


#### **STORYLINES**

- Montana State makes its first road trip of its Big Sky portion of the 2019-20 schedule when the Bobcats travel to Greeley to face Northern Colorado on Thursday. MSU plays its first game of a stretch of three contests on the road against the Bears. The Bobcats' Big Sky slate features two spans of three consecutive road games this season.
- The Bobcats ended 2019 with a 63-61 victory over Northern Arizona in Worthington Arena on Dec. 30. MSU improved to 5-1 in Bozeman, matching starts at home in the last 10 years of the 2016-17 and 2013-14 seasons. The Bobcats' best home start of the past decade came during the 2010-11 season, when MSU won its first eight games within Brick Breeden Fieldhouse before finishing 9-5 in its home confines.
- MSU's improved defense has been evident since the start of the 2019-20 season. The Bobcats are 7-1 when holding opponents to less than 70 points, while a season ago MSU held foes to less than 70 only seven times over the 32-game schedule.
- Montana State has held 11 of its 13 opponents this season to under 50% shooting from the field. The Bobcats are 8-3 in those contests. The 'Cats are 0-2 when teams shoot over 50% against them which includes a 98-72 loss to Green Bay (Nov. 30) and a 74-72 narrow defeat to CSU Bakersfield (Dec. 19). MSU's loss to the Phoenix on Nov. 30 is the lone game this season the Bobcats have been out-shot from the field.
- Style of play over a year span has been noticeable for the men's basketball program. Last season's team averaged nearly 10 more points per game and ranked 50th in the country at 78.2 points per contest compared to its average of 69 this season. MSU's defense is giving up 14 less points to opponents per outing this season at 65.4. The 'Cats ranked 336th a season ago giving up 79.8 points to foes per game.
- The free throw line proved to be a difference maker for the Bobcats in their latest victory. MSU had season highs in free throws made and attempted by going 25-for-28 from the charity stripe. The Bobcats' season percentage improved to 73.7%, which currently is the same mark the 'Cats recorded during the 2018-19 season. This season's mark paces the Big Sky Conference and is 72nd best in the nation.
- The Bobcats have got off to strong starts to begin conference play the last two seasons. MSU went 4-1 in its first five league games last year and started 4-0 to open the 2017-18 Big Sky schedule. Both starts were disrupted with losing streaks of three and four games, respectively.
- MSU's 8-5 overall record under Danny Sprinkle is one of the best among Bobcat recent head coaches in their first year leading the program. The 13-game mark is the best for a first-year MSU head coach since Bruce Haroldson guided the program in his opening campaign in 1978-79. That squad began the year 7-0 and eventually got out to an 11-2 start.
- Senior Harald Frey surpassed 1,600 career points in MSU's last outing, improving his fifth-place mark on MSU's all-time scoring chart. Frey currently ranks third in assists (441), 3-pointers (239) and is tied for eighth in free throws (357). He's also ranked 30th in the Big Sky in career scoring and 14th in assists in conference history.

#### READ INTO THE CATS

#### Frey a Constant For Montana State

Among Harald Frey's statistical accolades, the Bobcats have also been able to rely on him to be on the court. The senior guard has made 109 consecutive starts which is the eighth most among active players in Division I. He came into the season fifth in career minutes played among all DI active players with 3,154.

#### **Kirby Crashing The Boards**

Junior Devin Kirby became the team leader in rebounds per game this season in MSU's win versus South Dakota State. His 15 rebounds versus SDSU (Dec. 5) were the most by a Bobcat in a single game since Quentin Everett snagged 15 versus Sac State on Feb. 7, 2016. Kirby recorded at least nine rebounds in three straight games heading into the NDSU matchup.

#### **Belo Providing Big Presence**

Jubrile Belo has continued to improve his play since making his way overseas. After breaking a knee for the second time in 2017 after only seven games and using a redshirt at Lamar Community College, Belo played 30 games in 2018-19 and averaged 15 points and 8.8 rebounds per game for the Lopes. That improvement has translated to MSU.

Belo is second on the team in points per game (12.2) and his 73.3% mark from the field is second in the Big Sky. That mark if the season ended today would be the best in program history and unofficially is among the top 10 in Division I basketball. His interior presence can be seen on the stat line, with 31 of his 55 field goals coming by way of a dunk.

#### **Adamu and Paulo Helping Steady Backcourt**

Amin Adamu and Mychael Paulo both have made big impacts for MSU at various times early in the 2019-20 season after making the jump from the junior college

Adamu has played in 30 minutes in six of MSU's games while he's recorded six double-digit scoring efforts. He helped spur the 'Cats to a win versus Appalachian State (Nov. 15) when he hit all six of his free throw attempts with under a minute to play to hold off the Mountaineers. Paulo played a career-high 37 minutes in that same game and had a 16-point performance versus Rocky Mountain (Nov. 9). Paulo proved essential down the stretch in a win over SDSU (Dec. 5), scoring five points in the final 25 seconds which was capped by a breakaway dunk.

#### No Senior Slide for Ricketts

Ladan Ricketts has found his groove as he works his way back from a ruptured calf muscle he suffered this past March. The senior from Livingston, Mont., has been a force from the 3-point line.

Ricketts is 26 of 58 from beyond the arc. His 48% clip from deep is fourth among all players in the Big Sky Conference this season. He's appeared in over 20 minutes on the court in eight of the last nine games. His career 3-point percentage of 45.5% currently ranks him second in program history. While he went 1 of 6 versus NAU on Dec. 30 from deep, his one shot made with under two minutes to play served as an eventual game winner over NAU.

Whole New Meaning of Defense Montana State held Colorado Christian to 24% shooting in the second half of their game on Nov. 26. That mark was the second lowest percentage MSU has allowed in a half, with the lowest a 22.9% clip recorded by Tennessee Tech on Nov. 17. The Bobcats have held opponents to under 30% shooting during a half on four occasions this season.

#### **Big Crowd Highlights Nonconference Home Finale**

The Bobcats beat South Dakota State on Dec. 5 in their last home game ahead of Big Sky play. The game's attendance of 4,877 against SDSU was the highest attended non-conference home game for the program since 1997. On Dec. 30, 1997, MSU beat San Diego 77-61 in front of 5,477 fans during a holiday tournament played in Worthington Arena. The next highest attended non-conference home game was on Nov. 16, 2007, when MSU hosted Boise State in Bozeman in front of 4,866 fans.

#### **Bobcats Split Contests Against the Summit**

Montana State went 1-1 for the second straight season in the Big Sky-Summit League series. Last year, MSU beat North Dakota at home and fell to Omaha on the road. The Bobcats again split its matchups versus Summit League opponents this year. MSU beat South Dakota State in Worthington Arena on Dec. 5, but dropped a 79-65 contest against North Dakota State in Fargo on Dec. 16.

#### Bobcats go Undefeated at Spartan Invitational

The Bobcats claimed their first regular season tournament title honors in two seasons by going undefeated over the course of three games in Greensboro from Nov. 15-17. MSU kept all three of its opponents to under 40% shooting from the field with all recording their season low scoring outputs. It was the first time MSU has went 3-0 at a regular season tournament since the 1966-67 season when the 'Cats defeated Texas, Temple and Oklahoma City at the All-College Tournament in OKC.

#### Long Road Stretch Out of The Way

MSU completed a five-day span featuring four games from Nov. 15-19. MSU has had a four-game road stand four times in the previous 10 seasons. The Bobcats played four games away from home consecutively a season ago and dropped all four. This year the Bobcats went 3-1 with their lone loss a 69-56 setback in front of 6,862 fans at GCU Arena against the Antelopes. MSU's longest stretch of road games in the last 10 years was in 2015-16 when MSU played six straight away from Bozeman in a span from Dec.

#### Defense Shines in Invitational Finale

Tennessee Tech shot just 25.9% (15-58) from the field in a 52-39 victory for MSU on Nov. 17. It was the first time since 2014 that MSU held an opponent under 30% shooting, while it was also the first time MSU kept an opponent under 40 points in a regular season game in 19 years

#### **Buzzer Beater Makes National Headlines**

College basketball took notice of Montana State on Nov. 16 thanks to an unforgettable buzzer beater.
UNCG's Isaiah Miller broke a 64-all tie by making a contested layup with 3.5 seconds remaining in the contest in the Spartans' home gym. MSU senior guard Harald Frey received the inbounds pass and drilled a shot off glass from past half court to propel the Bobcats past the Spartans, 67-66. The shot earned SportsCenter's No. 1 on its Top 10 Plays of the weekend. UNCG dropped a home game for just the third time in three seasons in the one-point defeat to

**Bobcats Hang Tough at No. 17/19 USU**For the second straight year Montana State opened its season against Utah State. While the 2018-19 opener ended in a 101-71 blowout by Utah State in Bozeman, this season's matchup came down to the end.

The Bobcats and ranked Aggies battled back and forth with MSU gaining a two-point lead with 5:30 remaining. The Aggies eventually used a 10-0 run to hold off the visiting Bobcats, 81-73, at Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. Utah State did most of its work from the free throw line, as the Aggies made 35, the most by a Bobcat opponent since 2007. MSU was led by senior Harald Frey who recorded a career-high 34 points, the most by a Bobcat in a season opener.

#### Former Bobcats Find Homes in G League

Recent MSU alumni Keljin Blevins and Tyler Hall were picked in the NBA G League Draft on Oct. 26. Hall was selected by the Westchester Knicks, the NBA G League affiliate of the New York Knicks, with the fourth overall pick. Blevins was chosen as the 18th pick by the Northern Arizona Suns, the Phoenix Suns' G League affiliate. The two are currently on each team's regular season rosters.

Hall and Blevins both competed in the NBA Summer League, with Hall playing for the Chicago Bulls and Blevins the Portland Trail Blazers. Blevins signed a training camp contract with Portland and scored 17 points over the course of four preseason games before being placed on waivers.

#### MSU Tabbed Seventh in Preseason Polls

The Montana State men's basketball team was picked to finish seventh in the Blg Sky Conference in both the preseason coaches' and media polls, announced on Oct. 17. MSU tied for fourth in the league standings a year ago at 11-9, but due to tiebreakers, was the sixth seed in the Big Sky Tournament.

#### **Harald Frey Earns Preseason Honors**

#### Collegiate Experience Back in Blue & Gold

MSU returned three starters that played significant roles on the team a season ago. Harald Frey (Sr. - Oslo, Norway), Devin Kirby (Jr. - Chandler, Ariz.) and Ladan Ricketts (Sr. - Livingston, Mont.) all return with experience in the Bobcats' starting lineup. Quentin Guliford (So. - Peoria, Ariz.) and Zeke Quinlan (So. -Portland, Ore.) also appeared in their first collegiate seasons last year for the Bobcats.

**Getting to Know The Roster**The Bobcats feature nine new players on their roster. That number is among the most among all Division I institutions. MSU's nine newcomers is tied for 22nd most in the nation with Auburn, Austin Peay, Bradley, Bryant, Florida, Kentucky and Little Rock, TCU has the most newcomers with 15 (20-player roster) and is followed by Nebraska with 14.

#### International Flavor

Six of Montana State's 15 players on its roster are from outside the United States. The six (Amin Adamu, Jubrile Belo, Borja Fernandez, Finn Fleute, Harald Frey, Mychael Paulo) make up the third highest amount of international players on a Division I roster. MSU is tied with Davidson, San Diego and Utah State with 6 foreign-born players. Only Saint Mary's (10) and Loyola Marymount (7) have more on their rosters.

#### Sprinkle Staff Tied by Familiarity

Head coach Danny Sprinkle is joined on the Bobcat bench by a group of coaches familiar to him and MSU. Chris Halsam and Luke Fennelly remained on staff for their seventh seasons, with Haslam staying on as an assistant and Fennelly serving as operations director. Shawn Dirden, who worked with Sprinkle previously as an assistant, returned to Bozeman to join his staff. Dan Russell joins the DI ranks after coaching at Casper College which has been the initial destination for several Bobcats in recent seasons.

#### A New Face to Lead the Program

Danny Sprinkle was appointed as the program's 23rd men's basketball coach on April 4, 2019. A Helena, Mont., native, Sprinkle began his coaching career in 2000 and spent all but two years since coaching as an assistant in the Big West Conference. Sprinkle has been a member of staffs that advanced to three NCAA Tournaments. Sprinkle completed an accomplished collegiate career as a Bobcat. He appeared in one NCAA Tournament as a player at MSU and still is among the top 10 in the Bobcats' record book in several categories.

**A Bow on the 2018-19 Campaign**MSU wrapped up the 2018-19 season with some positive benchmarks, and ultimately a new direction. The Bobcats won their first Big Sky tournament game in a decade and tied for fourth in conference play to match the program's best finish since 2005. Their 11 Big Sky wins tied for the most since 2002.

## Hall Leaves Legacy at Montana State Tyler Hall will forever be etched into the Bobcat

record books. Hall became Montana State's all-time scoring record holder as he finished his career with 2,518 points. He became the 69th player in Division I history to surpass 2,500 points. He also ended the year tied for ninth in Division I history with 431 made 3-point field goals in his career.

He broke the MSU scoring record during the Bobcats' 95-90 victory over Washington State on Dec. 9. He became the Big Sky Conference scoring king on Jan. 19 at Eastern Washington. The Rock Island, Ill., native was a four-time all-conference selection and was a first-team selection on two occasions.

#### A Tale of Two Sides of the Court

Montana State led the Big Sky Conference in several offensive categories last year. MSU led the league in assists (15.9) and points per game (82.7) in league assists (15.9) and points per game (82.7) in league play. MSU hadn't led the league in scoring since the 1997-98 season. MSU's 2,502 points scored was the second most in a season in program history. The Bobcats'. 755 free throw percentage was tied for second in the Big Sky while their turnover margin of 2.0 was second.

MSU's defense gave up 79.8 points per game and opponents shot 48.4% from the field which were both the the most among Big Sky schools. MSU blocked just 32 shots in league play, 10th among league members. The Bobcats went 4-12 when opponents made at least half their shots.

# **DANNY SPRINKLE**

Head Coach | First Season B.S. - Montana State 2000 |

Danny Sprinkle, one of Montana State's most accomplished basketball players during his career in the late 1990s, was appointed the program's 23rd men's basketball coach on Thursday, April 4, Montana State Director of Athletics Leon Costello announced.

"There are so many people to thank," Sprinkle said. "This is an unbelievable opportunity for me, my friends and my family. I wouldn't be close to anywhere to where I'm at right now without the support and guidance of so many individuals."

"The people at Montana State attracted me the most to the position," Sprinkle said. "It was even more attractive of a job once I got up to campus and met the people and sat down with them face

to face. President Cruzado's energy is contagious. You can see why the campus is booming and why the town is booming. I'm very excited to work with Leon. I know he's going to do all he can to get our program to the top."

A Helena High graduate, Sprinkle's coaching career began as a graduate assistant at Cal State Northridge in 2000-01. He spent all but two of the seasons since then – 2006-08, when he was a Bobcat assistant under Brad Huse – coaching in the Big West Conference. He worked at Cal State Northridge as a full-time assistant from 2001-06 and 2008-13. He coached at Cal State Fullerton prior to his return to Bozeman.

Sprinkle added duties as recruiting coordinator at each of his coaching stops. He helped lead Cal State Fullerton to the NCAA Tournament in

2017-18 for just the third time in program history and the year before that the Titans competed in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. He was also part of Cal State Northridge's 2001 and 2009 NCAA Tournament teams, with the Matadors winning the Big Sky regular season crown in 2001 and the Big West title in 2009.

As a Bobcat freshman in 1996, Sprinkle was a starter during the team's magical run to Big Sky regular season and tournament championships, landing All-Big Sky Tournament honors for his 30-point performance in the Championship. Sprinkle earned Big Sky Freshman of the Year honors in 1996 and was an all-league selection three consecutive seasons, including his ffirst team selection in 1997. He held the MSU career and season 3-point records upon graduation and remains the eighth-leading scorer in school history. Sprinkle is a member of the 1996 team that was inducted into the Montana State Athletics Hall of Fame in 2006. Born in Pullman, Wash., Sprinkle enjoyed an outstanding career at Helena High School which included all-state honors twice in basketball, while also competing in football and track. He graduated from Montana State in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in health and human development.


