• No. 15/15 Michigan State women's basketball heads to warmer temperatures playing in the Junkanoo Jam for the third time, Nov. 29-30. The Spartans will begin the tournament taking on LSU on Fri-

day, Nov. 29 at 5:15 p.m.

- This will be only the fourth meeting between the Spartans and the Tigers with MSU looking for its first win. The teams have not met since 2007. On Nov. 30, Michigan State will take on either Kansas State or Memphis who will meet at 3 p.m.
- Taryn McCutcheon is nearing several milestones as a Spartan. With 937 career points, McCutcheon is just 63 points away from becoming the 28th member of the 1,000-point club. She is also third in career assists with 486. She is just 88 helpers away from passing current MSU assistant coach Kristin Haynie who had 574 career assist during her Spartan career (2001-05).
- Michigan State is 5-0 for the first time since 2012-13, when MSU won its first eight games. Overall, it is the third time under head coach Suzy Merchant that the Spartans have started 5-0, joining 2012-13 and 2008-09.
- Freshman Julia Ayrault had a breakout performance against Hartford. She had a season-high 14 points, including scoring 13-straight for the Spartans. She became the fourth different Spartan player to lead or share the scoring lead this season.

SCOUTING LSU

The Tigers improved to 5-1 this season with a a 64-58 win over Rutgers in Baton Rouge on Nov. 24. LSU also has wins at home against New Orleans and Southeastern Louisiana and road victories over Little Rock and Tulane.

LSU has already faced two teams on the Spartans' schedule this season. The Tigers fell to No. 12 Florida State at home 70-62 on Nov. 9. Michigan State will face the Seminoles in Tallahassee in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge game on Dec. 5. The Spartans will also Rutgers twice in Big Ten action on the road on Jan. 20 and at home on Feb. 13.

The Tigers have three players averaging in double figures led by Khayla Pointer who averages 14.5 points and 3.3 rebounds per game. Faustine Aifuwa scores 13.5 ppg, while Ayana Mitchell averages 12.5 ppg and leads the team with 9.7 rpg.

SPARTANS VS TIGERS SERIES HISTORY

Michigan State is looking for it first win against LSU in the teams' brief history. The Tigers lead the overall series 3-0 and the teams have not met since 2007. This is the first meeting on neutral territory, as LSU the last meeting in Baton Rouge in 2007 64-41. In the only game in East Lansing, the Tigers won, 64-50. The previous season LSU won 72-52 in Baton Rouge.

LOOKING AHEAD - KANSAS STATE

Kansas State is 3-1 heading into the game with Memphis with its only loss coming against UT Arlington on Nov. 24. The Wildcats also have wins over Omaha, UIC and Oral Roberts.

The Spartans have the only win in the brief history with Kansas State. MSU defeated the Wildcats, 68-65 in East Lansing in 2008.

LOOKING AHEAD - MEMPHIS

Memphis is 3-3 this season heading to the battle with Kansas State. They have won two-straight games with wins over Southern Illinois and Toledo. The Tigers suffered three-straight losses to Eastern Kentucky, Louisiana Tech and George Washington.

Michigan State and Memphis have only met once with the Tigers earning the home win, 59-56 in 2002.

SPARTANS IN JUNKANOO JAM

Michigan State is playing in the Bahamas for the third time, after playing in the Junkanoo Jam in the 2009-10 season, going 2-0 with a 78-47 win over George Washingon on Nov. 27, 2009 and a wild, 93-90 double-OT win over Oklahoma State on Nov. 28, 2009. Senior Allyssa DeHaan was named the Lucaya Division's most valuable player, while Kalisha Keane joined her on the all-tournament team.

During the 2015-16 season, the Spartans went 1-1 at the Junkanoo Jam. No. 20 Michigan State topped Cincinnati, 103-63 behind a thencareer-high 30 points from Tori Jankoska in its first game. In the final game, MSU fell to No. 5 Baylor, 84-76. Jankoska and Aerial Powers both earned spots on the All-Tournament team.

Overall, it is the third time under head coach Suzy Merchant that the Spartans have started 5-0, joining 2012-13 and 2008-09 ... half of MSU's 5-0 starts have come under Coach Merchant, as the Spartans have a total of six 5-0 starts in program history, joining 1983-84, 1984-85, 1999-2000, 2008-09, 2012-13 and now 2019-20.

BEING A BOSS AT THE BREZ

The Spartans continue to dominate at home. Last season, Michigan State set a record with 15 wins at home. Since the 2016-17 season, the Spartans are 41-9 at the friendly confines of the Breslin Center. MSU has won 22 of the last 23 games at home.

FRESHMEN SENSATIONS

The five Spartan newcomers have made an immediate impact through the first five games. Guard Moira Joiner has started the last four games. Julia Ayrault had a breakout game against Hartford with 14 points and three blocks. She is tied for 12th in the Big Ten in blocks with 1.2 bpg. Against Detroit Mercy all the leaders in points, rebounds, blocks and steals were all freshmen. Guard Alyza Winston led all scorers with 17 points. Forwards Ayrault and Taiyier Parks had a game-high seven rebounds apiece. Winston also led MSU with four steals, while Parks had two blocks. All five freshmen scored in the season opener against Eastern Michigan led by 14 points from Winston. In under five minutes of play, center Cydni Dodd scored four points with one rebound.

APPROACHING MILESTONES

Against Oakland, senior guard Taryn McCutcheon led four Spartans in double-figures with 16 points, moving up to 923 for her career and just 77 points away from becoming the 28th member of MSU's 1,000-point club. McCutcheon drained a season-high four 3-pointers, including three in the first half. She now has multiple 3-pointers in three of the four games and nine treys on the season (2.3 pg).

SPREADING THE WEALTH

Michigan State been spreading the scoring around early this season. In four games, three different players have led the way in scoring: Alyza Winston, Nia Clouden and Taryn McCutcheon. Clouden was the leading scorer against both Eastern Michigan (Nov. 5) and Notre Dame

(Nov. 14). Winston was the top scorer versus Detroit Mercy (Nov. 8), while McCutcheon led the way against Oakland (Nov. 18). Overall, eight different Spartans are averaging over 5.5 ppg.

CLOUDEN NAMED B1G PLAYER OF WEEK

Michigan State guard Nia Clouden captured Big Ten Player of the Week honors on Nov. 18. This was sophomore's first Big Ten Player of the Week accolade, after earning Freshman of the Week honors once last season. This was Michigan State's first Big Ten Player of the Week honor since Jenna Allen, who earned the honor twice last season on Dec. 10 and Dec. 31. Clouden, a native of Owings Mills, Maryland, scored a career-high 28 points in the Spartans' 72-69 win over No. 15/14 Notre Dame on Nov. 14.

IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

The Spartans are 124-39 (76.1%) all-time in the month of November. Under Coach Merchant, Michigan State is 64-11 (85.3%) in November, with seven of the 10 losses coming against top-10 opponents. The Spartans have won 38 of their last 43 in the month.

SPARTANS IN THE B1G/NCAA RANKINGS

After five games, Michigan State is ninth in the nation in rebound margin (+15.2), which is also tops in the Big Ten. MSU is also 19th in scoring offense (84.4 ppg), as well as standing 31st in 3-pointers per game (8.6 per game). The Spartans are fifth in the nation in steals per game, averaging 14.8 spg, which is also first in the Big Ten.

FREQUENT FLIER

Three Spartans earned international experience during the offseason. MSU head coach Suzy Merchant earned a silver medal as the head coach of U.S. Pan American team that competed in Lima, Peru. Sophomore guard Nia Clouden also participated in the U.S. U19 World Cup Trials in Colorado Spring in May. Redshirt-senior guard Shay Colley continues her quest for the 2020 Olympics continuing training with the Canadian National Team.

AGAINST THE GREAT LAKES STATE

Michigan State has had great success against other collegiate programs in the state of Michigan over the past 17 seasons. Since the beginning of the 2002-03 season, the Spartans are 62-5 (.925) against in-state rivals, including a 47-5 (.904) mark under Coach Merchant. Alltime, Michigan State is 195-60 (.765) against other Michigan schools.

SEASON OPENERS

All-time, the Spartans are now 33-15 in season openers, but 25-2 when the opener is in East Lansing. Coach Merchant is 10-3 in season openers at MSU, and has won 16 of her last 19, including her time at Eastern Michigan.

RETURN TO THE GREAT LAKES STATE

Michigan State adds two new coaches to the staff this season in Dean Lockwood and former Spartan All-American Kristin Haynie. Lockwood and Haynie come to Michigan State with extensive basketball roots in the state of Michigan, as well as highly-decorated careers. During his 15-year tenure as an assistant coach at Tennessee, Lockwood won two NCAA titles. Haynie returns to Michigan State where she earned All-American honors, leading MSU to the 2005 National Championship game.



TEAM NOTES

FANS CONTINUE TO PACK THE BRESLIN

Michigan State women's basketball continued to pack the Breslin Center last season, averaging 5,496 fans per game last season. MSU was 15th in the nation and fifth in the Big Ten in attendance. This marked the 15th-consecutive season that the Spartans have ranked in the top 15 nationally in attendance. Michigan State has had a total attendance of over 80,000 every season since 2005-06. The Spartans had their 15th-best crowd this season when 11,368 fans packed the Breslin Center as MSU defeated Michigan.

COLLEY EARNS PRESEASON HONOR

To kickoff the beginning of Big Ten Women's Basketball Media Week, the conference released the Preseason Coaches and Media Polls, in addition to the preseason All-Big Ten teams. Michigan State redshirtsenior guard Shay Colley earned Preseason All-Big Ten honors for the second-straight season.

The Spartans were voted to finish second by the Big Ten coaches and third by the media. This was MSU's highest preseason ranking since being voted to finish second by the coaches prior to the 2016-17 campaign.

MAGIC NUMBERS

In head coach Suzy Merchant's tenure, when two numbers on the scoreboard were achieved it typically has been a sign of a MSU win. MSU has won 142 of its last 160 games when scoring at least 70 points, and MSU is 160-27 (.856) under head coach Suzy Merchant when hanging at least 70 points on the scoreboard. The Spartans have reached the 70-point margin in all five games this season.

CLOSING OUT THE GAMES

The Spartans have been extremely effective closing out games over the last couple years, winning 198 of their last 210 games (.943) when leading with five minutes left, including 148 of their last 162. In Coach Merchant's tenure, Michigan State is 233-18 (.928) when holding a lead with five minutes left.

UP NEXT

After the Junkanoo Jam, the Spartans remain on the road to take on No. 12 Florida State on Dec. 5 at 8 p.m. in the ACC/B1G Challenge.

GAME FOUR REWIND: MSU 79, HARTFORD 34

Taryn McCutcheon and Julia Ayrault had 14 points apiece, as No. 15 Michigan State cruised to a 79-34 win over Hartford on Sunday afternoon at the Breslin Center.

Four Spartans were in double figures led by the 14 from McCutcheon and Ayrault, who set an new career high. Sophomore forward Kayla Belles earned her first career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds. Sophomore guard Nia Clouden also added added 12 points to go along with two steals.

Postgame Notes vs. Hartford

- MSU did not yield a 3-pointer to Hartford on Sunday, not only a season-low for the Spartan defense, but the first time of holding the opposition without a 3-pointer since Dec. 6, 2015 vs. Loyola Chicago (o-for-7).
- The Spartans had a +18 rebounding advantage (48-30), as they have

 Senior guard Taryn McCutcheon and freshman forward Julia Ayrault shared top-scoring honors for MSU with 14 points apiece ... Ayrault becomes the fourth different Spartan player to lead or share the scoring lead, as well as the third different Spartan to post a career-high when doing so.

SIGNING DAY

Michigan State women's basketball head coach Suzy Merchant announced the signing of Kendall Bostic (Kokomo, Indiana/Northwestern High School) to a National Letter of Intent.

Bostic is a 6-2 forward who plays for head coach Katie Layden at Northwestern High School in Kokomo, Indiana and AAU basketball for Tony Marlin and the Indiana Flight/Elite. Bostic is ranked No. 16 at her position and No. 67 overall by ESPN HoopGurlz. As a junior, Bostic averaged 18.7 points, 9.2 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game on 68 percent shooting from the field. Last season, Northwestern captured its second consecutive state championship, as Bostic earned State Championship Player of the Game accolades, along with AP First-Team All-State and Co-Player of the Year honors.

MICHIGAN STATE HEAD COACH SUZY MERCHANT



12th Season; Central Michigan '91 <u>Career Record: 471-254 (.650)</u> <u>Record at MSU: 270-134 (.668)</u>

Michigan State head Suzy Merchant has established herself as one of the premier coaches in MSU history. With nearly 500 career wins, Merchant has proven to be one of the best coaches in Michigan State history and a force in the Big Ten Conference. Entering her 13th season as head coach of the MSU women's basketball program, Merchant has brought the Spartan program to the upper echelon at the Big Ten and national level. The Spartans have finished third or better in the Big Ten in eight of the last 12 seasons, and her conference record of 127-77 (62.3%) is in the top-12 career winning percentage in the 35-year history of the Big Ten. The Spartans have won at least 20 games in 10 of her 12 seasons.

The Great Lakes State native was hired at MSU on April 30, 2007, after spending time as a head coach at Eastern Michigan (1998-07) and Saginaw Valley State (1995-98). In her 24 years as a head coach, she has won nearly 65 percent of her games, collecting a 466-254 (.647) career record, including 265-134 (.664) in 12 seasons in East Lansing. Merchant became the fastest Spartan coach to 100 wins. She is also the winningest coach in Eastern Michigan history, compiling a 147-91 record in her nine seasons.

Through her first 12 seasons at MSU, 43 Spartans have earned All-Big Ten recognition and 55 have been named Academic All-Big Ten. A pair of Spartans have earned major Big Ten awards - Kalisha Keane was the Big Ten Player of the Year in 2010-11, following up the Sixth

Player of the Year award as a junior, while Lykendra Johnson (2010-11) and Allyssa DeHaan (2009-10) were named Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year. DeHaan, who finished her career second all-time in NCAA history in blocked shots, and Keane were also named All-Americans following their senior seasons. In 2013-14, Aerial Powers became the first Spartan freshman to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Powers would go on to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors in 2014-15 and 2015-16, as well as being named an All-American both seasons. During the 2016-17 season, Tori Jankoska became the Spartan all-time leading scorer as well as earning first-team All-Big Ten and All-American honors.

Last season, the Spartans had some dazzling wins with victories over No. 3 Oregon and No. 16 Iowa, as MSU was 15-1 at the Breslin Center. Michigan State ended the season with a 21-12 overall record, going 9-9 in Big Ten play. The Spartans reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to national runner-up Notre Dame. Four Spartans earned All-Big Ten honors with Shay Colley picking up first-team honors by the coaches. Jenna Allen earned second-team accolades, as Nia Clouden captured honorable mention honors and was named to the All-Freshman team. Taryn McCutcheon rounded out the group with honorable mention honors.

The 2017-18 Spartans battled injuries throughout the season and still managed to make the Sweet 16 of the WNIT, ending the season with a 19-14 mark and a 7-9 Big Ten record. MSU earned its first-ever win over Maryland on Jan. 11. Four Spartans earned All-Big Ten honors: Branndais Agee, Allen, Colley and McCutcheon earned honorable mention honors. Once again, Michigan State continued to fill the Breslin Center, finishing 10th in the nation and second in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 5,689 fans per game.

During the 2016-17 season, Michigan State reached the NCAA Tournament with a 21-12 record, including going 9-7 in Big Ten action. The year was filled with more record-breaking performances as Jankoska became the first Spartan to score over 2,000 points. Four Spartans were honored with All-Big Ten honors. Jankoska was named first-team All-Big Ten, while Agee, Taya Reimer and McCutcheon were named to the honorable mention squad. MSU finished eighth in the nation and first in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 6,011 fans per game.

The 2015-16 season was a return to form for the Spartans, as MSU ended the season with a 25-9 overall record. Michigan State ended league play 13-5, which

was good for third place in the ultra-competative Big Ten Conference. Powers was once again named to the first team, while Tori Jankoska was named to the second team. Both Agee and Jasmine Hines earned honorable mention honors. Against Minnesota on Feb. 21, Merchant earned her 400th win as a head coach. The Spartans continue to pack the stands, finishing seventh in the NCAA in attendance with an average of 6,561 fans per game.

The 2014-15 Spartans suffered through an injury-plagued season, finishing 16-15 overall and 7-11 in Big Ten action. Powers and Jankoska earned All-Big Ten honors with Powers being named to the first team and Jankoska to the second. The Spartans finished 10th in the nation and second in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 6,119 fans per game.

In 2013-14, MSU captured a share of the Big Ten title with a 23-10 overall record and a stellar 13-3 league record. The Green and White posted its 11th-straight 20-win season. The Spartans qualified for the "Big Dance" for a school-record sixth-straight season, advancing to the second round. Powers was also named to the All-Freshman team, while Annalise Pickrel was named to the second-team, Klarissa Bell, Jankoska and Bella Mills picked up honorable mention honors.

Merchant has accumulated international experience as well during her time at MSU. In the summer of 2009, she spent time with USA Basketball as an assistant coach for the Women's World University Games team in Belgrade, Serbia. Team USA went undefeated and took home the Gold medal, topping Russia, 83-64 in the championship game. In the summer of 2019, Merchant was the head coach of the U.S. Pan American team that captured the silver medal in Lima, Peru. The team went 4-1, falling to Brazil in the championship game.

In all her years in the Greater Lansing area, Merchant has gone to great lengths to become an integral part of the community. In her time off the court and out of the office, Merchant can be seen at many community service events in the Great Lansing area. She has been an Honorary Chair for numerous events, including Ele's Place, Sparrow Foundation's Hike for Hospice, Women Working Wonders, MSU Children's Health Initiative, Women's Center of Lansing, Haven House, Ronald McDonald House, Advent House Ministries, Old Newsboys' Shoe and Coat Drive, and Muscular Dystrophy Association.

In 2016, Merchant helped create the EmpowHER Retreat. EmpowHER is designed to build confidence in girls by providing interactive workshops concentrated on the importance of self-empowerment, confidence, health and wellness and relationship building. In 2018, Merchant was honored with the ATHENA Leadership Award by the Lansing Regional Chamber of Commerce. The award honors individuals who strive towards the highest levels of professional accomplishment, who excel in their chosen field, have devoted time and energy to their community, and who pave paths for other women to follow.

A four-year starter and three-year captain at Central Michigan (1987-91), Merchant holds Chippewa records for assists with 463 and single-season assists with 156, and is tied for first in single-game assists with 11. She also finished her career third-best in made 3-point field goals with 75.

A native of Traverse City, Michigan, Merchant was a three-sport standout at Traverse City Central High School, lettering in basketball, volleyball and softball. She earned honorable mention All-America honors by USA Today and was a two-time Class A all-state selection in basketball. She also earned all-state honors in volleyball. During the summer of 2010, she was inducted into the Traverse City Central H.S. Hall of Fame.
