## RED HAWKS COME BACK HOME TO HOST FOURTH-RANKED WESLEY

Montclair State is on the road this week heading down the NJ Turnpike and to the capital of Delaware where it will face Wesley College at Wolverine Stadium.

Last week, Montclair State scored all 21 points in the first quarter and let its defense do the work as the Red Hawks provided its Homecoming crowd with a 21-7 victory over The College of New Jersey. Senior defensive end **Joe Falato** recorded 3.5 sacks with the Montclair State defense adding a score of its own. Senior running back **John DiStefano** rushed for 121 yards and a score as MSU racked up eight sacks. **Julane Prince** registered a 47-yard touchdown catch-and-run with **Nick Volpe** scooping up a fumble and returning it 22 yards for the other score.

It was a tale of two halves last Saturday afternoon in Glassboro for Wesley as the Wolverines built up a big lead and withstood a second half run to earn a crucial 24-17 victory over No. 21 Rowan University. **Dan Kesack** went 15-for-32 for 268 yards and a touchdown through the air. The quarterback also ran for a score. **Jamar Baynard** rushed for 98 yards and a touchdown while **Alex Kemp** hauled in four passes for 118 yards including a 62-yard touchdown reception.

This is the sixth meeting between the teams with MSU holding a 4-2 advantage although Wesley has won the last two matchups, including last year's contest at Sprague Field.

**WESLEY COLLEGE**

**HEAD COACH MIKE DRASS**

Since Mike Drass took over the reins of the Wolverines program in 1993, Wesley College football has become synonymous with winning. Now entering his 24th year as head coach in 2016, Drass, who also serves as the school's Director of Athletics, is one of the winningest coaches in Division III history.

Drass' 215 victories are currently the third-most among active coaches, ranking only behind Rick Giancola of Montclair State and Michael DeLong of Springfield, and his 78.1 winning percentage ranks among the top ten all-time.

Wesley is one of the winningest programs nationally since 2000, and has advanced to the NCAA Playoffs 11 consecutive times dating back to the 2005 season. During that stretch, the Wolverines have emerged victorious 125 times, compared to just 20 losses. Drass has led his team to 26 NCAA Tournament wins since 2005, and taken the Wolverines to the NCAA Quarterfinals in nine of those 11 playoff appearances. Wesley has come away with six regional championships as well, reaching the NCAA Semifinals in 2005, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2014.

In each year of the current 11-year playoff run, Wesley has had a player selected to the AFCA All-America Team which is currently the longest-active streak in the nation. Last year it was Gagliardi Trophy winner Joe Callahan who carried on the Wolverines' All-American streak.

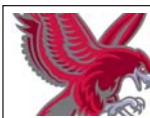
Including his four years as an assistant coach/defensive coordinator before taking over the Wesley program in March of 1993, Drass has been on the sideline for all but one win in the program's Division III history. Drass also guided the team into the inaugural Atlantic Central Football Conference in 1998, the first of nine ACFC Championships for a program that posted a .843 win percentage as a conference member. Since becoming independent in 2011, the head coach played an integral role in securing Wesley a place in the New Jersey Athletic Conference in 2015. The move guaranteed the Wolverines a chance at an Automatic Qualifying bid for the NCAA Tournament by winning the NJAC in the regular season. Wesley earned the title of Co-Champions in their first year of membership, securing an at-large NCAA Tournament bid.

The Wolverines have proven extremely difficult foe at home at Drass Field at Scott D. Miller Stadium. Since FieldTurf was installed in 2004 Wesley has posted a 78-5 record on their Home Turf for winning percentage of .949.

Under Drass' leadership, Wesley has proven to be the premier small college football program on the East Coast. During his tenure, the Wolverines have won either the Lambert Meadowlands Trophies or ECAC Team of the Year Awards seven of the last nine years in recognition of Eastern supremacy in college football.

Drass has coached student-athletes to 162 All-America honors during his time at Wesley and more than 200 all-conference selections during the team's run in conference play. The Wolverines have also produced eight D3football.com South Region Players of the Year and six ECAC Southwest Players of the Year, as well as four ECAC Rookies of the Year. In 2004, Rocky Myers won the Gagliardi Trophy for the best player in Division III Football and is still the only defensive player and student-athlete on the East Coast to do so. Last season, quarterback Joe Callahan brought home the award making Wesley the only East Coast team with multiple Gagliardi Trophy winners.

In 2015, Joe Callahan's five-year career at Wesley College ended with Division III football's highest honor as the senior quarterback from Absecon, N.J. was awarded the Gagliardi Trophy, given to the most outstanding player in Division III. Callahan led D-III in seven passing categories, including passing yards (5,068, a D-

III record) and touchdowns (55). The Wolverines finished 11-2, producing the nation's top offense at 592.2 yards per game. In his final collegiate game, Callahan threw for 379 yards and four touchdowns. Callahan is only the second player at any college level to throw for more than 5,000 yards and 55 touchdowns in a single season. Callahan ended his career at Wesley signing with the NFL's Green Bay Packers at the end of April.

The Wolverines, committed to success on the field and in the classroom, stress an academics-first approach to college football. "Football at Wesley College is about a cap and gown, not a helmet and shoulder pads," says Drass. "I get the most satisfaction when one of our players walks across the graduation stage. Our belief is simple: There can be no success on the field unless there is progress toward a degree in the classroom."

Drass has coordinated the Wesley defense and has spearheaded the Wolverines' recruiting since his arrival at Wesley in 1989. Wesley has held top 25 total defense ranking 13 of the last 19 seasons. In 2010, the Wolverines' finished as the No. 1 defense in Division III, in addition to a pair of second place finishes during his tenure.

Coach Drass began his coaching career at North Penn High School in Blossburg, Pennsylvania in 1983. Following two seasons as an assistant, he spent two years as the school's head coach before accepting a coaching position at Mansfield University, where he is a member of the Mansfield University Athletic Hall of Fame. At his alma mater, he developed the reputation of being an outstanding recruiter while he coached under Tom Elsasser from 1986-88. In 1989, he was hired at Wesley as the defensive line coach and recruiting coordinator.

As a player, Drass was a three year starter and two-time All-PSAC selection as an offensive lineman and captain of the Mountaineers. In his senior year Drass was the only Mountie named to the All-PSAC 1st team. Coach Drass originally hails from Glen Mills, Pennsylvania and attended Penncrest High School where was inducted into the School District's Hall of Fame.

Coach Drass is an active member of the American Football Coaches Association. He has served as the chairman of the Division III All American selection Committee and has served two terms as the District II Chairman of the AFCA Rules Committee. Coach Drass is a member of the ECAC Championship committee for football. He and his wife, Laurie, reside in Dover, and their daughter, Molly Ann.

**RICK GIANCOLA  
BY THE NUMBERS**

Rick Giancola begins his 34th season as the head coach of the Red Hawks. Throughout his career, which also includes seven years as an assistant coach beginning in 1976, Giancola has just about seen it all when it comes to Montclair State football.

**34** Number of years as a head coach - the longest tenure by a coach in any sport in Montclair State history.

**234** Total number of victories, a program record, and the most among active coaches in Division III. He enters the 2015 campaign 26 wins ahead of Springfield's Mike DeLong who second on the list.

**47** Percentage of Montclair State football seasons Giancola has been a part of (41). The Red Hawks begin their 86th year of football in 2015.

**5** Number of Montclair State University Presidents since Giancola joined the staff in 1976 starting with Donald W. Dickson through current President Dr. Susan Cole.

**9** Number of New Jersey Governors during Giancola's tenure at MSU. That list spans from Hon. Brendan T. Byrne to current Governor Chris Christie.

**7** Presidents of the United States that have occupied the White House since Giancola came on board from President Gerald R. Ford to President Barack Obama.

**4** "Second-Generation" players that Giancola has coached, including current Red Hawk Jack Castiglia, son of former punter Paul Castiglia in 2014. Sam Mills III, son of College Football Hall of Famer Sam Mills (1977-1980) was the first in 1998.

♦ Rick Giancola is in his 34th season as a head coach. He was named the 12th head coach in Montclair State history in July, 1983. It was his first head coaching position.

♦ Giancola enters the 2016 campaign as the active winningest coach in Division III taking over that spot following the retirements of St. John's (MN) John Gagliardi and Mount Union's Larry Kehres in 2013.

♦ Giancola is the all-time winningest coach in MSU history with 231 wins. He took over the top spot in September 1989 against Ramapo. Giancola, member of the MSU and Glassboro/Rowan Halls of Fame, surpassed Fred Hill for the mark.

♦ Giancola is one of eight coaches in MSU athletic history to record 200 career wins. He joined former baseball coach Norm Schoenig, softball coach Anita Kubicka, men's basketball coaches Ollie Gelston and Ted Fiore, wrestling coach Steve Strellner and swimming and diving coach Brian McLaughlin in that exclusive group.

♦ Giancola has led Montclair State to 11 of its conference record 20 NJAC Championships. Giancola won four straight from 1983-86, and added titles in 1989, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2009, 2010 and 2014.

♦ Giancola's teams have made nine NCAA Division III Playoff appearances (1985-86, 1989, 1999-2001, 2003, 2010). Four times, the Red Hawks reached the quarterfinal round.

♦ Giancola became just the second collegiate football coach in New Jersey State history to win 200 games as Montclair downed William Paterson in 2010. Giancola joined TCNJ's Eric Hamilton as the only two coaches to reach that plateau. In 2007, Giancola joined Hamilton again as the only coaches in NJAC Football history to record 100 conference victories.

♦ Giancola has been named the NJAC Coach of the Year eight times, including the 1999, 2000, 2003, 2009 and 2010 seasons.

♦ Giancola has guided Montclair State to two long winning streaks in the NJAC during his tenure. He posted 18 straight NJAC wins from 1984-86 and had a 16-game win streak from 1999 until the final game of the 2001 season.

♦ He has had 26 players named to NCAA Division III All-American Teams. He has also seen 20 players sign professional contracts, including safety Chad Faulcon and defensive lineman Bobby Skinner in 2012 and C. J. Conway in 2015.

♦ Giancola graduated from Glassboro State (now Rowan) in 1968 with a degree in Education. He played both football and baseball for the Profs. He was an All-East selection at tight end and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 1991.

**AWAY FROM HOME**

The Red Hawks are back out on the road for the fifth time this season. So far, Montclair is 1-3 having captured its opener at FDU-Florham before falling at Salisbury on September 17, at William Paterson on October 1 and at Christopher Newport in overtime two weeks ago. Last year, MSU went 2-3 away from Sprague Field in 2015. Two years ago, the Red Hawks were true road warriors winning all five games marking its first undefeated road campaign since 2003 when it also posted a 5-0 record. The most road victories for Montclair in one season is six set in 1981 (6-0) and equaled in 1999 (6-0) both of which included wins in the NCAA playoffs. Over the last 11 seasons MSU has posted a record of 57-35 (.626 winning percentage) away from home.

**GETTING AFTER THE QUARTERBACK...**

The Red Hawks have been after QBs all season and that was evident last week with MSU racking up eight sacks in its win over TCNJ on Homecoming. The eight sacks were the most by Montclair State since posting the same number against Kean in a 9-0 win in 2003 (also on Homecoming). The eight sacks also upped MSU's season total to 26 which currently leads the NJAC. The 26 sacks are five more than Montclair amassed in 2015. It was the third time this season that the Red Hawks have recorded five or more sacks in a game. The 26 sacks have been distributed among 12 players with three ranked in the Top 10 in the NJAC - **Joe Falato (Lodi, NJ / Lodi)**, the leader with **Vin Cordasco (Cedar Grove, NJ / Cedar Grove)** and **Nick Catalano (Ramsey, NJ / Ramsey)** ranking second and eighth respectively.

**FALATO CAUSES HAVOC**

Falato is currently the NJAC leader in sacks and the senior showed why last Saturday registering 3.5 in the victory against the Lions. The total was the most by an MSU player since Ed Kirschenbaum had the same coincidentally against TCNJ on Homecoming in 2010. Falato currently had seven sacks on the season which is the most by an MSU player since All-American Chris Merkle had eight during the 2009 campaign. He also upped his career total to 13.5 which is now 15th on the all-time Montclair State list.

**PILING UP THE YARDAGE**

DiStefano topped the 100-yard mark again last week with 121 in the win over The College of New Jersey. It was the sixth time in seven games that DiStefano surpassed the century mark. He one of three running backs in the last 16 years to accomplish that feat joining Ron Lewis in 1999 and All-American Chris D'Andrea in 2011. DiStefano is also the fifth running back since the start of the 1999 season to register two games of 175 or more yards. He currently leads the NJAC in rushing with 891 yards and is looking to become the first Montclair State back to reach the 1,000 yard mark in a season since D'Andrea set the single-season mark with 1,583 yards in that 2011 campaign.

**ANOTHER HAPPY RETURN**

Montclair State went 10 years without a fumble return for a touchdown. The Red Hawks appear to be making up for lost time as for the third time in four games, MSU ran back a fumble for a score. This time it was lineman

**Nick Volpe (Freehold, NJ / Colts Neck)**, who got the touchdown with a 22-yard return after Joe Falato forced the fumble on a sack. Junior linebacker **Joshua Betts (Newark, NJ / Central)** recorded the other two in back-to-back weeks. Betts returned a fumble for a touchdown with a 30-yard runback all but wrapping up the victory for the Red Hawks over Southern Virginia on October 8 and raced 25 yards for a score at William Paterson on October 1.

**SHUTTING 'EM DOWN**

The sack/fumble return for a touchdown highlighted another outstanding effort by the Montclair State in the win against TCNJ. Montclair held the Lions to 181 yards of total offense, including 69 passing. It is the second time this season and 16th time in the last eight campaigns that Montclair has allowed less than 200 yards in a game.

**BIG PLAY MAN...**

Wide receiver **Julanee Prince (Matawan, NJ / St. John Vianney)** has been a "big-play" man for the Red Hawks this season. Last week, Prince registered a 47-yard catch-and-run for a touchdown against TCNJ, one week after hauling in a 50-yard touchdown pass at Christopher Newport. It was the fifth touchdown catch of the year for Prince. Of the five scores, four of them are at least 30 yards. Prince also had a 73-yard scoring catch against Rowan and a 30-yard grab at Salisbury in Week 2. Prince leads the Red Hawks in receptions, yards and touchdowns is ranked sixth in the NJAC in receiving yards at 59.1 per game.

**HAWK FEED...**

- ◆ For the fifth time in seven games, the Red Hawks scored on their first possession of the game. In fact, Montclair tallied points on its first three touches against TCNJ.
- ◆ Sophomore **John Apicella (Springfield, NJ / Jonathan Dayton)** got his second start last Saturday and recorded his first career touchdown on the connection with Prince. Apicella finished 7-of-14 for 111 yards.
- ◆ The Red Hawks made it back-to-back games with a blocked kick as rookie **Je'Von Mason (West Orange, NJ / West Orange)** blocked a punt against TCNJ. It was the fourth block of the season for MSU and the first punt block. Two weeks ago, DiStefano swatted away a potential game-winning field goal attempt in overtime at Christopher Newport. **Michael Stradford (Rahway, NJ / Rahway)** and **Jake Weber (Matawan, NJ / Matawan)** had PAT blocks at FDU-Florham and Salisbury, respectively.
- ◆ Sophomore **Mauro Altamura (Hasbrouck Heights, NJ / Hasbrouck Heights)** picked off his second pass of the season last week. He is second on the team in INTs.
- ◆ Junior **Shaon Stephenson (Paterson, NJ / John F. Kennedy)** led all MSU tacklers last week with 10. It was the second time this season that Stephenson hit double digits for tackles and he is now second on the team in the category with 52.
- ◆ Through seven games this season, Montclair State has been a quick start and strong finish when it comes to scoring. MSU has scored 103 of its 138 points in the first and fourth quarters combined. The

**RED HAWKS SELECTED SIXTH IN NJAC PRESEASON POLL**

Montclair State was picked to finish sixth in the NJAC Preseason Coaches Poll announced in early August. Defending league champion Salisbury University was picked to repeat despite receiving just three of the 10 first-place votes from the conference's coaches. Wesley College was selected second and got five first-place votes. Frostburg State, the "dark horse" team was third with Rowan University fourth as each team got one first-place vote. Kean University was fifth followed by MSU. Christopher Newport was chosen seventh with The College of New Jersey, William Paterson and Southern Virginia occupying the final three spots.

**MAGRINI, CAPPELLO, O'CONNOR INDUCTED INTO MSU HALL OF FAME**

Montclair State football had plenty of representation as the newest class of the Athletics Hall of Fame was inducted on October 22. Wide receiver **Eric Magrini**, offensive lineman **Al Cappello** and former assistant coach **Rich O'Connor** were part of the 43rd class to be enshrined. Cappello was a three-year starter at guard for the Red Hawks helping Montclair State to NJAC Championships in 1999 and 2000 and three consecutive trips to the NCAA Division III Playoffs. He was a two-time All-NJAC selection and was the 2003 NJAC Male Athlete of the Year. Magrini was a three-time All-NJAC pick and finished No. 1 all-time in receptions (198) and yards (2,864) – marks that still stand today. Magrini, who averaged 14.5 yards per reception in his career, is

third in touchdown grabs with 24 and ranked eighth in all-purpose yards (2,871) and 12th in points scored (146) at the time of his graduation. O'Connor spent three decades on the sidelines of Sprague Field, the last 13 as offensive coordinator. In his tenure on Sprague Field at Montclair, the Red Hawks qualified for 13 postseason appearances, including nine NCAA Playoffs berths.

**CAPTAIN RED HAWKS...**

The Montclair State football team announced its team captains for the 2016 campaign at the Red Hawks annual banquet held on February 10. Seniors **Joe Falato (Lodi, NJ / Lodi)**, **Anthony Dorsi (Matawan, NJ / Red Bank Catholic)**, **John DiStefano (Lincroft, NJ / Red Bank Catholic)** and junior linebacker **Josh Betts (Newark, NJ / Central)** were named. Falato was a Second-Team All-NJAC selection last year and registered 45 tackles, including 6.5 for loss and a sack. The defensive end broke up for passes and forced a fumble. Betts finished fourth on the team in tackles with 61 and led MSU with 4.5 sacks in addition to one interception and four passes defended. DiStefano rushed for 472 yards and scored five touchdowns. He also served on special teams and averaged 24.7 yards per runback on kickoffs. Dorsi appeared in all 10 games at fullback and on special teams. He pulled in six passes out of the backfield and scored once in Montclair's season opener against Delaware Valley.

**NEW ADDITIONS...**

New players aren't the only new additions to the Red Hawk roster this season. Head coach Rick Giancola's staff will also have a new look as well. **Steve Sciarappa** takes over as offensive coordinator taking over for Rich O'Connor who retired after 33 seasons. Sciarappa comes to MSU from Division I-AA Monmouth University and also served as head coach at Mater Dei Prep for five seasons. Also new to the staff are offensive backfield coaches **Andy Maurizio** and **John Walker** both former Red Hawks. Maurizio returns for his second stint having coached with MSU from 2005-07 before coaching in the high school ranks at Westside High School in Newark and at his alma mater JFK Iselin where he led the Mustangs to a pair of playoff berths. Walker, the all-time leading rushed in school history, is also on staff for the second time having coached in 1995. **Frank Bakirtzis** will serve as the tight ends coach following a successful playing career at Sacred Heart University. **Bill Shimko**, a 2015 All-American, moves to the coaching sidelines with **Taylor Groh** serving as a quality control coach.

**SECOND GENERATION...**

Having been at the helm for over three decades, the possibility existed that head coach Rick Giancola could some day coach "Second-Generation" players and that time has arrived again. Junior wide receiver **Jack Castiglia (Allendale, NJ / Northern Highlands)** returns for his third year and he is the second father-son combination that Giancola has coached. Castiglia's father Paul was an All-NJAC punter for Montclair from 1987-89 and is currently third all-time in program history for attempts (153) and yards (5,434) and fifth in average (35.5 ypp). Wide receiver Joe Owens Jr., (2011-12) whose dad Joe Sr., played running back in the 1990s is the other father-son combination to have played while Giancola has the head coach (1983-present) and there have been four total since Giancola came to MSU in 1976 as an assistant. The other two were 2014 graduate Matt Grundy, who's father Bill was an All-NJAC running back from 1978-80 and graduated as the all-time leading rusher in school history with 2,152 yards (now ninth-best). And finally there was Sam Mills III, son of the late College Football Hall of Famer Sam Mills (1977-80). Mills III played for the Red Hawks in 1997.
