## NCAA CENTRAL REGION TOURNAMENT PITS DRAGONS AGAINST TIGERS

**Matchup History...**The Dragons and Tigers have only matched up once in the last 10 seasons. MSUM last played Fort Hays State on November 15, 2014, defeating the Tigers by a 83-71 count as part of the Northwest Missouri State Classic. The Saturday tilt between the two teams will be just the second meeting all-time.

**Last Time Out...**MSUM secured its third NSIC Tournament victory in four seasons after a 78-66 win over Minot State. **Carson Johnson** scored a game-high 27 points while **Logan Kinsey** and **JaMir Price** each scored 16 points. Johnson, Kinsey and Jacob Jennissen were named to the NSIC All-Tournament Team with Johnson collecting Tournament MVP honors. Johnson becomes the first freshman in conference history to earn the MVP award.

**Five For Five...**With their NSIC Tournament victory, MSUM qualified for the NCAA Central Region Tournament for the fifth consecutive season. Overall, it is MSUM's ninth appearance in an NCAA Tournament game in the Division II era. Additionally, it is **Tim Bergstraser's** third appearance in the NCAA Tournament as head coach in three seasons at the helm.

## SUPERLATIVES

**Dragons On All-NSIC...** Junior **Logan Kinsey**, freshman **Carson Johnson** and junior **Jacob Jennissen** were all named to the All-NSIC team on Thursday. Kinsey and Johnson were tabbed as First Team performers while Jennissen was a Second Team honoree. It is the first all-conference honor for all three student-athletes.

**Bergy In The Postseason...** MSUM head men's basketball coach **Tim Bergstraser** will embark on his third NCAA Tournament on Saturday. Throughout his short tenure, Bergstraser has already collected 73 career wins and has seen success in the NSIC Tournament. Bergstraser is 6-1 at the Sanford Pentagon in the NSIC Tournament. In the NCAA Central Region Tournament, Bergstraser is 1-2 after collecting his first national tournament victory against Pittsburg State last season (73-55).

**CJ Is Unconscious...** Freshman guard **Carson Johnson** was lethal throughout the NSIC Tournament. Johnson averaged a staggering 26 points per game in the tournament. More impressively, Johnson connected on 50.9 percent of his field goal attempts in three games. This included sinking 47.6 percent of his three-point looks.

**JaM Feelin' Nicey...** Senior guard **JaMir Price** had a stellar performance for the Dragons in the NSIC Tournament championship against Minot State. Price used a seven-point spurt late in the first half to give MSUM its first lead of the contest. In total, Price scored 16 points on 60 percent shooting with five rebounds.

**Can He Get There...** Entering the NCAA Central Region Tournament, **Logan Kinsey** sits at 953 career points as a Dragon. Kinsey has scored a career-best 464 points so far this season.

**Quick Scout...** Fort Hays State was able to win the MIAA Tournament this past weekend behind their star Kaleb Hammeke. The graduate student guard averaged 20.6 points per game in the tournament and bolsters a team-best 16.5 points per game. Hammeke was named an All-MIAA First Team performer while sophomore guard Kyle Grill was named All-MIAA Honorable Mention. Grill averages 11.6 points per game. Hammeke and senior forward Shaun Riley were also named to the MIAA All-Defensive Team.

**MSUM HEAD MEN'S  
BASKETBALL COACH  
TIM BERGSTRASER**

Tim Bergstraser is in his third season as the head men's basketball coach at Minnesota State University Moorhead. He was named to the post in May 2022.

MSUM finished the 2023-24 season with a 25-6 overall record and an 18-6 mark in NSIC competition. The Dragons had All-NSIC performers in Jacob Beeninga (First Team), JaMir Price (First Team), Ja'Kair Sanchez (Second Team) and Dane Zimmer (Second Team). Price was named the NSIC's Newcomer of the Year as well. Beeninga was also named an NABC All-Central District Second Team selection under Bergstraser's tutelage. The Dragons made their second straight appearance in the NCAA Central Region Tournament under Bergstraser in 2023-24.

In his second season, Bergstraser only upped the profile of MSU Moorhead men's basketball, helping the program to its first number one ranking in the NABC Coaches' Poll on January 9, 2024. The Dragons spent the entire season ranked within the top 13 in the country in the NABC Poll. Bergstraser became the fastest coach in program history to 50 wins in MSUM's NCAA Central Region Tournament victory over Pittsburg State on March 16. The win over the Gorillas was also his first NCAA Tournament victory.

Bergstraser only saw continued success in his first season at the helm of Dragon men's basketball. MSUM went 25-7 in 2022-23, including a 17-5 mark in NSIC competition. The Dragons secured their second consecutive NSIC Tournament championship with a resounding win over Minnesota Duluth in the tournament title game. MSUM would go on to compete at the NCAA Central Region Tournament in Maryville, Mo. MSUM had three all-conference performers during the year in Gavin Baumgartner, Lorenzo McGhee and Jacob Beeninga.

In 2021-22, he completed his fourth season as the top assistant coach for Minnesota State University Moorhead men's basketball in 2021-22. He has been involved in all aspects of the Dragon program, including recruiting and scouting.

The St. Cloud native has helped the Dragons to two straight NCAA tournament appearances (2020-21 and 2021-22) and to the Dragons' first-ever NSIC tournament championship in March 2022.

Bergstraser is no stranger to MSUM men's basketball, having served as a graduate assistant from 2015-17. During his time at MSUM,, the Dragons went 54-12, won two division championships and an overall conference championship in 2016-2017. The Dragons also went to two consecutive NCAA tournaments with Bergstraser on staff. For his efforts, Bergstraser received the NABC Under Armour 30-Under-30 award.
