#2/2 Montana State Bobcats vs. #7/7 FBS Oregon Ducks

THE MATCHUP

Montana State plays its highest-ranked FBS opponent on record Saturday when the Bobcats open the 2025 season at No. 7 Oregon. This year's MSU opener pits teams that finished the 2024 regular season unbeaten.

Montana State advanced to the FCS Championship game for the second time in four seasons in 2024. **Oregon** finished 2024 13-1, falling to Ohio State in the Rose Bowl.

Montana State lost its 1947 season opener 27-14 at Oregon. Legendary quarterback Norm Van Brocklin led the Ducks to 21 fourth-quarter points at Hayward Field in UO's come-from-behind win.

BOBCAT TEAM NOTES

- ▶ The Bobcats' 15 wins and six road victories in 2024 stand as program bests.
- ▶ MSU's 2024 semifinal win against South Dakota was Brent Vigen's 47th as Bobcat head coach, tying Sonny Holland for second-most in program history.
- ▶ Brent Vigen's tenure has produced four straight playoff appearances and two national title games, both bests by a Bobcat coach.

ON THE MSU OFFENSE

- ▶ Montana State gained over 400 total yards in 22 of its last 28 games.
- ▶ Based on available records, the 2024 Bobcats joined 2009 Nevada as the only Division I football teams with three 1,000-yard rushers. MSU's Tommy Mellott eclipsed 1,000 yards during the FCS Championship game, finishing the season at 1,050. Scot-tre Humphrey (1,306) and Adam Jones (1,172) also reached that milestone.
- ▶ Adam Jones stands 34th in MSU history with 1,224 career rushing yards, and his 1,172 in 2024 was a freshman record.
- ▶ MSU finished as the only FCS team to score 30 points in each 2024 game, averaging 40.8 points to lead the nation. MSU's 478.8 yards a game was 2nd in the FCS.
- ▶ MSU scored in 57 of last season's 64 quarters.

ON THE MSU DEFENSE

- ▶ MSU had 10 sacks in the 2024 playoffs, 4.5 by Kenneth Eiden IV. He recorded at least a share of a sack in the last seven games.
- ▶ Montana State allowed 14.7 points per game at home in 2024, 4.8 in the first half.
- ▶ The Cats allow 306.0 total yards per game, 12th nationally.

ON THE MSU SPECIAL TEAMS

- ▶ Taco Dowler is now MSU's career punt return yards leader (1,036).
- ▶ MSU introduces new punter, kickoff specialist and long snapper in 2025.

STADIUM STORY

- ▶ MSU is 31-1 at home under Brent Vigen.
- ▶ The Cats have never played at Autzen Stadium, but are 0-1 at Oregon's legendary Hayward Field, its current track stadium.

MSU-UO Series Notebook

- Montana State's only matchup with the Ducks came in 1947, when the Cats held a 14-6 lead in the fourth quarter. College and Pro Football Hall of Fame quarterback Norm Van Brocklin led the Webfoots to a 21-point final period and a 27-14 win.
- MSU legend Gene Bourdet was marvelous in the 1947 game at UO. The Bobcat Athletics Hall of Famer, later an assistant coach and Athletic Director at his alma mater, connected on a second-quarter pass to Ken Card and a third-quarter throw to Harry Perrigo to account for Montana State's scores.
- Montana State has capitalized on several transfers from Oregon in the last two decades. Receiver Elvis Akpla, a future Bobcat Athletics Hall of Famer, came to MSU in 2009 and remains second in school history with 2,207 career receiving yards. Quarterback Cody Kempt (2008-10) and defensive lineman John Laidet (2008-11) also played key roles at MSU.
- This year's season opener marks the fourth game for a Brent Vigen-coached team in the state of Oregon. The Cats lost to Oregon State in Portland in 2022, beating PSU in Hillsboro in 2021 and 2024.

Scouting Oregon

- Oregon's first season in the Big 10 Conference couldn't have gone much better. The Ducks swept through the 2024 regular season with a 12-0 record, 9-0 in the conference, then topped Penn State in the league's title tilt. The only blemish was a season-ending loss to Ohio State, which UO had beaten earlier in the season.
- The Ducks operated one of college football's most efficient offenses in 2024, averaging 279.5 yards per game passing (13th in the FBS) and 34.9 points per game (17th) behind quarterback Dillon Gabriel.
- This is Oregon's second straight season opener against a Big Sky opponent. The Ducks topped Idaho 24-14 on August 31, 2024.
- While the Ducks utilize a new starting quarterback in 2025, that player will have several impressive offensive weapons at his disposal. Running backs Noah Whittington, who battled an injury in 2024, and Tulane transfer Makhi Hughes trigger Oregon's bruising ground game. Receivers Justius Lowe and Gary Bryant Jr. bring experience to the aerial attack.

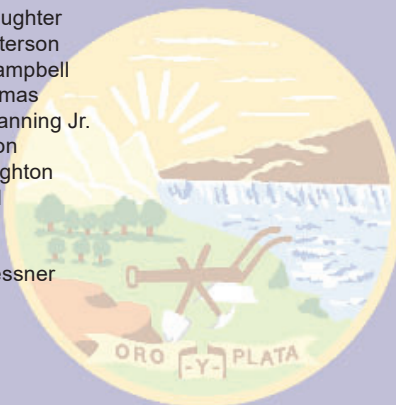

Bobcat Legacy Number

Former Bobcat coach Jeff Choate introduced 41 as Montana State's legacy number in the summer of 2016, a tribute to the Treasure State's status as the 41st state in the Union and to Montana State's iconic 1941 football team, the last group of Bobcats to play football before World War II. By the end of the 1944 season 10 Bobcat football players had perished in the war effort, a fact observed by famed sportscaster Bill Stern. Stern's 1944 All-America football was comprised only of those 10 men, and in the next year their names had been memorialized nationally and read into the Congressional record. By the time the 1945 academic year dawned, four teammates had joined those 10. Bozeman's Grant Collins wore no. 41 when Choate decided to designate it as MSU's legacy number, and Belgrade's Brayden Konkol was the first Bobcat selected specifically for the honor.

Bobcat Team Notebook

- Montana State's 15th straight win last December vs. South Dakota set a new school record win streak, topping the 13 consecutive wins by the 1976-77 Bobcats. The team's only unbeaten regular season of more than five games was 1956 (9-0 before the Aluminum Bowl tie).

- The Cats finished 2024 6-1 vs. ranked opponents, 5-1 versus top 10 foes. Brent Vigen is 18-7 against ranked teams.

- The Bobcats clinched the program's first 6-0 regular season road record with last November's win at UC Davis.

- The Bobcats have scored at least 30 points in 16 consecutive games (dating to last year), a school record.

- Montana State has scored at least 30 points in 44 of Brent Vigen's 57 games as head coach. The Bobcats have led the Big Sky in scoring in three of Vigen's four seasons, finishing in the top three in the nation in those three campaigns:

- With his 106 yards against UNC, Taco Dowler became MSU's only 100-yard receiver of 2024

- MSU's 4.50 penalties per game was 15th-fewest in the FCS in 2024. While 56 penalties were enforced against the Cats in the season's first 11 games, that number shrank to 12 in the last five.

- Saturday's game marks the third opener in Brent Vigen's five seasons that the team opens against an FBS foe, the first against a power conference opponent.

- MSU has sold out 26 straight home regular season games.

- The Bobcats' only first-quarter deficits in 2024 came against New Mexico, UC Davis and North Dakota State. Montana State outscored its foes 152-53 in the opening period.

- MSU outscores its foes 358-83 in the first half. By quarter: 1st – 152-53, 2nd – 233-65, 3rd – 146-58, 4th – 121-116.

- MSU's six straight post-season appearances is the program's longest stretch.

- MSU's 9-0 home slate in 2024 was the fifth undefeated home season in school history and the best in school history, eclipsing the 8-0 home marks in 2021 and 2022. The perfect home seasons during the Sales/Bobcat Stadium era are 1976, 2005, 2021, 2022 and 2024. The stadium opened in 1973.

- MSU's 2024 senior class finished with a four-year career record of 47-9 (.839). The 2023 group finished 43-13 (.768). The Class of '22 compiled 44 wins and a .772 win percentage. The 1956-59 group finished with an .816 win percentage.

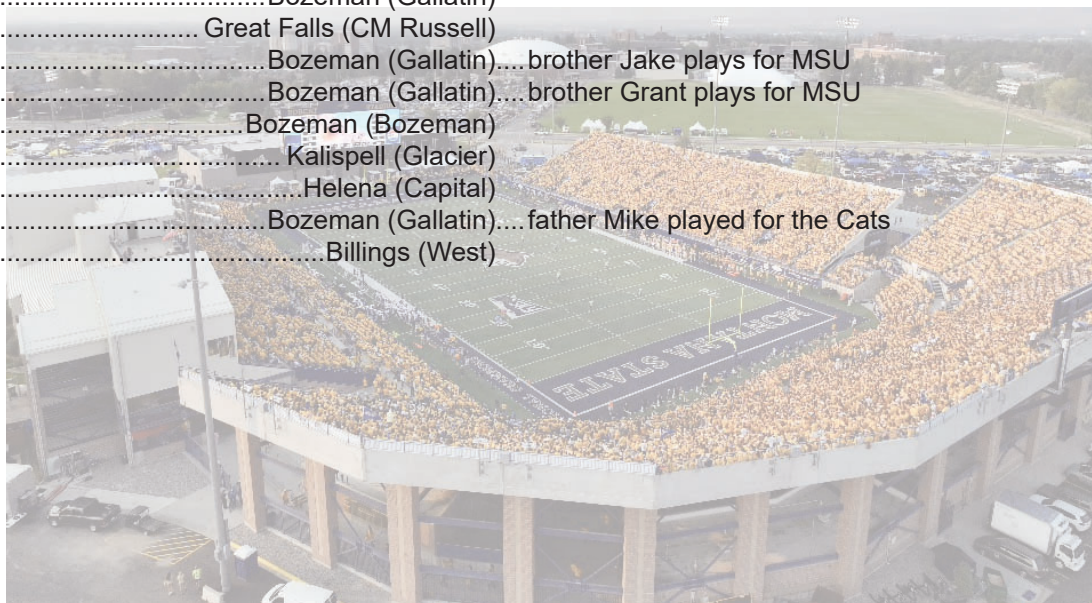
