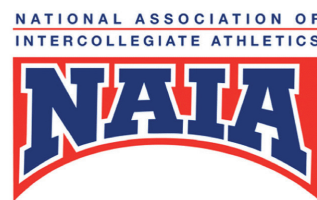

## Comet Coaches Club

The Mayville State University Athletic Department developed the Comet Coaches Club in the Fall of 2018. The program is a sponsorship signage advertising program that provides promotional opportunities in Mayville State's three main athletic venues: Lewy Lee Fieldhouse (basketball and volleyball), Jerome Berg Field (football and softball), and Scott Berry Field (baseball). MSU's Campus Center Foyer and the Comets Landing Snack Bar are also incorporated into the Comet Coaches Club advertising program.

Mayville State's Comet Coaches Club allows for you to showcase your business while supporting the athletic programs. Each advertiser can display a company name and logo. Levels within the program accommodate different levels of participation. There is room for four advertisers at the top level. This level requires a commitment of \$12,000 - \$15,000 per year. The second level in the Comet Coaches Club asks for a commitment of \$4,000 per year. There is also opportunity for advertising at \$2,000-\$3,000 per year as well.

Currently, 20 business are participating in Mayville State's Comet Coaches Club.



# CDC Guidelines

Aside from his work in administration, Mr. Hall had a successful nine-year record as a head wrestling coach including four straight team state championships.

Ryan Hall grew up in Mineral, Va., where he competed as a two-sport all-state athlete in wrestling and soccer and was a member of the National Honor Society. He graduated cum laude from Ferrum College in 2007, where he was a four year starter on the varsity soccer team and then earned a Master of Education degree in Sport Leadership/Administration from Virginia Commonwealth University in 2008, graduating with honors.

# 2020 Mayville State Women's Basketball Coaching Staff



Dennis Hutter is entering his 16th season as the Head Women's Basketball Coach at Mayville State. Coach Hutter has been instrumental in turning the women's basketball program around. The Comets have been a model of consistency during Coach Hutter's sixteenth year leadership. During the past eight seasons, the Comets have compiled an overall record of 135-60, for a winning percentage of .692, and they also have advanced to the National Tournament twice, advancing to the "Sweet Sixteen" in 2014. The Comets also have won numerous conference championships and conference tournament championships during that period.

The Comets were Conference Champs this past season, defeating Viterbo in the NSAA Championship by a final score of 74-70. The Comets advanced to the National Tournament for the first time since 2014. Mayville State lost in the opening round of the 2020 National Tournament to Kansas Wesleyan to finish the season at 25-6. Claire Blaszczek and Kylee Heuring were named to NSAA All-Conference First-Team. Heuring was also named NSAA Player of the Year and named Second-Team All-American.

Coach Hutter has developed numerous All-Conference and All-American players during his tenure at Mayville State. The Comets up-tempo style of play is very enjoyable for the players to play in, and also for the fans to watch. The Comets have ranked in the Top 10 in the country in numerous offensive categories over the past six years including: Points scored per game, three pointers made, three pointers attempted, three point field goal percentage, steals per game, and free throw percentage.

Coach Hutter has built the Comets women's basketball family around the idea of Four Daily Do's: 1) Great Effort, 2) Great Attitude, 3) Great Improvement 4) Great FUN!!!! The coaches and players focus on these Four Daily Do's everyday both on and off the floor. Those are the four areas of their basketball game and their lives that the coaches and players have complete control of.

Prior to coming to Mayville State, Coach Hutter was the assistant coach at NCAA Division II Southwest Minnesota State University in Marshall, MN. Prior to that, he was the Head Girls Basketball Coach at Centennial High School in Blaine, MN. Coach Hutter graduated from Bethel College in St. Paul, MN with a degree in Physical education, and then received his Master's Degree from Southwest Minnesota State University in Educational Leadership.

Coach Hutter lives in Mayville, ND with his wife Missy and their four children: Ali (21), Brianna (18), Jake (15) and Cole (10).

## Quick Hits on the Comets

- The Women's Basketball team is entering the final non-conference game before the conference opener Wednesday with a 3-1 record.
- The Comets are averaging 64.8 points per game, 35.8 rebounds, 11.8 assists, shooting 44.2 percent from the field, 35.3 3-point percentage, and 7.8 made free throws per game.
- The defense is allowing 62.3 points per game, 28.8 rebounds, 12.0 assists, shooting 39.4 percent from the field, 35.1 percent from behind the arc, and 12.8 made free throws per game.
- Jordan Zrust is leading MSU in the scoring department with 18.8 points per game, she is also averaging 5.3 rebounds, 1.2 assists, 1.7 steals.
- Danneka Voegeli is second on the team with 12.0 points per game, 5.3 rebounds per game, and 1.2 steals.
- CJ Decker is leading the Comets in assists and rebounds with 4.5 and 6.5, respectively, she is also averaging 8.8 points.
- Grace Cote is averaging 9.3 points off the bench for the Comets with 4.0 rebounds, and a team-high nine 3-pointers made.
- The Comets were selected fifth in the NSAA Preseason Coaches' Poll with 27 points, Bellevue was selected first in the Poll with 60 points.

## Matching up with the Lions

- Trinity Bible College enters the game against the Comets with a 1-4 record.
- TBC and MSU matched-up on November 13th at the Israel-Strong Memorial Tournament in Aberdeen and the Comets won by a final score of 75-36.
- The Lions are averaging 49.6 points per game, 29.0 rebounds, 29.9 field goal percentage, 25.6 percentage from behind the arc, and 9.9 made free throws.
- Defensively, TBC is allowing 72.4 points per game, 45.0 rebounds, 42.7 percent from the field, 30.8 3-point percentage, and 3.3 free throws made.
- Stacia West is averaging 21.4 points per game, 7.2 rebounds, 1.0 steals, and 0.4 blocks.
- Brenna Anderson is second on the team with 11.8 points per game, shooting 30.7 percent from the field, and tallying 6.2 rebounds, 3.2 assists, and 1.2 steals.

# 2020 Mayville State Men's Basketball Coaching Staff



Darren Tighe is entering his fourth season as the head men's basketball coach at Mayville State University. During his first three years, the Comets have claimed back-to-back-to-back Conference Championships.

In three seasons, Tighe has helped coach the Comets to an overall record of 62-25 including back-to-back-to-back appearances in the NAIA National Tournament.

For the second straight season, the Comets surpassed 20 wins in 2019-20, finishing the season with a 24-5 record and 11-3 second place finish in the NSAA. The Comets opened the conference tournament with a win over #7 Dakota State 74-59, followed by a win over #3 Viterbo 75-62. In the championship, the #2 Comets defeated #5 Waldorf 65-62 to claim the third straight NSAA Tournament Championship. Max Cooper was named MVP of the NSAA Conference Tournament averaging 17.3 points, 9.3 rebounds, 2.0 blocks, and shooting 58.3 percent from the field.

Max Cooper was named to 1st team All-Conference and NAIA All-American Honorable Mention. Jalen Valverde was named to NSAA 2nd team All-Conference. The

Comets were in the NAIA Coaches Top-25 for six straight weeks during the season, with the highest rank of 22. The Comets led the conference in Points per Game with 82.0 points per game, Points per Game allowed with 67.7 points per game, Field Goal Percentage Defense allowing 43.1%, and Rebounding with 41.3 rebounds per game and a 11.5 rebounding margin. The Points per Game allowed was also ranked in the top-5 nationally.

The 2018-19 season saw the Comets win 20 games which was the most wins since the 2007 National Runner Up Team coached by Craig Smith (Utah State). The Comets were 9-5 in conference play (most conference wins since 2007), finished in 3rd place in the NSAA (highest conference finish since 2007) and hosted a home playoff game (first time since 2007). The Comets would go on to beat #6 Viterbo, #2 Presentation College, and #1 Bellevue University to win the NSAA Conference Tournament Championship for the second straight year.

The Comets received votes in the NAIA National Poll for 15 straight weeks. Gorg Alhag capped off a stellar two-year career with the Comets by earning Honorable Mention All-American, NSAA 1st Team All-Conference, and NSAA Tournament MVP. Daniel Lindgren finished his 5-year career with the Comets earning a spot on the NSAA 2nd Team All-Conference Team. Gorg Alhag and Daniel Lindgren also became members of the 1,000 point club.

Darren and his wife Samantha live in Mayville with their children Adeline (7), Eli (4), and Piper (2).

## Quick Hits on the Comets

- The Comets enter the non-conference matchup with the Lions after dropping their first game last week to Dickinson State by a final score of 87-93.
- Mayville State is currently averaging 93.7 points per game, 44.7 rebounds, shooting 55.8 percent from the field, 33.9 percent from the 3-point line, and 16.7 free-throws made per game.
- Defensively, MSU is allowing 81.3 points, 27.3 rebounds, 29.7 percent from the field, 36.0 percent from behind the 3-point line, and forcing 11.7 turnovers.
