



# 2025-26 D2CCA All-South Region Men's Basketball Team

## PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Dallas Graziani, NOVA SOUTHEASTERN



Nova Southeastern's Dallas Graziani has been selected as the D2CCA South Region Player of the Year.

The senior guard led the No. 1 ranked Sharks to a 27-1 record (19-1 SSC) and their fifth consecutive Sunshine State Conference championship. Graziani contributed for the Sharks as a scorer and distributor, being named amongst one of the top guards in the nation. He ranked in the top 10 in the conference and in the South Region in four different categories; assists (176), assists per game (6.2), points per game (20.0), steals per game (2.3).

Graziani was a two major award winner in the SSC, winning the Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the year. The Pembroke Pines native ranks atop of the all-time ranks in NSU history in career assists (781) and steals(269).

Nova Southeastern is the No. 1 seed and will host the upcoming NCAA South Regional beginning March. 14.
