ABOUT LAST WEEK: The Monmouth College football team honored a group of successful seniors on Saturday with a 56-13 Midwest Conference win over Ripon College in the regular-season home finale. The Fighting Scots (7-1, 7-0) scored 49 points in a row as seniors Cody Szclz (Riverview, Florida) and Nate Thornton (Peoria, Illinois) put their names in the record books

EARLY LEAD: Down 6-0 after a muffed punt, the Scots bounced back and responded to take the lead. Brayden Deem (Andalusia, Illinois) got the offense going with a 15-yard pass to Thornton and the two hooked up for 34 more and a touchdown two plays later. Szclz hit the extra point for a 7-6 Monmouth lead.

ADDING ON: Deem found Gabriel Zeigler-Harris (East Peoria, Illinois) for an 11-yard touchdown and a 14-6 lead. Deem alter ran for a 24-yard score and hit Thornton for a 24-yard touchdown pass for a 28-6 lead.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Brant Baltes (Lisbon, Iowa) and Anthony Cikauskas (Oswego, Illinois) had sacks that ended separate Ripon drives. An interception by senior Zane Beebe (Davenport, Iowa) gave Monmouth the ball at the Ripon 48. Deem hit Thornton and Zeigler-Harris for first downs before Nate Wrublik (Lemont, Illinois) scored for a 35-6 lead. After a 3-and-out, Deem found Chase Newman (Morrison, Illinois) for a 35-yard touchdown and a 42-6 lead.

FINAL DEEM SCORE: Deem hit Kessinger for 15 and Thornton for 11 before Angel Duarte (Mt. Sterling, Illinois) ran for nine and into the red zone. Deem found Thornton for a third score on the day, this time from 20 yards out. Szclz drilled his seventh extra-point of the day and 167th for his career, tying the all-time Monmouth record.

RECORD BREAKER: Monmouth got the ball back in the fourth quarter with a 49-13 lead. Senior Ashton Summers (Mt. Zion, Illinois) connected with Jeremiah Williams (Oviedo, Florida) on a jet sweep for 48 yards and Blake Regenold (Downs, Illinois) ran for 12 yards. Summers and Williams hooked up again, this time on a 9-yard touchdown over the middle. Szclz drilled the extra point to set a new career Fighting Scots record with 168 makes in a 56-13 win.

STATTING UP: Deem completed 17-of-27 passes for 337 yards and five touchdowns while also rushing for 24 yards and a touchdown. Wrublik ran for 94 yards and a touchdown while Duarte finished with 53 yards on the ground. Thornton caught seven passes for 154 yards and three touchdowns while Zeigler-Harris caught four passes for 71 yards and a score. Kessinger also tallied 71 receiving yards while both Williams and Newman scored through the air.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: Cikauskas led the Scots with two sacks while Baltes had one and both players tallied 3.5 tackles for loss. Baltes led the Scots with 10 total tackles while Beebe had an interception.

MONMOUTH MOMENTS: Szclz broke Joey Biel's career extra-point record with 168 makes...Szclz is 168-for-180 in his career, a 93.3% success rate...His 234 career points rank third all-time among kickers and seventh for all players...Thornton has 42 career touchdowns in 40 games, one behind Michael Blodgett's career record...His 252 career points ranks sixth in school history...Thornton has a career-high 15 touchdown receptions this season, second on the single-season list and three behind Blodgett's record from 2011...Thornton went over the 800 yard mark, the 13th time that has been done in a single-season in MC history...Thornton's 90 points on the season is tied for 10th on the single-season list...Deem has 20 touchdown passes in the last four games...His 29 TD passes on the season are tied for fifth on the single-season list with Tanner Matlick...His 2062 passing yards are 12th on the single-season list, 14 behind Matlick for 11th...Cikauskas passed Korbyn Personett for fourth on the career sacks list with 27.5 and he also moved past both Greg Bennett and Matt Lerner into fourth on the career tackles for loss list with 47.5...Tevin Baker (Kewanee, Illinois) and Rockyen Spinks (Galesburg, Illinois) moved into a tie for fourth with Nick Harris (Winter Haven, Florida) and Scott Stanton for fourth on the career list with 22 pass break ups...The Scots honored 19 seniors in a pre-game ceremony...The seniors are 33-7 overall with a 31-3 MWC record...Monmouth is 36-1 at home in MWC action under Braun and 40-5 overall at April Zorn...The Red Hawks lead the all-time series 35-30-3 but the Scots have won seven in a row and 11 of the last 12...Monmouth is 18-5 in November under Braun...The Scots are 63-3 under Braun when allowing less than 20 points and 45-0 when scoring at least 40

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT

- Lake Forest College opened as Lind University in 1857 and was renamed in 1865. Hall of Fame Chicago sportswriter Bob Verdi is an alum of Lake Forest.
- Lake Forest College was the home to the Chicago Bears training camp from 1977-97 and the original Halas Hall is still used on campus
- Head coach Jim Catanzaro is in his 16th season as head coach at LFC and 19th season overall with the program. He is the winningest head coach in school history with 97 wins and three MWC Championships. An alum of Greenville University, Catanzaro was all-conference on both sides of the ball while also playing basketball and tennis. He earned a masters from West Virginia University and has coaching stops at Wingate (D2) and Glenville State College
- Lake Forest went 7-3 last year, 6-3 in MWC play. They lost three of their final four games of the season at Ripon (12-0), at Monmouth (16-14) and at home to Chicago (15-14).
- Lake Forest started the season with a 21-7 win over Wisconsin Lutheran before winning at home against defending MWC champions Illinois College 42-35. They won at Cornell 28-19 before beating Knox 42-0 for Homecoming. The Foresters beat Lawrence 54-7 and Grinnell 42-22 on the road before taking care of Ripon 66-0 and Beloit 62-17
- Quarterback Joshua Gasca is a senior but a first-year starter. He has completed 68.5% of his passes on the season for 1741 yards. He has 19 touchdowns and three interceptions while averaging 249.9 ypg. Gasca has rushed for -20 yards and two scores.
- Sixth-Year A.J Jackson leads the ground game with 398 yards on 52 carries and 16 TD. He averages 7.7 ypc and 49.8 ypg. Josiah Kidd has 235 yards on 30 carries while Mal Chunn has five rushing scores.
- Jackson is also the top receiver with 31 catches for 616 yards and five touchdowns on the season. Lanston Metoyer has 26 catches for 435 yards and four scores while Tee Land has 22 catches for 427 yards and five touchdowns. Tommy Carberry also has four receiving touchdowns
- Defensive leaders include Blake Ware with 45 tackles. Jaylen Johnson has 10 TFL and 6.5 sacks to lead the team. Brandon Henderson has four interceptions and Preston Mosher has forced two fumbles

SCOTS/FORESTERS HISTORY: The Scots and Foresters have met 56 times since 1902 with the Scots leading 32-21-2. Lake Forest started 7-2-2 in the series between 1902-13 before the Scots won five in a row. Monmouth won five of eight meetings between 1920-31 and then the series went on a 46-year hiatus. Monmouth won the first game back in 1977 and LFC won games in 1984 and 1985. The teams played six times in the 1990s with Monmouth winning four. The Scots won eight of nine from 2003-11 before LFC won two straight. The Scots won another five in a row 2014-18 before LFC won in 2021 and 2022. Monmouth won last year to end the two-game slide.

LAST TIME VS. FORESTERS (11/4/2023) The Scots jumped out to an early lead at home against LFC when Nate Wrublik scored from 1-yard out half way through the first quarter. Just 42 seconds into the 2nd quarter, a field goal by Alec Hesson made it 10-0. The teams traded turnovers and punts before Jackson Bergren blocked a LFC punt and Michael Lord returned it to the 12 with 1:14 to play in the half. Nate Thornton scored two plays later but MC missed the extra point to lead 16-0 at half. After a series of punts, LFC scored on a 71-yard pass play with 2:06 left in the 3rd. They scored again with 8:09 to play to pull within 16-14 and the Scots punter. Rockyen Spinks intercepted a pass with 4:40 to play but MC couldn't run out the clock and had to punt. Nick Harris picked off a pass with 1:30 to play but again the Scots couldn't get a first down. The Foresters blocked a punt and recovered on the MC 14 with 29 seconds left. With no timeouts, the elected to kick on first down but Tevin Baker blocked the FG to preserve a 16-14 Monmouth win.

CHAD BRAUN

Head Coach • 10th Year as Monmouth HC
24th Year Coaching • 10th Year as Head Coach

CHAD BRAUN became the 31st head coach in Monmouth football history in 2015 after serving as the defensive coordinator for 15 seasons. Braun didn't wait long to earn a conference title, winning the Midwest Conference crown in just his second season, the same year the Scots claimed their fourth Gagliardi Trophy finalist. His team repeated as MWC champions in 2017, earning their first back-to-back titles since Braun's assistant days in 2008 and 2009. Another league title came the Scots' way in 2019, the same year Braun earned his fifth straight Coach of the Year honor from the Midwest Conference. The 2020 season was cancelled by COVID. The Scots finished second in the MWC in 2021, shared a MWC crown in 2022 and won the inaugural Lakefront Bowl. In 2023 the Scots tied for first place but lost the tiebreaker, again winning the Lakefront Bowl.

Braun continues to direct the defense as head coach, a defense which led the nation in scoring defense in 2016 and 2018. The 2016 squad coupled with the offense which laid claim to the nation's top individual pass efficiency rating to win their fifth league crown with Braun on the coaching staff. The team repeated as league champions in 2017, giving Braun two league titles in three years, making him a multiple league champion faster than any coach in Scots' football history.

Under Braun's direction, the Scots' defensive units have been known as a swarming, hard-hitting group. During his tenure both as head coach and prior as an assistant, the defense has rewritten Monmouth's modern-era record book and been among the nation's leaders in numerous categories, including scoring defense, turnover margin, interceptions, pass defense efficiency and total defense.

Braun's teams have won four conference titles, produced nine All-Americans and he has won five Midwest Conference Coach of the Year awards.

Coach Braun is also the winningest men's tennis coach in Monmouth history. He coached the men's tennis team from 2004-14 and posted a record of 139-112 for a .553 win percentage. Braun coached five MWC singles champions and three doubles champions and was in charge for both 20+ win seasons in school history. The 2006 team won a school-record 22 matches and Braun was named the 2011 Midwest Conference Coach of the Year.

Joe Freitag '07: Offensive Coordinator/O-Line

The first assistant hired when Chad Braun took the reins in 2015, Joe Freitag enters his 10th year and as the offensive coordinator and offensive line coach. His offense turned in memorable seasons during their back-to-back league championships in 2016 and 2017. While rolling up more than 500 yards of offense per game in 2016, the team produced the national leader for individual pass efficiency. Under Freitag's tutelage in 2017, converted defensive lineman Joe Krall earned MWC Offensive Lineman of the Year honor and was named All-Region by D3football.com, repeating the latter honor in 2018. Current center Derek Brown was MWC Offensive Line MVP in 2022 while also earning D3football.com All-Region honors and he is a 2023 D3football.com preseason All-American.

A native of Springfield, Illinois, Freitag played for Hall of Fame coach Ken Leonard at Sacred-Heart Griffin High School. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Coe College in 2007. After earning his masters from Coe, Freitag spent two years at Augsburg College in Minnesota as the offensive line and special teams coach. From there he went to Benedictine as the offensive coordinator before returning to Monmouth for the 2015 season to work under Coach Braun.

Freitag earned a degree in history from Monmouth in 2007 and a master's from Coe two years later. He resides in Monmouth with his wife Amy, also a 2007 Monmouth graduate, and their children Ella and Graham.



Jack Healy - Quarterbacks Coach

Jack Healy joined Monmouth in February 2021 as a wide receivers coach and he switched to quarterbacks coach for the 2023 season. Prior to coaching the Fighting Scots, Healy was a graduate assistant wide receivers coach at Elmhurst College.

A native of Glenview, Illinois, Healy played college football at Illinois Wesleyan while earning a bachelors degree in Business Management. With the Titans he was a three-time CCIW All-Conference Selection. He was a co-captain as a senior in 2019. As a junior, Healy was CCIW Player of the Week after hauling in 12 catches for 203 yards and three touchdowns against Augustana on September 24.

Healy finished his career with 159 catches in 33 games for a 4.8 receptions per game average, top 20 in IWU history. He also ranks in the top 20 with 25 touchdown catches and he finished his career with 2,337 receiving yards. Healy had six games with at least 100 yards receiving, six games with at least two scores and four games with at least 10 catches.

He was also an All-Conference selection in the Central Suburban League at Glenbrook South High School in 2015 and an All-Area selection.



Cooper Gosch - Defensive Line Coach

Cooper Gosch joined the Scots as the Defensive Line coach in July 2022. Prior to his time at Monmouth he coached at William Penn, Nebraska Wesleyan and Westminster.

At Westminster, Gosch was the linebackers coach and he coached defensive line and special teams at Nebraska Wesleyan. At William Penn, his alma mater, Gosch coached the defensive line and linebackers.

Gosch played on the defensive line at William Penn while earning a bachelor's degree in sports management. He also earned a masters in sports management at William Penn.

A native of Branson West, Missouri, Gosch graduated from Reeds Spring High School.



Nate Graham '21 - Wide Receivers Coach

After a stellar MC career, Nate Graham joined the program in August 2023. Prior to joining the Scots, Graham was an assistant coach (WR/DB) at Argenta-Oreana High School (IL), in 2022.

A 2021 Monmouth graduate with a degree in physical education and a minor in global health, Graham played for the Fighting Scots from 2017-21 as a four-year varsity letter award winner. In 39 games he hauled in 92 passes for 1,091 yards while scoring 11 touchdowns. Graham also excelled as a returner, finishing with 891 kick return yards and 280 punt return yards in his career for 2,332 all-purpose yards. He ranks top 5 in Scots history in both punt and kick return yards.

A native of Monticello, Illinois, Graham led the Monticello Sages to a 12-1 record and a semifinal appearance in the 2016 IHSA 3A Playoffs. His younger brother Devin was a Monmouth teammate during the 2021 season.



Caleb Kizewski - Linebackers Coach

Caleb Kizewski joined the Fighting Scots football team for the 2024 season as a linebackers coach. Before coming to Monmouth, Kizewski coached two seasons at Emporia State (D-II) in Kansas as a graduate assistant. He coached the offensive line in 2022 and then served as the special teams coach and assistant linebackers coach for the 2023 season. Kizewski coached at Division III Rose-Hulman in Indiana for the 2021 season as a running backs coach.

Kizewski played at New Mexico Highlands, a Division II program in Las Vegas, New Mexico. He was a tight end for the Cowboys while also making the Dean's List. Kizewski graduated from New Mexico Highlands in 2021 with a degree in human performance and sport. He then earned a masters in health, physical education and recreation from Emporia State in 2024.



Phil Pullen '04 - Special Teams Coach

Phil Pullen, a former Fighting Scots punter, debuted on the Monmouth coaching staff in the fall of 2018. Under Pullen's guidance, the Scots produced their first All-Region punter since 2013 when Joey Biel was named to the D3football.com third team. Addison Fletcher also earned All-Region from D3football.com in 2021.

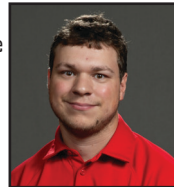

Andy Davis - Volunteer Running Backs Coach

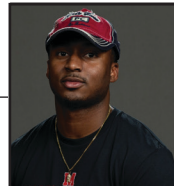
This is the second season as a volunteer running backs coach for Andy Davis. He previously worked at Monmouth College on the security staff.
