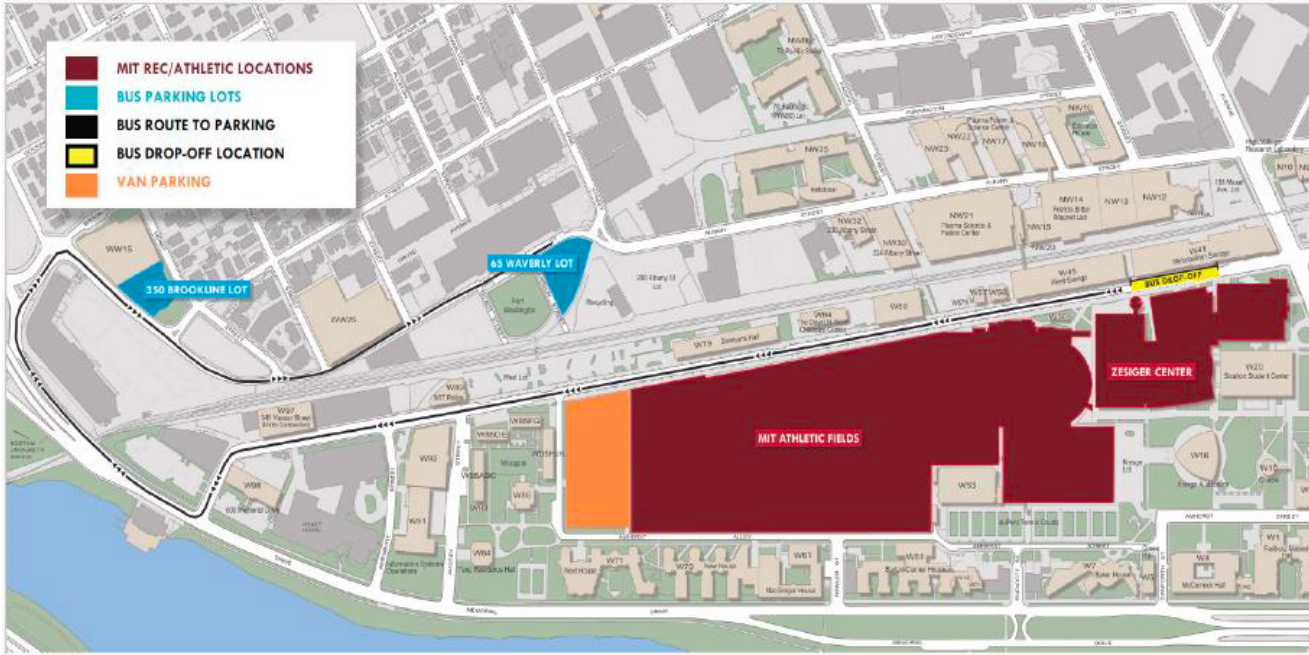
