#### **NEWS & NOTES**

#### **TODAY'S GAME**

- · Two teams afflicted with COVID issues resume their season Thursday, as Mount St. Mary's battles Long Island.
- The Mount have gone 19 days since their last game on December 18, while LIU have been off the court for 24 days, playing Columbia on the 13th.
- · Both sides were forced to forfeit their opening two NEC games. The defeats affect conference records only.
- · Forfeits aside, the Mount is seeking their second straight victory, while LIU eyes their first win since March 1st.

#### **SERIES BITS**

- · Contested since the Mount joined the Northeast Conference, LIU is one of several longtime conference rivals.
- For the first decade, Mount St. Marv's dominated the series, rattling off 23 straight wins. During that span, the Mount's margin of victory was a staggering 19.6 points.
- Since 2001, Long Island has worked the close the gap, maintaining a 24-16 advantage. But over the past three seasons, the Mountaineers reversed the tide by taking five games out of six, including both games last vear.

#### THE MOUNT'S TRACK RECORD

- Mount St. Mary's won its fourth NEC title and third appearance in the NCAA Tournament this past March.
- · Defeating Fairleigh Dickinson and Wagner in the conference championships, the team earned a trip to San Antonio as a No. 15 seed, where they fell to No. 2 Maryland 98-45.
- In their opening contest, the Mount lost to Big East challenger Seton Hall by an 81-68 final in South Orange, then took down Valley Forge in a 102-15 win to open the home schedule.
- Six players recorded career highs in points during the win over the Patriots. Aryna Taylor went 9-for-9 from the floor to score 25 points, and Isabella Hunt earned her first double-double with 15 points and 11 rebounds. Jessica Tomasetti added 20 points for the first time in her college
- Defending Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year Kendall Bresee picks up where she left off last season, leading the Mount in points, rebounds, assists and blocks,
- Michaela Harrison added 20 points against Seton Hall to cross the 1100 point threshold.
- · Using four different starting lineups this season, sophomores Isabella Hunt and Jessica Tomasetti got their first opportunities to play the tip-off, along with freshman Jasmine Lindsay-Huskey on December 4th.

#### **MOUNT ST. MARY'S NEWS AND NOTES**

#### FAMILIAR FACE, NEW TERRITORY

- The 2021-22 season marks the debut for new head coach Antoine White.
- No stranger to the Mount, White began as an assistant under Bryan Whitten, and was elevated to Associate Head Coach while Maria Marchesano was at the helm.
- White handled the defensive scheme, opponent scouts, workouts and player development as the AHC.
- Connections to the Mount family run deep with White, who played for men's coach Dan Engelstad while he was at Southern Vermont. The Montgomery County native is also co-alumni with Engelstad at Walt Whitman High School in Bethesda.

#### IT'S UNANIMOUS!

- For the second straight year, Mount St. Mary's received a first-place vote for all coaches in the Northeast Conference.
- Kendall Bresee also earned a coveted spot on the Preseason All-NEC team as she defends her Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year awards.
- The acknowledgement is the sixth first-place vote in program history. Twice before the Mount came through on the prediction, including last year.

#### COVID CANCELATIONS

- Right before the Christmas break, the Mount was afflicted with several COVID-19 cases, forcing the cancelation of three games.
- The team's final non-conference bout with UMBC was nullified, interrupting an intrastate rival destined for a fourth straight season of battle.
- More damaging was the following week, as the team's first two conference games could not be played. Forfeits were declared per Northeast Conference policy, so the Mount starts NEC play with an 0-2 record. The defeats do not affect overall record or any statistics the team accrues.
- With forfeitures affecting multiple squads, the NEC modified the tournament field, allowing all nine eligible teams to compete. Merrimack is the lone exception, as the Warriors remain in transition to full Division I status.

#### SHATTERING THE RECORD BOOKS

- On November 13th, the Mount defeated Valley Forge 102-15. The victory in their largest margin as well as the fewest points allowed in program history.
- Mount St. Mary's held the Patriots to six points at the half and used a 26-0 first quarter run to pull away early.
- The margin and fewest points allowed replaced the previous mark of 73 and 22, respectively. Both came in the same game when the Mount defeated Hood College (Md.) 95-22 on February 16, 1976.

#### TOUGH STREAK

- Mount St. Mary's dropped six consecutive games dating from Maryland on November 16th to Ohio State on December 7th.
- A challenging schedule is partly to blame as the Mount faced three Power 5 teams and a fellow 2021 NCAA Tournament team in Lehigh during the stretch.
- The dubious distinction is the longest since they dropped six games to open the 2017-2018 season. The longest streak before that was a nine-game slide across January and February of 2015.

#### HOST OF HONORS

- At the 2020-21 season conclusion, five Mountaineers were awarded postseason honors by the NEC. Maria Marchesano earned Coach of the Year in her final year at the Mount.
- Bresee's Player of the Year honor makes her the ninth Mountaineer to be named best in the league and the fourth for top defender. Marchesano is the third person and the sixth time that the Mount was voted to have the best coach.
- Michaela Harrison was named to the All-NEC Second Team, Aryna Taylor placed on the Third Team and Jessica Tomasetti took a spot as a member of the All-Rookie squad.

#### **NEWCOMER HEAVEN**

- Seven new faces join the team for this fall, with five players and two coaches.
- Graduate transfer Tess Borgosz (Towson) headlines the players. Standing 6-foot-4, Borgosz comes to Emmitsburg as a fifth-year and is expected to start at the center position, filling the void left by the departing Rebecca Lee.
- Four true freshmen round out the group, hailing from New Jersey (Maddie McCrea), Maryland (Jasmine Lindsay-Huskey, Abby Bailey) and Virginia (Jaedyn Jamison).
- Newcomers to the coaching staff are Dave Scarborough and Maggie Tien. Scarborough boasts over a decade of experience between several programs, most recently at Sacred Heart, and comes on as an assistant coach. Tien is a recent graduate of Washington Adventist and is in her first-ever role on a college staff, serving as Director of Operations.

#### PURE DOMINATION

 Mount St. Mary's won a lot of games last season in convincing fashion against NEC foes. This included four victories of 20-30 points and another four ranging from 30-40 games. The biggest blowouts of the season came in a pair of 38 point margins on back-to-back days against Bryant. The Mount won the first game 92-54 and the second 87-49.





#### **MOUNT ST. MARY'S NEWS AND NOTES**

#### MIRROR, MIRROR ON THE COURT

- The Northeast Conference introduced a new format for conference games during the 2020-21 season. When the Mount women play at home, the men will play the same opponent on the road, and vice versa.
- One exception is the series with Saint Francis U. The Mount hosts the Red Flash in a doubleheader for Winter Homecoming January 29th, and the women hit the road in an unpaired match to conclude the season on March 3rd.

#### HARRISON'S HIGH BAR

- · Senior guard Michaela Harrison became the 28th Mountaineer all-time to register 1,000 points in a career and the 10th to do in three seasons of play.
- The Cleveland, Ohio native secured the prestigious mark last February 25th in a 59-58 win over Merrimack.
- Entering the season, she stood 23rd on the all-time list with 1,079 points. Harrison needs 319 points to crack the top 10 list for the program.
- Also on her radar is the three-point record for the Mount. Harrison is already second on that list (209 at start) and needs 29 to best Myriam Baccouche's school record. Harrison posseses the game record for triples, earning it last February 20th with nine.

#### KENDALL'S KILLER NUMBERS

- Reigning Player and Defensive Player of the Year Kendall Bresee led the Mount in points per game (13.7), rebounds per game (8.5), assists (100) and steals (50).
- The last person to lead the team in four categories was Alexis Carter in 2015-16. During her junior year, Carter led in PPG, RPG, steals and blocks.
- Despite playing just two seasons in Emmirsburg thus far, Bresee has cracked the record books in several spots. She surpassed the top 50 in scoring, and is top 10 in career rebounds and career assists per game. Bresee is also 11th all-time in double-doubles with 11.

#### SIXTH YEAR STANDOUT

- · Graduate student Kayla Agentowicz is embarking on her sixth season in a college career that has lasted since 2016.
- Debuting on November 12th of that year, Agentowicz obtained extra eligibility via an injury that caused her to miss all of the 2018-19 season, earning her undergraduate degree and getting a year back because of the pandemic.
- Agentowicz has 677 points across 107 games, with 345 rebounds, 143 assists and 114 steals.
- In the team's win over Maryland Eastern Shore, she notched a new career high in three's with five, and was one off her career-best 24 points, set in 2017.

#### TAYLOR FINDS STABILITY

- · Guard Aryna Taylor completed two seasons on the Mount's roster, cracking the starting lineup last year after several setbacks with leg injuries dating back to high school.
- Her All-NEC Third Team selection came after averaging double digits in scoring, posting 11.7 points per game.
- On the final game last season, Taylor scored eight points to register an even 500 points in her collegiate career.

#### CAN I GET A REJECTION?

- One stat line the Mount will be looking to replace is shot blocks. Rebecca Lee graduated last year with the second most rejection in program history with 139, including 39 in her ultimate year.
- With Lee departing the prgoram, the team's leader in blocks is now Michaela Harrison with 33. Newcomer Tess Borgosz had 25 during her career at Towson, Bresee had 14 last year and forward isabella Hunt added six as a freshman.
- So far, the team has stood up to the challenge with 20 blocks, led by Kendall Bresee with six.

#### HIKING OFF THE MOUNTAIN

- In addition to replacing Lee's blocks, along with her 9.7 points and 7.2 rebounds a game, the Mount is searching to replace three-point specialist Bridget Birkhead.
- · Birkhead finished one spot behind Lee in scoring average with 7.2 points a game, including 39 triples. She finished her career with 687 points, was fourth all-time in three pointers (173) and eighth in three point percentage (.360).
- · After playing four years in Emmitsburg, Birkhead is now pursuing a graduate degree at Radford while competing for the Highlanders.

#### HOME VS. ROAD

- · Last season the Mount dominated on their home floor, winning 11 out of 12. The only loss came to NEC semifinalist Fairleigh Dickinson.
- On the road they battled to a 6-5 record, including sweeps of Merrimack and LIU at their gyms.
- Their one neutral game was the NCAA Tournament loss at Maryland.
- For 2021-22, the Mountaineers are nearly split between Emmitsburg and elsewhere, playing 13 times at home and 15 times on the road. There are no neutral games scheduled at this time.
- · Early on in the season, the Mount is looking for their first win away from Knott Arena. They have won two games of three at home.
