OVERVIEW

THE MORGAN ATHLETICS FACILITY MASTER PLAN

is a comprehensive facility road map for the future of Morgan Athletics. The Facility Master Plan responds to the current needs of today's Division I student-athletes, and focuses on creating conditions for success for all of Morgan's 14 Varsity sports. Addressing over 10 venues, the plan will improve the function and sustainability of existing facilities, with additions in critical areas for student-athlete health and performance. The master plan supports the year-around academic and athletic needs for Morgan's over 300 student-athletes.

The Morgan Athletics facility master plan provides a guide for capital investment and facility infrastructure that will ensure Morgan's academic and athletic excellence for years to come. Financial support for facility projects will consist of philanthropic dollars from alumni, supporters and corporate sponsorships of Morgan Athletics and Morgan State University.

Timeframe for the projects are to be determined and construction will begin as soon as funding goals are met.

Philanthropy designated for specific facilities could provide an opportunity for additional projects. Naming right opportunities are available for each facility project in the Athletics Facilities Master Plan.

- Softball Field Upgrade
- Locker Room Renovations and Upgrades
- Hughes Stadium Enhancements

- Indoor Tennis Facility
- Student-Athlete Nutrition and Health Center
- Sports Medicine and Sports Performance Support Center

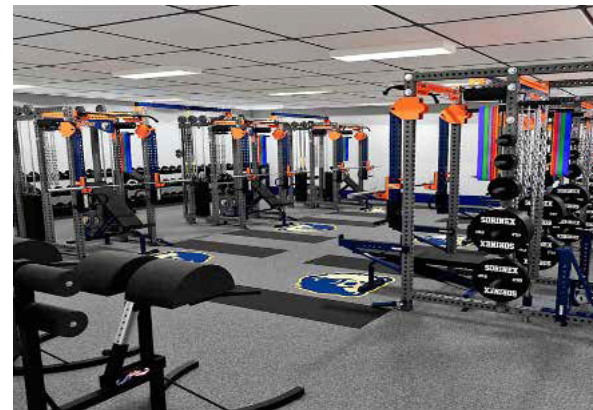
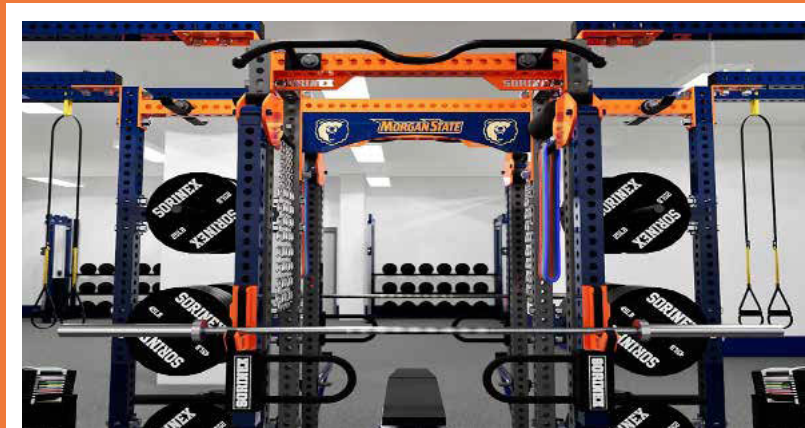

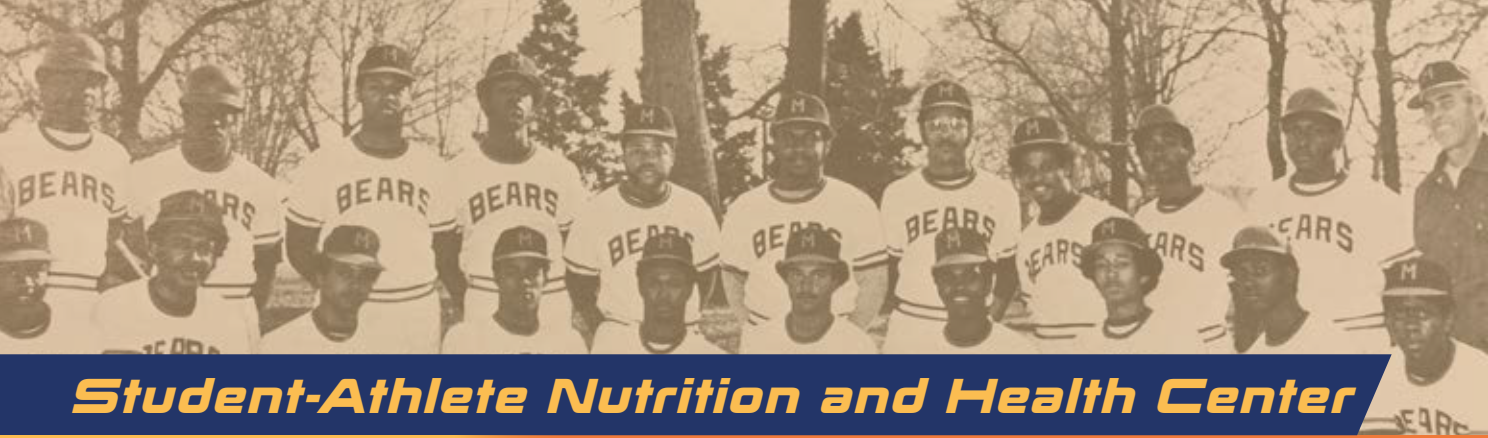


Indoor Tennis Facility
