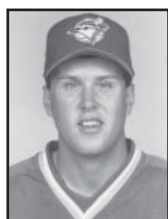
MSU Baseball From A-to-Z

- A -

Ayotte, Scott...1995 first-team All-Big Ten and third-team AABC All-American...MSU's career leader in doubles with 47.

- B -

Behney, Mel...1968 first-team All-Big Ten pitcher...went 9-4 with 107 strikeouts in 84 innings...pitched for the Cincinnati Reds in 1970.

- C -

Crabtree, Tim...Eight-year career in the major leagues with Toronto and Texas...went 8-2 with seven saves in 1992.



Mike Davidson

D -

Davidson, Mike...1988 first-team All-Big Ten outfielder and third-team AABC All-American...sits in top 10 in 11 different career and single-season offensive records.

- E -

Eddington, Mike...1984 first-team All-Big Ten DH and third-team AABC All-American...20 home runs (MSU single-season record) and 66 RBI in 1984.



Lyman Frimodig

- F -

Frimodig, Lyman...1914-17 baseball letterwinner and earned a total of 10 MAC/MSU letters in football, basketball and baseball.

Gibson, Kirk...A first-team All-Big Ten and AABC All-American in 1978...played major league baseball for Detroit, L.A. Dodgers and Pittsburgh.

Garvey, Steve...A second-team All-American in 1968 and a first-team All-Big Ten player the same year...played 18 seasons of major league baseball with San Diego and Los Angeles.



Stuart & Steve Hirschman

- H -

Hirschman, Stuart & Steve...Combined for 45 career wins at MSU from 1990-93...Stuart is tied for the most career wins by an MSU pitcher with 28...both were Academic All-Big Ten honorees in 1991 and 1992.

- I -

Ike, Larry...23-6 in his career as a pitcher at MSU from 1970-72...second-team All-Big Ten selection in 1972 and third-team honoree in 1971...threw eight complete games and four shutouts in 1971.

- J -

Juday, Steve, Rich and Bob...Steve (father of Rich and Bob) lettered in 1964-66 and also quarterbacked the MSU football team...Rich won three consecutive MSU batting titles from 1989-91...Bob was a starting infielder from 1990-92 and played professionally with the Boston Red Sox.

- K -

Kobs, John...Head coach at MSU for 39 years from 1925-63...MSU's baseball facility is named after him for his length of service to MSU...coached the 1954 team to the Big Ten Titles and a berth in the College World Series...compiled an all-time record of 574-377, the most victories of any MSU coach...was elected into the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1993.

- L -

Litwhiler, Danny...Head coach at MSU for 19 seasons from 1964-82...compiled a record of 488-362...led Spartans to Big Ten Championships in 1971 and 1979...“Skip” was elected into the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1994.

- M -

Mulder, Mark...1997 and 1998 first-team All-Big Ten Pitcher...1998 third-team AABC and Louisville Slugger All-American...owns the MSU single-season record for strikeouts with 113 in 1998...second overall pick in the 1998 Major League Draft by the Oakland Athletics...has an 103-57 record and a 4.11 ERA in seven Major League seasons.

Nutter, Jack...Compiled a 12-7 record during his career at MSU 1961-63...captain of the 1963 team.

- O -

Oldsmobile Park...State-of-the-art minor league park located in downtown Lansing is the home of the Lansing Lugnuts...the park also plays host to the Spartan baseball team during its collegiate season...the Spartans played the first-ever game at Oldsmobile Park to a then-sell-out crowd of 7,000 fans.

- P -

Pellerin, Frank...Lettered in 1941-43...Assistant coach for head coaches John Kobs, Danny Litwhiler and Tom Smith.

- R -

Roberts, Robin...Only Spartan to be elected to the Baseball Hall Of Fame in Cooperstown, N.Y., with his induction in 1986...MSU letterwinner from 1946-47...pitched 19 years in the major leagues, winning

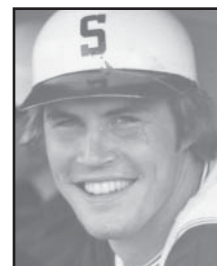
286 games.

- S -

Smith, Tom...Head coach at MSU for 13 years from 1983-95...received Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1988 and 1992...compiled an overall record of 377-332 at Michigan State.

- U -

Urbanik, Daniel...Lettered in 1948-49...served as team captain in 1949.

- V -

Van Pelt, Brad...Lettered in 1971-72...earned second-team All-Big Ten honors as a pitcher in 1972...played 14 seasons of professional football in the National Football League with the N.Y. Giants, L.A. Raiders and Cleveland Browns.

- W -

Willingham, Tyrone...Two-sport star at MSU in both football and baseball (1975-77)...baseball team captain in 1977...current head football coach at Washington.

- Y -

Yewcic, Tom...Inducted into the MSU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003...MSU varsity letterwinner in both football and baseball...named College World Series MVP in 1954.

- Z -

Zeitler, John...Captain of the 1954 MSU squad that won the Big Ten Championship and played in the College World Series.
