MSUM recorded a 42-28 win over Northern State on Saturday at Scheels Field. The Dragons built a 35-7 halftime lead and picked up their second straight win of the season. Sophomore quarterback Jakup Sinani threw for 238 yards and three scores while sophomore running back Zach Simons rushed for 84 yards and two scores. Senior safety Aaron Doan led the defense with 14 tackles while Deiondre Taylor and Shad Vedaa each had interceptions.

# MINNESOTA STATE UNIVERSITY MOORHEAD DRAGONS

Simons leads MSUM with 175 rushing yards and three touchdowns. Junior Herman Gray has rushed for 117 yards and a touchdown. Sinani has thrown for 341 yard and four touchdowns. Sophomore receiver Jake Richter has 13 catches for 284 yards and four touchdowns while sophomore receiver Grady Bresnahan has 13 catches for 108 yards and a score. MSUM is scoring 27.7 points per game and recording 361.3 yards per game of total offense.

Doan and senior linebacker Casey Paskey lead the defense with 26 tackles while Taylor has 25 tackles and a team-best two interceptions. Vedaa has 13 tackles and an interception while senior cornerback Jerry Raye has 17 tackles and a blocked kick. Sophomore Darius Woods-Steichen has a team-best two tackles. MSUM is allowing 32.7 points per game and 435.7 yards per game.

About Mary  
Mary fell to 0-3 on the season with a 41-28 loss at Minot State on Saturday. The Marauders trailed 41-14 at one point before scoring a pair of fourth quarter touchdowns to cut the lead late.

Sophomore running back Jordan Beaty leads the Marauder ground game with 85 yards on 29 carries. Junior quarterback Jordan Velarde has thrown for 326 yards and a score while freshman quarterback Jason Hoekstra has thrown for 313 yards and a score. Sophomore receiver Luke Little has 20 catches for 334 yards to lead the receiving corps. The Marauders score 13.67 points per game and record 307 yards per game of total offense.

Junior linebacker Grady Blewett leads the defense with 22 tackles while sophomore linebacker Will Blewett has 19. Freshman linebacker Maxwell Askew has four tackles for loss. The Marauders allow 40.3 points per game and 436.0 yards of total offense.

### More about the Dragons Deiondre's Defense

Junior cornerback Deiondre Taylor is off to a strong start for the Dragon defense. He leads the team with two interceptions, including a key one in the end zone to end a Northern scoring threat, and is tied for fifth in the NSIC in that category. He is second on the team with 25 tackles as well.

### Doan Getting It Done on D

Senior safety Aaron Doan shares the MSUM team lead with 26 tackles and is tied for fourth in the NSIC at 8.7 tackles per game, along with senior teammate Casey Paskey. Doan had a career-high 14 tackles, including eight solo stops, in the win over Northern

State.

### Simons Says

Sophomore Zach Simons was recruited to MSUM as a quarterback but made the switch to running back last season and has been an important part of the MSUM ground game this season. He leads the Dragons with 175 rushing yards and three touchdowns and recorded two in the win over Northern, including a 29-yarder in the first quarter. Simons is averaging 4.9 yards per carry.

### Richter Big Threat at Receiver

Sophomore receiver Jake Richter had the best game of his Dragon career during the win over UMC. He caught five passes for a career-high 123 yards and two scores in the win. For the season the Richter leads the Dragons in receptions (13), receiving yards (284) and touchdowns (four) and is fourth in the NSIC at 94.7 receiving yards per game.

### Meehl A Winner in First Start

Junior Bryce Meehl made his first start at quarterback of his collegiate career a winning one on Aug. 30 vs. Minnesota Crookston. The junior from Oakes, N.D., completed 15-of-30 passes for 215 yards and two scores in the win. He didn't turn the ball over and also was only sacked once.

### Sack Party

Darius Woods-Steichen had a career-high two sacks in the win over UMC. The performance was part of five sacks by the Dragon defense, which held UMC to 10 points and 204 yards of total offense.

### Youth Movement

Nearly half of MSUM's roster is freshmen, as 48 are on the roster this year. That does not include nine redshirt freshmen from a year ago.

### Home Grown

A total of 69 players on MSUM's roster are from Minnesota and North Dakota as the Dragon coaching staff continues to emphasize recruiting locally. A total of 38 players are from Minnesota. There are 16 players from Wisconsin and 12 from Illinois.

### Week 4 Under Laqua

MSUM is 2-5 in the Steve Laqua era during week 4 games. MSUM ended a five-game losing streak on Week 4 with a 21-20 win over Concordia-St. Paul last season. The Dragons had lost five straight week 4 games, including a 36-34 loss to Concordia St. Paul in 2013 and a 28-14 loss to Minnesota State last season. MSUM lost to Southwest Minnesota State 48-9 in 2015. In 2014, MSUM lost to Sioux Falls 73-21. In 2012, they lost to Minnesota State 24-0.

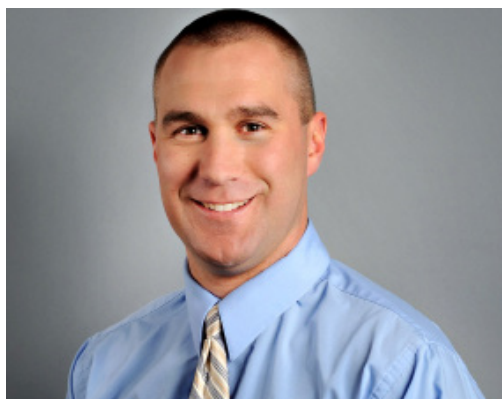

## COACHING BIO

Steve Laqua is entering his eighth year as the head football coach at Minnesota State University Moorhead in 2018. The Cavalier, N.D., native has taken on the challenge of helping restore Dragon football to its past glory.

Laqua is the 17th coach in Dragon history, being named to the post in the spring of 2011. He came to the Dragons after a turning around the Fargo Shanley High School program as its head coach for four seasons.

MSUM finished 7-4 in 2016 and posted back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 1998-99. The Dragons' seven wins were most since 1999. The Dragons also regained the Axe with a 42-41 win over Bemidji State. A total of 11 players earned All-NSIC honors while junior wide receiver Damon Gibson was AFCA 2nd Team All-American.

In 2015, the Dragons, despite losing two key offensive starters to injury early in the year, recorded their first winning season in nine years by posting a 6-5 mark. MSUM opened 3-0, highlighted by a last-second win at Concordia-St. Paul in Week 2 and a 35-34 win over playoff qualifier Augustana in Week 3. The Dragons regained the Paddle with a 37-0 win over Mary in Week 10. MSUM had two players named to the All-NSIC North Division Second Team, Bennen Bierman and Jake Busse, while six players were honorable mention selections.

The 2014 campaign saw the MSUM offense reach new heights. MSUM ranked fourth in the nation in first downs (292), a mark that led the NSIC. The Dragons were sixth in total offense (517.6, which also led the NSIC) and 13th in rushing offense (260.7). The Dragons (12 on offense, one on special teams) accounted for 13 school records in 2014. Six were single-game records while five were single-season and two were career records. A highlight was MSUM setting a new single-game record for total yardage twice, including in the finale win over Minnesota Crookston.

Six players earned All-NSIC North Division honors, led by first-team selections Adam Jiskra (junior wide receiver) and Zayne Medhaug (junior running back). Jiskra and Medhaug also earned all-region honors from Don Hansen and the Beyond Sports Network.

The 2013 season saw the Dragons make significant progress. MSUM finished third in the eight-team NSIC North Division with a 4-3 mark after being picked to finish seventh in the preseason poll. MSUM finished the season strong, going 4-2 in its last six games. The Dragons had seven All-NSIC players, including sophomore wide receiver Adam Jiskra, who was first-team all-conference. MSUM's offense set eight school records, including most total yards in a game (685) and most passing yards in a game.

The team's offense was ranked 35th in all of Division II in total yards per game. Sophomore quarterback Jake Hodge ranked fourth in the nation for points responsible for and seventh in total offense.

MSUM also beat Mary for the first time in school history to claim the "Paddle" for the first time, and the Dragons also regained the Battle Axe for the first time since 2008 with a 35-17 win over Bemidji State.

The Dragons fielded one of the youngest teams in the NSIC -- starting as many as 11 freshmen in a game -- in 2012 and finished with a 1-10 mark.

In his first season, Laqua led the Dragons to a 2-9 record including an opening-day victory and a thrilling overtime win on homecoming. Four players were named to the All-Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference team while making a national impact. Jeff Schuette, named to the All-NSIC Second Team, was eighth in the country in tackles followed closely by Tyler Brody, named to the All-NSIC Honorable Mention Team, who was 18th.

Prior to his reign at Shanley, the Deacons had two winless seasons, and under Laqua's guidance became North Dakota State Football Champions during his third year (2009). The team won a tight battle over Devils Lake, 31-30. In 2010, he coached the Deacons to their second state title, as the team topped Devils Lake on a field goal as time expired, 24-21. Laqua was honored as the the 2009 and 2010 North Dakota High School AA Coach of the Year.

Prior to joining the prep-ranks, Laqua served as the Running Backs, Tight Ends and Punt Team Coach at North Dakota State from January 2005-March 2007, where he coached five All-Americans including Tyler Roehl and Mike Dragosavich. While at NDSU, Laqua was one of the team's top recruiters, as he was heavily involved in recruiting players from North Dakota, South Dakota and western Minnesota.

He also served as the Bison's academic coordinator where he implemented a program that put an emphasis on study skills and a college degree. As a result, the team had 21-Academic All-Conference players during his two-year stint at NDSU.

For the 2004 season, Laqua was the Minnesota Crookston Golden Eagles' Offensive Coordinator, where he led an offense that led the NSIC in rushing yards, yards per attempt and least turnovers. During that season, he directly coached an NCAA DIII All-American Frederic Rollins, who was also named a National Player of the Week during the season. The Golden Eagle offense set records for rushing yards in a season, as well as single game marks. He directed the Golden Eagle offense that led the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in rushing yards, yards per attempt and least turnovers per game.

His coaching experience also extends to one season at St. Olaf College, in Northfield, Minn., where he was the Outside Linebackers Coach. Laqua had a decorated career at North Dakota State as a Division II student-athlete, playing safety for the Bison. He was an Academic All-Conference member for three years as well as graduated with honors. He earned his Masters of Education from NDSU in 2007.

Laqua and his wife, Patty, have seven children.
