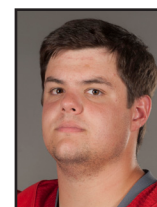

MINNESOTA STATE UNIVERSITY MOORHEAD DRAGONS

The Head Coaches

Steve Laqua is in his 10th season, and 11th year overall as MSUM's head coach with a record of 48-64 at the school. Jason Hoskins is in his second season as Upper Iowa's head coach with a record of 1-11.

About MSUM

MSUM fell to 0-1 on the season with a 27-14 home loss to Sioux Falls. Four turnovers were costly for the Dragons as they led to 21 Cougar points.

Sophomore quarterback Tommy Falk threw for 207 yards and a touchdown in the game.

Junior fullback Hayden Boll rushed for 31 yards and a touchdown in the game while redshirt freshman wide receiver Gage Florence caught five passes for 65 yards. Junior receiver Ryan Bieberdorf caught five passes for 62 yards and a touchdown.

On defense senior linebacker James Eggert had a team-high 11 tackles while junior defensive back Jake Bettcher had nine tackles.

Junior defensive lineman Jackson Faller and sophomore linebacker Marcus Gulley had interceptions in the game.

MSUM was outgained by the Cougars 484-209, including 175-2 on the ground. The Dragons committed four turnovers.

About Upper Iowa

The Peacocks are 0-1 on the year after losing at Northern State, 30-0 to

open the season.

Willy Camacho rushed for 34 to lead the ground game.

Quarterback Marcus Orr threw for 132 yards on 8-of-17 passing to lead the offense. Desean Phillips had three catches for 50 yards.

On defense Zacarius Murray had nine tackles, including one for loss, while Cejai Parrish and Trevor Thompson had seven each.

Upper Iowa was outgained by Northern State 398-156.

More about the Dragons Take Your Pick

MSUM finished 10th in all of Division II in 2021 with 17 interceptions, led by four each from Cody Sorenson and Jared Kallenbach. MSUM got off to a good start in that department against Sioux Falls with two picks, as Jackson Faller and Marcus Gulley recorded interceptions.

Falk Looks to Build Off Of 2021

Falk will be entering his second year as the Dragon starting quarterback. Last season he ranked 13th in completions per game (22.91), 19th in the nation in passing yards (2,874), 22nd in passing yards per game (261.3) and 37th in the nation in total offense (250.8). He threw for 204 yards and a touchdown in the opener.

Week 2 Under Laqua

MSUM is 1-9 in Week 2 games under Laqua. In 2011, MSUM lost

to Winona State, 48-10 and lost to Sioux Falls, 45-10 in 2012. In 2013, at Nemzek Stadium, in a game-long downpour, the Dragons lost to Southwest Minnesota State, 27-20. In 2014 MSUM lost to No. 4-ranked Minnesota State, 69-13 at home. MSUM got its first Week 2 win under Laqua with a thrilling 30-28 last-second win over Concordia-St. Paul in 2015. In 2016 MSUM lost at nationally-ranked Sioux Falls, 42-21. In 2017 it was a 51-35 home loss to SMSU followed by back-to-back losses to nationally-ranked Minnesota Duluth. The Dragons lost to Winona State, 27-13 in Week 2 last season.

Not Seeing Yellow

After one game MSUM ranks fifth in the nation in fewest penalty yards per game with 15.0. The Dragons were ninth in fewest penalties with three.

Just for Kicks

Redshirt freshman punter Brian Knudslie made his collegiate debut on Sept. 1 and had a solid opening outing, averaging 44 yards per punt. That is 14th-best in all of Division II. Three of those punts were placed inside the 20.

Behm Anchors Defense

Sophomore linebacker Josiah Behm had a solid 2021 season and earned All-NSIC North honors as a result. He finished fifth in the NSIC at 7.8 tackles per game and led the Dragons with 86 tackles overall. Behm added three interceptions, second on the team, with 2.5 tackles for loss.

Steve Laqua is entering his 11th season as the head football coach at Minnesota State University Moorhead in 2019.

2018 was a big year for Dragon football. MSUM finished 8-4, and advanced to play in the Mineral Water Bowl for the first time in school history. The Dragons finished second in the NSIC North, and the eight wins are the most for the program since 1991. Laqua was named the NSIC Coach of the Year as well for the first time in his Dragon tenure.

2016 saw MSUM go 7-4 with WR Damon Gibson earning All-American honors after a 90-catch season.

In 2015, the Dragons, despite losing two key offensive starters to injury, recorded their first winning season in nine years by posting a 6-5 mark. MSUM opened 3-0, highlighted by a last-second win at Concordia-St. Paul in Week 2 and a 35-34 win over playoff qualifier Augustana in Week 3. The Dragons regained the Paddle with a 37-0 win over Mary in Week 10.

The 2014 campaign saw the MSUM offense reach new heights. MSUM ranked fourth in the nation in first downs (292), a mark that led the NSIC. The Dragons were sixth in total offense (517.6, which also led the NSIC) and 13th in rushing offense (260.7). The Dragons (12 on offense, one on special teams) accounted for 13 school records in 2014. Six were single-game records while five were single-season and two were career records. A highlight was MSUM setting a new single-game record for total yardage twice, including in the finale win over Minnesota Crookston.

Six players earned All-NSIC North Division honors, led by first-team selections Adam Jiskra (junior wide receiver) and Zayne Medhaug (junior running back). Jiskra and Medhaug also earned all-region honors from Don Hansen and the Beyond Sports Network.

The 2013 season saw the Dragons make significant progress. MSUM finished third in the eight-team NSIC North Division with a 4-3 mark after being picked to finish seventh in the preseason poll. MSUM finished the season strong, going 4-2 in its last six games.

The Dragons had seven All-NSIC players, including sophomore wide receiver Adam Jiskra, who was first-team all-conference. Jiskra was also named to the Don Hansen Super Region 3 Second Team. MSUM's offense set eight school records, including most total yards in a game (685) and most passing yards in a game.

The team's offense was ranked 35th in all of Division II in total yards per game. Sophomore quarterback Jake Hodge ranked fourth in the nation for points responsible for and seventh in total offense. MSUM also beat Mary for the first time in school history to claim the "Paddle" for the first time, and the Dragons also regained the Battle Axe for the first time since 2008 with a 35-17 win over Bemidji State.

The Dragons fielded one of the youngest teams in the NSIC – starting as many as 11 freshmen in a game – in 2012 and finished with a 1-10 mark, although the team had close calls against St. Cloud State and Bemidji State in games taken down to the final minutes of the fourth quarter. Safety Shea DeJong was named the NSIC Defensive Newcomer of the Year, while senior defensive lineman Steve Parks was named first-team All-NSIC.

In his first season, Laqua led the Dragons to a 2-9 record including an opening-day victory and a thrilling overtime win on homecoming. Four players were named to the All-Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference team while making a national impact. Jeff Schuette, named to the All-NSIC Second Team, was eighth in the country in tackles followed closely by Tyler Brody, named to the All-NSIC Honorable Mention Team, who was 18th. Laqua signed 23 recruits during his first full offseason to prepare his team for the 2012 season.

Prior to his reign at Shanley, the Deacons had two winless seasons, and under Laqua's guidance became North Dakota State Football Champions during his third year (2009). The team won a tight battle over Devils Lake, 31-30. In 2010, he coached the Deacons to their second state title, as the team topped Devils Lake on a field goal as time expired, 24-21. Laqua was honored as the 2009 and 2010 North Dakota High School AA Coach of the Year. Prior to joining the prep-ranks, Laqua served as the Running Backs, Tight Ends and Punt Team Coach at North Dakota State from January 2005-March 2007, where he coached five All-Americans including Tyler Roehl and Mike Dragosavich.

For the 2004 season, Laqua was the Minnesota Crookston Golden Eagles' Offensive Coordinator, where he led an offense that led the NSIC in rushing yards, yards per attempt and least turnovers. During that season, he directly coached an NCAA DII All-American Frederic Rollins, who was also named a National Player of the Week during the season. The Golden Eagle offense set records for rushing yards in a season, as well as single game marks. He directed the Golden Eagle offense that led the NSIC in rushing yards, yards per attempt and least turnovers per game.

His coaching experience also extends to one season at St. Olaf College, in Northfield, Minn., where he was the Outside Linebackers Coach. He also served his first stint at NDSU as a Graduate Assistant Coach for tight ends in 2002-03.

Laqua had a decorated career at North Dakota State as a Division II student-athlete, playing safety for the Bison. He was an Academic All-Conference member for three years as well as graduated with honors. He earned his Masters of Education from NDSU in 2007.

Laqua and his wife, Patty, have eight children.
