NEWS & NOTES

TODAY'S GAME

- Mount St. Mary's looks to remain undefeated in Northeast Conference play as they take on Sacred Heart.
- According to preseason voting, this matchup features the #1 and #2 teams in the NEC. The Mount was voted as the preseason favorites, while SHU was picked second by the conference coaches.
- Sacred Heart has split their first two conference matchups, winning one game over Long Island and Wagner.

SERIES BITS

- Sacred Heart is one of Mount's more challenging historical opponents, winning 34 of 41 meetings.
- One of the Mount's seven wins came last season, a 67-58 win in Fairfield. Rebecca Lee's seven blocks and a double-double of 16 points and 10 rebounds.
- The victory last season broke a four game streak in favor of the Pioneers. Sacred Heart has won 33 of the past 36 games, after Mount St. Mary's won the first three out of four when the series began in 2000 and 2001.

THE MOUNT'S TRACK RECORD

- The Mountaineers stand at 3-2 (2-0 NEC) on the year, after going 20-11 (14-4 NEC) in 2019-2020, clinching the #2 seed in the conference tournament.
- The Mount is going for their fourth straight win, and a 3-0 start in NEC play after sweeping St. Francis Brooklyn last week.
- Redshirt senior Kendall Bresee leads in four major statistical categories - points, rebounds, assists and steals. She ranks third in the conference for steals, fifth in scoring, seventh in rebounding and tied for seventh in assists.
- Bolstered by five blocks in a game and six for the series with St. Francis Brooklyn, Rebecca Lee leads the team with nine blocks, with stands third in the NEC.
- Fellow senior Bridget Birkhead leads the team with 13 three-pointers. 39.4 percent of her long range shots have found the bottom of the net.
- Mount St. Mary's made their presence known on the defensive end in their most recent win over St. Francis Brooklyn. Holding the Terriers to 59 points for the game, they overcame a six point deficit at half to win, thanks in large part to a 5:27 drought for SFBK at the end of the contest. The Mount is 20-4 when the team holds their opponent between 50-59 points.

MOUNT ST. MARY'S NEWS AND NOTES

PONDERING THE PIONEERS

- Sacred Heart stands at 2-4 overall and 2-2 in the NEC, and in sixth place in the conference.
- The Pioneers are diverse in their scoring attack, with six players registering between seven and 10 points per game, led by Adrianne Hagood with 9.8.
- On January 8th, SHU broke a four-game slide with a 58-50 win over Wagner. Three Pioneers scored in double figures and the defense held the Seahawks to 21 points in the second half.
- In the victory against Wagner the Pioneers outrebounded the Seahawks 42-25. They are second behind Saint Francis U in defensive rebounding in the conference.

FROM PAUSE TO PLAY

- Mount St. Mary's paused team activities for over a month following positive COVID-19 tests within the program.
- Contests affected were non-conference meetings with Maryland, La Salle and Hofstra, which were canceled, and three NEC games with Wagner at Saint Francis U were postponed.
- This series with Sacred Heart was advanced two weeks after both Central Connecticut and Merrimack were sidelined with COVID issues. The Mount was schdeuled to play Merrimack and Sacred Heart was supposed to play CCSU.

MIND THE GAP

- From December 5th to January 7th, 33 days passed since Mount's last game.
- That in-season gap is the fifth longest in team history, and the longest since 1978. The longest is 56 days going back to the team's inaguaral season of 1974-75. After their first-ever game against Loyola on December 4th, the team's next game didn't occur until January 29th versus Frederick Community College.

TYING UP OPPONENTS IN KNOTT

- December 5th's win against UMBC was the program's 100th non-conference victory at Knott Arena since the facility opened in 1987.
- Mount stands 278-155 all-time on their home floor, including a 25-15 mark in the Marchesano era.

FROM DOWNTOWN!

- The Mountaineers under Coach Marchesano have rewritten the record books for making three pointers. Under her three seasons, her teams are 1st, 2nd and 4th for triples made in a season.
- Last season, the team once again set the record with 264 made three pointers. That accomplishment also ranked 15th among all NCAA Division I teams.
- On December 14, 2019, another record toppled with 16 made three's in a game with Maryland Eastern Shore. Bridget Birkhead was responsible for eight made shots.
- So far in 2020-21, Mount has 24 triples for an average of eight per game.

THAT'S DOWNRIGHT OFFENSIVE

- Mount St. Mary's led the NEC in offensive output last year, averaging 67 points per game.
- The squad also topped the NEC in field goal percentage (.406) and three point percentage (.342).
- When they upped their point totals to 70 or more in a game last season, the Mount went 11-1, as opposed to 9-10 when scoring 60 or less.
- Although a small sample, Mount has increased this total in 2020-21 to 70 points a game. November 30th's defeat to Howard was a rare moment in the past three years, marking just the second time in the Marchesano era the team scored 80 or more and took the loss.

27TH HEAVEN

- Junior guard Michaela Harrison stands at 813 career points, 187 away from becoming the 27th member of the 1,000 point club.
- Harrison is on the fast track to becoming the 10th member to push past the milestone in three seasons. The last Mountaineer to achieve this was Jacqueline Brewer in 2015.

PRESEASON COACHES POLL

- For the first time in 20 years, Mount's women were on top of the NEC Preseason Poll. The unaminous decision came from a poll of the conference's coaches.
- It is the fifth time in program history they sit atop the preseason poll, and twice prior a Mountaineer team that was predicted first ended in first by season's end.

MARCHESANO'S MILESTONES

• Entering her fourth season, Maria Marchesano needed two wins for 125 career wins and six victories for 50 as Mount head coach. She crossed the

125 threshold with a win over St. Francis Brooklyn on January 7th.

• A 17-win season would put Marchesano fourth on the all-time list, bolting ahead of Rev. James Delaney (45) and Fred Carter (60).

AWARD-WINNING ACHIEVEMENTS

- A pair of players last season received All-NEC honors at season's conclusion.
- Leading scorer Michaela Harrison earned a First Team nod, while leading rebounder and assister Kendall Bresee received a Third Team selection.

HARRISON'S HILL

- Michaela Harrison earned a spot on the All-NEC Preseason Team following her strong sophomore season.
- The Clevelander led the charge in the scoring department for the Mount, averaging 12.6 points per game. Her 75 three pointers were a school record for an indivudual's season.
- Along with her scoring ability, she tied the team lead in steals (61) and ranked third on the team with 75 assists.

NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- Mount has seven games on the non-conference slate, with three games in Emmitsburg (Coppin State, UMBC, La Salle) and four away from home (James Madison, Howard, Maryland, Hofstra).
- There are several regional rivals renewed in the non-conference slate. This year marks the first game with JMU since 2000 and La Salle since 1993.
- The final contest outside the NEC will be against Hofstra, the first-ever meeting between the schools.
- Mount is looking to improve on a 5-7 non-conference result last season.

WHOLE SQUAD READY

- 9 of the 13 players from last year are back the 2020-21 season.
- Departures include Delaney Connors, who transfered to Southern Connecticut State and Alexis Wooden, who graduated and will play for Hampton as a post-graduate player.

20/20

- Just like their first place vote in the NEC Preseason poll, Mount is coming off a 20 win season for the first time in 20 years.
- The 20-11 record was the team's highest since a 20-9 mark during the 1999-2000 season.

KELSEY HAPPY RETURNS

- Coach Marchesano welcomed back Kelsey Funderburgh to the coaching staff for her first-ever role as a college assistant coach.
- Funderburgh played for Marchesano at Walsh, finishing with 1,304 career points. A three-point shooter, she ranked in the top 50 in Divison II for long-range shots.
- Since graduating, she worked three seasons as a Director of Basketball Operations - two here at the Mount and last season at Monmouth.

MIRROR, MIRROR ON THE COURT

- The Northeast Conference introduced a new format for conference games. When the Mount women play at home, the men will play the same opponent on the road, and vice versa.
- Adapting the schedule further for COVID-19, teams will now play games back-to-back at one location. Mount will host St. Francis Brooklyn, Central Connecticut, Bryant, and Fairleigh Dickinson.
- The only team that Mount will split home and away is our closest adversary, Saint Francis U. The team will head to Altoona on December 19 and will host the Red Flash in the regular season finale on February 28th.

LOCAL FLAIR

- Last November, Coach Marchesano and her staff signed four new players to NLI's. All four were local talents, either from Maryland or Pennsylvania.
- The quartet is split between a duo of fowards both named Isabella (Hunt, Pelaia) and a pair of guards, Jada Lee and Jessica Tomasetti.
- . Hunt was a two-time district champion; Pelaia the leading scorer on a PIAA Class 5A champion; Lee a three-time All-Section awardee; and Tomasetti a 2018-19 WCAC First Team and team captain.

HOME VS. ROAD

- During the 2019-20 season, Mount St. Mary's played 14 contests in Emmitsburg, 15 on the road, and two at neutral sites.
- The Mount split the neutral contests 1-1, carried a 10-4 mark at home and were 9-6 on the road.
- This year the Mountaineers are undefeated at Knott Arena and winless on the road. Scoring has stayed consistent throughout, with the Mount averaging 71 points at home and 69 on the road.

MARIA MARCHESANO BIO

Maria Marchesano was named the sixth head coach in Mount St. Mary's women's basketball history on May 1, 2017.

In charge for three full seasons, Marchesano has orchestrated a full program turnaround, which culminated in her third year. The Mount reached heights not seen in Emmitsburg since the beginning of the century, registering 20 wins and 14 in the NEC - both marks were last achieved in 1999-2000. The team was the best offensive unit in the conference, leading the NEC with an average of 67 points a game along with a .406 field goal percentage. Much of their success came from three-point range, ranking 15th in the nation with 264 shots from downtown. Mount locked up the No. 2 seed thanks to a nine-game win streak lasting the entire month of February. They won in the NEC Quarterfinals before the season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Sophomore Michaela Harrison continued her success with an All-NEC First Team selection, and newcomer Kendall Bresee earned a Third Team nod.

In her first two seasons at the helm, Marchesano guided the squad to a 24-36 overall record and a 14-22 mark in Northeast Conference play. Under Marchesano's guidance, the Mount averaged its most points per game since the 2013-14 season. Marchesano mentored and developed guard Juliette Lawless, who was named the NEC Most Improved Player and earned an All-NEC Third Team Selection and NEC All-Rookie Team members Daly Sullivan and Michaela Harrison.

Marchesano came to the Mount following a stint as an associate head coach at IUPUI, where she helped guide the squad to the most wins in a season in program history in 2016-17, as the Jaguars finished at 24-9 overall and 12-4 in Summit League play. IUPUI made its first appearance in the conference championship game since 2008, and also earned a berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT) to cap off the outstanding season. During the campaign, the Jags collected seven wins versus RPI top-100 teams and earned their highest RPI ranking in program history (53). Marchesano coached three All-Summit League honorees and one Academic All-Summit League member during her season with the Jags.

Prior to her time at IUPUI, Marchesano served for three years as the head coach at Walsh University in North Canton, Ohio. Marchesano led the team to 52 wins during her three seasons, including back-to-back 20-win campaigns in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Cavaliers made two GLIAC Tournament Final Four appearances, won three-straight Mayor's Cup titles, and defeated a pair of Division I teams (Butler & Kent State) during Marchesano's tenure at the helm.

In her final season at Walsh, she guided the Cavaliers to a 20-9 overall record and 16-6 mark in GLIAC play, as they earned home-court advantage for the first time ever in the conference tournament. During the regular season, the Cavaliers registered an upset-victory over third-ranked Ashland University, which was the highest-ranked opponent Walsh had ever defeated as a Division II program.

Marchesano got her first experience as a head coach at Urbana University in Urbana, Ohio midway through the 2011-12 season. She inherited a 2-8 team in January, before turning the season around, guiding the Knights to a 12-7 record after taking over the helm, which included an eight-game winning streak at home. The team qualified for the D-II Ohio Independent Championships, and Marchesano was named the D-II Independent Coach of the Year. The following season, Marchesano led the Knights to a G-MAC Conference Tournament Championship.

Before her time at Urbana, Marchesano served as an assistant coach for both the women's basketball and softball programs at Manchester College in North Manchester, Indiana from 2010-12.

During her collegiate career, Marchesano was a four-year letter winner at Butler University in women's basketball, and also played one season on the softball team. The Fort Wayne, Indiana native was named the Butler Freshman Female Athlete of the Year, earned Horizon League All-Newcomer Team honors, and was a recipient of the Butler Team Community Service Award. Marchesano finished her career as the second-best three-point shooter in program history. Following her collegiate career, she went on to sign three professional basketball contracts and five professional softball contracts in the Italian Federation.
