Lacy Stokes: In division II ranks third in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.65), fifth in assists per game (6.2), eighth in free throws attempted (74), ninth in assists (62), 14th in steals per game (3.10), 15th in steals (31) and 20th in free throws made (51).

QUICK HITS PT.1

Bearcats Scout

Northwest Missouri was picked to finish ninth in the MIAA preseason polls after going 7-15 last year to finish ninth in MIAA standings. This season the Bearcats are off to a 9-2 start and 4-1 in MIAA action going 6-1 inside Bearcat Arena. Molly Hartnett was the MIAA Freshman of the Year last season and is averaging 10.7 points and 2.3 rebounds a game while dishing out a team-high 31 assists. Mallory McConkey was an All-MIAA honorable mention last season and is averaging 11.1 points and 4.7 rebounds per game while shooting .538 from the field. Peyton Kelderman is the deep threat going 23-70 from three while averaging 9.2 points and 3.4 rebounds a game. Against Missouri Western the Bearcats defended Bearcat Arena with a 49-46 win behind a collective effort as they have had back-to-back game with no Bearcat scoring in double figures.

Griffions Soaring

Missouri Western was picked to finish eighth in the MIAA preseason polls after going 6-16 last year to finish 11th in the MIAA standings. This season the Griffions are off to a 10-1 start and are 4-1 in MIAA action behind a perfect 8-0 record inside the MWSU Fieldhouse. Corbyn Cunningham leads the charge averaging 14.4 points and 7.4 rebounds a game. Connie Clarke leads the team with 9.5 rebounds a game while scoring 11.3 points. Graduate transfer from Northwest Missouri Jaelyn Haggard is the threat from deep and leads all bench scorers going 24-60 from three and averages 9.9 points per game. The only setback of the season came against Northwest Missouri before bouncing back with a school record 120-49 win over Saint Mary (kan.) on December 29th at home.

Well Rested And Ready To Play

Coming into the match up with the Bearcats the Lions have been waiting two weeks for game day following three games in a week to close out December action.

2021-22 Preseason MIAA Polls

The Lions were picked to finish 9th in the MIAA Coaches Poll and 10th in the Media Poll after going 9-14 overall and 9-13 in MIAA play during the 2020-21 campaign. The defending MIAA regular season champions Fort Hays State was picked to win the conference in both the media and coaches poll this season. Central Missouri who made it to the Final Four this past season was picked second in the coaches and tied with Fort Hays for first in the media poll. Picked third and fourth in both polls were Nebraska-Kearney and Emporia State. Each of the top-four teams made it to the Central Regional Tournament this past season. Rounding out the top eight teams were Central Oklahoma, Washburn, Pittsburg State and Missouri Western in both polls.

That's A Lot Of Games

The Lions' are on a streak of 616 games of having made at least one made three. The last game where they were shutout was Nov. 20, 1999 in Tahlequah, Okla playing Southern Arkansas losing 68-53.

All-MIAA

Madi Stokes was an All-MIAA honorable and All-Defensive Team selection last season after being the only player to average a double-double and ended the regular season leading the conference in blocks.

To The Extreme Stokes

This season the Lions will have two student-athletes with the last name Stokes (no relation) and they are the shortest and tallest player on the roster in Madi Stokes (6' 3") and Lacy Stokes (5'4").

Running It Back Again

Mount Vernon high school product Lacy Stokes has a familiar face to play with again as Cameron Call transferred to MSSU from Division I Illinois State. The pair were part of three consecutive district championships at Mount Vernon high school, before Lacy led the Mountaineers to a Class 4 Runners-up finish this past season. Call holds the three-point record with 210 made in her high school career and in her junior season connected on 91 threes a school record. Stokes as a senior averaged 25.8 points, 6.5 rebounds, 5.2 assists and 6.1 steals per game, had over 100 wins in her high school career and have over 2,000 points at point guard.

Madi Is Stoked To Block You

Sophomore center Madi Stokes had a freshman campaign to remember as a defensive force down low. The Cassville, Missouri native had 33 blocks during the 2019-20 season finishing fifth in the MIAA overall and eighth in Division II for freshman. Last season she had 50 blocks the second most in a single-season at MSSU. She ranked 10th in Division II for blocks (1st among Sophomores) and finished second in the MIAA after the postseason concluded while leading the MIAA in blocks for a majority of the season. Tied the school record of seven at Rogers State (Jan 28, 2021). At the beginning of the 2021-22 season Stokes is tied with Jensen Maydew (2014-18) for third in career blocks at 83.

Climbing The Chart Fast

Madi Stokes has quickly rose up the career blocking list at MSSU where she is currently third passing Jensen Maydew's (2014-18) total of 83 and is second in blocks per game at 1.65 behind Joyce Falls (1986-88) who had a 1.69 blocks per game average.

Madi Has It

Last season Madi Stokes led the MIAA in blocks per game (2.17) and rebounds per game (10.5), second in blocked shots (50), defensive rebounds per game (8.2) and total rebounds (242). Fifth in double-doubles (7) and was eighth in offensive rebounds per game (2.3) last season. Ranked 10th in Division II for blocked shots, 15th in defensive rebounds per game, 19th in blocked shots per game, 21st in rebounds per game and 34th in double-doubles.

20-20's New Member

Madi Stokes against Emporia State (Jan. 16, 2021) finishing with 21 points and 22 rebounds (10 offensive) becoming the third member of the 20-20 club at Southern. The most recent since Marie Scott had a 24 point 22 rebound game (Nov. 24, 1995) in a 81-71 win over Missouri Valley. The last time anyone in the MIAA had a 20-20 game was Vivian Essuon who had 20 points and 23 rebounds against Missouri Western Jan. 7, 2012. Stokes was the second player to achieve the feat in Division II as Lilly Ritz did it the same day putting up 22 points and 25 rebounds (10 offensive). For the 2020-21 season only Stokes, Ritz (Wheeling) and Zyaire Ewing (Delta St.) Achieved a 20 points - 20 rebound game.

QUICK HITS PT.2

30-20 History

Madi Stokes became the first player to achieve a 30 point - 20 rebound game in Southern's history at Rogers State (Jan. 28, 2021). Putting up a career-high 31 points shooting 13-of-19 from the field and pulling down 21 rebounds and blocking a single-game tying seven blocks in the overtime win. It is the first 30-20 game of the 2020-21 season in Division II, Ritz (Wheeling) and Danielle Norquest (West Florida) also accomplished the feat later on in the season.

Freshman Scoring Record Had L&P Stoked

Lacy Stokes set a new school record for freshman scoring with 33 last time out against Central Oklahoma (Dec. 2nd) that powered the Lions to a 81-74 win. Lacy is the first freshman since the 1984-85 season to have 30+ points and one of only four freshman or sophomores to score 30+ points in a game for the Lions since the 84-85 season.

Lacy Floods The Box Score To Open Season

Freshman point guard Lacy Stokes opened her collegiate career with 25 points, seven rebounds, six assists, and four steals. Lacy repeated the trick with a 21 point, eight assist, seven rebound, three steal and a block game while playing 42 minutes of an overtime loss to Harding (Nov. 13th).

Freshman Had A Historic Start

Lacy Stokes became the first freshman since Joyce Falls (1986-87) to begin a season with back-to-back 20+ point games. Stokes' 25 points against Henderson State (Nov. 12th) rank seventh among all Missouri Southern players in a season opening game since the 1984-85 season and the first to score 25+ points since Jasmine Lovejoy scored the second most points in a season opener finishing with a double-double of 36 points and 15 rebounds against Arkansas-Fort Smith (Nov. 16, 2010)

Bench Sparks Turned Starters

Redshirt freshman guard Kaitlin Hunnicutt and junior guard/forward Amaya Johns brought it off the bench this past season and are now in the starting lineup regularly. Hunnicutt was fourth on the team in scoring averaging 6.7 points a game, and connected on 26 threes. Her season-high of 15 was on the road against Pittsburg State (Jan. 9, 2021). Johns led all bench scoring with 7.7 per game in 14 minutes a game. Her season-high of 21 points happened at home against Rogers State (Dec. 5, 2020) shooting 7-of-9 from the field, 1-of-2 from the three point line and a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line. This season Hunnicutt is averaging 9.5 points and 3.5 rebounds a game while connecting on a team-high 20 threes so far and is shooting 40.8 percent from three. This season Johns is averaging 10.3 points and pulling down 4.7 rebounds a game.

A Trio Of Thieves

In the early going of the season Lacy Stokes, Kaitlin Hunnicutt and Layne Skiles have established themselves as top talents in stealing the ball from the opposition. Stokes leads the MIAA with 3.10 steals a game and 31 total steals while Hunnicutt (12) and Skiles (14) rank in the top-25 in the MIAA. Hunnicutt became the first Lion since Krista Clark (Dec. 30, 2017) to have a game with 5 or more steals in the Lions 84-65 win at Rogers State and Stokes repeated the feat against McKendree (Dec. 13).

Who Wants To Get Blocked

This season the lions feature two of the premier shot blockers in the MIAA in redshirt guard/forward Hailey Grant and sophomore center Madi Stokes. Grant and Stokes each have 11 blocks on the season and are tied for ninth in the MIAA. The pairing pace the Lions who rank sixth and average 3.6 blocks per game and are ninth in the MIAA with 36 total blocked shots through nine games.

Bench Scoring Coming Alive

This season the Lions have averaged 28.3 points per game as a bench unit and are led by sophomore center Madi Stokes who averages 9.9 points and 5.3 rebounds a game while blocking 11 shots ans is shooting .615 from the field (32-52). Sophomore guard Cameron Call is second averaging 7.0 points per game and is shooting .385 from three (15-39) and has dished out 13 assists while averaging 21.1 minutes a game. As a unit the Lions scored 41 of their 74 points in the win against Missouri S&T (Nov. 20) as freshman guard Mia Topping finished with 12 points and Cameron Call added 11 points, both career-highs. The Lions against McKendree (Dec. 13) scored 55 of their 92 points from the bench with Stokes leading all scorers with 19 points and Call adding 13 of her own. Maleigha Landers connected on three from deep for nine points, Anna Hall scored eight, Mia Topping connected on two threes and Hailey Grant came away with career-highs in rebounds (10) and assists (7).

Let It Fly

This season the Lions are returning their top three-point shooters from 2020-21 in Layne Skiles and Kaitlin Hunnicutt while having Brooke Stauffer, Kailani Jones, Amaya Johns and Hailey Grant as capable shooters along with Division I Transfer Cameron Call to stretch the floor this season.

Skiles To Create 500 Career Points, 100 Assists, Made Free Throws, Three's Club

Currently Layne Skiles has 600 points, 102 assists, 112 made free throws and 96 made three-pointers in her career. When Skiles accomplishes the quadfecta of having 500+ career points, 100+ assists, made free-throws and made three-pointers she will become the first in MSSU history with such totals. She would also become the 13th Lion to have 100+ career three-pointers, the 52nd Lion to have 500+ career points and made free throws since the 1984-85 season and the 53rd Lions to have 100+ career assists since the 1984-85 season.

Madi Nears 500 Career Point, Rebounds Club

Currently Madi Stokes has 480 career points and has pulled down 449 rebounds so far in her career. She would be the 13th Lion to have 500+ career points and rebounds and only Caryn Schumaker (1987-91) has more blocks presently at 109 the second best amount in MSSU history.

HEAD COACH RONNIE RESSEL



Ronnie Ressel was named the head women's basketball coach on March 16, 2017 after serving three years as an assistant and one year as an interim head coach. He will be entering his sixth season as a head coach of the women's program in 2021-22.

Ressel is entering his 19th season as part of the athletic department at Missouri Southern, having also served as an assistant with both the men's and women's programs. A 1992 graduate of Missouri Southern, he returned to his alma mater for the 2002-03 campaign after spending ten years at Rend Lake College in Ina, Ill. In five years as a head coach for the women, Ressel has a record of 63-85.

Year five saw a reduction in games played and an all conference schedule due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Carley Turnbull earn All-MIAA third team honors and Madi Stokes had a breakthrough season for the

Lions being named All-MIAA honorable mention and being on the All-Defensive team after leading the conference in blocked shots. Stokes pieced together a 20 point, 20 rebound performance becoming the third lion to ever do that and then became the first to ever score 30 points and grab 20 rebounds and tied the single-game record for blocked shots with seven. Finished the season with 50 blocks the second most in a single-season at Southern and climbed up to a tie for third in career blocks with 83 already in just 51 games played. As a team the Lions finished the season 9-14 overall and 9-13 in the MIAA, clinching a berth into the MIAA tournament for the fifth straight time under Ressel and the ninth straight year and seven Lions were named onto MIAA Academic Honor Rolls.

Year four saw Destiny Owens and Chasidee Owens earn All-MIAA Honorable Mention recognitions. The 2019-20 campaign saw Zoe Campbell shatter shot block records. She posted 62 blocks on the season, 20 more than Brianna Volmer's previous record (42 in 2005-06). She now sits in the top spot in the career record list with 113, four more than Caryn Schumaker's previous record (109 in 1987-91). The Lions finished the season 10-18 overall, 7-12 in the MIAA and a berth in the MIAA tournament.

Year three saw Chelsey Henry and Chasidee Owens both earn All-MIAA honors as Henry was a second-team honoree and Owens picked up honorable mention accolades. Henry finished her career seventh on the MSSU all-time scoring list with 1,296 points after averaging 16 points as a senior. Owens burst on the scene and helped provide a boost down low averaging 11.5 points and 5.9 rebounds.

In year two, a pair of juniors earned All-MIAA honors as Desirea Buerge was a second-team pick and Chelsey Henry earned Honorable Mention honors. Southern saw an eight-game stretch without a loss in the middle

of the season in which the Lions reeled off six wins in conference play, as well as a pair of non-conference wins over the holiday break. The team would also take out perennial MIAA power Emporia State at home as part of a stretch winning nine of ten games.

In year one at the helm, Ressel helped the team to a 12-17 mark and a trip to the MIAA Tournament. The Lions saw both Desirea Buerge and Deb Holcomb earn All-MIAA status and nine different Lions earned a spot on the MIAA Academic Honor Roll.

During his three years as an assistant for the women, Ressel had helped the team to a 57-27 record and a 38-22 mark in the MIAA. In 2015-16 the team saw two players earn All-MIAA status as Sharese Jones was a first-team selection, while Deb Holcomb was a third-team pick.

Jones also joined the 1,000 point club on Nov. 24, 2015 in a game against Avila and finished her career in fourth place in points with 1,421. She is fifth in career rebounds (651) while achieving the second-best career free throw percentage (.824) and holding a career field goal percentage of .501.

For the four seasons prior to his time with the women, Ressel mentored the posts at Southern including 2012 MIAA Player of the Year, Keane Thomann.

He was elevated to the position of men's Associate Head Coach in 2010-11, and was instrumental with his help in development of the guards and overall program at Southern. Former Lion Skyler Bowlin was the MIAA's Player and Defender of the Year in 2011, and was a four-time member of the MIAA's All-Defensive team. At the end of Bowlin's career he was the Lions' all-time leader in three-pointers and ranked fourth all-time in scoring and second in free-throw percentage. He was selected to three different All-American teams, while being named All-Region and the Region Player of the Year. He was also a finalist for National Player of the Year.

In 11 years with the Lions, Ressel helped the team to a 204-145 record, including 11-straight appearances in the MIAA Postseason Tournament. The Lions played in the conference tournament title game in 2005 and again in 2011.

ASSISTANT COACHES



KELBY FRITZ

Fritz enters her fifth season as an assistant coach for Missouri Southern.

Fritz cam to Southern after a year as the assistant coach for the Northeastern Oklahoma A&M Lady Norse Basketball Team. Prior to NEO, she spent two seasons as the graduate assistant coach for Hastings College in Hastings, Nebraska. During her tenure, the team earned two trips to the NAIA National Tournament and finished in the final four during her

first year.

Fritz helped Northeastern Oklahoma A&M (NEO) to a National Junior College (NJCAA) Division 1 Region 2 and District B title this past season. The 29-3 Lady Norse entered the national tournament as the 11 seed and defeated 22nd seeded Iowa Western 73-47 in the opening round at the Rip Griffin Center in Lubbock, Texas. NEO fell in the second round to sixth seeded and national runner up Trinity Valley, 67-53. The Lady Norse finished 16th in the nation in points per game (80.1), 14th in field goals made per game (29.6), and seventh in three point field goals per contest (8.7). While at NEO, Fritz was responsible for game preparation, scouting, game day duties, recruiting, strength and conditioning, and all aspects of team travel for the Lady Norse.

She began her playing career at Missouri Southern State University (09'-12') where she averaged 10 points per game. She continued her collegiate carrier in 2012 at Rogers State University. As a starter for the Hillcats, she shot 42% from behind the arch and 85% from the charity stripe. Fritz was also 41% from the field. The Hillcats attended the NAIA D1 National tournament the 2012-2013 season and made it to the second round.

Porter comes to the Lions after four years at Tyler Junior College where he helped lead the team to an 88-37 record and three-straight National Tournament Appearances. The Appache's reached the Sweet 16 in 2018-19 and the Elite Eight in 2020-21. The team won the Region 14 Championship in 18-19.

Porter coached the National Junior College Player of the Year, as well as a Region Player of the Year and two Region Freshmen of the Year, while mentoring 11 All-Conference Players.

Prior to Tyler, Porter was on the staff at Incarnate Word where he worked for three seasons, serving as the head of player development and junior college recruitment while the team transitioned from Division II to Division I.

A 2011 graduate of Missouri Valley College, Porter was an All-Conference selection as a senior. He earned a degree in exercise science from MVC. Porter is a native of Red Bud, Illinois and also earned an associates degree from Southwestern Illinois College where he was a starter for a nationally-ranked team in both seasons.
