STORYLINES

- Montana State hosts its final regular season game of the 2019-20 season when the Bobcats take on Northern Colorado Saturday in Worthington Arena. MSU is set to recognize its two seniors, Harald Frey and Ladan Ricketts, prior to the game.
- The Bobcats defeated Southern Utah, 73-65, on Thursday in Bozeman. The victory helped MSU clinch the #5 seed in the upcoming Big Sky Conference Championships presented by My Place Hotels. The 'Cats are slated to face Portland State in the quarterfinals Thursday. It's the first time MSU has earned a bye in the conference tournament since the league moved to a neutral site. The Bobcats have previously earned byes in Big Sky tournaments in 1988, 1996, 2002 and 2005.
- Senior Harald Frey recorded 22 points in the Bobcats' victory over the Thunderbirds and moved to third in program history in scoring (1,875 points) in the process. The Oslo, Norway, native also ranks second all-time among Bobcats in assists (510), free throws (447) and 3-pointers (270), as well as sits fifth in steals (136). His expected appearance in Saturday's game would set a new program record of 127 for games played and consecutive starts.
- Jubrilé Belo recorded his second consecutive double-double, and fifth of the season, with 25 points and 11 rebounds against the T-Birds Thursday. Belo upped his season point output to 382 through 30 games. It's the most by a Bobcat newcomer since the freshman seasons for Frey (406) in 2016-17 and Tyler Hall (578) in 2015-16. Both players earned Big Sky Freshman of the Year honors.
- MSU and Northern Colorado previously met this season with the Bears picking up a 68-59 victory in Greeley on Jan. 2. The Bobcats shot 63.6% in the second half, but 12-5 edge in the turnover battle and a 10-point Bears halftime lead was too much to overcome. Amin Adamu scored his career-high 26 points to lead the Bobcats while UNC was led by Jonah Radebaugh's 17 points and Kai Edwards's 11 rebounds.
- Northern Colorado enters Saturday's game in the hunt for the Big Sky Conference regular season title. The Bears defeated Montana, 71-64, in Missoula Thursday to remain a game behind Eastern Washington in the league standings at 14-5. The Eagles, 15-4 in Big Sky play, close out their regular season at home versus Weber State.
- Montana State holds a 40-26 lead in the all-time series against Northern Colorado. Neither team has won more than three straight against the other since 2008 when MSU had a nine-game win streak snapped. UNC has since won 15 of the last 24 head-to-head meetings.
- MSU held its 20th opponent of the season to under 70 points or less on Thursday. The Bobcats are 16-4 overall this season when doing so. That mark is nearly one of the best for the program since the start of the 21st century. The 'Cats held 23 foes to 70 or less during the 2001-02 season, their last Big Sky Championship regular season campaign.
- The Bobcats led by head coach Danny Sprinkle enter Saturday with one of their best win outputs under an MSU coach in their first season. The 16 victories this year are the most by a first-year coach in nearly a half century. Hank Anderson guided the 1972-73 team to a 17-9 mark.

Fans Turned Out in The Brick

Montana State has had one of its best home schedules when it comes to attendance in recent memory. The Bobcats have hosted 13 games in Worthington Arena during the 2019-20 slate, averaging 3,459 fans per contest.

MSU's average attendance is the third highest in the Big Sky Conference. It also currently stands as the Bobcats' highest mark in over 10 years in Brick Breeden Fieldhouse. MSU saw an average of 4,767 fans per game in 2008, while the 2005-06 slate had 3,596 per game.

MSU in the NCAA Rankings

The Bobcats rank among the top 100 teams in Division I basketball in four categories through 30 games. MSU is 49th in defensive rebounds per game (27.5), 58th in 3-point field goal defense (30.7%), 77th in field goal percentage defense (41.2%) and 78th in free throw percentage (74.1%).

Two of MSU's biggest improvements from a season ago have come on defense. The Bobcats gave up a 37.5% clip from deep and 48% mark from the field. Those outputs ranked the 'Cats 327th and 344th in the nation, respectively.

Defense on Display Over Course of Season

The Bobcats have stepped up defensively through the 2019-20 season.

Montana State held Northern Arizona to its second lowest shooting percentage of the season on Feb. 29 in a 63-57 win in Flagstaff. The Lumberjacks shot just 31.7%, narrowly topping their 31.5% they shot to open the season at then nationally-ranked Arizona.

MSU held Idaho to 50 points for one of its best defensive efforts in the past decade. Idaho's point total was the least given up by MSU to a Big Sky opponent since 2010-11. The Bobcats lost a 50-45 matchup on Jan. 24 that season to Idaho State.

Offense Lights it up in Bobcat Victories

MSU's two best shooting halves this year have come in wins against Idaho State (Feb. 13) and Idaho (Feb. 6).

MSU shot 69.2% on 18 of 26 from the field in the first half of its game against the Bengals. The Bobcats' previous best was a 68% clip they completed during the second half of their 72-50 victory over the Vandals.

Frey a Constant for Montana State

Among Harald Frey's statistical accolades, the Bobcats have also been able to rely on him to be on the court. The senior guard has made 126 consecutive starts which is the eighth most among active players in Division I. He came into the season fifth in career minutes played among all DI active players with 3,154. He's played in at least 35 minutes in 25 of 30 contests this season. He ranks 42nd in the nation playing nearly 36:04 minutes per game.

He added more to his accolades this January when he was selected as a candidate for the Senior CLASS Award. One of 30 to be recognized as an initial men's candidate, the award honors the most outstanding senior student-athletes in Division I athletics.

Ups and Downs Evident in Back-to-Back Contests

The Bobcats went 30 of 50 from the floor for a 60% shooting percentage against the Vandals on Feb. 6. The overall shooting mark was MSU's best in a game since Feb. 18, 2006, when MSU topped Idaho in Bozeman. The 'Cats have shot at least 50% from the field eight times this season. The 50 points the 'Cats allowed were the lowest given up to a Big Sky opponent since Jan. 24, 2011.

In its next time out, MSU shot just 13 of 58 (22.4%) in a 74-49 loss to EWU on Feb. 8. It was the Bobcats' lowest shooting mark of the 2019-20 season. The 49 points in the defeat also marked the first time the 'Cats have recorded under 50 in a contest since Nov. 9, 2018, when they lost at Indiana.

Foes at Best as Shots Fall Through

Four teams have shot over 40% from deep against MSU and four have shot 50% from the floor or higher against MSU through 30 games. The Bobcats are 0-4 in both cases.

MSU sits at 9-3 when they either hold the edge or tie their foe in the turnover category. The Bobcats are 14-6 when they are able to outshoot their opponent.

Taking Advantage of Close Opportunities

Montana State's one-point win over Weber State in Ogden on Jan. 23 served as the seventh contest that ended with a score by one possession (three points or less) this season. The 'Cats are 5-2 in those games. That mark is the most for MSU since the 2013-14 season when the Bobcats went 4-4 in games that ended with a result difference of one field goal.

Road Skid in Ogden Comes to End

Amin Adamu made a layup off a feed from Harald Frey with 3.2 seconds left to lift the 'Cats to 62-61 win over Weber State on Jan. 23. MSU came back from a 13-point second half deficit and led in the contest for just 2:53. The win for the Bobcats snapped an 11-game losing streak to the Wildcats that dated back to 2013. The victory for MSU in Ogden was its first on Weber State's home floor since the 2009 Big Sky Conference tournament.

Sprinkle in Rare Territory With Weber Win

Head coach Danny Sprinkle became the first in program history to win his first game coaching in Ogden, Utah. He also became the first MSU coach to pick up a win in his team's first matchup against Weber State since Roger Craft accomplished the feat in 1964. That matchup was the first ever between the two schools in men's basketball.

New Air Against Historical Foes

The Bobcats went 4-0 against Idaho State and Weber State during the regular season. Danny Sprinkle became MSU's first coach to earn wins in his opening two games against the two schools.

MSU's regular season sweep over the Wildcats was the first for the program since the 2004-05 season. It was also the first time MSU has picked up consecutive victories over Weber State since 2006.

Bobcats Sweep I-15 Road Trip

MSU's pair of victories over Weber State (Jan. 23) and Idaho State (Jan. 25) on the same road trip were the first for the program since the 2004-05 season. That year also featured MSU's previously held longest true road win streak of three which they matched.

The Bobcats had their three-game road win streak snapped in Missoula on Feb. 1.

'Norwegian Curry' Moving up Charts

Frey has been a mainstay in the Bobcat lineup since arriving to Bozeman from Oslo, Norway. He's continued his assault on MSU's record book with his career-high 37 points at Montana on Feb. 1. In that game, his points tied for 13th most in a single game in program history, his seven 3-pointers tied for seventh in a single game and his 12 free throws tied for fifth most all-time.

Frey is third among all-time Bobcats in points (1,875), second in assists (510), free throws made (447) and 3-pointers (270). He also is among the best in the Big Sky Conference. He's ranked 12th all-time in scoring and 10th in assists.

London Natives Putting Stamp on Records

Amin Adamu and Jubrile Belo have made their marks in their debut seasons at Montana State with both surpassing 340 points. The last time the Bobcats had at least two newcomers score over 300 points in the same season was during the 2004-05 campaign (Ja'Ron Jefferson, Branden Miller, Marvin Moss).

Belo Providing Big Presence

Jubrile Belo has continued to improve his play since making his way overseas. After breaking a knee for the second time in 2017 after only seven

games and using a redshirt at Lamar Community College, Belo played 30 games in 2018-19 and averaged 15 points and 8.8 rebounds per game for the Lopes. That improvement has translated to MSU.

Belo is second on the team in points per game (12.7) and has a 62.0% clip from the field. His interior presence can be seen on the stat line, with 57 of his 127 field goals coming by way of dunk. Belo has registered five double-doubles this season, with his most recent occurring on March 5 versus Southern Utah when he scored 25 and had 11 boards. He also put together a five-block performance against Idaho State on Feb. 13. His five blocks were the most by a Bobcat in a game since Feb. 12, 2015, when Eric Norma swatted five shots against Northern Colorado.

The Fernandez Vendetta Against Idaho

Borja Fernandez made his first career start at Idaho on Jan. 9 and has played a big role in both of MSU's wins over Idaho.

A freshman from Bilbao, Spain, Fernandez recorded his first career double-double of 10 points and 10 rebounds in Moscow on Jan. 9. He then scored a career-high 18 points and added 8 rebounds in the victory in Bozeman on Feb. 6.

Fernandez has played a combined 60 minutes versus Idaho and went 12-for-19 from the field against the Vandals.

No Senior Slide for Ricketts

Ladan Ricketts has found his groove as he works his way back from a ruptured calf muscle he suffered this past March. The senior from Livingston, Mont., has been a force from the 3-point line.

Ricketts is 50 of 125 from beyond the arc for a 40.0% clip. He's appeared in over 20 minutes on the court in 23 of the last 26 games. His career 3-point percentage of 43% currently ranks him fifth in program history. While he went 1 of 6 versus NAU on Dec. 30 from deep, his one shot made with under two minutes to play served as an eventual game winner over NAU.

Offense Matching Defensive Production

Montana State has been outshot by its opponent in just 10 of 30 games this season. The Bobcats were outshot by Weber State 39-33% on Jan. 23, with the 33% mark from the field that contest was MSU's lowest in a win this year.

Thirty games into the 2019-20 slate and only four opponents have shot over 50% against Montana State. Green Bay, CSU Bakersfield, Montana and Portland State each surpassed the mark in victories over MSU. The Bobcats have held 15 of their 30 foes to shooting less than 40% from the field.

New Style of Play Paying Dividends

Style of play over a year span has been noticeable for the men's basketball program. Last season's team averaged over 11 more points per game and ranked 50th in the country at 78.2 points per contest compared to its average of 66.8 this season. MSU's defense is giving up 13 less points to opponents per outing this season at 66.7, good for the 106th best mark in the country. The 'Cats ranked 336th a season ago giving up 79.8 points to foes per game.

Kirby Crashing The Boards

Junior Devin Kirby jumped to MSU's lead in the time in rebounds per game this season in MSU's win versus South Dakota State. His 15 rebounds versus SDSU (Dec. 5) were the most by a Bobcat in a single game since Quentin Everett snagged 15 versus Sac State on Feb. 7, 2016.

Kirby had his best output of 2020 by registering a double-double performance of 14 points and 10 rebounds versus Idaho State on Jan. 25. He's second on the team averaging 5.7 rebounds per game.

Backcourt Steadied by First-Year Duo

Amin Adamu and Mychael Paulo both have made big impacts for MSU at various times early in the 2019-20 season after making the jump from the junior college level.

Adamu has played in 30 minutes in 12 of MSU's games while he's recorded 18 double-digit scoring efforts. He poured in a career-high 26 points on Jan. 2 at Northern Colorado behind a team-best 11 field goals this season. He also hit an eventual-game winning layup with 3.2 seconds left in a 62-61 victory at Weber State (Jan. 23). Paulo played a career-high 37 minutes versus App State and had a 16-point performance versus Rocky Mountain (Nov. 9). Paulo proved essential down the stretch in a win over SDSU (Dec. 5), scoring five points in the final 25 seconds which was capped by a breakaway dunk.

Taking Advantage of Free Opportunities

Montana State leads the Big Sky Conference at the free throw line with its 74.1% clip this season. The Bobcats, ranked 78th in the nation from the stripe, have only shot under 60% from the line three times. Their worst effort at the line was in a 72-50 victory over Idaho (Feb. 6) when they went 6 of 13 at the charity stripe.

The Bobcats have sustained success in Big Sky play. Through 19 games of the conference schedule, MSU has went 297 of 392 from the line for a 75.8% clip.

Whole New Meaning of Defense

Montana State held Colorado Christian to 24% shooting in the second half of their game on Nov. 26. That mark was the second lowest percentage MSU has allowed in a half, with the lowest a 22.9% clip recorded by Tennessee Tech on Nov. 17. The Bobcats have held opponents to under 30% shooting during a half on eight occasions this season, with their latest a 25% first half output by Northern Arizona on Feb. 29.

Big Crowd Highlights Nonconference Home Finale

The Bobcats beat South Dakota State on Dec. 5 in their last home game ahead of Big Sky play. The game's attendance of 4,877 against SDSU was the highest attended non-conference home game for the program since 1997. On Dec. 30, 1997, MSU beat San Diego 77-61 in front of 5,477 fans during a holiday tournament played in Worthington Arena. The next highest attended non-conference home game was on Nov. 16, 2007, when MSU hosted Boise State in Bozeman in front of 4,866 fans.

Bobcats Split Contests Against the Summit

Montana State went 1-1 for the second straight season in the Big Sky-Summit League series. Last year, MSU beat North Dakota at home and fell to Omaha on the road. The Bobcats again split its matchups versus Summit League opponents this year. MSU beat South Dakota State in Worthington Arena on Dec. 5, but dropped a 79-65 contest against North Dakota State in Fargo on Dec. 16.

Bobcats go Undeclared at Spartan Invite

The Bobcats claimed their first regular season tournament title honors in two seasons by going undefeated over the course of three games in Greensboro from Nov. 15-17. MSU kept all three of its opponents to under 40% shooting from the field with all recording their season low scoring outputs. It was the first time MSU has won 3-0 at a regular season tournament since the 1966-67 season when the 'Cats defeated Texas, Temple and Oklahoma City at the All-College Tournament in OKC.

Long Road Stretch Out of The Way

MSU completed a five-day span featuring four games from Nov. 15-19. MSU has had a four-game road stand four times in the previous 10 seasons. The Bobcats played four games away from home consecutively a season ago and dropped all four. This year the Bobcats went 3-1 with their lone loss a 69-56 setback in front of 6,862 fans at GCU Arena against the Antelopes. MSU's longest stretch of road games in the last 10 years was in 2015-16 when MSU played six straight away from Bozeman in a span from Dec. 13-Jan. 2.

Defense Shines in Invitational Finale

Tennessee Tech shot just 25.9% (15-58) from the field in a 52-39 victory for MSU on Nov. 17. It was the first time since 2014 that MSU held an opponent under 30% shooting, while it was also the first time MSU kept an opponent under 40 points in a regular season game in 19 years.

Buzzer Beater Makes National Headlines

College basketball took notice of Montana State on Nov. 16 thanks to an unforgettable buzzer beater. UNCG's Isaiah Miller broke a 64-all tie by making a contested layup with 3.5 seconds remaining in the contest in the Spartans' home gym. MSU senior guard Harald Frey received the inbound pass and drilled a shot off glass from past half court to propel the Bobcats past the Spartans, 67-66. The shot earned SportsCenter's No. 1 on its Top 10 Plays of the weekend. UNCG dropped a home game for just the third time in three seasons in the one-point defeat to MSU.

Bobcats Hang Tough at No. 17/19 USU

For the second straight year Montana State opened its season against Utah State. While the 2018-19 opener ended in a 101-71 blowout by Utah State in Bozeman, this season's matchup came down to the end.

The Bobcats and ranked Aggies battled back and forth with MSU gaining a two-point lead with 5:30 remaining. The Aggies eventually used a 10-0 run to hold off the visiting Bobcats, 81-73, at Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. Utah State did most of its work from the free throw line, as the Aggies made 35, the most by a Bobcat opponent since 2007. MSU was led by senior Harald Frey who recorded a career-high 34 points, the most by a Bobcat in a season opener.

Former Bobcats Find Homes in G League

Recent MSU alumni Keljin Blevins and Tyler Hall were picked in the NBA G League Draft on Oct. 26. Hall was selected by the Westchester Knicks, the NBA G League affiliate of the New York Knicks, with the fourth overall pick. Blevins was chosen as the 18th pick by the Northern Arizona Suns, the Phoenix Suns' G League affiliate. The two are currently on each team's regular season rosters.

Hall and Blevins both competed in the NBA Summer League, with Hall playing for the Chicago Bulls and Blevins the Portland Trail Blazers. Blevins signed a training camp contract with Portland and scored 17 points over the course of four preseason games before being placed on waivers.

MSU Tabbed Seventh in Preseason Polls

The Montana State men's basketball team was picked to finish seventh in the Big Sky Conference in both the preseason coaches' and media polls, announced on Oct. 17. MSU tied for fourth in the league standings a year ago at 11-9, but due to tiebreakers, was the sixth seed in the Big Sky Tournament.

Harald Frey Earns Preseason Honors

Senior Harald Frey was named to the 2019-20 Big Sky Men's Basketball Preseason All-Conference Team on Oct. 16. Frey was previously selected to the All-Big Sky Second Team during the 2018-19 season. As a junior, Frey set career highs in points (17.2), assists (5.0) and rebounds (4.5) per game. He's already earned Big Sky honors this year as he was picked as Big Sky Player of the Week on Nov. 19 for his performance at UNCG's Spartan Invite.

Collegiate Experience Back in Blue & Gold

MSU returned three starters that played significant roles on the team a season ago. Harald Frey (Sr. - Oslo, Norway), Devin Kirby (Jr. - Chandler, Ariz.) and Ladan Ricketts (Sr. - Livingston, Mont.) all return with experience in the Bobcats' starting lineup. Quentin Guliford (So. - Peoria, Ariz.) and Zeke Quinlan (So. - Portland, Ore.) also appeared in their first collegiate seasons last year for the Bobcats.

Getting to Know The Roster

The Bobcats feature 10 new players on their roster. That number is among the most among all Division I institutions. MSU's nine newcomers to start the season was tied for 22nd most in the nation with Auburn, Austin Peay, Bradley, Bryant, Florida, Kentucky and Little Rock, TCU has the most new-

comers with 15 (20-player roster) and is followed by Nebraska with 14.

International Flavor

Six of Montana State's 15 players on its roster are from outside the United States. The six (Amin Adamu, Jubrile Belo, Borja Fernandez, Finn Fleute, Harald Frey, Mychael Paulo) make up the third highest amount of international players on a Division I roster. MSU is tied with Davidson, San Diego and Utah State with 6 foreign-born players. Only Saint Mary's (10) and Loyola Marymount (7) have more on their rosters.

Sprinkle Staff Tied by Familiarity

Head coach Danny Sprinkle is joined on the Bobcat bench by a group of coaches familiar to him and MSU. Chris Halsam and Luke Fennelly remained on staff for their seventh seasons, with Halsam staying on as an assistant and Fennelly serving as operations director. Shawn Dirden, who worked with Sprinkle previously as an assistant, returned to Bozeman to join his staff. Dan Russell joins the DI ranks after coaching at Casper College which has been the initial destination for several Bobcats in recent seasons.

A New Face to Lead the Program

Danny Sprinkle was appointed as the program's 23rd men's basketball coach on April 4, 2019. A Helena, Mont., native, Sprinkle began his coaching career in 2000 and spent all but two years since coaching as an assistant in the Big West Conference. Sprinkle has been a member of staffs that advanced to three NCAA Tournaments. Sprinkle completed an accomplished collegiate career as a Bobcat. He appeared in one NCAA Tournament as a player at MSU and still is among the top 10 in the Bobcats' record book in several categories.

A Bow on the 2018-19 Campaign

MSU wrapped up the 2018-19 season with some positive benchmarks, and ultimately a new direction. The Bobcats won their first Big Sky tournament game in a decade and tied for fourth in conference play to match the program's best finish since 2005. Their 11 Big Sky wins tied for the most since 2002.

Hall Leaves Legacy at Montana State

Tyler Hall will forever be etched into the Bobcat record books. Hall became Montana State's all-time scoring record holder as he finished his career with 2,518 points. He became the 69th player in Division I history to surpass 2,500 points. He also ended the year tied for ninth in Division I history with 431 made 3-point field goals in his career.

He broke the MSU scoring record during the Bobcats' 95-90 victory over Washington State on Dec. 9, 2018. He became the Big Sky Conference scoring king on Jan. 19, 2019, at Eastern Washington. The Rock Island, Ill., native was a four-time all-conference selection and was a first-team selection on two occasions.

A Tale of Two Sides of the Court

Montana State led the Big Sky Conference in several offensive categories last year. MSU led the league in assists (15.9) and points per game (82.7) in league play. MSU hadn't led the league in scoring since the 1997-98 season. MSU's 2,502 points scored was the second most in a season in program history. The Bobcats' .755 free throw percentage was tied for second in the Big Sky while their turnover margin of 2.0 was second.

MSU's defense gave up 79.8 points per game and opponents shot 48.4% from the field which were both the the most among Big Sky schools. MSU blocked just 32 shots in league play, 10th among league members. The Bobcats went 4-12 when opponents made at least half their shots.

DANNY SPRINKLE

Head Coach | First Season

Danny Sprinkle, one of Montana State's most accomplished basketball players during his career in the late 1990s, was appointed the program's 23rd men's basketball coach on Thursday, April 4, Montana State Director of Athletics Leon Costello announced.

"There are so many people to thank," Sprinkle said. "This is an unbelievable opportunity for me, my friends and my family. I wouldn't be close to anywhere to where I'm at right now without the support and guidance of so many individuals."

"The people at Montana State attracted me the most to the position," Sprinkle said. "It was even more attractive of a job once I got up to campus and met the people and sat down with them face

to face. President Cruzado's energy is contagious. You can see why the campus is booming and why the town is booming. I'm very excited to work with Leon. I know he's going to do all he can to get our program to the top."

A Helena High graduate, Sprinkle's coaching career began as a graduate assistant at Cal State Northridge in 2000-01. He spent all but two of the seasons since then - 2006-08, when he was a Bobcat assistant under Brad Huse - coaching in the Big West Conference. He worked at Cal State Northridge as a full-time assistant from 2001-06 and 2008-13. He coached at Cal State Fullerton prior to his return to Bozeman.

Sprinkle added duties as recruiting coordinator at each of his coaching stops. He helped lead Cal State Fullerton to the NCAA Tournament in 2017-18 for just the third time in program history and the year before that the Titans competed in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. He was also part of Cal State Northridge's 2001 and 2009 NCAA Tournament teams, with the Matadors winning the Big Sky regular season crown in 2001 and the Big West title in 2009.

As a Bobcat freshman in 1996, Sprinkle was a starter during the team's magical run to Big Sky regular season and tournament championships, landing All-Big Sky Tournament honors for his 30-point performance in the Championship. Sprinkle earned Big Sky Freshman of the Year honors in 1996 and was an all-league selection three consecutive seasons, including his first team selection in 1997. He held the MSU career and season 3-point records upon graduation and remains the eighth-leading scorer in school history. Sprinkle is a member of the 1996 team that was inducted into the Montana State Athletics Hall of Fame in 2006. Born in Pullman, Wash., Sprinkle enjoyed an outstanding career at Helena High School which included all-state honors twice in basketball, while also competing in football and track. He graduated from Montana State in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in health and human development.

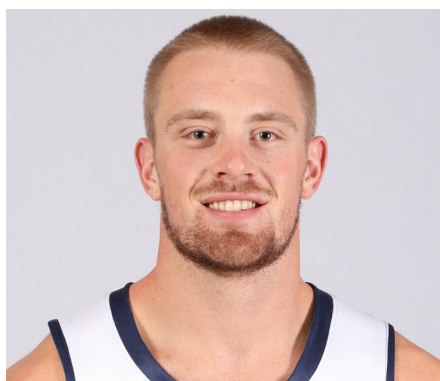

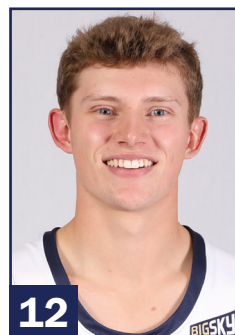
