# VISITING ATHLETIC TRAINING

On behalf of the Missouri Baptist Sports Medicine Staff, we would like to welcome you and your athletic team to Missouri Baptist University (MBU) and St. Louis. We look forward to an enjoyable and injury free contest.

The athletic training room is located on the lower level of the Carl and Deloris Petty Sports and Recreation Complex (room 102). The athletic training room will be open approximately two hours prior to game time. We offer ice, hydrocollator, whirlpool, ultrasound and electrical stimulation for your use. Please notify the Missouri Baptist Athletic Training Staff if a certified athletic trainer will not be traveling with the team. If your team is not traveling with a certified athletic trainer, we ask that you send treatment instructions and the supplies that will be needed with the student-athletes.

Football games take place at Spartan Field, located at 12575 North Outer 40 Road, adjacent to our main campus. Offsite locations like those for tennis, golf, or bowling do not have an athletic training room available. If your student-athletes need heat or an electrical modality treatment prior the match, we recommend you use the athletic training room that is located on the MBU campus prior to arriving to the location. A certified athletic trainer will be onsite and inform the visiting team where they will be located if assistance is needed during contests.

The following supplies will be present for you during the contest:

Ten gallon cooler with ice and water

Ice

Cups

Biohazard container

Splints and emergency equipment will be available on the home sideline, if needed.

Follow signs for I-70 West. Turn Left to merge onto I-70 West

Continue on I-70 for 3 miles to I-270 South. Take exit 232 to merge onto I-270 south toward Memphis.

Continue 7.6 miles and take exit 12A onto I-64 West, US-70 toward Wentzville.

Continue 1.5 miles, take exit 24 onto Mason Rd.

Stay right and turn onto N. 40 Dr.

Turn left onto College Park Dr. Onto the University Campus for SRC Events

Turn left at 12575 North Outer 40 Road for Spartan Field Events

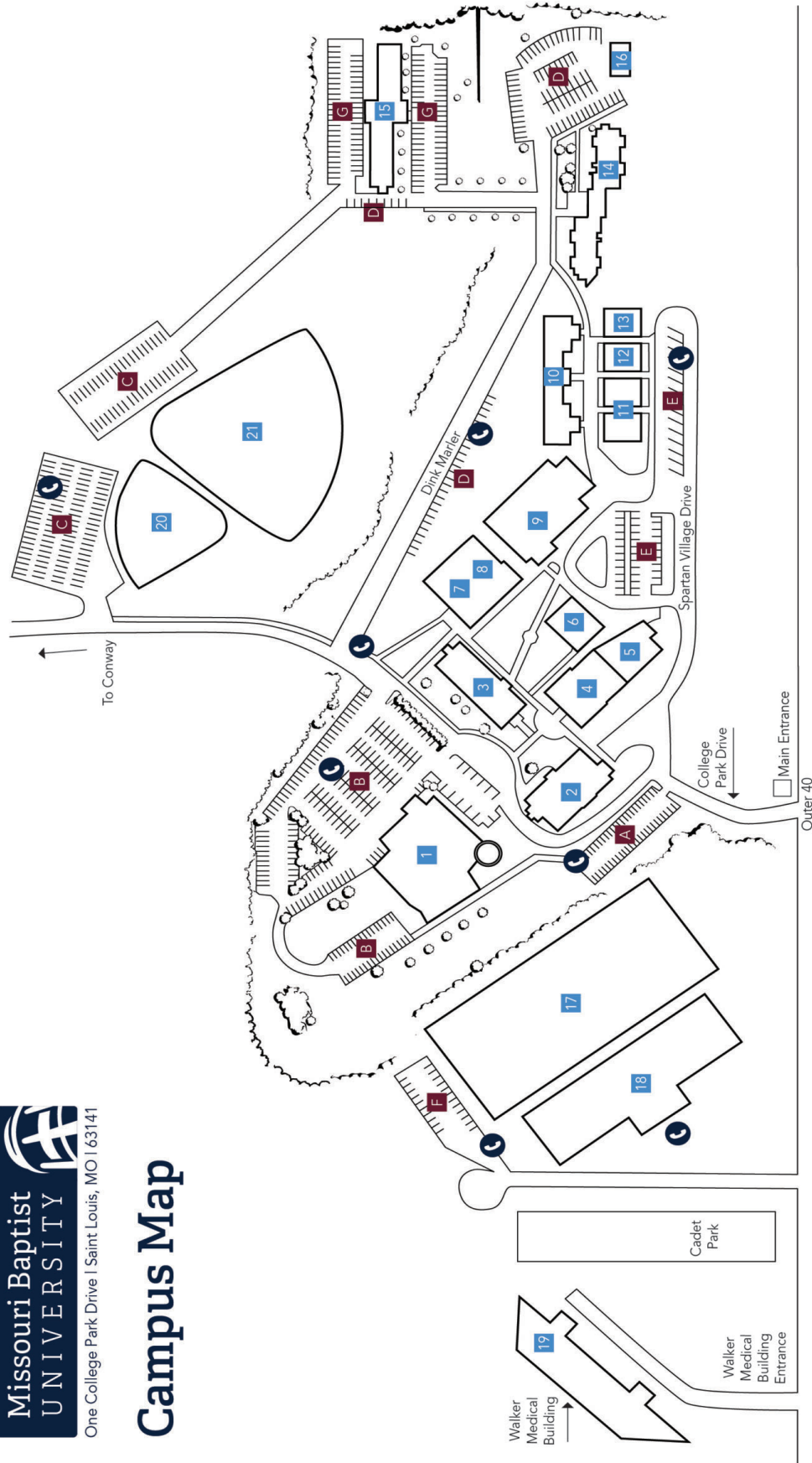

# BUS AND VAN PARKING

## PETTY SRC

The Visiting Team bus will park at the loading dock at the Field Building, the first right as you drive into the campus. Visiting Team vans will park in Lot B. There is a campus map that will assist you with directions to the parking areas. The driver will be required to stay with the vehicle until the conclusion of the game. Teams will be dropped off at the Carl and Delores Petty Sports and Recreation Complex (SRC). There will be event staff available to direct them to their locker rooms.

Visiting Team vans can drop off in front of the Carl and Deloris Petty SRC. Spectator and Visiting Team van parking will be in Lot B. Follow the main road around to the left and up the hill. Lot B is at the top of the hill on the left. Accessibility parking is available in Lot B.

## SPARTAN FIELD

After turning onto the drive of 12575 North Outer 40 Road, the bus will take the second entrance on the right and pull up along the front of Spartan Field where it can unload. The bus will then back up and park along the curb near the trees along the front of the facility. The driver is expected to stay in or near the vehicle until the conclusion of the game.

## SPARTAN BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL FIELDS

The Visiting Team bus should enter through the main entrance to campus and proceed until they reach Lot C. Once there, they can unload outside the baseball and softball fields. Bus parking should then be in the upper section of Lot C, away from the threat of errant foul balls.
