A MONMOUTH WIN WOULD...

- » mark Monmouth's 18th win of the season
- » be the 179th win of King Rice's career, passing Dave Calloway for second all-time in program history and the most in Division I history at Monmouth
- » be the Hawks eighth win at home this season
- » be the Hawks eighth win in the last 11 games
- » move the Hawks four games over .500 in MAAC play at 10-6
- » make Monmouth the second MAAC team to 18 overall victories (Iona)
- » give MU the 1-0 season series lead over Siena
- » make Monmouth 5-2 in February
- » be MU's 13th win all time against the Saints
- » snap a four-game losing streak to Siena
- » lock up at least a .500 record in MAAC play for the fourth straight year and seventh of eight

NOTES FROM THE LAST TIME OUT...

- » King Rice picked up his 178th career win, tying the program record for Division I wins by a head coach with Dave Calloway. He is tied with Calloway for second in the program's all-time history behind Bill Boylan (364 wins).
- » Nikkei Rutty's 13 rebounds marked his sixth double-digit rebounding contest of the season and 12th game with eight or more boards this year.
- » Myles Foster posted his fifth career double-figure game with 10 points.
- » Foster tied his career best with eight rebounds, set earlier this year at St. John's.
- » Monmouth has now won three in a row over Rider.
- » Seven turnovers is MU's second lowest in a game this season.
- » Shavar Reynolds led MU with 17 points in his first game back after missing the last two.
- » MU won on the glass, 45-39.
- » The Hawks had 17 offensive rebounds for the second straight game, their season best.
- » MU limited Rider to just 20% from three (3-15).
- » Monmouth was better in the paint, 26-20.
- » The game featured five ties and 10 lead changes.

JOINING THE CAA

Monmouth University accepted an invitation to join the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA), effective July 1, 2022. Monmouth will compete in the CAA in all sports except women's bowling, which will remain a member of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC). The Hawks will compete in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) for the remainder of the 2021-22 season.

RICE APPROACHING A MILESTONE

King Rice enters today's game with 178 career wins, all of them coming at Monmouth. A win today would make the program's all-time winningest coach at the Division I level, and place him second all-time in the history of the program behind only Bill Boylan, the first ever coach that won 364 times. He is currently tied with Monmouth Hall of Famer Dave Calloway for the most Division I wins at MU in program history.

REYNOLDS RETURNS

Shavar Reynolds returned from a two-game injury absence against Rider and was effective in leading Monmouth in scoring with 17 points, going 7-8 from the foul line. Reynolds netted the eventual game-winning points on a drive to the rim with 24 seconds remaining.

VAUGHAN'S BEST GAME

Monmouth's Jarvis Vaughan comes off his best collegiate game statistically at Iona, where he scored in double figures for the first time. He netted 11 points, including his first contest with multiple three-pointers, and was 4-4 from the field and 2-2 from downtown in addition to converting a late three-point play.

ROAD WARRIORS

Monmouth is leading the nation in road victories with 10 true road wins, tied only with Chattanooga who also has 10. MU has won 10 times outside of West Long Branch, including five in conference play. MU has won 10 of its 14 road contests this season. The 2015-16 Hawks led the nation in road and road/neutral wins, finishing with 13 true road wins and 17 away from home.

200 TRIPLES FOR PAPAS

With three made triples at Manhattan, George Papas reached the 200-made threes mark for his career, the seventh Hawk in program history to do so. He is one shy of John Giraldo in sixth, and 11 shy of Dwayne Byfield in fifth.

SWIPING IT

George Papas grabbed six steals at Manhattan, a career high and the most since Justin Robinson set the program record with eight in the 2016 MAAC quarterfinal.

MAAC SWEEPS

Monmouth has completed a series sweep of three MAAC opponents already, collecting two wins against each of Fairfield, Canisius and Manhattan. MU will have a chance later this season to sweep Quinnipiac and Rider, and have yet to play Siena.

HITTING 1,000

George Papas became the 26th player in the program’s Division I history to reach 1,000 career points against Marist, doing so on a three-shot foul in the second half. He becomes the only player on the current roster to reach the mark, and the first since Deion Hammond to accomplish it. Seven players have reached 1,000 under King Rice (Ed Waite, Andrew Nicholas, Deon Jones, Micah Seaborn, Justin Robinson, Ray Salnave, Deion Hammond). The last Hawk to reach 1K was Ray Salnave, with Hammond preceding him.

A MAGICAL NIGHT FOR MARCUS MCCLARY

Marcus McClary broke the program’s record for all-time games played against Fairfield with his 137th appearance after starting the game.. He passed former teammate Diago Quinn for the most games played in school history and has missed just one career game, a contest vs. Rider in 2020. He capped the historic night by banking in a three-pointer with 0.6 seconds remaining to win the game.

MYLES AND MYLES

Monmouth sophomores Myles Foster and Myles Ruth combined for 21 points off the bench in the win at Manhattan. Foster was a perfect 5-5 from the field.

PAPAS EARNS SPOT ON PRESTIGIOUS LIST

George Papas was named to the Lou Henson Award Watch List, awarded to the National Mid-Major Player of the Year. Papas is the second ever Hawk to earn a spot on the list, joining program all-time leading scorer Justin Robinson, who won it in 2017. Papas is one of two MAAC players on the list (Nelly Jr Joseph- Iona) and one of just two players from the state of NJ (Jaelin Llewellyn - Princeton).

LAST TIME OUT

Monmouth topped Rider in a tight contest, 60-58 on Friday.

HEAD COACH KING RICE

North Carolina, 1992 | | 11th Season | | 178-163 Overall | | 103-66 MAAC



King Rice has been on the Monmouth sideline for 10 seasons and enters his 11th in 2021-22. He has a trio of MAAC Coach of the Year honors to his credit. He has set Monmouth records for wins in a season with 28 and consecutive victories with 17. Rice also set a MAAC Record in 2016-17 by winning 18 league games for the first time ever. He has also won the JohnMcLendon National Coach of the Year honor, while being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award.

Rice led MU through a pandemic-altered season to win a third MAAC regular season title in six years, leading the MAAC in wins with 12. He mentored the program's top three-point shooter ever in Deion Hammond to First Team honors, while George Papas and Melik Martin also earned All-MAAC accolades.

The 2019-20 season saw Rice lead the Hawks to an 18-win campaign, tied for the third most in a season in his tenure. He had his third player ever named to the All-MAAC First Team in junior guard Deion Hammond, who finished second in the league in scoring, while backcourt mate Ray Salmave was a Second Team selection. Hammond and Salmave both reached the 1,000 career point plateau in their third seasons. MU finished non-league play over .500 in a slate that included wins over Princeton, Albany, Lehigh and eventual Big South regular season champion

Radford, and eventually tied for third in the conference and secured a first-round tournament bye for the fourth time in six seasons.

Rice orchestrated a momentous turnaround in 2018-19, leading the Hawks to the conference finals while beating three teams in the MAAC Tournament that MU had not yet topped during the regular season. He tutored senior big man Diago Quinn into All-MAAC Third Team honors, while the New York City native graduated as the program's all-time games played leader.

Rice coached a pair of players to All-Conference honors in 2017-18, including four-year guard Austin Tilghman, who was named to the Third Team and also became the first guard in school history to register a triple-double, doing so at Yale on December 22. He also mentored Deion Hammond to unanimous All-Rookie Team accolades, with the guard averaging 12 points per contest.

In eight years in West Long Branch, Rice has now graduated 26 seniors. Following the 2016-17 year, Monmouth men's basketball was one of 35 programs recognized across the nation in men's hoops for its multiyear Academic Progress Rate (APR) and received the NCAA's APR Public Recognition Award. Monmouth was the only school in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference as well as one of just three teams in the state of New Jersey. Rice's team has earned this recognition in three straight seasons.

With his second straight conference Coach of the Year honor in 2016-17, Rice became just the third coach in MAAC history to repeat and the second to do it outright, joining former Iona coach Tim Welsh and ex-LaSalle head man Speedy Morris. Rice secured a second consecutive regular season title and the top seed in the MAAC Tournament, coaching the Hawks to a National Invitation Tournament for the second time. He also earned his second straight NABC District I Coach of the Year accolade, the first MU coach to do so.

Rice mentored Justin Robinson to a second straight MAAC Player of the Year and third All-MAAC First Team, as well as being named the Lou Henson National Mid-Major Player of the Year. Robinson graduated as the school's all-time leading scorer at the Division I level and became the second 2,000-point scorer in MU history. He also coached his second MAAC Sixth Man of the Year in three years in guard Austin Tilghman, and a second straight all-league selection for Micah Seaborn, who was named First Team. MU won 17 straight games, including 16 straight to end the regular season, not losing after January 2. He secured a comeback win at Memphis in December, as well as a win over eventual Ivy champion Princeton at home.

In 2015-16, leading the Hawks to a program best 28 wins and a top seed in the National Invitation Tournament, as well as wins over five high-major programs. He coached the Hawks to the MAAC regular season title with a 17-3 league mark, collecting MAAC Coach of the Year honors in addition to being named John McLendon National Coach of the Year. Rice picked up ECAC and NABC District I Coach of the Year accolades as well, while being named a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award.

Rice posted 17 league victories, including an 11-2 mark at home and a nation-leading 13 road tallies and 17 wins away from home, including neutral site wins. He secured Monmouth's first regular season title in 11 years and the top seed in the conference tournament while knocking off the program's first-ever ranked opponent in No. 17 Notre Dame on Thanksgiving night as well as wins at UCLA, Georgetown and Rutgers and a neutral site victory over Southern California. The Blue and White also notched its first national postseason win since 2006 and the first ever at home, topping Bucknell in the opening round of the NIT.

In his fifth season in West Long Branch, Rice mentored MAAC Player of the Year Justin Robinson and league Rookie of the Year Micah Seaborn, both of whom were all-conference selections along with senior Deon Jones. Robinson earned multiple national awards while setting the single-season scoring record under Rice's tutelage.

Following the 2015-16 campaign, Rice was rewarded with a contract extension, which extended his contract to 2020-21.

Rice, who was named a finalist for the 2015 Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award, led the Hawks to an 18-15 overall record in 2014-15 and a 13-7 mark in Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference action, which resulted in the No. 4 seed in the league postseason. The Hawks, who advanced to the conference semifinals in just their second season in the league, put a pair of guards on all-conference teams and held 26 of their opponents to 70 points or less.

In 2014-15, the Hawks placed guard Justin Robinson on the All-MAAC First Team and the NABC All-District Second Team and guard Deon Jones on the All-MAAC Third Team, while senior guard Andrew Nicholas was honored as the league's Sixth Man of the Year.

Rice, whose roster featured nine first-year players and no seniors in 2013-14, guided the Hawks into their first season in the MAAC, where the Blue & White claimed the No. 9 seed in the league's postseason. In his first two seasons in the league, Monmouth outperformed its preseason coaches poll prognostication, as the Hawks were selected sixth prior to 2014-15 and finished the regular season in a tie for third place, with eventual tournament champion Manhattan.

In 2013-14, paced by one of the highest scoring duos in program history in Jones and Nicholas, the Hawks posted an 11-21 overall record, which included the championship trophy in the regional pod of the Barclays Center Classic, and the team's highest scoring average in 13 years.

The Hawks started the 2012-13 campaign with a 5-3 record before finishing their final season in the Northeast Conference with an overall mark of 10-21 and 5-13 in league play. Monmouth, which ranked near the top of the league in steals and turnover margin, capped its season with forward Ed Waite scoring his 1,000th career point and guard Jesse Steele writing his name all over the record books in just two and a half seasons.

In his first season with the Blue and White, Rice made an immediate impact on the program, leading the Hawks to a fifth place tie in the league standings. The Hawks finished 12-20 overall, but finished the year winners of nine of their last 12 games to claim a 10-8 league mark and grab the No. 6 seed in the conference postseason.

THE OCEANFIRST BANK CENTER

Prior to the 2016-17 season, the arena formerly known as The MAC was renamed the OceanFirst Bank Center thanks to a naming rights deal with OceanFirst Bank. MU Basketball enters its eighth season in the building after playing previously in Boylan Gymnasium. Monmouth University ushered in a new era in the school's history with the completion and opening of the long anticipated arena in the Fall of 2009. It not only serves the school's 23 Division I Athletics programs, but is also a key asset for the entire University community. The facility features classroom and seminar space and a conference center that can be used for meetings, or be partitioned and used for study hall, clinics or workshops. The gym, which features a state-of-the-art fitness center, is also the location of the Leon Hess Champions' Hall, Monmouth Athletics Hall of Fame and Varsity Club, which will be used for hospitality for Blue/White Club members. Student lounges and study areas with complete wireless Internet access are also available.

The OceanFirst Bank Center, which is connected to Boylan Gym and the Steadman Natatorium, is 153,200 square feet of space for students and the community to utilize in many different capacities. It's most prominent feature is the 4,000 seat arena, which is the nest for the Monmouth men's and women's basketball programs. The arena also features a six-lane, 200-meter indoor track, which can be used for training and competition all year long. A fitness center with state-of-the-art strength and cardiovascular equipment is also housed here.

The arena provides varsity athletes & coaches with meeting facilities, locker rooms, practice and competition facilities & expanded and upgraded amenities. The University Bookstore was also relocated from the Stafford Student Center, which will improve accessibility for commuting students, and the additional square footage will enable the stocking of a greater variety of merchandise.

In the summer of 2011, with funds raised through private donations, Monmouth's varsity athletics weight room was given a \$200,000 overhaul.

Renovations, which began in June and were funded entirely by the generous donations of Monmouth supporters, included a brand new Mondo floor, replaced HVAC system, new lights and a fresh paint job. The aesthetics of the room were improved with MU branded wall decorations.

A member of the Monmouth Athletics Communications staff will escort Monmouth head coach King Rice and requested players to the media room in the OceanFirst Bank Center. The opposing coach and players (if requested) will also be brought to the media room after Coach Rice.

Media Credentials: Arrangements for media credentials for Monmouth home basketball games must be made through the Monmouth Athletics Communications office. Requests by accredited media members should be submitted through Gary Kowal. Credentials must be requested at least 48 hours prior to requested game.

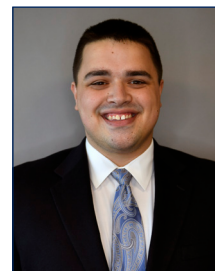
