BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- Four Big Ten programs are in action Sunday, including three (Ohio State, Purdue and Wisconsin) who will be making their 2020-21 debuts. In addition, No. 12/11 Maryland closes out the #BeachBubble at the Gulf Coast Showcase with its second consecutive Top 25 opponent, facing 14th-ranked Arkansas.
- Offense has been the story in the Big Ten through the opening week of the 2020-21 season. Conference teams have scored at least 80 points in seven of 10 games thus far (and Michigan State scored 77 points in its season-opening win over Saint Francis-Pa. on Friday), highlighted by five 90-point games.
- Led by a career-high 35 points from Big Ten Preseason Co-Player of the Year Naz Hillmon, No. 25/24 Michigan rolled to its second straight 90-point performance, a 95-62 win at Oakland on Friday. It's the first time the Wolverines have scored 90 points in back-to-back games since Nov. 11-18, 2016, when they opened the season with three consecutive 100-point outings.
- Several Big Ten freshmen made a splash in their collegiate debuts this week. Iowa's Caitlin Clark led the way with a game-high 27 points in Wednesday's win over Northern Iowa, believed to be the most by a conference freshman in her first game since Dec. 1, 1992, when Illinois' Robin Preacely scored 27 against Illinois State. Maryland's Angel Reese scored 20 points Friday in the Terrapins' season-opening win over Davidson, while Michigan State's Kendall Bostic and Rutgers' Diamond Johnson both scored 15 points Friday in victories over Saint Francis (Pa.) and Monmouth, respectively.
- Indiana's Mackenzie Holmes tied a Big Ten record Wednesday, going 13-for-13 from the field to help the No. 16/15 Hoosiers to a 100-51 win over visiting Eastern Kentucky. The only other Big Ten player to go 13-for-13 from the field was Iowa All-America center Megan Gustafson, who pulled off the feat on Nov. 13, 2018, at Western Kentucky.
- Holmes' teammate, Grace Berger, tallied the first triple-double in Indiana women's basketball history on Wednesday with 17 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists. Berger also recorded the 29th triple-double in Big Ten history and first since Jan. 23, 2018 (Illinois' Alex Wittinger at Penn State).
- Iowa scored 38 points in the third quarter of its 96-81 win over UNI on Wednesday. It tied for the third-most points in a single quarter in Big Ten history (the quarter system was introduced in NCAA women's basketball in 2015-16) and the most by a conference team since Nov. 13, 2016, when Penn State scored a conference-record 39 points in the first quarter of its 106-50 win over Saint Peter's.
- With Wednesday's win over UNI, Iowa also extended its home winning streak to 37 games, the second-longest active string in the nation behind Baylor (57). The Hawkeyes' run began on Feb. 4, 2018, with a 92-84 win over Minnesota.
- The Big Ten shared top honors among all conferences with five Top 25 teams in both the Associated Press and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today preseason polls (plus two others receiving votes). Both polls can be found in full on page 2 of this update.
- On Nov. 23, the Big Ten released its 2020-21 conference schedule, which will see schools play 20 Big Ten games, up two from the previous two seasons. Schools will play seven opponents twice (home and away) and the other six once (three at home and three on the road). To account for the additional games and preserve flexibility in the schedule, the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament has been moved to March 9-13 and will continue to be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.
- For the 13th consecutive season, Big Ten women's basketball honored more than 45 Academic All-Big Ten standouts as a record-setting 87 women's basketball students were recognized in 2019-20.
