#### **ABOUT THE SPARTANS**

Michigan State is off to a 4-5 start in dual action, with wins over No. 20 Oklahoma, Kent State, Duke and Wyoming. The Spartans are led by redshirt junior Jake Tucker at 157 pounds, who leads the team with 18 wins. A native of Lowell, Indiana, Tucker holds six wins in the dual slate. Tucker claimed a first-place finish at the Navy Classic, tallying a 5-0 record and capping the title with an 8-3 win over Ohio's Zac Carson in the final.

Redshirt sophomore Cameron Caffey, who has three top-5 finishes in tournament action, including a secondplace finish at the Cougar Clash, holds a 16-6 record and leads the team with seven falls at 184 pounds. Caffey is 7-2 in duals with his losses coming to No. 16 Zach Carlson of South Dakota State and Billy Janzer of Rutgers. Redshirt junior Christian Rebottaro is 6-3 in duals and holds a 13-8 record overall at 285 pounds for the Spartans.

Redshirt freshman Layne Malczewski is tied for second on the team with 16 wins, including a 2-1 mark in B1G action. Malczweski ranks No. 24 by TrackWrestling and TheOpenMat at 174 pounds and has third-place finishes at the Navy Classic and Cougar Clash. Malczewski is coming off an 11-10 decision over No. 19 Joe Grello of Rutgers on Jan. 12. Redshirt junior Drew Hughes, a two-time NCAA Qualifier, holds a 11-6 record on the season with six dual wins and ranks No. 26 by TheOpenMat. Hughes won by decision over Tyler Meisiner of Michigan, 6-0, on Jan. 10, finishing with 5:44 of riding time.

#### **ABOUT THE TERRAPINS**

The Spartans take on Maryland on Sunday for just the sixth time, with the Spartans holding a 4-1 record in the all-time series. MSU recorded a dominant 28-12 win over the Terrapins in their last meeting on Jan. 27, 2019 at Maryland. Six Spartans claimed wins in the bout, including a fall by redshirt junior Drew Hughes and a tech fall by redshirt sophomore Cameron Caffey.

Maryland enters the weekend with a 2-8 record and wins over Southern Virginia and Fresno State. Maryland dropped a 34-3 decision to Michigan on Friday, Jan. 17 in Ann Arbor. Philip Spadafora collected Maryland's lone win at 174 pounds, with a 5-3 decision over Max Maylor, improving to 13-7 on the season.

The Terrapins are led by All-American and four-time NCAA Qualifer Alex Clemsen in his first year at the helm. Philip Spadafora (13-7, 3-5 duals) ranks No. 23 by FloWrestling at 174 pounds and Jaron Smith (7-6, 4-4) ranks No. 29 by TrackWrestling at 197 pounds. Lucas Cordio leads the Terrapins with 13 wins at 157 pounds

#### SPARTANS FALL IN B1G OPENER TO NO. 25 MICHIGAN

Michigan State wrestling's late rally fell short to No. 25 Michigan, falling 22-14 in front of a sold out Cliff Keen Arena on Friday, Jan. 10 in Ann Arbor.

The Wolverines raced out to a 16-0 lead with five-straight wins. MSU answered with four-consecutive wins at 165, 174, 184 and 197 pounds to cut Michigan's lead to two, 16-14, with one match to go. No. 3 Mason Parris sealed the 22-14 win with a fall over redshirt junior Christian Rebottaro 29 seconds into the match.

Redshirt Junior Drew Hughes started a four-match win streak for th Spartans at 165 pounds, claiming a 6-0 decision over Tyler Meisinger with 5:44 riding time. Redshirt freshman Layne Malczewski added his 15th win of the season with a 7-2 decision over Max Maylor at 174 pounds and redshirt sophomore Cameron Caffey continued his dominant wrestling with nine takedowns on his way to a 23-8 tech fall win over Bobby Striggow. At 197 pounds, redshirt junior Nick May put together one of his best performances of the season, reeling off a 5-2 decision over Jackson Striggow.

#### TUCKER CLAIMS TITLE AT NAVY CLASSIC, 2ND AT COUGAR CLASH

Redshirt junior Jake Tucker raced out to a hot start to begin the 2019-20 season, collecting an individual title at the Navy Classic on Nov. 23 in Annapolis,Md., followed by a second-place finish at the Cougar Clash on Decc. 7 in Edwardsville, Ill. After starting the season with a fourth-place finish, Tucker reeled off seven-straight wins on his way to the Navy Classic title. Tucker bested Zac Carson of Ohio, 8-3, in the Navy Classic final. At the Cougar Clash, Tucker knocked off No. 21 Justin Ruffin of SIUE in the semifinals, before falling to No. 14 Jarrett Jacques of Missouri in the final.

#### **SPARTANS TO WATCH**

#### Redshirt Junior Jake Tucker - 157 pounds

After suffering a knee injury a day before the Big Ten Championships in 2018-19 that kept him off the mat for the remainder of the season, Tucker has bounced back in a big way in 2019-20. Tucker, who finished 21-13 and 9-9 in dual play last season, is off to an 18-5 start in 2019-20. Tucker has been balanced all season, and has secured a title at the Navy Classic and two top-5 finishes at both the Cougar Clash and MSU Open.

#### Redshirt Sophomore Cameron Caffey - 184 pounds

One of three NCAA Qualifiers from 2018-19, Caffey ended his freshman season with a stellar 32-9 record and 13-5 mark in the Big Ten. A CoSIDA All-American and computer engineering major, Caffey joined sophomore Rayvon Foley and redshirt sophomore Drew Hughes at the NCAA Championships. Caffey went 2-2 at NCAA's, with wins over No. 16 Dylan Wisman (Missouri), 7-5, and Will Schany of Virginia, 7-3. Caffey is off to a 16-6

start to the 2019-20 season and leads the team with seven falls and and 7-2 mark in duals. Caffey claimed top-5 finishes at the MSU Open (5th), the Navy Classic (3rd) and the Cougar Clash (2nd).

#### • Redshirt senior Garrett Pepple - 133 pounds

A transfer from Indiana, Pepple joins the Spartans for the 2019-20 season. Pepple competed four years for the Hoosiers, compiling a 50-53 record. Pepple brings experience and leadership to the program, as he is one of only two seniors on this year's team. Pepple has captured two third-place finishes at both the Navy Classic and Cougar Clash and is 13-9 overall and 3-5 in duals. Pepple is coming off an 11-0 major decision win over Brent Jones of Minnesota on Jan. 17. Many of Pepple's matches have come down to the wire, as five of his losses have been decided by two or fewer points. Of his nine losses, five are to top-15 opponents.

#### • Redshirt junior Drew Hughes - 165 pounds

Hughes looks to become a three-time NCAA Qualifier in 2020 after a 26-15 finish in 2018-19. Hughes qualified for the NCAA Championships as a true freshman, where he compiled a 3-2 record and became the first true freshman to make the NCAA's since 2011. Hughes is off to a 11-6 start at 165 pounds, and holds a 6-2 record in duals and 2-1 clip in B1G. Three of Hughes' six losses are to top-25 opponents. Hughes finished second at the Cougar Clash and sixth at the Navy Classic this season.

#### • Redshirt freshman Layne Malczewski - 174 pounds

A native of Macomb, Michigan, Malczewski jumped into the Spartan lineup to begin the season and hasn't looked back. Malczewski has won four of his last five and is coming off an 11-10 win over No. 19 Joe Grello of Rutgers on Jan. 12. Malczewski is 2-1 in the B1G and has won seven of his last nine matches. Malczewski went 11-2 during his redshirt-freshman campaign for the Green and White in open tournaments.

#### CHANDLER IN FOURTH YEAR AS HEAD COACH

Michigan State head coach Roger Chandler is in his 23rd season on the Spartan wrestling staff, but his fourth as head coach, taking over the reins of the MSU program from longtime head coach Tom Minkel, who directed the program since 1991, and retired following his 25th season at Michigan State in 2015-16.

In 2018-19, Chandler led the Spartans to a 10-8 record and a 33rd place finish at the 2019 NCAA Team Championships, marking the best finish since 2002-03 for head coach Roger Chandler in his third season at the helm. Chandler guided sophomore Rayvon Foley to a seventh-place finish at the NCAA Championships. Foley earned All-America honors for the Spartans, the first to do so since 2014. Along with Foley, redshirt sophomore Drew Hughes and redshirt freshman Cameron Caffey were national qualifiers for the Spartans under Chandler's guidance.

Chandler has helped produce 10 different All-Americans and six Big Ten Champions for a total of 22 All-America selections and nine Big Ten individual titles during his time at Michigan State. He also coached three-time All-American Franklin Gomez, who won a national title in 2009 at 133 pounds

In his first season as head coach, Chandler led the Spartans to a 10th-place finish at Big Ten Championships, the team's best finish since 2012. MSU's 38.5 points at the meet was their highest total since 2012, showing the signs of the program's progress in Chandler's first year acting as head coach. The Spartans also qualified three for NCAA Championships for the first time since 2013 in Chandler's first year at the helm of the program.

In year two, Michigan State improved their record in dual meets to 6-11 and brought 12 freshman into the program. MSU continues to rebuild with 16 freshman on the roster in 2018-19.

#### **SPARTAN ASSISTANT COACHES**

- Former Spartan All-American **Chris Williams** is in the fourth year of his second stint on the MSU staff as an assistant coach. Williams had served as the head wrestling coach at Adrian College since November 2014, where he restarted the program and led the Bulldogs in their first season of competition in 31 years in 2015-16. He previously was an assistant coach at Michigan State, along with Chandler, for eight seasons (2005-13).
- Former Central Michigan All-American and U.S. Senior Nationals Champion **Wynn Michalak** enters his fourth as Spartans' assistant wrestling coach. One of the most successful wrestlers in Central Michigan history, Michalak was a four-time Mid-American Conference Champion (2005-08), three-time MAC Wrestler of the Year (2006-08), and a three-time NCAA All-American (2005, 2006, 2008), including a runner-up finish at 197 pounds in 2008. He won the 2015 U.S. Senior Nationals title at 97 kg/213 pounds on Dec. 19, 2015, in Las Vegas, and competed in the past two U.S. Olympic wrestling trials.

#### MILKOVICH INDUCTED INTO MSU HALL OF FAME

Former wrestling standout Tom Milkovich was among five Spartans inducted into the Michigan State Athletics Hall of Fame on Thursday, Oct. 24. Milkovich was joined in the 2019 Hall of Fame Class by Dan Bass (football), Karen Dennis (track & field), Mike Donnelly (hockey) and Mike Robinson (men's basketball). Milkovich etched his name in the record books during his time at Michigan State from 1969-73, claiming a national championship in 1972 at 142 pounds and earning four Big Ten Tournament titles after going undefeated in all four years of wrestling in Big Ten action. Milkovich was only the third wrestler to accomplish that feat at the time and pres-

ently only 16 wrestlers have won four Big Ten titles. Prior to his fourth conference championship crown in 1973, no one had been a four-time winner since 1950. No one was again until 1981.

#### PEYTON OMANIA CLAIMS BRONZE AT GRECO-ROMAN JUNIOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Michigan State wrestler Peyton Omania claimed the 67kg bronze medal on Sunday, Aug. 18, at the Greco-Roman Junior World Championships in Tallinn, Estonia. Omania became the first Spartan wrestler to earn a World medal since Franklin Gomez's silver medal at the 2011 World Championships in Istanbul..

Omania, who elected to take an Olympic redshirt for the 2019-20 season to train for the 2020 Olympics, put together an impressive run to the semifinals at the Junior World Championships. In his first of five matches on the day, Omania opened with a 13-5 tech fall against Jaekwon Lee of Korea in the Round of 64 and never looked back. Omania came out hot in his Round of 32 match against Italy's Ignazio Sanfilippo, scoring a headlock and arm throw in the first two minutes on his way to a 13-3 win and a spot in the Round of 16.

Omania, who made his third World Championships appearance in Tallinn, faced off against bronz Xin Huang of China in the bronze medal match. The 2018 U.S. Junior World Team member jumped out to a quick 4-0 lead over Huang, capitalizing on a headlock throw. After racing to a 6-1 lead, Huang battled back to cut the lead to one at 6-5. Omania remained strong and finished out the match on top, winning 6-5 to claim the bronze.

#### WRESTLING CLAIMS THIRD PLACE FINISHES AT NAVY CLASSIC AND COUGAR CLASH

Michigan State wrestling placed six wrestlers in the top six, including Jake Tucker winning his weight class to go with three third-place finishers at the 42nd Annual Navy Classic on Saturday, Nov. 23 on its way to a third-place finish in the team standings.

MSU finished with 99 team points in the 18-team field at the Navy Classic, behind second-place Campbell with 107 points and first-place finisher and No. 16-ranked Virginia Tech who captured the team crown with 116 points. The Spartans finish in the top three for the second-straight year after taking the title in 2018. A total of 10 Spartans reached the championship quarterfinals and six advanced to the semifinals.

Michigan State's wrestling team wrapped up action at the Cougar Clash Invite with its second-consecutive third-place finish of the season, on Saturday, Dec. 7, inside Southern Illinois-Edwardsville's Vadalabene Center

The Spartans finished in third place with 114.5 points behind No. 19-ranked Missouri (138.5) and No. 8 Wisconsin (121.5). MSU had nine wrestlers finish in the top 4, including a trio of second-place finishes from redshirt junior Jake Tucker at 157 pounds, redshirt junior Drew Hughes at 165 pounds and redshirt junior Christian Rebottaro at 285 pounds. Redshirt sophomore Cameron Caffey compiled a 3-1 record in the 184 pound round robin bracket.




