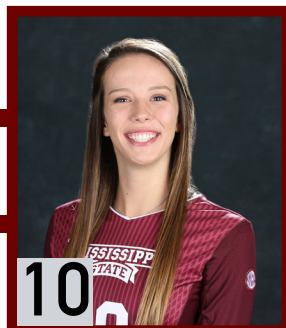

Bulldogs Return In 2016 Looking For More ...

There's no doubt that 2015 was a special year for the Mississippi State Bulldogs. With year two of the David McFatrach era now here, expectations are high for the Maroon and White. State returns 10 players, including four starters and libero, while adding a number of talented newcomers.

The Bulldogs will be tested out of the gate, as they face No. 5 Kansas in the season opener. It stands as the second top 5 opponent MSU has faced in the last year, as they took on No. 1 Penn State last season in the Golden Dome Invitational.

Going For 100 At #TheGriss ...

Mississippi State has called Newell-Grissom home for the last 19 year and as the Bulldogs enter the 20th season at The Griss, they'll be searching for a milestone victory very soon. With one home win, MSU will earn its 100th victory in program history at the venue.

Seniors Set To Lead The Way ...

All five seniors on the 2016 MSU squad will serve important leadership roles this season, as head coach David McFatrach announced that all five will be named team captains. Chelsea Duhs, Jazmyne Johnson, Bali Leffall-Young, Evie Grace Singleton and Cheyenne Spell will serve as the team's leaders this season. Singleton was also named team captain last season.

MSU Closes Out 2015 In Dominating Fashion ...

Facing their in-state rival in the season finale, the Bulldogs took down Ole Miss to the tune of 3-1 to secure their first winning season since 2006. It marked the first time since 2009 that MSU defeated Ole Miss in back-to-back matches.

2015 Bulldog Milestones ...

- First consecutive wins against Ole Miss for the first time since 2009
- Secured first winning season since 2006 and only the ninth in school history
- Earned three-straight SEC wins for the first time since 2007
- Tallied back-to-back home wins against LSU for the first time in program history
- Tied for most wins in program history since 2010 with 10
- Third largest crowd in Newell-Grissom history (Aug. 28 vs. UAPB/ULM, 1,018)
- First home non-conference title since 2013 (Maroon Classic)
- Won two non-conference tournament titles for first time since 2010

Non-Conference Domination ...

Last year saw the Bulldogs have tremendous success on the non-conference circuit, as the Bulldogs finished out non-conference play in 2015 with 11 wins (11-3). The 11 wins are the most single-season non-conference wins since 2000 (13). State will take on a total of 14 non-conference matches this season.

State was near unstoppable in 2015 when leading matches in kills, blocks, aces and hitting percentage. However, when failing to do so, it was a tough road for the Bulldogs.

Bulldog Set Points

Defense Has Been Bulldogs' Calling Card ...

As shown below, opponent hitting percentage has been the staple statistic for the Bulldog defense this season. When holding opponents below a .200 hitting clip, State is 14-2, including a perfect 9-0 when keeping their foes below .100.

First Set Is The Key...And The Second Doesn't Hurt Either ...

State was 16-4 in 2015 when winning the opening set. They are also 15-4 when winning the second frame and 14-2 when winning both the first and second sets.

Harris Chasing The MSU's Digs Record ...

Sophomore **Payton Harris** has already hit the 1,000 digs mark for her career and has her sights set on the school record of 1,707, which is held by Melissa Kariker (1993-96). Harris currently has 1,169 career digs, putting her in 10th place and 13 away from ninth.

Singleton Served Up Excellence In 2015 ...

When **Evie Grace Singleton** arrived at State, her serving prowess was already nationally known. The MSU junior has kept that rolling, standing first in the SEC in aces per set (0.43) and second in total aces (43), while standing 31st and 48th nationally in both, respectively.

New Kids On The Block ...

The Bulldogs added four new faces to the roster and three are poised to make their debut this weekend during the Bulldog Invitational. Freshmen Riley Duzenack and Emily Hill, along with junior transfer Jelena Vujcin, will be looked upon as key members of the 2016 squad. Fellow freshman Liv Benner will be sidelined for the year as she recovers from an ACL injury suffered in the spring.

State Adds West Coast Talent ...

As previously noted, one of the Bulldogs' new additions for the 2016 season is junior transfer Jelena Vujcin. The Seattle transfer was a stud for the Redhawks, as she earned All-WAC Second Team honors last team and landed on the All-WAC Freshman Team in her first season.

A Look At The 2016 Roster ...

McFatrigh's second year in Starkville brings a squad of 14 total players with 10 returning letterwinners and seven newcomers. Of those 10 returners, five are seniors (**Anderton, Amber Gass, Emily Howard, Ellen Stuart and Warren**). Of the seven newcomers, five are freshmen, while two (**Jazmyne Johnson** and **Singleton**) are junior transfers.

Nicholson A Warrior On The Court ...

Freshman middle **Katie Nicholson** has overcome a number of injuries in her young career to remain playing the game she loves. In the past two years, she has completely torn her ACL, fractured the end of her femur bone and torn her meniscus three times, twice in 2014 and once in 2015.

Sato, The First Family Of Volleyball ...

Freshman setter **Blossom Sato** comes from a long line of volleyball greatness and will look to continue her family's excellence as she begins her rookie campaign at MSU.

Sato's mother, Liane, lettered at San Diego State from 1985-86 and was a member of the U.S. Women's National Volleyball Team in 1988 and 1992, when the U.S. won the bronze medal.

Her uncle, Eric Sato, was a member of the 1988 U.S. Men's National Team that claimed gold and the 1992 squad that earned bronze. Her other uncle, Gary Sato, lettered at UC-Santa Barbara as an All-American outside hitter and served as the U.S.'s head coach in the 1985 FIVB World Cup gold medal finish. Sato has over 20 years of coaching experience for the USVMNT. Gary Sato's son and Blossom's cousin, Andrew, is a star libero at Long Beach State.

Trading In Basketball For Volleyball ...

When **Singleton** began her athletics career, she was a major fan of the sport of basketball, what she claims as her "first love." When **McFatrigh** first saw her play volleyball, he knew her future was in one of the most widely played sports in the world. A couple of conversations and some convincing later, McFatrigh had Singleton sold on focusing solely on volleyball and its been golden ever since.

A Little Texas Flavor ...

Of the 14 on the MSU roster for the season, six call the state of Texas home, the most of any place represented on the Bulldog team. Coming in second is California, which has three on the Maroon and White.

With only one year leading the Maroon and White under his belt, David McFatrigh has already cemented himself as one of the greatest coaches in Mississippi State volleyball history.

McFatrigh, who directed Central Arkansas to NCAA Tournament appearances in two of his four seasons as head coach, was named the 11th head coach in Mississippi State volleyball history on January 12, 2015 and since then has led the Bulldogs to one of the most successful seasons in over a decade.

When MSU athletic director Scott Stricklin announced the hire of McFatrigh, he knew success was imminent for the volleyball Bulldogs.

"David possesses all of the characteristics of a successful coach," said Stricklin. "He has an aggressive style with high energy and connects well with his student-athletes. He has the vision to be great. He's also a man of good values, and we are excited to have him as a part of the Mississippi State family."

In his first season at the helm, McFatrigh led the Bulldogs to a 17-15 record, posting the first winning season at State since 2006 and becoming the first head coach in MSU history to finish with a winning record in their first year. His 17-15 record also matched the finish in his first year at Central Arkansas and marks the best season by a head coach in their first year with the volleyball Bulldogs.

The 17 wins marked the most for MSU since 2006, while the six SEC wins were the most since winning seven conference games in 2011.

McFatrigh's Bulldogs started off the season on a hot streak, winning six of their first seven matches and 10 of their first 13, both the best starts since 2006. During that hot start, MSU captured the Maroon Classic and Tiger Invitational championships, marking the first time since 2010 that the Bulldogs won multiple non-conference titles in a season. Included in the Maroon Classic title was McFatrigh's 100th-career victory, which came in a sweep of Stetson on Sept. 4.

State kept the good times rolling in Oxford, as McFatrigh's squad snapped a six-match losing streak to Ole Miss with a 3-0 victory. The sweep again pointed back to the success in 2006, which is the last time the Bulldogs had done so against the Rebels. It was also only the third time in school history that State had swept its in-state rivals in Oxford, the other two coming in 2005 and 1975.

McFatrigh led his squad to a number of other historical accomplishments during the rigorous SEC slate. MSU's sweep of Georgia on Oct. 11 snapped an eight-match losing streak to UGA and marked the first sweep of Georgia for MSU since 1979. McFatrigh and his Bulldogs would go on to sweep Georgia later in the season, marking the first season sweep and back-to-back wins against Georgia since 2006-07. It was also State's first win in Athens since 2010 and only the fifth in school history.

The Bulldogs would close the season with three-straight SEC wins, the first time MSU has won three-straight league matches since 2007. A 3-0 home win against LSU marked the first time in school history that State has defeated LSU in Starkville two-straight times. The season-ending 3-1 win against Ole Miss gave MSU its first back-to-back wins against the Rebels since 2009.

McFatrigh's team was also dominant on the non-conference side of the schedule. Along with its two non-conference titles, the Bulldogs finished the non-SEC part of the schedule with 11 wins, the most single-season non-conference wins since earning 13 in 2000.

With his high-energy style of play, McFatrigh helped MSU improve greatly in seven different offensive categories. After posting 1,269 kills (10.57 K/S) in 2014, McFatrigh's up-tempo offense improved State's numbers to 1,393 kills (12.55 K/S) in 2015. McFatrigh's leadership also helped State make major jumps in its setting and serving games, going from 1,184 assists (9.87 A/S) and 115 service aces (0.96 SA/S) in 2014 to 1,308 assists (11.78 A/S) and 158 service aces (1.42 SA/S) in his first season.

State made its biggest showing from the service line, where its 1.42 aces per set stood second in the SEC and its 158 total aces finished fourth. Leading the

way for State from the service line was Evie Grace Singleton, one of McFatrigh's Central Arkansas stars who made the journey to Starkville with him. Singleton led MSU with 46 aces (2nd SEC, 26th NCAA) and a 0.43 aces per set average (1st SEC, 20th NCAA). McFatrigh's star junior also stood top 10 in the SEC in kills (378, 6th), kills per set (3.53, 6th), points per set (4.13, 6th) and points (441.5, 8th).

McFatrigh's influence can be seen in the classroom as well, as the leader of the Bulldogs constantly preaches relentless effort in all aspects of life. The Bulldogs landed five players on the All-SEC Academic Honor Roll in his first season, which is the most on the team since MSU placed five in 2011. The Bulldogs posted a 3.44 GPA in the spring, which set a number of impressive marks, including the highest GPA amongst all MSU sports for the 2015-16 year. The spring semester GPA, led by seven players who posted career-best GPA's in that span, also marked the fourth-best semester in program history.

One Bulldog landed on the 4.0 List (Riley Duzenack), while four earned President's List honors (Duzenack, Emily Howard, Katie Nicholson and Ellen Stuart) and two placed on the Dean's List (Savannah Cressman and Chelsea Duhs).

McFatrigh has also made an impact off the court. On the recruiting trail, McFatrigh and his staff have signed a number of talented stars that will join the Maroon and White, including seven Bulldogs that played important roles during the successful 2015 season. The Bulldogs' home, Newell-Grissom Building, has also seen a number of improvements since McFatrigh's arrival. State's locker room and playing court underwent major renovations and included the addition of a team film room.

In his four seasons at the helm of the Sugar Bears, McFatrigh showed no fear in going toe-to-toe with the nation's elite, annually facing programs such as Penn State, Washington, Florida State, Kansas and Oklahoma. Over the past four years, he has amassed an overall record of 96-36 (.727) with a Southland Conference record of 56-11 (.839).

Also upon his arrival in 2007, UCA's RPI was in the 240's. Since then, the Sugar Bears climbed up to an RPI as high as 44th nationally.

Arriving at UCA in 2007 as an assistant, McFatrigh earned a promotion to head coach of the Sugar Bears in 2011. In his eight total seasons, he saw UCA capture nearly 200 victories, a rate of 25 per season.

McFatrigh saw his biggest success the last three years, tallying a record of 46-6 (.885) and a Southland Tournament record of 9-2 (.818). The Sugar Bears averaged nearly 27 wins per season, while piling up numerous championships to help build McFatrigh's legacy as one of the nation's up-and-coming coaches.

In his eight years at UCA, McFatrigh, the 2013 Southland Coach of the Year, produced four Southland Conference Regular Season Championships, two Southland Conference Tournament Championships and four Southland East Division crowns. Individually, McFatrigh has produced one ESPN Academic All-American, five Southland Conference Players of the Year, two Southland Liberos of the year, three Southland Freshman of the Year and five Southland Setters of the Year. In addition, Sugar Bear players have captured numerous conference player of the week awards. Twenty-two UCA players have been named All-Southland Conference, with 19 of those earning first-team laurels.

Most recently, McFatrigh faced a tall task in 2014 after the graduation of six players, but took the challenge head on. The Sugar Bears played for a berth in the NCAA Tournament for the third-straight season in the Southland Conference tournament finals and reached the 20-win milestone for the seventh time in his eight years with the program.

In 2014, McFatrigh's Sugar Bears extend the program's conference winning streak

to 38-consecutive matches dating back to 2012, which stands as the longest such streak in Southland Conference history.

McFatrigh and UCA finished out 2013 in grand style as the Sugar Bears won their second-straight Southland Conference regular season title, their second-straight conference tournament championship and made their second-straight appearance in the NCAA Tournament. UCA posted a 29-4 record, highlighted by a victory against No. 9 Kansas. That squad became the first Southland team in 23 years to capture the regular season and tournament titles in back-to-back years.

Along the way, the Sugar Bears boasted one of the longest winning streaks in the nation at 22 matches, while also finishing the regular season ranked No. 17 in the Volleyblog Seattle Poll and No. 44 in the RPI.

In 2012, McFatrigh led UCA to a 30-5 ledger and Southland Conference regular season and tournament titles. The season saw UCA capture a win against Big 12 foe Texas Tech and earn the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament.

Spanning from 2012-14, McFatrigh led the Sugar Bears to 38-straight victories in conference play, the longest such record in Southland Conference history. Also, McFatrigh's 59 total victories between the 2012-13 seasons stood only second to NCAA national champion Penn State for wins during that span.

Success in the classroom has also been prevalent in McFatrigh's time at Central Arkansas. From 2011-13, UCA volleyball earned a perfect NCAA Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 1,000. In that time, UCA has also placed a number of players on the Southland All-Academic team, including the 2012 Student-Athlete of the Year, which recognizes the top student-athlete both on and off the court.

Prior to being named head coach at Central Arkansas, McFatrigh spent four seasons as an assistant coach of the Sugar Bears under three-time Southland Coach of the Year, Steven McRoberts. From 2007-10, McFatrigh oversaw a number of successes at UCA, as the program was elevated into the national spotlight. The year before McFatrigh arrived at UCA, the Sugar Bears finished 19-17. In his four seasons as an assistant, UCA went 103-27. Also in that time, UCA saw 14 All-Southland honors, 12 Academic All-Southland honors, three Southland Players of the Year, three Southland Freshmen of the Year and the 2009 ESPN The Magazine Second-Team Academic All-American.

McFatrigh is the former Captain & Setter for the 1988 Athletes In Action International Volleyball Team. Touring throughout Latin America, he helped lead the team to a 23-2 record. He has four gold and two silver medals as a member of the Canada Masters Volleyball Team (2009-present), which competes in the U.S. Open each summer. They also finished fifth in the World Masters Games in the summer of 2013.

McFatrigh, a graduate of the University of Arkansas, earned a Bachelor's of Science in business administration in 1986 and a Master's Degree in exercise science in 1988. A native of Woodbridge, Va., he and his wife Sonya have three children, Luke (18), Elle (15) and Sami (11).

for Bulldog student-athletes. Likewise, the training room, locker room, practice facility and apartment/dormitory areas are considered private player areas and are off-limits to the media.

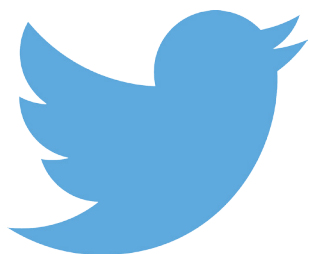
