SETTING THE STAGE

Morgan State (4-5) will continue non-conference action when they travel to face the Longwood Lancers (5-4) on Saturday, December 11. The Bears look to build off a 77-71 home victory against Millersville on Monday night. Longwood will enter the contest coming off an 78-58 home victory against Delaware State on Saturday (Dec. 4). Saturday's game will be broadcast by Heritage Sports Radio Network (HSRN.com). Tip-off is set for 3 p.m.

KEY NOTES ABOUT MORGAN STATE

- The Bears roster features 16 student-athletes, including 10 players who were on the team last season. Morgan's returning nucleus includes: Sherwyn Devonish-Prince Jr., Malik Miller, Trevor Moore, Lagio Grantsaan and De'Torrion Ware. The Bears had added incoming transfers Seventh Woods (South Carolina), Myles Douglas (St. Joseph's), Keith McGee (New Mexico), Collin Nnamene (Mount St. Mary's) and Ty Horner (North Dakota State Sciences).
- Morgan's roster includes three sophomores, three juniors, seven seniors and three graduate students.
- Kevin Broadus enters his third year at the helm as Morgan State's 16th head coach of the men's basketball program effective May 1, 2019. In Broadus' debut season, Morgan State went 15-16, its largest victory total since 2013-14. Then last year, in the midst of a pandemic, the Bears produced a 14-8 mark --- their best winning percentage since going 27-10 and making the NCAA tournament in 2009-10. Prior to Morgan, Broadus worked at the University of Maryland, College Park, where he has been one of the nation's best recruiters as the top assistant on Mark Turgeon's coaching staff. Broadus was influential in the successful NCAA tournament run for the Terps. Consistently ranked in the top 20 nationally for recruiting, Broadus was instrumental in signing a number of local Baltimore talents such as DeJuan Summers, Brandon Herbert, LaFonta Johnson, and Henry Sims.

CHRIS PAUL HBCU CHALLENGE

The Bears early schedule includes playing eight of nine games away from Hill Field House, highlighting that stretch was back-to-back games in the Chris Paul HBCU Challenge in Phoenix, where the Bears met Grambling State (Nov. 28 / L, 74-59) and Hampton (Nov. 29 / W, 60-47).

- The first-of-its-kind event for Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) will be played at the Footprint Center (Home of the Phoenix Suns) and air on ESPN Networks.
- The two-day doubleheader will feature the likes of Norfolk State University, Morgan State University, Hampton University and Grambling State University.

NBA HBCU CLASSIC

The NBA announced an extension of its ongoing commitment to Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) with new programs designed to create greater opportunity for students and alumni, encourage economic advancement and further celebrate their rich traditions.

- The celebrations will be highlighted by a Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) matchup between Howard University and Morgan State University men's basketball teams. The game will be played at the Wolstein Center in Cleveland on February 19, 2022 and will be broadcast live.
- The NBA 2K League will host events on HBCU campuses to introduce students to careers in gaming and esports, creating pathways for students to pursue careers in the growing industry.
- As part of this partnership, the NBA will develop new programs and events focused on the HBCU community
 specifically around professional development, career advancement and increased support and awareness for HBCU athletics and institutions.
- "Chris Paul has shown unwavering support for HBCUs and brought an awareness to creating opportunities for the student-athletes at these institutions," said John L. Doleva, President and CEO of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. "The Hall of Fame is proud to share in Chris's vision and bring this event to life alongside Boost Mobile and the Phoenix Suns."

WHO'S OUT

Troy Baxter (Tallahassee, Fla.), Victor Okafor (Greenbelt, Md.), Sharone Wright (Macon, Ga.), and Jamar Brown (Harlem, N.Y.) wrapped up their collegiate careers last spring.

WHO'S BACK

The Bears return four starters from last year's team, bringing back guards Sherwyn Devonish, Malik Miller, Trevor Moore and forward Lagio Grantsaan. MSU also returns guards **De'Torrion Ware**, I**saiah Burke**, **Naseem Khaalid**, **Thai're Vance**, **Elijah** Bowens along with forward Chad Venning.

WHO'S IN

The Bears have added several newcomers to the 2021-22 roster: G Seventh Woods, G Will Thomas, G Keith McGee, F Ty Horner, F Collin Nnamene and F Myles Douglas.

RETURNING PRODUCTION NUMBERS

Morgan State returns 72.4 percent of its scoring, 63.7 percent of its rebounding and 70.4 percent of its minutes played totals from last year's team. The team leaders in field goal percentage (De'Torrion Ware - .425), three-point percentage (Ware, .384), free throw percentage (Ware, .832), rebounding (Malik Miller - 8.0 rpg), assists (Sherwyn Devonish, 3.6), steals (Miller, 2.0), blocked shots (Miller, 0.9). and minutes played (Sherwyn Devonish, 29.5). Four (4) players who started in at least five (5) games a year ago also return - Devonish (22), Miller (22), Lagio Grantsaan (21), and Trevor Moore (20).

NON-CONFERENCE RECAP

Morgan State went 7-3 in non-conference play, the most non-conference wins since a 2019-20 season in which the Bears held a 6-9 non-conference mark. Prior to that, MSU had not won at least seven nonconference games since the 2012-13 season (7-9).

- Last season, MSU went 2-2 at home, 3-0 in road games and 2-1 in neutral site games.
- The Bears are 1-0 so far during this 2021-22 season.

HOME GROWN

Morgan State has seven players from the DMV (D.C., Maryland & Metropolitan-D.C.) area. Senior guard Sherwyn Devonish is from Bladensburg, Md. and graduated from Wise HS. Senior guard Isaiah Burke is from Annapolis and was a prep standout at Bowie HS, while senior guard Malik Miller hails from Washington, D.C. and played at Friendship Tech Prep. Senior forward **Myles Douglas** is from Edgewood, Md. and was a standout at Aberdeen HS. Sophomore quard Will Thomas is from Baltiomore and played at Mervo HS. Junior guard Thai're Vance is a product of Silver Spring, Md. and played at DeMatha Catholic HS.

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

- The Bears are currently averaging 78.1 points (No. 2 in MEAC) thru its first nine games.
- Morgan exploded for 118 points in its 2021-22 season opener versus St. Mary's College of Maryland and followed it up with a 126-71 win against Penn State Allegheny.
- The Bears are shooting 44.7 percent from the field (ranked No. 3) and 30.4 percent from beyond the arc
- Morgan led the MEAC in scoring by averaging 79.8 points thru 22 games of the 2020-21 season.
- They scored a season-high 102 in a home win vs. Lincoln-Pa. (Dec. 1, 2020).
- MSU also led the MEAC in offensive rebounding (39.7 avg).

THE CHARITY STRIPE

The Bears' returning team includes six players who shot 70 percent or better from the free throw line last season.

- Morgan has converted 65.9 percent (135-205) from the stripe thru the nine eight games.
- Sherwyn Devonish is currently shooting 70.4 percent (ranks No. 10 in MEAC) from the stripe to lead the Bears.
- Last season, Morgan shot 73.9 percent (369-499; ranked No. 1 in MEAC) from the stripe, led by De'Torrion Ware who shot 83.2 percent (84-101; ranked No. 5) and Malik Miller 71.6 percent (58-81; ranked No. 10).

BEAR D

Morgan has started off the 2021-22 campaign by allowing opponents to 73.1 points per game and 44.0 percent shooting from the field.

- MSU's opponents have shot at a 38.0 percent clip on avearge from beyond the arc ... this ranks last in the conference.
- The 22.2 turnovers per game Morgan's defense forces ranks No. 2 in the country ... MSU's 11.1 steals per game ranks No. 6 in the nation.
- The Bears defense was ranked among the conference leaders a season ago and should once again be solid defensively for 2021-22 season.
- The Bears ranked No. 3 in the MEAC in field goal percentage defense at 42.2 percent.
- The Bears ranked No. 2 in the MEAC in three-point field goal percentage defense at 30.6 percent.
- MSU led the league in rebounding (+3.7) and ranked No. 2 in rebounding defense (36.0).
- MSU recorded 82 blocked shots (No. 2).



SCOUTING THE LONGWOOD LANCERS

 Longwood enters Saturday's contest coming off an 78-58 home win against Delaware State on Saturday (Dec. 4). Behind 17 LONGWOOD points from Isaiah Wilkins and



a 31-13 run over the game's final 11:03, the Lancers (5-4) pulled away in the second half to dispatch the Hornets and improve to 5-1 on their home court. The Lancers hit 11 three-pointers and had 21 assists on 31 made field goals.

- Isaiah Wilkins (Winston-Salem, N.C.) is one of three players averaging double-figures for the Marauders. Wilkins, who previously played at Wake Forest, leads the Lancers by averaging 12.1 points and 6.3 rebounds. He's also shooting 48.6 percent from the field and 48.6 percent from 3-point territory. Junior 6-foot-7 forward Leslie Nkereuwem (Lawrenceville, Ga.) is averaging 12.1 points and 4.9 boards off the bench, and Justin Hill (Houston, Texas) is averaging 10.2 points, 4.7 rebounds is leads the team in assists (4.3 avg). **DeShaun Wade** (Virginia Beach, Va.) is chipping in 9.7 points and 3.0 rebounds.
- The Lancers added former N.C. Central point guard Jordan Perkins for the 2021-22 season ... the veteran guard started all four years for the Eagles, during which NCCU won three MEAC titles and made two trips to the NCAA Tournament.
- The Lancers are currently averaging 76.1 points thru its first nine games and are shooting 45.7 percent from the field and 34.8 percent from downtown.
- Longwood has limited opponents to 63.4 points per game and 40.6 percent shooting, including 29.8 percent from three.
- The Lancers are currently 5-4 overall and 1-0 in Big South play and 5-1 at home.
- Griff Aldrich enters his fourth season as head coach and in just three seasons at the helm, Aldrich has led the Lancers to a bevy of milestones and program firsts, including multiple Division I postseason tournament invitations, record Big South wins and back-to-back topfive conference finishes. During that time, the Lancers have engineered one of the most drastic turnarounds in all of college basketball and ascended to the upper tier of the Big South.

BAXTER GONE

The Bears will look to offset the loss of graduated Troy Baxter, who completed the MEAC regular season by averaging 17.1 ppg (No. 1 in MEAC), 4.8 rpg and shot 44.5 percent from the field and 36.7 from the three.

- He was named to the 2021 All-MEAC First Team and All-Defensive Team and was named the MEAC Male Student-Athlete of the Year.
- He was also named NABC All-District Second Team and BoxToRow Second Team All-American.
- Baxter won the 2021 Great Clips College Slam Dunk championship back in April.
- He was signed as an undrafted free agent in October by the NBA's Chicago Bulls.



LAST GAME | Dec. 6, 2021:

BALTIMORE -- Trevor Moore scored a season-high 18 points with four steals off the bench to help Morgan State secure a 77-71 victory over Millersville on Monday night inside Hill Field House.

- Millersville had the ball trailing 72-71 with under 40 seconds to play. Moore intercepted a pass intended for Caden Najdawi in the post, and he was fouled on his way up the court. Moore made both free throws for a three-point lead.
- Millersville had one last chance to tie it, and James Sullivan took a three from the right wing, but it hit front iron. Forced to foul to stop the clock, Millersville sent Morgan to the line two more times in the final 10 seconds, where the home team extended its lead.
- The Bears improved its record to 3-0 at home and 4-5 for the season, while Millersville's loss does not count against the Marauder's record because it was officially an exhibition game.
- Malik Miller finished with 10 points, seven rebounds and three assists. Keith McGee came off the bench to score nine points, hitting 2 of 4 shots from 3-point territory, while Seventh Woods added eight points and six rebounds.
- Sullivan led Millersville with a game-high 20 points and connected on 4 of 8 3-pointers. Mekhi Hendricks was 5 of 8 from the field and finished with 13 points. Khari Williams was just shy of posting a double-double with nine points and a game-high 11 rebounds.
- Millersville out-shot the Bears, hitting 49.1% of its shots from the field and 48% from three while Morgan 44.6% from the field and 33.3% from three. Millersville also held a 35-27 edge on the glass. The real difference came at the free throw line and in turnovers. Morgan State made 21-of-26 free throws while Millersville attempted just six all game. The Marauders also committed 24 turnovers, which turned into 30 Morgan points.
