THE COACHES: Denver Johnson was named the 13th head coach in Missouri Southern history on April 1, 2015. He came to Southern after serving four seasons at the University of Tulsa as the Assistant Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator.

Now in his second year at MSSU, in 2015, Johnson started the re-building process of a program that he intends to be one built on depth. The team had seven named All-MIAA, but more importantly, he increased the roster by more than 40 players, providing that depth he desires.

In his four seasons at Tulsa, four of his offensive linemen earned first-team all-league accolades, while Tyler Holmes was an honorable mention performer in 2011 and spent the 2012 season with the Minnesota Vikings.

Johnson coached an offensive line that helped pave the way for a 1,000-yard rusher in two of his final three seasons at Tulsa. In 2012, Tulsa's offense ranked fourth nationally for fewest sacks allowed, ninth for rushing offense, 21st for fewest tackles for lost yardage allowed and 28th for total offense.

Johnson has spent a total of 31 years coaching college football. In the summer of 2012, Johnson was awarded the Merv Johnson Integrity in College Coaching Award by the Jim Thorpe Association.

An All-Missouri Valley Conference offensive lineman as a senior for Tulsa, Johnson was an eighth-round draft choice by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 1981. He spent two years (1981-82) with the Bucs and three seasons in the USFL, playing two years (1983-84) with the Los Angeles Express and the 1985 season with the Houston Gamblers. Johnson's USFL tenure included playing stints with NFL Hall of Fame quarterbacks Jim Kelly and Steve Young. Johnson earned his bachelor's degree in business management from Tulsa in 1981. He and his wife, Danita Kay, have two daughters: Taylor and Kelsey.

Chris Brown Chris Brown enters his sixth season as head coach at Fort Hays State in 2016. He has guided FHSU to 30 wins in five years and coached Fort Hays State to a bowl appearance in 2015 with an 8-4 mark, tying the school record for wins in a season. He is 30-26 overall as a collegiate head coach.

Brown guided FHSU to its highest placing in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association in 2015 with an 8-3 mark, finishing third in the standings. The Tigers earned a spot in the Mineral Water Bowl in Excelsior Springs, Mo. It marked the first postseason game for FHSU Football since the 1996 season.

Brown helped Washburn compile a 62-41 record in his nine-year span with the program, which included two NCAA playoff appearances and two bowl wins.

In his time at Washburn as defensive coordinator, Brown coached the 2009 and 2006 MIAA Most Valuable Defensive Players.

THE SERIES: The series between the two teams is tied at 13-13-1. The Lions have a 6-6 record at Hughes Stadium and are 7-7-1 at Lewis Field in Hays. The two teams renewed their series in 2006 for the first time since 1988, with the Tigers snapping a season-long losing streak with a 10-0 win over Southern. Prior to that, the last time for the two to meet was when both schools were a member of the NAIA Central States Intercollegiate Conference. Southern won that game 21-10. Southern has won nine of the last 13 games against the Tigers, dating back to the 1983 season.

LIONS IN THE MIAA POLL: The Missouri Southern football team has been picked to finish tenth by the coaches and 11th by the media as the MIAA announced its pre-season polls today at Children's Mercy Park in Kansas City.

The Lions return 41 letter winners and 14 starters from last year including eight starters on offense and three on defense. Leading the way on offense is junior quarterback TJ Fleeton as the Daphne, Ala. native started in eight games and played in all 11 last year. He went 175-322 for 1,975 yards and eight touchdowns. The team also returns four starting wide receivers including seniors Chad Nolan, Terrell Crawford and Jordan Morrison, as well as sophomore Carson Day.

On the defensive side of the ball, Ricky Green and Chris Goss III return as starters in the backfield, while Stephan Randall returns as a starter at tackle. Randall started all 11 games, recording 37 stops, 4.5 for a loss of 13 yards and 1.5 sacks. Green is the top returning tackler from 2016 with 57, as well as 4.5 for a loss. Goss III had 51 tackles, a sack and an interception.

Defending national champion Northwest Missouri was picked to finish first in both the coaches and media polls. The top four in both polls were the same with Northwest at one, Central Missouri at two, Pittsburg State was third in both polls, but shared third place with Emporia in the coaches poll. The Hornets were fourth in the media poll.

Rounding out the poll for the coaches were Central Oklahoma at five, followed by Fort Hays State, Missouri Western, Washburn, Northeastern State, Southern, Nebraska-Kearney and Lindenwood.

Fort Hays State was fifth in the media poll, followed by Central Oklahoma, Missouri Western, Washburn, Lindenwood, Northeastern State, Southern and Nebraska-Kearney.

THE DISH ON THE TIGERS: The Tigers were 8-4 last year and were tied for third place in the MIAA with an 8-3 overall record, falling in the final game of the season to Minnesota-Duluth at the Mineral Water Bowl.

Hays is receiving votes in the preseason AFCA Coaches Poll and return six starters on offense, however the bulk of its offense from a season prior is gone as Shaquille Cooper is the only Tiger to return with an offensive touchdown from 2015. Cooper rushed for 1,441 yards on 245 carries, while catching 37 passes for 309 yards. He had nine rushing and five receiving scores. Sophomore quarterback Jacob Mezera will be making his first start under center for the Tigers and he threw four passes last year for 12 yards.

Cooper is the leading returning receiver from 2015 but Isaiah Maxi and Tyler Bacon both caught double-digit passes in 2015.

Defensively, the Tigers return nine starters and 15 total on defense. Doyin Jibowu leads the way with 91 tackles and seven tackles for a loss, while Sie Doe Jr. had 70 stops and 15 tackles behind the line to go with 6.5 sacks. Alex Schmidtberger had 85 tackles and 2.5 sacks.

The Tigers will be at Central Missouri in week two of the MIAA season.

LION TIDBITS

A VICTORY VS. FORT HAYS STATE WOULD: stop a three-game winning streak for the Tigers. It would give the Lions and the Tigers a split of the previous eight meetings.

NFL REPRESENTATION: The Lions will have two different starters on NFL rosters to start the season. Brandon Williams is a starter on the defensive line for the Baltimore Ravens, while Allen Barbre will start on the offensive line for the Philadelphia Eagles.

NFL LEADERS: Brandon Williams has become a leader on the defense for the Baltimore Ravens, shoring their defensive line. Last year, the third-year pro had a career-high 52 tackles and two sacks. He was listed by many as a notable snub for the NFL Pro Bowl in 2015. Allen Barbre will be in his second year as a starter on the offensive line for the Eagles and head coach Doug Pedersen is very high on Barbre, naming him the starter prior to training camp. Barbre started all 16 games for the Eagles in 2015.

NFL EXECUTIVE: Former Lion and former NFL wide receiver James Thrash is in his second season serving as the NFL and NFLPA's Appeals Officer. He hears all appeals for the NFL regarding on-field player discipline. Thrash played 12 seasons in the NFL for the Washington Redskins and Philadelphia Eagles.

LIONS ON RADIO: The Lions will partner with ESPN Joplin this year as Southern can now be heard on three separate FM stations, as well as an AM station. ESPN Joplin will air the Lions' games on 101.3 and 103.5 FM, as well as AM 1560. MSSU's KXMS 88.7 will also simulcast the games giving the Lions a larger reach in the four-states than they've ever had.

TOUGH LEAGUE/REGION: The MIAA has three teams in the coaches top 25 this week. Northwest Missouri is 1st, while Central Missouri is 20th and Emporia State is 24th. The Super Region Three, which the Lions are a part of, has nine teams in the top 25. There are 17 teams total that are either ranked or receiving votes in the poll from the region.

NEW COACHES: Bill Bleil (offensive line) and Darius Hart (defensive line) will join the Lions this year on coach Denver Johnson's staff. Bleil comes to Southern from the University of Rhode Island, while Hart previously coached at Trinity Valley Community College.

MIAA PRESEASON POLL: Missouri Southern was picked 10th by the coaches and 11th by the media in the annual MIAA Preseason Poll the league released in early August. Defending National Champion Northwest Missouri was the pick by both the coaches and the media to repeat as League champs.

CALL ME A HALL OF FAMER: Allen Barbre will go into the Missouri Southern Athletics Hall of Fame this year. Barbre was a multiple All-American offensive lineman in his four-year career for the Lions and is now a starter with the Philadelphia Eagles.

EXPANDED ROSTER: Last season, the Lions carried between 80-90 players on their roster and that provided depth issues for the team. This year, Southern has between 130-140 players, much more to the liking of head coach Denver Johnson.

QB COMPETITION: The Lions had a pair of D-I transfers battling it out in spring and fall camp for the starting quarterback job. Memphis transfer Brayden Scott and last year's starter TJ Fleton (Northwestern State) went head-to-head and Fleton has been named the starter.

WELCOME BACK: Southern welcomed back a pair of former starters to the lineup after both had sat out last year with an injury. Lars Lindquist and Scott Lathrop are both back, but both are playing different positions. Lindquist has moved to the offensive line after serving as a starter on the other side, while Lathrop will move from quarterback to receiver.

FORT HAYS 42, @ SOUTHERN 31

Joplin, Mo. -- The Missouri Southern football team out gained visiting Fort Hays State 493-445 tonight, but the Tigers scored points when they needed and defeated the Lions 42-31 tonight on Senior Night at Fred G. Hughes Stadium inside the Robert W. Plaster Sports Complex.

Southern (1-9, 1-9 MIAA) was led offensively by TJ Fleton as the sophomore quarterback went 36-55 for 344 yards and two touchdowns, while gaining 36 yards on the ground and a touchdown. Will Gregory had 114 yards on the ground and a score. Carson Day had ten catches for 88 yards, while Gregory caught five passes for 56 yards out of the backfield. Chad Nolan had two touchdown passes on 35 yards, while Jordan Morrison caught five passes for 87 yards.

Hays (7-3, 7-3 MIAA) was led by the tandem of Shaquill Cooper and Treveon Albert. Albert threw for 257 yards on 13-23 and three touchdowns, while Cooper gained 99 yards and a score.

Defensively, the Lions were led by 14 tackles from Johnquavious McBride. Kyjuan Tate had 10 stops, while Ryan Solomon had seven tackles and a sack. Michael Burks had an interception.

The Lions stopped the Tigers on their first possession, but on the first play from scrimmage on the ensuing Southern drive, a fumble was picked up by Hays and returned eight yards for a touchdown. A touchdown rush from Albert with 5:55 left in the first made the score 14-0, before a 19-yard field goal from Brock Renken made the score at the end of the first 14-3.

Hays added another touchdown, this time from Cooper to go up 21-3, but a touchdown pass from Fleton to Nolan made the score 21-10 and that is how the first half would end.

A fumble on the Lions' opening possession of the second half set up a FHSU scoring drive that resulted in Albert hitting Bilal Salat for 37 yards to go up 28-10. Another touchdown pass for Hays made it 35-10, before a Fleton rushing touchdown near the end of the third quarter made the score 35-17.

Hays got its last score early in the fourth when Albert hit Cooper for a 29-yard score. The Lions tacked on two more scores, a 13-yard rushing score from Gregory and a ten-yard pass from Fleton to Nolan to make the final tally.

Southern gained 344 yards in the air and 149 on the ground. The Lions had six more first downs (30-24) in the game than Hays and time of possession was nearly equal.

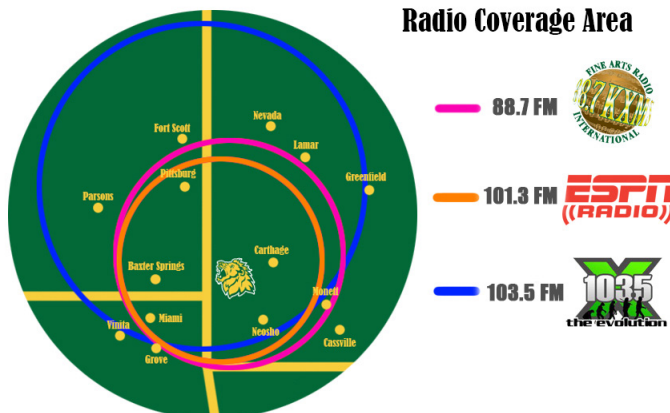
