SEASON OPENER:

The 2015-16 edition of Montana State women's basketball will open its season at Seattle U, Friday, Nov. 13 at 5:30 p.m. (MST) in historic Key Arena. The Bobcats will conclude its first road-trip of the non-conference at the University of Nevada, Sunday, Nov. 15 at 3 p.m. (MST) in the Lawlor Events Center in Reno. Reno is also the site for the 2016 Big Sky Conference Tournament, March 7-12. Head coach Tricia Binford is in her 11th season at the helm of the MSU women's basketball program, and welcomes back nine letterwinners, including three starters - Jasmine Hommes, Alexa Dawkins and Lindsay Stockton.

THIS WEEK'S VITALS:

Seattle U, led by legendary women's basketball coach Joan Bonvicini, opens with MSU on Friday, before traveling to Montana on Sunday to face the Lady Griz in Dahlberg Arena in Missoula. Bonvicini is closing in on 700 career victories. She is currently tenth on the all-time NCAA Division I active win list with 692 victories. Bonvicini led Long Beach State to back-to-back NCAA Division I Final Four appearances in 1987 and 88, and was the 1981 NCAA Division I Coach of the Year. Montana State and Seattle U have met eight times, with the Redhawks owning a 5-3 advantage. The Bobcats won the last meeting between the two squads 74-61 in Bozeman on Nov. 23, 2014. Nevada is also coached by a notable mentor. Jane Albright is in her 32nd year of coaching and her eighth at Nevada. She is honing in on 500 career wins and sits at 496 heading into the Wolf Pack's opener against San Diego on Friday. Albright has coached at UN, Wichita State, Wisconsin and Northern Illinois. She led the Badgers to the 2000 WNIT title. Montana State and Nevada have met 11 times with the Bobcats holding a 10-1 lead in the series. The two teams faced each other often when the Wolf Pack were members of the Big Sky Conference. The last meeting between MSU and UN was March 7, 1992 as the Bobcats defeated the Wolf Pack 80-63 in Reno.

OPENING DAY HISTORY:

Montana State is 25-14 all-time in season-openers dating back to the 1976-77 season. Under the direction of Tricia Binford, the Bobcats are 6-4 in its first game of the year. Last season, the Bobcats dropped the opener 75-60 at Boise State, but bounced back two days later with a 63-47 win at Cal State Fullerton.

BINFORD BITS (150-149 OVERALL, 87-79 BIG SKY CONFERNCE, TENTH SEASON):

- In her 11th season at Montana State.
- Binford has notched 150 career victories at Montana State, which ranks first on MSU's all-time women's basketball coaching ladder.
- Prior to MSU, Binford served two seasons at Utah State. Also served as an assistant coach at her alma mater- Boise State, 1999-2001.
- Binford was the 31st overall pick in the 1998 WNBA draft, and played with the Cleveland Rockers, 1999-02, and Utah Starzz, 1998-99.
- As Tricia Bader, she was a three-time All-Big Sky Conference selection on some of the best teams in Boise State history. She led the Broncos to a national ranking (#17) and the NCAA tournament in 1994.
- Binford was named the 1996 Idaho NCAA Woman of the Year and was inducted in the Boise State Hall of Fame in 2001.
- Binford was a member of the 1993 West Team at the U.S. Olympic Festival coached by current Connecticut head man Geno Auriemma.
- Binford prepped at Roaring Fork High School in Carbondale, Colo., where she was the Colorado Player of the Year and a Street and Smith's High School All-American in 1991.

ABOUT THEM 2015-16 CATS:

Head Coach Tricia Binford returns nine letterwinners from last season, including three starters that guided the Bobcats to a 15-15 overall mark and a 9-9 Big Sky Conference ledger. Returning starters include second-team All-Big Sky performer Jasmine Hommes, Alexa Dawkins and Lindsay Stockton. Junior Peyton Ferris, who garnered Big Sky Conference Top Reserve accolades last winter, also returns to MSU's front line. "Our three post players – Hommes, Dawkins and Ferris – have all had an excellent fall," Binford said. "I think we have one of the strongest front lines in the Big Sky. They have great chemistry and really feed off each other." In the backcourt, Binford will look to Stockton to anchor the guard play. In addition, look for Hannah Caudill, Delany Junkermier, Margreet Barhoum, Michelle Seitz and transfer Riley Nordgaard to make strong contributions. "We have good experience and depth at the guard spot," Binford said. "They have worked hard in the offseason and they have all improved their game." Rounding out the roster will be freshmen Annika Lai, Ashton Siegner and Haley Blodgett. Freshman Madisyn Shaide will redshirt the 2015-16 year.

THE SCOUTING REPORT:

Seattle U was picked to finish third and fourth, respectively, in the Western Athletic Conference Coaches and Media preseason polls for 2015-16. In the coaches poll, Taelor Ross represented SU on the preseason first-team while Crystal Allen was named to the second-team. In the media poll, Ross was named to the second-team. Last winter, Seattle U recorded an overall mark of 10-21 and a WAC ledger of 6-8. SU was paced by Ross, who averaged 12.3 points and 7.4 rebounds, while shooting 47 percent from the field, but just 49 percent from the line.

It will be a new-look Nevada team this season as it will have eight suit up who have not previously played in a game for the Pack. The team has already lost starting point guard T Moe for the duration of the season, however with 10 guards behind her the transition should be smooth. Last season, the Wolf Pack notched a 9-21 overall mark and a 5-13 Mountain West Conference record, good for ninth place in the league. Only one starter returns from last winter. UN does have high hopes for transfer Stephanie Schmid, who was named preseason MWC Newcomer of the Year. She connected on over 200 triples last season.

Nordgaard transferred to MSU and sat out last season...as a sophomore at Augustana, she posted 20 games in double-figure scoring, including four double-doubles...notched ten games in double-digit rebounds... finished third in the Northern Sun, averaging 2.6 steals....as a rookie, garnered NSIC All-Freshmen team accolades...was the 2012 Minnesota Class A Player of the Year...a two-time all-state selection.

Dawkins played in 28 games, including 19 starts last winter...finished the season averaging 6.9 points and 5.0 rebounds per game...posted five double-figure scoring games, including a season-high 14 points against Seattle U, connecting on seven-of-nine from the field...ended the season shooting 45 percent from the field and 70 percent from the line...hauled down season-best nine rebounds at Northern Arizona.

Earned second-team All-Big Sky Conference honors last season after averaging 16.9 points and 5.1 rebounds per game...finished first in scoring on the Bobcat squad and was the third leading scorer in the Big Sky...started 29 of 30 games...posted ten games with 20 or more points...set a career-high 25 points on two occasions against North Dakota and Montana...tallied three games in double-figure rebounds.



#10 5-7 Guard **Junior** Edmonds, WA Margreet Barhoum

Played in just six games during the 2014-15 campaign before being sidelined with a foot injury...averaged 4.8 minutes per game...recorded four points on two-of-three from the field against No. 24 Gonzaga... finished the non-conference shooting 50 percent from the floor...hauled down two rebounds versus Seattle U...dished out one assist in MSU's win over Seattle U.
