#### **Teams**

The meet is open to collegiate teams, high school teams, and unattached athletes.

#### **Course Location**

#### **Entry Procedure**

All entries must be submitted on-line at [www.athletic.net](http://www.athletic.net)

**Varsity races will be limited to 10 athletes per team, per gender.** Unlimited entries will be allowed for elementary school, middle school and JV races.

#### **Entry Deadline**

Wednesday, September 2 by 12:00 PM.

#### **Entry Fees**

College Teams: \$250 per team (M/W combined \$500).

Varsity Teams: \$175 per team (B/G combined \$350).

Junior Varsity Teams: \$50 per team (B/G combined \$100).

#### **Spectator Admission**

#### **Parking**

Parking will be on the campus of Minnesota State University Moorhead. Teams should part in lot G-10. Spectator parking will be in lot(s) G-7 and G-10.

#### **Team Facility Access and Packet Pickup**

Teams will access the course via the Northeast entrance of Nemzek Hall. Wrist bands will be provided and required for entry/reentry to the course

Team packets will be available for pick-up at the North end of Nemzek Hall beginning at 2:30 PM. **Race chips are embedded in the race number. To prevent damage to the timing chip, please instruct your athletes to NOT BEND or WRINKLE their numbers.**
