15th-Rated Mavericks Entertain Nanooks at Verizon Center in Two-Game Western Collegiate Hockey Association Series Friday and Saturday Minnesota State Takes 8-5-1 Overall Record into Series With Alaska; Mavericks Resume League Action Following Nonconference Series Split With Minnesota

Off the Hop: #15 Minnesota State (8-5-1 overall, 5-4-1 WCHA) resumes Western Collegiate Hockey Association action this weekend with two conference games vs. the University of Alaska (4-9-1 overall, 3-6-1 WCHA) this weekend. The Mavericks and the Nanooks play at Verizon Center (4,832) Friday (7:07 p.m. CST) Saturday (7:07 p.m. CST).

<u>About the Minnesota State-Alaska Series:</u> The Mavericks, which split a road series at Alaska earlier this year (7-1 win, 4-2 loss, Oct. 21-22) own a 5-14-1 all-time mark in the series with the Nanooks.

Minnesota State Most Recently: Minnesota State, which was idle last weekend, stands 8-5-1 overall (5-4-1 WCHA) after a nonconference series with the University of Minnesota the weekend of Nov. 18-19. The Mavericks prevailed by a 4-1 margin over the Gophers in the first game of the series in Mankato before dropping a 1-0 decision in Minneapolis the next night.

About Alaska: The Nanooks stand 4-9-1 overall and are 3-6-1 in WCHA games on the year after dropping a pair of home league games (4-1 loss and 4-2 loss) to Michigan Tech last weekend.

Senior forward **Marcus Basara** has 5-5--10 on the year to sit atop the Alaska scoring charts, while sophomore center **Chad Staley** (4-5--9), junior defenseman **Zach Frye** (3-5--8) and senior winter **Brandon Morley** (0-8--8) follow close behind. Sophomore **Jesse Jenks** (3-6-1, 3.04, .895) has started 10 games in the Alaska net. The Nanooks are led head coach **Dallas Ferguson** (Alaska '96) who stands 66-14--39 and is in his ninth season as a college head coach.

Minnesota State All-Time: The Minnesota State men's hockey program, begun in 1969-70, completed its 47th year of competition last year. The Mavericks are in their 21st year as members of NCAA Division I and in their 18th season as members of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association. The Mavericks are 844-627-149 (.567) all-time and stand 216-212-58 (.506) in regular-season games vs. WCHA opponents.

Minnesota State Head Coach Mike Hastings

Named the head coach in April of 2012, Crookston, Minn., native Mike Hastings has enjoyed immense success behind the bench of the Minnesota State men's hockey program in his four seasons with the Mavericks.

Under his guidance, the Mavericks have forged a 100-49-7 record, won a pair of MacNaughton Cups as WCHA regular-season champions, two Broadmoor Trophies as WCHA post-season tournament champions and made three NCAA postseason tournament appearances.

In his first year as head coach of the Mavericks in 2012-13, Hastings was named WCHA Coach of the Year after leading MSU to a 24-14-3 mark. The Crookston, Minn., was named national coach of the year by College Hockey News and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award as the AHCA National Coach of the Year.

In his second season in charge, 2013-14, the Mavericks continued its ascent with the program racking up a 26-14-1 mark. Minnesota State captured its first ever Broadmoor Trophy as the WCHA Final Five champions (league postseason tournament) and made its third NCAA postseason tournament appearance.

The ascendency continued in 2014-15 with a third consecutive trip to the NCAA postseason, while establishing a school record for wins with a 29-8-3 record. Rated #1 in the country five times during the course of the season, the Mavericks won the Broadmoor for the second consecutive year, while a 21-4-3 league mark gave the school its first MacNaughton Cup as conference regular-season champs. Hastings was named WCHA Coach of the Year and the recipient of the Spencer Penrose Award as the AHCA National Coach of the Year.

Year Four of the Hastings regime concluded with a share of the MacNaughton Cup as the WCHA regular-season champions with Minnesota State turning in a 16-5-7 league slate en route a fourth consecutive 20-win campaign (21-13-7). The Mavericks won a first-round play-off series for the fourth straight year in advancing to the Final Five championship game for the third straight year.

The third coach in the history of the Maverick men's hockey program and a 1993 graduate of St. Cloud State where he served as a defenseman for the Huskies, Hastings coached and served as GM of Omaha of the United States Hockey League for 14 years before stops as an assistant coach with college hockey programs at Nebraska-Omaha and the University of Minnesota led him to his current position with Minnesota State.

Has 1-4--5 on the year, owns 9-34--43 with 142 shots on goal, is +16 and has 101 blocked shots in 115 career games.

Carter Foguth Notes: In second season serving as team captain...Three-time letterwinner (2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16) was a WCHA All-Academic honoree last year... At 123 games played stands as Minnesota State's active career games played leader...Has 36 blocked shots this year, which is tied for second in the nation...Has 242 blocked shots and is +26 in four seasons with the Mavericks.

Cole Huggins Notes: Three-year letterwinner (2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16) is a two-time WCHA All-Academic pick...Owns school record for shut-outs with 11 and ranks sixth on school's career wins list with 44...Named WCHA Defensive Player of the Week (third time in career) after backstopping Mavericks to 3-1 an 4-0 wins over #17 Michigan Tech Oct. 7-8, owns a 6-3-0

record along with a 2.02 goals against average and a .919 save percentage this year.

Michael Huntebrinker Notes: Three-year letterwinner (2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16) is in first year as an alternate captain...Two-time WCHA All-Academic honoree and WCHA Scholar-Athlete honoree (at least 3.50 grade point average)...Has 2-5--7 in 14 games played this year... 13-25--38 in 99 career games with the Mavericks.

Jordan Nelson Notes: Three-year letterwinner (2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16) is a two-time WCHA All-Academic honoree and WCHA Scholar-Athlete honoree (at least 3.50 grade point average)...Has points in six of the last 12 games, leads the Mavericks with 121 face-off wins and face-off percentage (.568). The Williston, N.D., native has 15 goals and 17 assists for 32 points in 112 career games played.

Zach Stepan Notes: Three-time letterwinner (2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16) is a 2012 Nashville Predators draft pick (4th round, 112 overall)...Has 18-30-48 in 112 career games.

C.J. Franklin Notes: Two-year letterwinner is in first season as team captain...2014 Winnipeg Jets draftee (5th round, 129th overall)... Finished third on team in scoring and second in goals with 14-11--25 in sophomore season and saw action in all 41 games...Had a goal and an assist in Minnesota State's 4-1 win over the University of Minnesota on Nov. 18. His goal against the Gophers is his sixth career game-winning goal.

Zeb Knutson Notes: Two-year letterwinner (2014-15, 2015-16) finished sixth on school's point-scoring charts in 2015-16 with six goals and 11 assists for 17 points...Ranks seventh on Minnesota State's scoring chart with 3-5-8...Has totalled 11-17--28 in 62 career games.
