#### THE STARTING FIVE

• No. 15/16 Michigan State women's basketball concludes its brief two-game homestand on Sunday, Nov. 24 at 2 p.m., hosting Hartford. The Spartans are celebrating Go Green Day for sustainability. Michigan State improved to 4-0 for the fourth time in the last four years with 76-56 win over Oakland on Nov. 19. This is the second-straight season the Spartans and the Hawks have met with MSU earning the road win last year.

• Michigan State is first in the Big Ten in rebound margin (+14.5) and third scoring margin (+29.0). MSU also leads the league in steals per game (14.5 spg) and offensive rebounds (20.5).

• Taryn McCutcheon is nearing several milestones as a Spartan. With 923 career points, McCutcheon is just 77 points away from becoming the 28th member of the 1,000-point club. She is also third in career assists with 485. She is just 89 helpers away from passing current MSU assistant coach Kristin Haynie who had 574 career assist during her Spartan career (2001-05).

• Sophomore guard Nia Clouden captured her first Big Ten Player of the Week honor on Nov. 18. After her career-high 28-point performance against Notre Dame.

• Through four games, eight different players are averaging at least 5.5 ppg, led by Nia Clouden's 17.0 ppg. Taryn McCutcheon is also averaging in double figures with 12.0 ppg.

## TEAM NOTES

### SCOUTING HARTFORD

The Spartans have only met the Hawks three times in program history with Michigan State leading the series 2-1. The first meeting was in 2004 and MSU won 58-45. The following year in 2007, the Hawks bested the Spartans 51-54 in Suzy Merchant's first year as head coach. Last season in an overtime thriller on the road, Michigan State came out on top, 74-66. Victoria Gaines had a double-double in the battle with season-high 16 points and 11 rebounds. Sidney Cooks led the way with 19 points off the bench.

The Hawks are 0-5 so far this year, losing to Harvard, 53-44, on the road on Nov. 22. They've played Hofstra, Rhode Island and Providence at home, and fell to UMass on the road.

Jada Lucas is the Hawks leading scorer for the Hawks, averaging 16.2 points and 1.6 rebounds per game. Jordan McLemore is second in scored with 9.4 ppg. As a team, Hartford averages 49.2 ppg, while allowing 62.6.

### LAST TIME AGAINST THE HAWKS

A career-high 19 points from sophomore forward Sidney Cooks lifted the No. 23/22 Michigan State women's basketball team past a tenacious Hartford squad on the road Dec. 16, 2018, 74-66, in overtime.

With the win, the Spartans improved to 9-1 for the first time since the 2012-13 season, when they started the season 13-1.

Cooks scored 19 points and added six boards to lead the Spartans. Redshirt-junior forward Victoria Gaines earned her first double-double of the season and third of her career with 16 points and 11 rebounds as the Spartans scored 40 points in the paint. Junior guard Taryn McCutcheon added 14 points and six boards.

### CLOUDEN WITH A CHANCE OF SCORING

Guard Nia Clouden has had a stellar start to her sophomore campaign. In four games, she has averaged 17.0 points per game. The guard put the Spartans on her back with a career-high 28 points in MSU's win over No. 15/14 Notre Dame on Nov. 24. Her previous career high was 27 points in a win over Iowa on Dec. 30, 2018. She got the ball rolling for the Spartans against the Irish making, four 3-pointers

to start the game. Her previous career high for treys in a game was three.

### FAMILIAR FACE

Hartford assistant coach Courtney Davidson is familiar with the Breslin Center. Davidson was a four-year letterwinner for MSU from 2005-08, playing in 101 games and averaging 3.8 ppg.

### EXCLUSIVE COMPANY

Guard Taryn McCutcheon is part of exclusive Michigan State company. She is one of only five players in Spartan history with at least 900 points and 400 assists. Tori Jankoska is the all-time points leader with 2,212 points, while current MSU assistant coach Kristin Haynie holds the all-time assist crown with 574 helpers.

### REACHING THE CENTURY MARK

With a start against Oakland, senior guard Taryn McCutcheon earned her 102nd career start. She has missed only one game during her MSU career against Michigan on Jan. 23, 2018. She now stands 10th in the MSU record books in career starts. Fellow senior Victoria Gaines has now played in 110 career games as a Spartan. She is just 16 games away from reaching the top 20 in career games played.

### BEING A BOSS AT THE BREZ

The Spartans continue to dominate at home. Last season, Michigan State set a record with 15 wins at home. Since the 2016-17 season, the Spartans are 40-9 at the friendly confines of the Breslin Center. MSU has won 21 of the last 22 games at home.

### BLOCK PARTY

The Spartans have strong on the defensive end this season, including already earning 18 blocks in four games. Freshmen Taiyier Parks (8) and Julia Ayrault (5) lead the way. Parks is tied for sixth in the Big Ten in blocks per game, averaging 2.0, while Ayrault is tied for 14th with 1.3 bpg.

**FRESHMEN SENSATIONS**

The five Spartan newcomers have made an immediate impact through the first four games. Guard Moira Joiner has started the last three games. Against Detroit Mercy all the leaders in points, rebounds, blocks and steals were all freshmen. Guard Alyza Winston led all scorers with 17 points. Forwards Julia Ayrault and Taiyier Parks had a game-high seven rebounds apiece. Winston also led MSU with four steals, while Parks had two blocks. All five freshmen scored in the season opener against Eastern Michigan led by 14 points from Winston. In under five minutes of play, center Cydni Dodd scored four points with one rebound.

**APPROACHING MILESTONES**

Against Oakland, senior guard Taryn McCutcheon led four Spartans in double-figures with 16 points, moving up to 923 for her career and just 77 points away from becoming the 28th member of MSU's 1,000-point club. McCutcheon drained a season-high four 3-pointers, including three in the first half. She now has multiple 3-pointers in three of the four games and nine treys on the season (2.3 pg).

**SPREADING THE WEALTH**

Michigan State been spreading the scoring around early this season. In four games, three different players have led the way in scoring: Alyza Winston, Nia Clouden and Taryn McCutcheon. Clouden was the leading scorer against both Eastern Michigan (Nov. 5) and Notre Dame (Nov. 14). Winston was the top scorer versus Detroit Mercy (Nov. 8), while McCutcheon led the way against Oakland (Nov. 18). Overall, eight different Spartans are averaging over 5.5 ppg.

**CLOUDEN NAMED BIG PLAYER OF WEEK**

Michigan State guard Nia Clouden captured Big Ten Player of the Week honors. This was sophomore's first Big Ten Player of the Week accolade, after earning Freshman of the Week honors once last season. This was Michigan State's first Big Ten Player of the Week honor since Jenna Allen, who earned the honor twice last season on Dec. 10 and Dec. 31.

Clouden, a native of Owings Mills, Maryland, scored a career-high 28 points in the Spartans' 72-69 win over No. 15/14 Notre Dame on Nov. 14. She got off to a fast start, making her first four 3-pointers in the first quarter. She closed out the game strong as well, scoring six points in the final 10 minutes. For the game, she was 9-for-21 from the field and 4-for-9 from long range. She led MSU to its first win over Notre Dame since 2004 and the first victory by a Big Ten school over the Fighting Irish since 2009.

**IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER**

The Spartans are 124-39 (76.1%) all-time in the month of November. Under Coach Merchant, Michigan State is 64-11 (85.3%) in November, with seven of the 10 losses coming against top-10 opponents. The Spartans have won 38 of their last 43 in the month.

**SPARTANS IN THE BIG/NCAA RANKINGS**

After four games, Michigan State is 25th in the nation in steals per game, averaging 14.5. MSU is also 15th in scoring offense (85.8 ppg), as well as standing 21st in 3-pointers per game (9.0 per game).

**FREQUENT FLIER**

Three Spartans earned international experience during the offseason. MSU head coach Suzy Merchant earned a silver medal as the head coach of U.S. Pan American team that competed in Lima, Peru. Sophomore guard Nia Clouden also participated in the U.S. U19 World Cup Trials in Colorado Spring in May. Redshirt-senior guard Shay Colley continues her quest for the 2020 Olympics continuing training with the Canadian National Team.

**AGAINST THE GREAT LAKES STATE**

Michigan State has had great success against other collegiate programs in the state of Michigan over the past 17 seasons. Since the beginning of the 2002-03 season, the Spartans are 62-5 (.925) against in-state rivals, including a 47-5 (.904) mark under Coach Merchant. All-time, Michigan State is 195-60 (.765) against other Michigan schools.

**THRILLING THIRD QUARTER**

Michigan State held a two-point lead at half time against Eastern Michigan on Nov. 5, 31-29. Michigan State scored the first 28 points of the second half, highlighted by back-to-back treys by Taryn McCutcheon to open up a 59-29 lead. Freshmen Alyza Winston and Moira Joiner joined in on the fun netting their first 3-pointers of their MSU careers. During the game-changing quarter, the Eagles were 0-14 from the field, sinking three free throws. The Spartans were 11-of-18 from the field and 4-of-5 from long distance. The three points were the fewest allowed in the third quarter by Michigan State. The previous low was five against Charleston on Nov. 19, 2017.

**SEASON OPENERS**

All-time, the Spartans are now 33-15 in season openers, but 25-2 when the opener is in East Lansing. Coach Merchant is 10-3 in season openers at MSU, and has won 16 of her last 19, including her time at Eastern Michigan.

**RETURN TO THE GREAT LAKES STATE**

Michigan State adds two new coaches to the staff this season in Dean Lockwood and former Spartan All-American Kristin Haynie. Lockwood and Haynie come to Michigan State with extensive basketball roots in the state of Michigan, as well as highly-decorated careers. During his 15-year tenure as an assistant coach at Tennessee, Lockwood won two NCAA titles. Haynie returns to Michigan State where she earned All-American honors, leading MSU to the 2005 National Championship game.

**FANS CONTINUE TO PACK THE BRESLIN**

Michigan State women's basketball continued to pack the Breslin Center last season, averaging 5,496 fans per game last season. MSU was 15th in the nation and fifth in the Big Ten in attendance. This marked the 15th-consecutive season that the Spartans have ranked in the top 15 nationally in attendance. Michigan State has had a total attendance of over 80,000 every season since 2005-06. The Spartans had their 15th-best crowd this season when 11,368 fans packed the Breslin Center as MSU defeated Michigan.

## TEAM NOTES

### COLLEY EARNS PRESEASON HONOR

To kickoff the beginning of Big Ten Women's Basketball Media Week, the conference released the Preseason Coaches and Media Polls, in addition to the preseason All-Big Ten teams. Michigan State redshirt-senior guard Shay Colley earned Preseason All-Big Ten honors for the second-straight season.

The Spartans were voted to finish second by the Big Ten coaches and third by the media. This was MSU's highest preseason ranking since being voted to finish second by the coaches prior to the 2016-17 campaign.

### MAGIC NUMBERS

In head coach Suzy Merchant's tenure, when two numbers on the scoreboard were achieved it typically has been a sign of a MSU win. MSU has won 141 of its last 159 games when scoring at least 70 points, and MSU is 158-27 under head coach Suzy Merchant when hanging at least 70 points on the scoreboard. The Spartans have reached the 70-point margin in all four games this season.

### CLOSING OUT THE GAMES

The Spartans have been extremely effective closing out games over the last couple years, winning 197 of their last 209 games (.943) when leading with five minutes left, including 147 of their last 161. In Coach Merchant's tenure, Michigan State is 232-18 (.928) when holding a lead with five minutes left.

### UP NEXT

After the Spartans hosting Hartford on Nov. 24, the Spartans will then head to warmer climates, playing in the Junkanoo Jam in the Bahamas, Nov. 29-30. US will begin the tournament taking on LSU on Friday, Nov. 29. The Spartans will then face either Kansas State or Memphis on Nov. 30.

### GAME FOUR REWIND: MSU 72, OAKLAND 56

Taryn McCutcheon scored 16 points, Mardrekia Cook added 14 and No. 15/16 Michigan State women's basketball defeated Oakland 76-56 at the Breslin Center.

MSU had four in double figures led by 16 points by McCutcheon, while Cook added a season-high 14 points. Sophomore forward Kayla Belles was one point shy of matching her career high, scoring 11 points, while sophomore guard Nia Clouden added 10. Freshman Taiyier Parks was the first Spartan to reach double figures in rebounds with 10.

### Postgame Notes vs. Hartford

- Tuesday was MSU's 12th-straight win over in-state foe Oakland, as the Spartans improved to 16-4 all-time in the series vs. the Golden Grizzlies, including 10-2 at home ... Michigan State has held Oakland below 60 points in each of the last two meetings, winning 102-58, last season at Oakland.

- Sophomore guard Nia Clouden tallied 10 points for her third game in double-figure scoring in the Spartans' four contests this season ... Clouden also dished out a season-high six assists, while redshirt-sophomore Mardrekia Cook added a season-high 14 points.

# MICHIGAN STATE HEAD COACH SUZY MERCHANT



**12th Season; Central Michigan '91**  
**Career Record: 470-254 (.649)**  
**Record at MSU: 269-134 (.667)**

Michigan State head Suzy Merchant has established herself as one of the premier coaches in MSU history. With nearly 500 career wins, Merchant has proven to be one of the best coaches in Michigan State history and a force in the Big Ten Conference. Entering her 13th season as head coach of the MSU women's basketball program, Merchant has brought the Spartan program to the upper echelon at the Big Ten and national level. The Spartans have finished third or better in the Big Ten in eight of the last 12 seasons, and her conference record of 127-77 (62.3%) is in the top-12 career winning percentage in the 35-year history of the Big Ten. The Spartans have won at least 20 games in 10 of her 12 seasons.

The Great Lakes State native was hired at MSU on April 30, 2007, after spending time as a head coach at Eastern Michigan (1998-07) and Saginaw Valley State (1995-98). In her 24 years as a head coach, she has won nearly 65 percent of her games, collecting a 466-254 (.647) career record, including 265-134 (.664) in 12 seasons in East Lansing. Merchant became the fastest Spartan coach to 100 wins. She is also the winningest coach in Eastern Michigan history, compiling a 147-91 record in her nine seasons.

Through her first 12 seasons at MSU, 43 Spartans have earned All-Big Ten recognition and 55 have been named Academic All-Big Ten. A pair of Spartans have earned major Big Ten awards - Kalisha Keane was the Big Ten Player of the Year in 2010-11, following up the Sixth

Player of the Year award as a junior, while Lykendra Johnson (2010-11) and Allyssa DeHaan (2009-10) were named Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year. DeHaan, who finished her career second all-time in NCAA history in blocked shots, and Keane were also named All-Americans following their senior seasons. In 2013-14, Aerial Powers became the first Spartan freshman to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Powers would go on to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors in 2014-15 and 2015-16, as well as being named an All-American both seasons. During the 2016-17 season, Tori Jankoska became the Spartan all-time leading scorer as well as earning first-team All-Big Ten and All-American honors.

Last season, the Spartans had some dazzling wins with victories over No. 3 Oregon and No. 16 Iowa, as MSU was 15-1 at the Breslin Center. Michigan State ended the season with a 21-12 overall record, going 9-9 in Big Ten play. The Spartans reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to national runner-up Notre Dame. Four Spartans earned All-Big Ten honors with Shay Colley picking up first-team honors by the coaches. Jenna Allen earned second-team accolades, as Nia Clouden captured honorable mention honors and was named to the All-Freshman team. Taryn McCutcheon rounded out the group with honorable mention honors.

The 2017-18 Spartans battled injuries throughout the season and still managed to make the Sweet 16 of the WNIT, ending the season with a 19-14 mark and a 7-9 Big Ten record. MSU earned its first-ever win over Maryland on Jan. 11. Four Spartans earned All-Big Ten honors: Brannndais Agee, Allen, Colley and McCutcheon earned honorable mention honors. Once again, Michigan State continued to fill the Breslin Center, finishing 10th in the nation and second in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 5,689 fans per game.

During the 2016-17 season, Michigan State reached the NCAA Tournament with a 21-12 record, including going 9-7 in Big Ten action. The year was filled with more record-breaking performances as Jankoska became the first Spartan to score over 2,000 points. Four Spartans were honored with All-Big Ten honors. Jankoska was named first-team All-Big Ten, while Agee, Taya Reimer and McCutcheon were named to the honorable mention squad. MSU finished eighth in the nation and first in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 6,011 fans per game.

The 2015-16 season was a return to form for the Spartans, as MSU ended the season with a 25-9 overall record. Michigan State ended league play 13-5, which

was good for third place in the ultra-competitive Big Ten Conference. Powers was once again named to the first team, while Tori Jankoska was named to the second team. Both Agee and Jasmine Hines earned honorable mention honors. Against Minnesota on Feb. 21, Merchant earned her 400th win as a head coach. The Spartans continue to pack the stands, finishing seventh in the NCAA in attendance with an average of 6,561 fans per game.

The 2014-15 Spartans suffered through an injury-plagued season, finishing 16-15 overall and 7-11 in Big Ten action. Powers and Jankoska earned All-Big Ten honors with Powers being named to the first team and Jankoska to the second. The Spartans finished 10th in the nation and second in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 6,119 fans per game.

In 2013-14, MSU captured a share of the Big Ten title with a 23-10 overall record and a stellar 13-3 league record. The Green and White posted its 11th-straight 20-win season. The Spartans qualified for the "Big Dance" for a school-record sixth-straight season, advancing to the second round. Powers was also named to the All-Freshman team, while Annalise Pickrel was named to the second-team, Klarissa Bell, Jankoska and Bella Mills picked up honorable mention honors.

Merchant has accumulated international experience as well during her time at MSU. In the summer of 2009, she spent time with USA Basketball as an assistant coach for the Women's World University Games team in Belgrade, Serbia. Team USA went undefeated and took home the Gold medal, topping Russia, 83-64 in the championship game. In the summer of 2019, Merchant was the head coach of the U.S. Pan American team that captured the silver medal in Lima, Peru. The team went 4-1, falling to Brazil in the championship game.

In all her years in the Greater Lansing area, Merchant has gone to great lengths to become an integral part of the community. In her time off the court and out of the office, Merchant can be seen at many community service events in the Greater Lansing area. She has been an Honorary Chair for numerous events, including El's Place, Sparrow Foundation's Hike for Hospice, Women Working Wonders, MSU Children's Health Initiative, Women's Center of Lansing, Haven House, Ronald McDonald House, Advent House Ministries, Old Newsboys' Shoe and Coat Drive, and Muscular Dystrophy Association.

In 2016, Merchant helped create the EmpowHER Retreat. EmpowHER is designed to build confidence in girls by providing interactive workshops concentrated on the importance of self-empowerment, confidence, health and wellness and relationship building. In 2018, Merchant was honored with the ATHENA Leadership Award by the Lansing Regional Chamber of Commerce. The award honors individuals who strive towards the highest levels of professional accomplishment, who excel in their chosen field, have devoted time and energy to their community, and who pave paths for other women to follow.

A four-year starter and three-year captain at Central Michigan (1987-91), Merchant holds Chippewa records for assists with 463 and single-season assists with 156, and is tied for first in single-game assists with 11. She also finished her career third-best in made 3-point field goals with 75.

A native of Traverse City, Michigan, Merchant was a three-sport standout at Traverse City Central High School, lettering in basketball, volleyball and softball. She earned honorable mention All-America honors by USA Today and was a two-time Class A all-state selection in basketball. She also earned all-state honors in volleyball. During the summer of 2010, she was inducted into the Traverse City Central H.S. Hall of Fame.
