COMPETITION SHOES:

ONLY 1/8" or 1/4" pyramid spikes will be allowed. **No needles or pin spikes.**

PRELIMINARY ROUNDS, ADVANCEMENT TO FINALS, & TIMED FINALS:

- 1. We will place the fastest entry marks in the last heat in the 200, 400, 800, Mile. 3000.
- 2. Preliminary rounds will be contested in the 60 and 60 Hurdles if there are more than 6 participants. Top 6 will advance to 1 heat final.
- 3. Top 9 will advance to finals in throws and horizontal jumps

RUNWAY LENGTH & DISTANCE OF TAKE-OFF BOARDS TO THE LANDING PIT:

Long Jump: Runway Length – 145' Triple Jump: Runway Length – 145' Pole Vault: Runway Length – 128'

Triple Jump boards are 29'6, 36' and 41' from the pit.

Long Jump board is 12' from the pit.

FIELD EVENTS:

Top 9 performances advance to the finals Field Events will likely be limited to *top 14 entries* per event Pole vault minimum entry standards - Women 10'4", Men 13'

IMPLEMENT INSPECTION:

All throwing implements will be inspected immediately west of the throwing sector 75 minutes prior to the first throwing event. Implements for the first event that pass inspection will be delivered to the throwing area 45 minutes before the first event, or as soon as they pass inspection. Implements for subsequent throwing events will be delivered as soon as prior throwing events are concluded. Implements delivered to throwing area may not leave the throwing area until the end of the final flight or finals in which they are to be used. Implements that do

not pass inspection may be claimed at the conclusion of each respective event. All current NCAA rules regarding implements will be enforced.

LOCKER ROOMS:

There will be small visiting team locker rooms in the North Tunnel, one will be designated for men and one for women. Plan to furnish your own towels.

ATHLETIC TRAINING ROOM:
