NEWS & NOTES

TODAY'S GAME

- Continuing what is a greuling first week to the 2022-23 season, Mount St. Mary's takes on #10 North Carolina State.
- Mount St. Mary's comes in at 0-2, dropping contests to Virginia Tech and Richmond by 40+ point margins.
- N.C. State stands at 2-0, taking victories over Quinnipiac and Elon. The latest win over the Phoenix was the 1,000th in program history.

SERIES BITS

- The Mountaineers and Wolfpack have faced off twice, once in 2004 and again a decade later.
- First facing off at the Saint Peter's Christmas Classic, NCSU won that meeting by an 83-45 score. The second clash happened in Raleigh - a closer 25 point game.
- Had the Mount emerged victorious out of the First Four, N.C. State would've been the next opponent. That makes Sunday the third occasion Mount St. Mary's has competed on the Reynolds Coliseum floor.

THE MOUNT'S TRACK RECORD

- Mount St. Mary's is going for their sixth conference title since joining Division I and third consecutive, winning in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- Top returning guard Michaela Harrison stands 9th on the all-time points list (1,428) and already holds the team record in three-pointers with 273.
- Two more starters - juniors Isabella Hunt and Jessica Tomasetti - also return. Three transfers entered the program, as well as three true freshmen.
- Three-point scoring has been key in recent years as prior teams sit 1st ('19-'20), 2nd ('18-'19), 4th ('17-'18), 5th ('21-'22) and 6th ('20-'21) on the program's list of triples made.
- Coach Antoine White enters his second season at the head coaching helm and seventh with the program overall.
- In their final year as a Northeast Conference program, the Mount went 11-5 in league play and entered the tournament as the No. 3 seed. They defeated #6 Saint Francis U, #4 Wagner, and #7 Bryant to take the crown. All three games were on the team's home court.

MOUNT ST. MARY'S NEWS AND NOTES

A NEW ERA DAWNS

- For the first time since 1989, Mount St. Mary's has a new conference to call home. On May 2, the school formally announced their transition to the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference.
• The MAAC, founded in 1981, consists of 10 rival schools, most of them Catholic institutions, surrounding the Philadelphia, New York and Buffalo metro areas.
• This move completes a 33-year course in the Northeast Conference, where the Mount was a five-time champion.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM?

- Moving to the new conference does not change the Mount's goal of achieving a third consecutive conference title and a trip to the NCAA Tournament.
• In 2021, the Mountaineers took both the NEC regular season and tournament championships, earning a No. 15 seed in the San Antonio battle and a first round showdown with Maryland.
• Last year, the team rose from the third seed in the NEC tournament to a repeat trip to the Big Dance. This team went to Raleigh, N.C., falling to Longwood at Reynolds Coliseum.

FIRST AMONG THE FIRST FOUR

- By virtue of winning the NEC crown last year, the Mount got the opportunity to compete in the inaugural First Four for the women's tournament, coinciding with the field's expansion to 68 teams.
• In the game against Longwood, the Mount had to dig themselves out of a hole despite dressing seven athletes due to injury trouble.
• Down as many as 22, the team shot an impressive 70.8 percent from the field in the second half but the comeback fell four points short in a 74-70 final.

SURVEYING THE COMPETITION

- Teams on the schedule went a combined 256-316 last year, and 17 of the 19 squads have met Mount St. Mary's before on the Hardwood.
• Because of the conference shift, only one team - Loyola - faced the Mount during the 2021-22 season.
• Iona and East Tennessee State will square off with the Mount for the first time. The ETSU contest on December 22nd takes place on neutral ground, as the Harrah's Cherokee Casino serving as hosts.
• The other nine MAAC schools have had prior engagements with the Mountaineers. The latest came against Rider in 2018 - an 85-67 victory for the Broncos.

CLIMBING THE RECORD BOOKS

- Returning for a fifth season, graduate student Michaela Harrison seeks to continue advancing in the record books.
• Already the record holder for the most three-pointers in school history at 269, she stands 10th on the all-time list with

1,413 points. It's a long way to the top spot with 539 points to go, but the No. 2 spot (Kim Rhock, 1,808) is attainable.
• Harrison is projected to also pass Kayla Agentowicz in games played, needing to compete for half the season to achieve that record.

NEW COACHES

- Julie Kaufman and Dave Scarborough vacated the spots to accept head coaching positions. Kaufman is the head coach at Division II Shepherd and Scarborough returns to his native Pittsburgh, working at NAI's Point Park.
• In their places are two new assistants. Former Saint Francis University head coach Joe Haigh joins the staff, and veteran of the Division II HBCU circuit Nicole Graham embarks on her first Division I job.
• Coach Antoine White retained Assistant Coach Kelsey Funderburgh as well as Director of Operations Maggie Tien.

VETERAN PRESENCES

- Along with Harrison, seven Mountaineers are back with the team for another season.
• Starters Isabella Hunt and Jessica Tomasetti cracked the top 100 in scoring in program history at the end of the campaign. Hunt ended the year averaging 6.6 points and six rebounds per game. Tomasetti finished at 6.5 points, 3.2 rebounds and 45 assists.
• Before suffering a lower body injury in the tournament, Aryna Taylor was averaging 9.4 points per game and had reached 10th all-time at the Mount for made three pointers with 130.
• Jasmine Lindsay-Huskey averaged 3.5 points as a freshman and is due to return from an injury suffered after 21 games played.
• Jada Lee proved vital off the bench, especially when the Mount's roster became depleted. Lee averaged 3.3 points and 2.3 rebounds in 28 games played.

TAKING ON TRANSFERS

- A trio of new players arrive in Emmitsburg via the transfer window.
• Jo Raflo comes from Presbyterian after competing one season with the Blue Hose. The Gainesville, Virginia product played in 26 games and scored 48 points, including nine in the team's win over St. Thomas.
• Natalie Villafior is using her fifth year after an undergraduate career spent at Robert Morris. Over 106 contests in a Colonials uniform, she registered 387 points, 270 rebounds and 67 steals.
• Kemia Ward is a rising junior after two seasons at Austin Peay. Across 30 games from the Governors, she tallied 108 points and 86 rebounds. 82 of those points and 70 rebounds came in her freshman season.





MOUNT ST. MARY'S NEWS AND NOTES

COMING IN FRESH

In addition to the transfers, three true freshmen will also join the team. Carissa Dunham is a guard from Erie, Pennsylvania, Giana Hoddinott is a guard from Adams County and McKenzie Matheny is a forward from Virginia.

NOTEWORTHY DEPARTURES

- Two key starters ended their Mount careers with last year's title winning run.
Former NEC Player of the Year Kendall Bresee put the finishing touches on a splendid career, leading the team in points (14.9 per game), rebounds (7.3) and adding 111 assists with 26 blocks.
The steady presence of Kayla Agentowicz will also be missed. Making 29 appearances with 28 starts, the sixth year player surpassed the all-time games played record with 126 contests notched.
Tess Borgosz also departs after a graduate season, transferring from Towson. The 6-4 post player dined with 93 points and 70 rebounds.

A COMPLEX HISTORY

- Against the MAAC, Mount St. Mary's holds a 16-21 overall record, going back to 1989 when that unit defeated Niagara by a 79-73 final.
Knott Arena is where most games have been won, as the Mount boasts a 12-6 record in Emmitsburg.
The Mountaineers have three road wins - Loyola (1989, 1991) and Rider (2012).

HOME VS. ROAD

- Games are an even 14-14 split, with the 29th contest held at a neutral site.
The fourth contest will be the home opener when the Mount hosts Navy November 19th.
Conference play begins December 17th at Manhattan, with the home debut arriving two days later with Siena on the 19th.
In 2021-22, the Mount went 11-4 at Knott Arena, 5-8 away from home and 0-1 in neutrality, with the First Four contest marking that occasion.

In his first season, he guided an already accomplished team to another successful campaign. After securing a third-place finish in the regular season, the Mountaineers won three straight games in the Northeast Conference Tournament to advance to their second straight NCAA Tournament.

Promoted to Associate Head Coach in the summer of 2019, White is entering his sixth season on the Mount's women's basketball staff. While an associate, he handled the Mount's defensive scheme while also being in charge of opponent scouts during the season.

White graduated in May of 2016 from Southern Vermont College in Bennington, Vt., where he rounded out his career as the Mountaineers' all-time career assists leader with 242 in 59 games played (4.1 ast/g).

Prior to his time at Southern Vermont College, White worked as a coach with the KOA Sports travel team, and as the head JV coach and assistant varsity coach at his alma mater, Walt Whitman High School, in Bethesda.
